Indeks Pelopor terus bertumbuh 3.2 peratus pada Januari 2024, menjangkakan prestasi ekonomi yang lebih menggalakkan pada bulan-bulan akan datang

PUTRAJAYA, 25 Mac 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **Penunjuk Ekonomi Malaysia: Indeks Pelopor, Serentak & Susulan bagi Januari 2024**. Indeks Pelopor (IP) ialah alat yang digunakan untuk meramalkan arah aliran ekonomi secara purata empat hingga enam bulan ke hadapan.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Perubahan tahunan IP meneruskan momentum peningkatan dengan mencatatkan pertumbuhan 3.2 peratus kepada 112.0 mata pada Januari 2024 berbanding 108.5 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya **(Paparan I)**. Peningkatan ini dipacu terutamanya oleh kenaikan kukuh dalam Bilangan Syarikat Baru Didaftar (38.1%) dan Import Benar Logam Asas Berharga & Logam Bukan Ferus Lain (31.4%). Merujuk kepada prestasi bulanan, IP mencatatkan 1.6 peratus pada bulan rujukan berbanding 0.3 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya berikutan prestasi yang memberangsangkan dalam Import Benar Logam Asas Berharga & Logam Bukan Ferus Lain (0.7%)”.

Dari segi arah aliran jangka panjang terlicin pada Januari 2024, IP kekal di bawah trend 100.0 mata. Meskipun masih berada di bawah trend, lonjakan dalam prestasi IP menjangkakan pertumbuhan ekonomi yang lebih menggalakkan dalam tempoh terdekat susulan pemulihan dalam perdagangan luar **(Paparan II)**.

Berhubung keadaan ekonomi semasa, Indeks Serentak (IS) mengekalkan pertumbuhan positifnya sejak September 2021 dengan mencatatkan 124.1 mata, meningkat 3.2 peratus berbanding 120.2 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh prestasi yang baik bagi semua komponen. Prestasi bulanan IS pulih semula kepada 0.2 peratus berbanding negatif 0.2 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya, didorong oleh Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian dan Kapasiti Penggunaan dalam Pembuatan, masing-masing menyumbang 0.3 peratus.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah melancarkan OpenDOSM NextGen sebagai medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

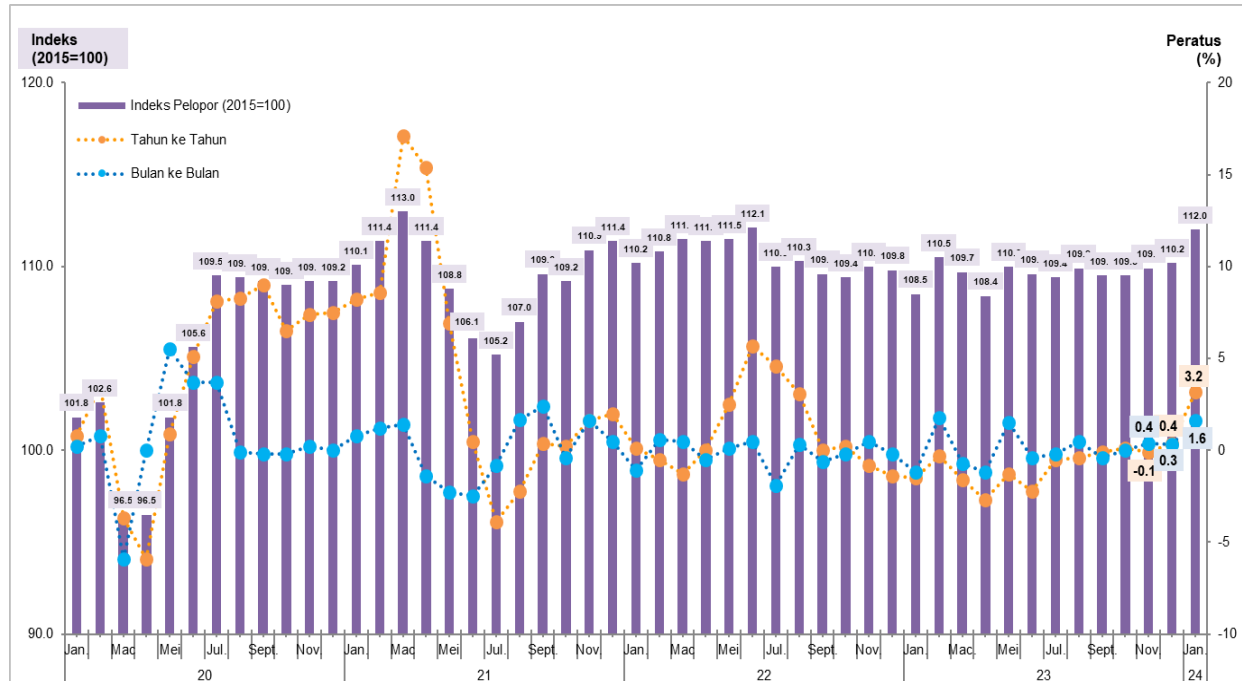

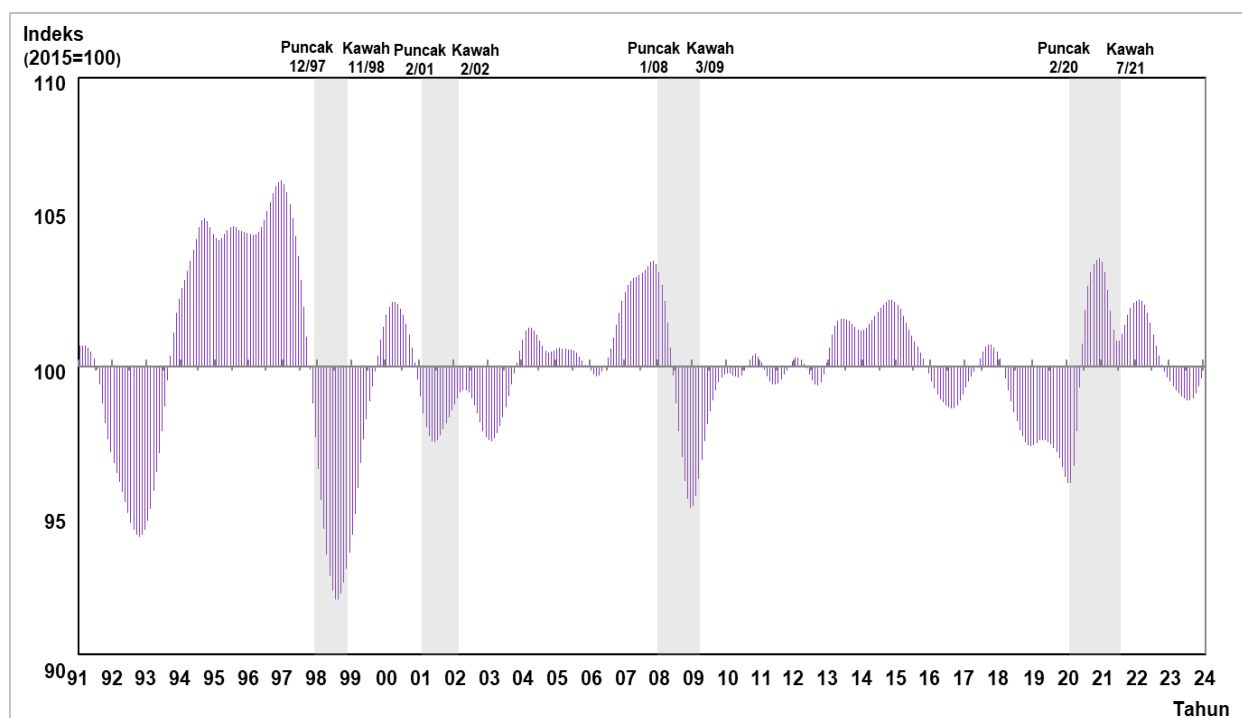

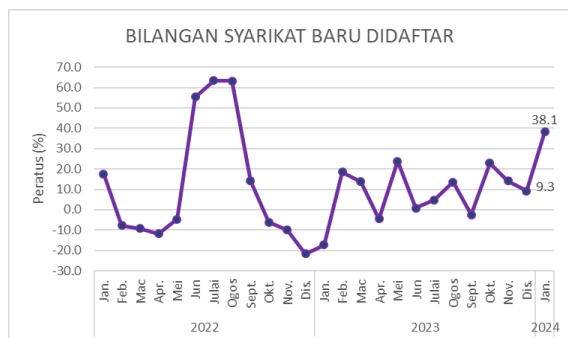
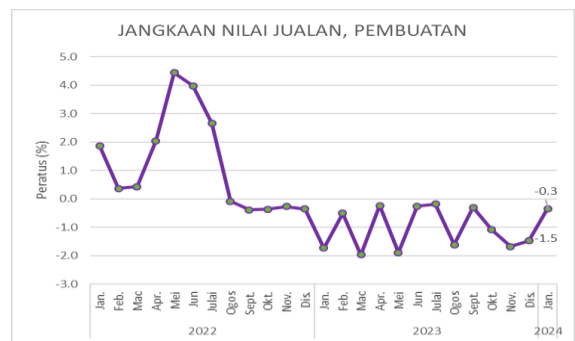
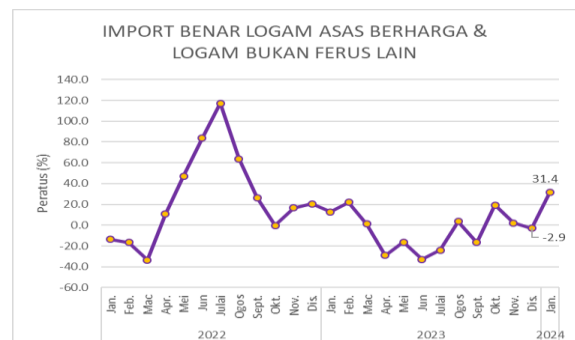
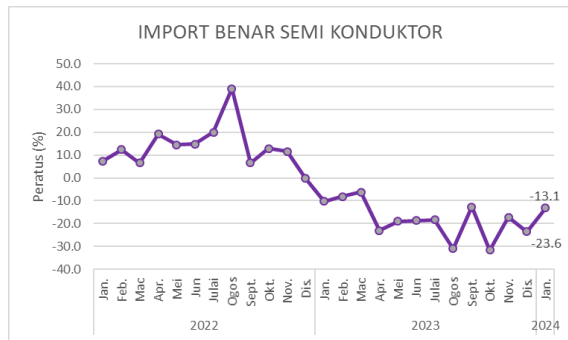
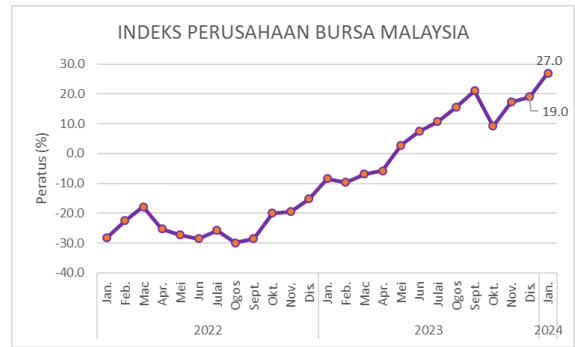
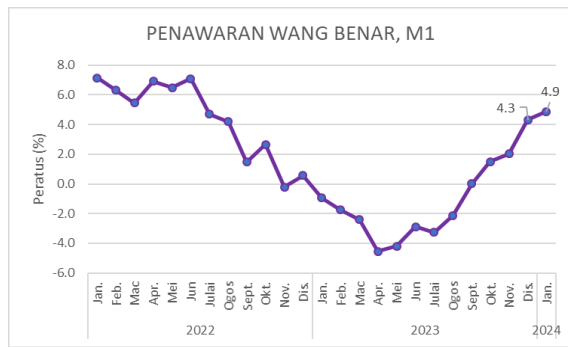
Paparan I: Indeks Komposit Pelopor

The Leading Index continues to grow by 3.2 per cent in January 2024, expecting a more encouraging economic performance in the coming months

PUTRAJAYA, March 25, 2024 - Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia released the **Malaysian Economic Indicators: Leading, Coincident & Lagging Indexes for January 2024**. The Leading Index (LI) is a tool utilised for predicting economic trends for an average of four to six months ahead.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The annual change of the LI continued its uptick momentum with a growth of 3.2 per cent to 112.0 points in January 2024 as compared to 108.5 points in the same month of the previous year **(Exhibit I)**. This improvement was primarily supported by a sturdy gain in the Number of New Companies Registered (38.1%) and Real Imports of Other Basic Precious & Other Non-ferrous Metals (31.4%). Referring to the monthly performance, LI recorded 1.6 per cent in the reference month as against 0.3 per cent in the preceding month, owing to favourable performance in the Real Imports of Other Basic Precious & Other Non-ferrous Metals (0.7%)".

In terms of the smoothed long-term trend in January 2024, the LI remained below the 100.0 points trend. Although it is still below the trend, the surge in the LI performance anticipates a more encouraging economic growth in the near term following the rebound in the external trade **(Exhibit II)**.

In view of the current economic situation, the Coincident Index (CI) continued its positive growth since September 2021 by registering 124.1 points, rose by 3.2 per cent as

compared to 120.2 points in the same month of the previous year. The increase was contributed by the good performance of all components. The monthly performance of the CI turnaround to 0.2 per cent as compared to negative 0.2 per cent in the previous month, driven by the Industrial Production Index and Capacity Utilisation in Manufacturing, accounting for 0.3 per cent respectively.

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index

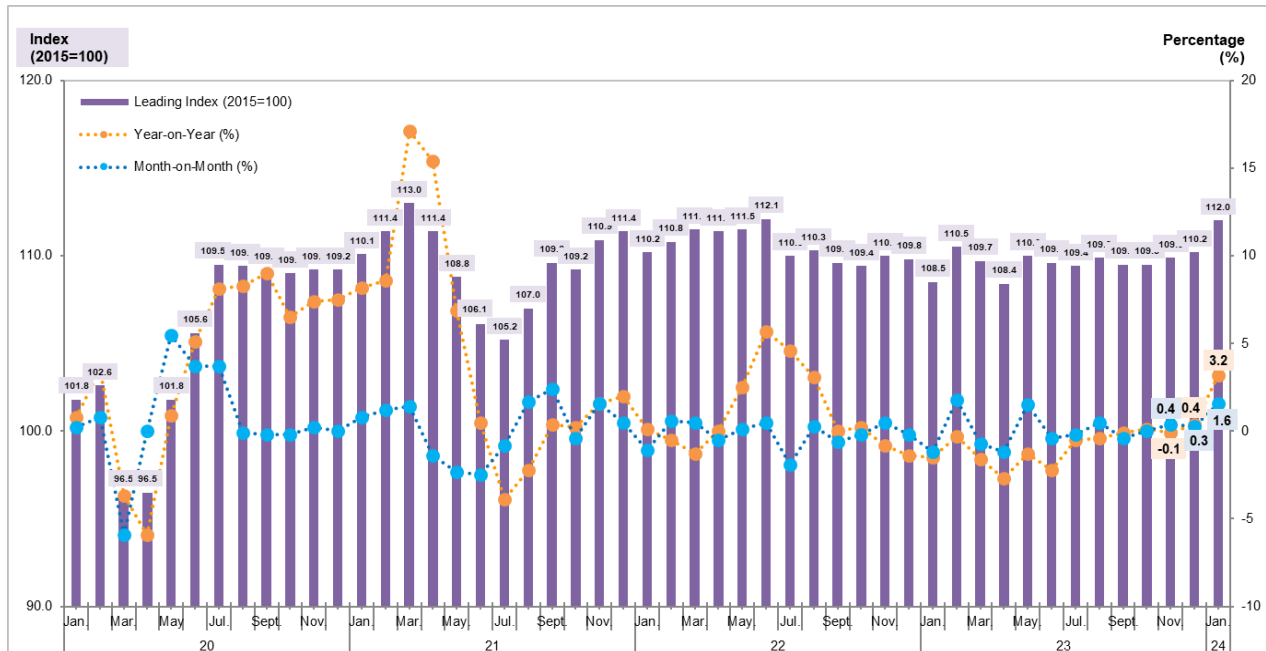


Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle

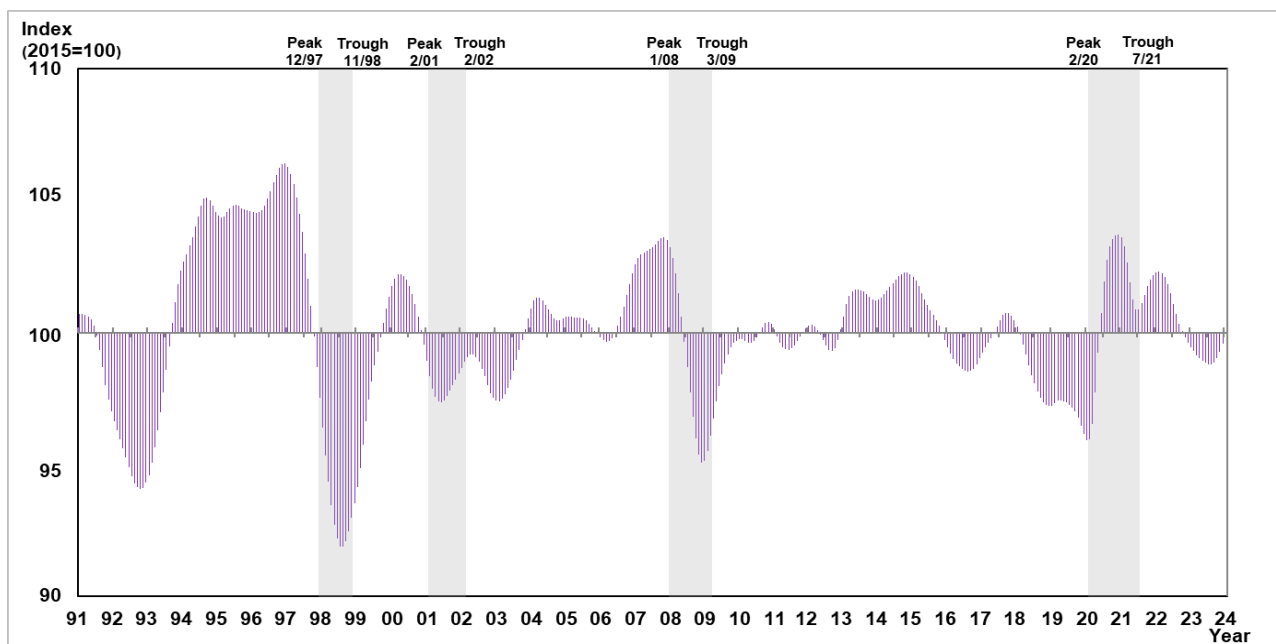


Exhibit III: Annual Changes of Leading Index Components
