KENYATAAN MEDIA BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI FEBRUARI 2024

PULAU PINANG, JOHOR DAN SELANGOR MENYUMBANG 67.2 PERATUS DARIPADA EKSPORT PADA BULAN FEBRUARI 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 27 Mac 2024 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM211.8 bilion pada Februari 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM111.3 bilion dan RM100.5 bilion. seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI FEBRUARI 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport Malaysia pada Februari 2024 bernilai RM111.3 bilion, menurun sebanyak RM939.5 juta (-0.8%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (-RM2.2 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM1.2 bilion), Johor (-RM658.5 juta), Sabah (-RM368.4 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM343.7 juta), Kelantan (-RM182.9 juta), Melaka (-RM156.4 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM139.8 juta) dan Perlis (-RM15.9 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport meningkat di Sarawak sebanyak RM2.1 bilion, Selangor (+RM460.3 juta), Perak (+RM446.2 juta), Pahang (+RM390.8 juta), Terengganu (+RM361.4 juta) dan Kedah (+RM234.6 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 28.0 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (21.1%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (10.6%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Februari 2024 meningkat RM7.8 bilion (+8.4%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM2.3 bilion), Selangor (+RM1.2 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM1.1 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.0 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.0 bilion), Sarawak (+RM599.6 juta), Johor (+RM426.9 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM285.4 juta), Sabah (+RM281.6 juta) dan Perak (+RM155.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Melaka sebanyak RM621.5 juta, Pahang (-RM171.8 juta), Kelantan (-RM34.8 juta), Perlis (-RM27.2 juta) dan Terengganu (-RM23.6 juta).

Selangor terus mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 25.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (24.4%), Pulau Pinang (20.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (8.1%) dan Kedah (5.6%).





**PULAU PINANG, JOHOR AND SELANGOR CONTRIBUTED
67.2 PER CENT OF EXPORTS IN FEBRUARY 2024**

PUTRAJAYA, 27 March 2024 – Malaysia's total trade for February 2024 amounted to RM211.8 billion with exports and imports recorded RM111.3 billion and RM100.5 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE FEBRUARY 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM111.3 billion in February 2024, decreased RM939.5 million (-0.8%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in exports was attributed to the lower exports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (-RM2.2 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM1.2 billion), Johor (-RM658.5 million), Sabah (-RM368.4 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM343.7 million), Kelantan (-RM182.9 million), Melaka (-RM156.4 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM139.8 million) and Perlis (-RM15.9 million). However, exports increased in Sarawak by RM2.1 billion, Selangor (+RM460.3 million), Perak (+RM446.2 million), Pahang (+RM390.8 million), Terengganu (+RM361.4 million) and Kedah (+RM234.6 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 28.0 per cent share, followed by Johor (21.1%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (10.6%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in February 2024 increased RM7.8 billion (+8.4%) as compared to the same month in 2023. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such

as W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM2.3 billion), Selangor (+RM1.2 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM1.1 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.0 billion), Kedah (+RM1.0 billion), Sarawak (+RM599.6 million), Johor (+RM426.9 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM285.4 million), Sabah (+RM281.6 million) and Perak (+RM155.7 million). However, imports decreased in Melaka by RM621.5 million, Pahang (-RM171.8 million), Kelantan (-RM34.8 million), Perlis (-RM27.2 million) and Terengganu (-RM23.6 million).

Selangor continued to dominate Malaysia's imports with a share of 25.3 per cent, followed by Johor (24.4%), Pulau Pinang (20.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (8.1%) and Kedah (5.6%).

Chart 1: Time Series Data on Exports and Imports in Johor, Pulau Pinang and Selangor, February 2023 – February 2024 (RM Billion)




Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, February 2024
