JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN PADA BULAN MAC 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 26 April 2024 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM244.5 bilion pada Mac 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM128.6 bilion dan RM115.8 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI MAC 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport Malaysia pada Mac 2024 bernilai RM128.6 bilion, menurun sebanyak RM1.0 bilion (-0.8%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Selangor (-RM2.1 bilion), W.P. Labuan (-RM1.6 bilion), Melaka (-RM686.2 juta), Sabah (-RM443.8 juta), Sarawak (-RM260.9 juta), Pulau Pinang (-RM129.8 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM118.5 juta), Johor (-RM44.6 juta) dan Perlis (-RM27.0 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport meningkat di Perak sebanyak RM1.5 bilion, W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.3 bilion), Terengganu (+RM929.9 juta), Pahang (+RM522.0 juta), Kedah (+RM151.7 juta) dan Kelantan (+RM36.2 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 32.0 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (20.0%), Selangor (16.9%), Sarawak (8.1%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.5%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Mac 2024 meningkat RM12.9 bilion (+12.5%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (+RM8.2 bilion), Melaka (+RM1.6 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.2 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.0 bilion), Selangor (+RM996.7 juta), Kedah (+RM419.7 juta), Pahang (+RM152.6 juta), Terengganu (+RM92.1 juta), Kelantan (+RM71.0 juta), Sabah (+RM55.5 juta) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM30.3 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Pulau Pinang sebanyak RM521.9 juta, Perak (-RM393.8 juta), Sarawak (-RM115.9 juta) dan Perlis (-RM6.8 juta).

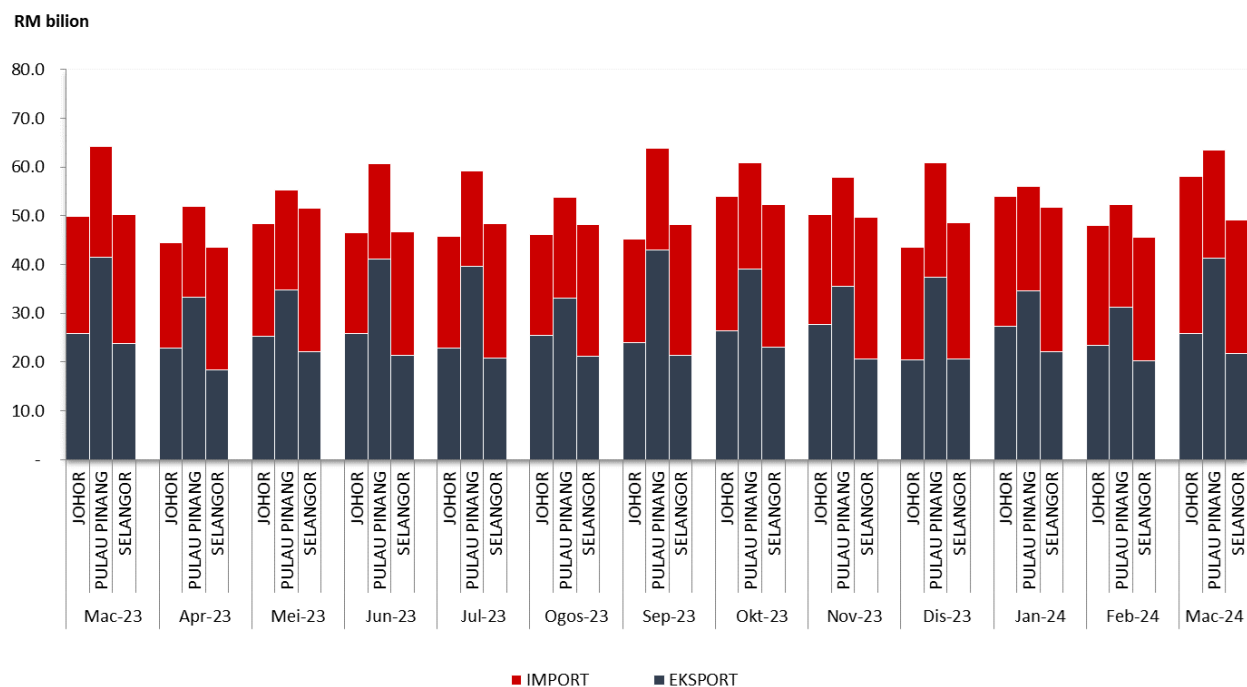
Johor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 27.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Selangor (23.6%), Pulau Pinang (19.2%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.5%) dan Kedah (5.0%).

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE MARCH 2024

FIVE STATES CONTRIBUTED 81.2 PER CENT FROM TOTAL TRADE IN MARCH 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 26 April 2024 – Malaysia's total trade for March 2024 amounted to RM244.5 billion with exports and imports recorded RM128.6 billion and RM115.8 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE MARCH 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM128.6 billion in March 2024, decreased RM1.0 billion (-0.8%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in exports was attributed to the lower exports in most states such as Selangor (-RM2.1 billion), W.P. Labuan (-RM1.6 billion), Melaka (-RM686.2 million), Sabah (-RM443.8 million), Sarawak (-RM260.9 million), Pulau Pinang (-RM129.8 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM118.5 million), Johor (-RM44.6 million) and Perlis (-RM27.0 million). However, exports increased in Perak by RM1.5 billion, W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.3 billion), Terengganu (+RM929.9 million), Pahang (+RM522.0 million), Kedah (+RM151.7 million) and Kelantan (+RM36.2 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 32.0 per cent share, followed by Johor (20.0%), Selangor (16.9%), Sarawak (8.1%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.5%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in March 2024 increased RM12.9 billion (+12.5%) as compared to the same month in 2023. The increase in imports was attributed to the higher imports in most states such as Johor (+RM8.2 billion), Melaka (+RM1.6 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.2 billion),

W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.0 billion), Selangor (+RM996.7 million), Kedah (+RM419.7 million), Pahang (+RM152.6 million), Terengganu (+RM92.1 million), Kelantan (+RM71.0 million), Sabah (+RM55.5 million) and W.P. Labuan (+RM30.3 million). However, imports decreased in Pulau Pinang by RM521.9 million, Perak (-RM393.8 million), Sarawak (-RM115.9 million) and Perlis (-RM6.8 million).

Johor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 27.9 per cent, followed by Selangor (23.6%), Pulau Pinang (19.2%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.5%) and Kedah (5.0%).

Chart 1: Time Series Data on Exports and Imports in Johor, Pulau Pinang and Selangor, March 2023 – March 2024 (RM Billion)

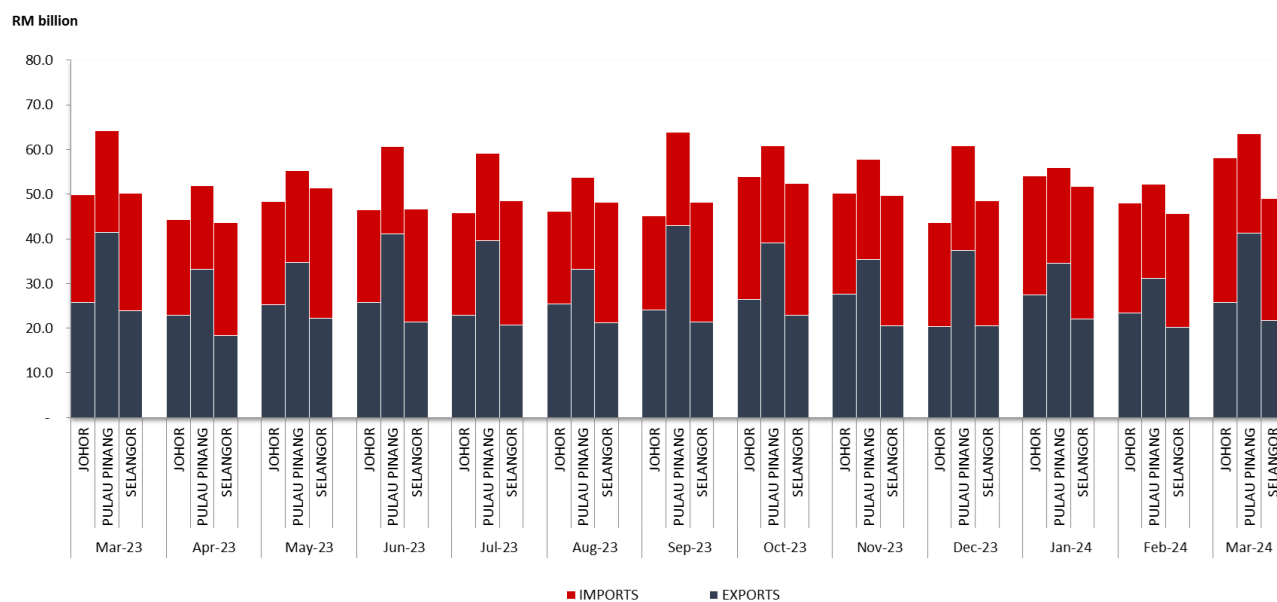


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, March 2024
