LIMA NEGERI MENCATATKAN SUMBANGAN 80.9 PERATUS DARIPADA JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN PADA BULAN APRIL 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 Mei 2024 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM221.7 bilion pada April 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM114.7 bilion dan RM107.0 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI APRIL 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport bernilai RM114.7 bilion pada April 2024, meningkat sebanyak RM9.5 bilion (+9.1%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Selangor (+RM3.0 bilion), Sarawak (+RM2.1 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM1.4 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.0 bilion), Perak (+RM894.4 juta), Terengganu (+RM826.4 juta), Sabah (+RM669.2 juta), Johor (+RM534.0 juta), Kelantan (+RM164.9 juta) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM7.2 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di Kedah sebanyak RM669.7 juta, Pahang (-RM377.0 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM125.6 juta), Perlis (-RM26.7 juta) dan Melaka (-RM25.6 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 30.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (20.4%), Selangor (18.5%), Sarawak (8.2%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.7%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan April 2024 meningkat RM14.5 bilion (+15.6%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Selangor (+RM4.0 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM3.6 bilion), Johor (+RM1.6 bilion), Melaka (+RM1.3 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.2 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM770.8 juta), Pahang (+RM532.9 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM520.9 juta), Sarawak (+RM479.4 juta), Perak (+RM228.3 juta), Terengganu (+RM125.8 juta), Sabah (+RM121.1 juta) dan Perlis (+RM9.6 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di W.P. Labuan sebanyak RM41.1 juta dan Kelantan (-RM19.3 juta).

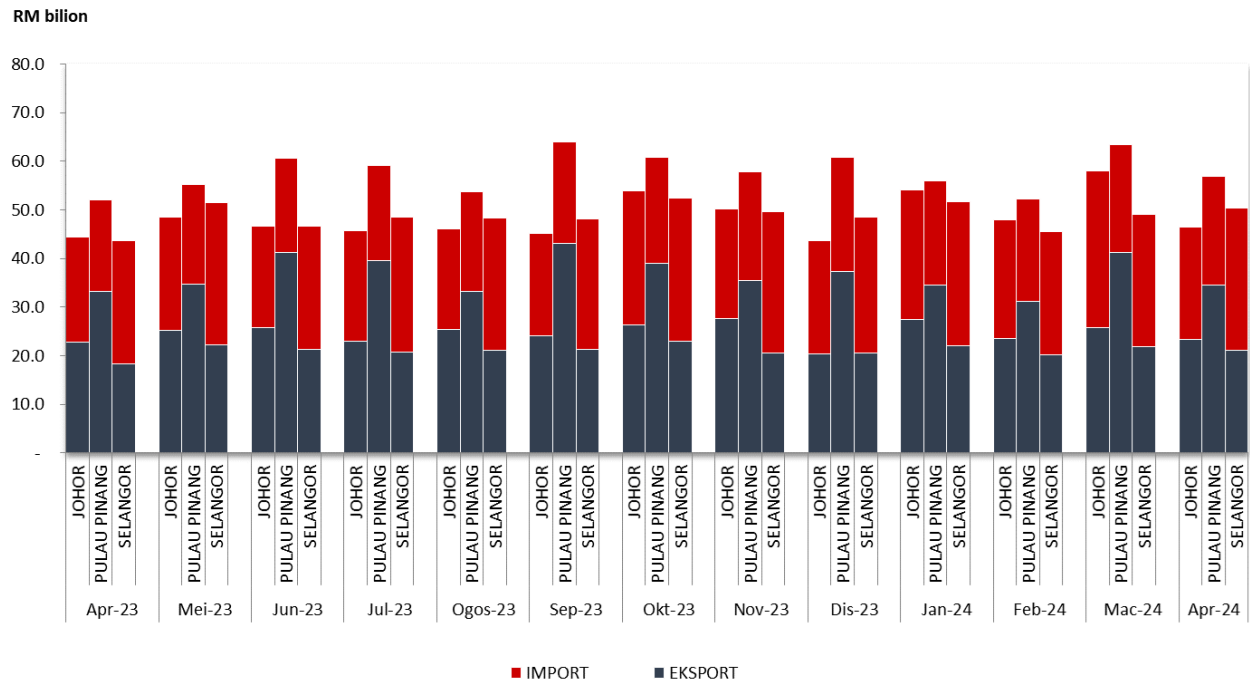
Selangor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 27.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (21.6%), Pulau Pinang (21.0%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.5%) dan Kedah (5.9%).

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE APRIL 2024

FIVE STATES REGISTERED A CONTRIBUTION OF 80.9 PER CENT FROM TOTAL TRADE IN APRIL 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 May 2024 – Malaysia's total trade for April 2024 amounted to RM221.7 billion with exports and imports recorded RM114.7 billion and RM107.0 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE APRIL 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM114.7 billion in April 2024, increased RM9.5 billion (+9.1%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in most states such as Selangor (+RM3.0 billion), Sarawak (+RM2.1 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM1.4 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.0 billion), Perak (+RM894.4 million), Terengganu (+RM826.4 million), Sabah (+RM669.2 million), Johor (+RM534.0 million), Kelantan (+RM164.9 million) and W.P. Labuan (+RM7.2 million). However, exports decreased in Kedah by RM669.7 million, Pahang (-RM377.0 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM125.6 million), Perlis (-RM26.7 million) and Melaka (-RM25.6 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 30.1 per cent share, followed by Johor (20.4%), Selangor (18.5%), Sarawak (8.2%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.7%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in April 2024 increased RM14.5 billion (+15.6%) as compared to the same month in 2023. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such

as Selangor (+RM4.0 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM3.6 billion), Johor (+RM1.6 billion), Melaka (+RM1.3 billion), Kedah (+RM1.2 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM770.8 million), Pahang (+RM532.9 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM520.9 million), Sarawak (+RM479.4 million), Perak (+RM228.3 million), Terengganu (+RM125.8 million), Sabah (+RM121.1 million) and Perlis (+RM9.6 million). However, imports decreased in W.P. Labuan by RM41.1 million and Kelantan (-RM19.3 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 27.2 per cent, followed by Johor (21.6%), Pulau Pinang (21.0%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.5%) and Kedah (5.9%).

April 2023 – April 2024 (RM Billion)**

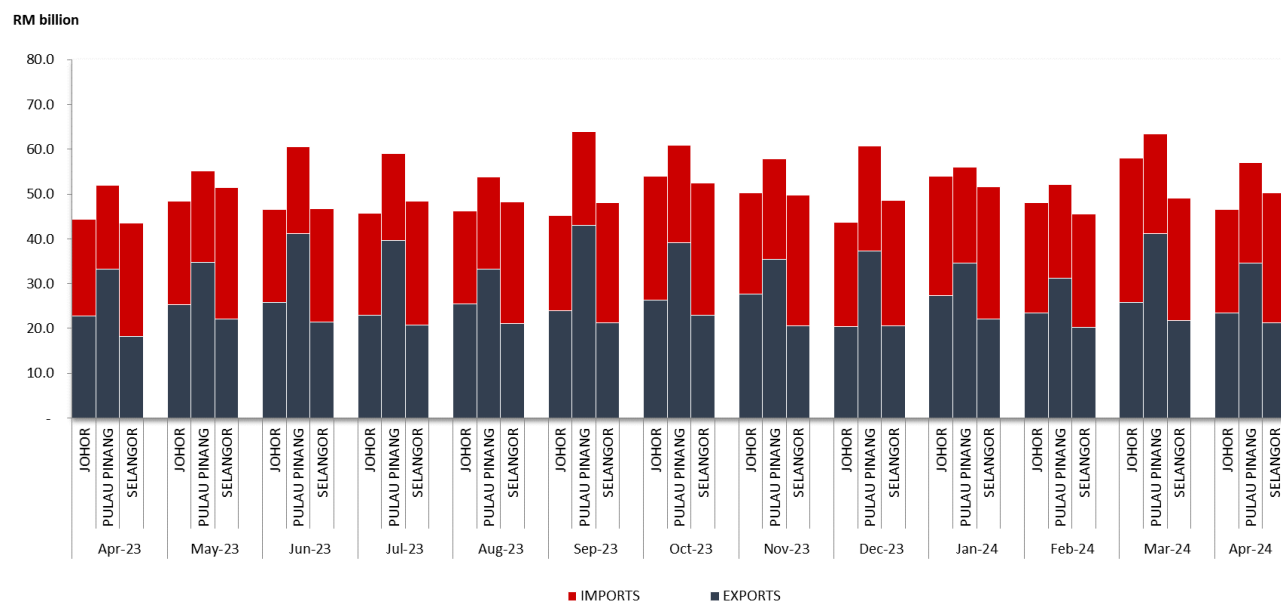


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, April 2024
