PERANGKAAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, APRIL 2024

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 5.7 peratus, mencapai nilai RM153.2 bilion pada April 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 10 JUN 2024 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 5.7 peratus tahun ke tahun, mencapai nilai RM153.2 bilion pada April 2024. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, April 2024** pada hari ini.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 5.7 peratus kepada RM153.2 bilion pada April 2024, mencatatkan pertumbuhan tertinggi dalam tempoh 13 bulan berikutan kesan nilai asas yang lebih rendah. Kenaikan tersebut didorong terutamanya oleh nilai jualan dalam subsektor Kelengkapan pengangkutan & pembuatan lain (16.9%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (12.8%); dan Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (2.7%). Namun begitu, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menguncup 3.3 peratus daripada RM158.4 bilion yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang 69.9 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, meningkat sebanyak 3.4 peratus daripada negatif 0.1 peratus pada Mac 2024. Kenaikan tersebut adalah didorong oleh pengembangan dalam industri Pembuatan kimia & produk kimia (9.9%); Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (8.3%); dan Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal (2.9%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport jatuh sebanyak 3.9 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan dua digit 10.0 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Mac 2024.

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik terus berkembang dengan mencatatkan pertumbuhan kukuh sebanyak 11.4 peratus pada April 2024 (Mac 2024: 5.4%). Kenaikan tersebut dipacu oleh Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler; dan Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan, yang masing-masing melonjak sebanyak 23.1 peratus dan 17.0 peratus. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan domestik menurun 1.9 peratus, berbanding positif 4.7 peratus yang direkodkan pada Mac 2024.

Selain itu, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Seramai 2.37 juta orang pekerja terlibat dalam sektor Pembuatan pada April 2024, yang meningkat 1.0 peratus berbanding 2.35 juta orang yang direkodkan setahun lalu (Mac 2024: 0.5%). Kenaikan itu sebahagian besarnya dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (4.7%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (2.3%); dan Kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan (1.3%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini meningkat secara marginal 0.4 peratus.”

Seiring dengan kenaikan bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan tumbuh 1.2 peratus tahun ke tahun untuk merekodkan RM8.11 bilion pada April 2024. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, gaji & upah terus menurun sebanyak 1.4 peratus daripada RM8.23 bilion yang direkodkan pada Mac 2024. Purata gaji & upah bulanan bagi setiap pekerja adalah RM3,419 pada April 2024, peningkatan sebanyak 0.2 peratus berbanding setahun lalu, manakala nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja bertambah baik sebanyak 4.6 peratus untuk merekodkan RM64,583.


Mengulas prestasi keseluruhan sektor Pembuatan bagi empat bulan pertama tahun 2024, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencapai RM610.6 bilion, meningkat sebanyak 2.7 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun 2023 (Januari - April 2023: 5.5%). Pada tempoh tersebut, bilangan pekerja bertambah sebanyak 1.0 peratus kepada sejumlah 2.37 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah menokok 1.2 peratus kepada RM32.9 bilion. Oleh itu, nilai jualan setiap pekerja mencatatkan sebanyak RM257,337 pada tempoh tersebut, merekodkan pertumbuhan 1.7 peratus.”




Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, April 2023 - April 2024




Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan, Mac 2024 dan April 2024




Carta 3: Nilai Jualan Industri Berorientasikan Eksport dan Domestik bagi Sektor Pembuatan, April 2023 - April 2024

The sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose by 5.7 per cent, reaching a value of RM153.2 billion in April 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 10 JUNE 2024 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose by 5.7 per cent year-on-year, reaching a value of RM153.2 billion in April 2024. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, April 2024**.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, the Chief Statistician said, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose by 5.7 per cent to RM153.2 billion in April 2024, marking the highest growth in 13 months due to a lower value base effect. The increase was mainly propelled by sales in the sub-sectors of Transport equipment & other manufactures (16.9%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (12.8%); and Electrical & electronics products (2.7%). Nonetheless, the Manufacturing sector sales value contracted by 3.3 per cent from RM158.4 billion registered in the preceding month.”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which contributed 69.9 per cent of total sales, turned upward by 3.4 per cent from a negative 0.1 per cent in March 2024. The increase was attributable to the expansion in the Manufacture of chemicals & chemical products (9.9%); Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (8.3%); and Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (2.9%) industries. On a month-on-month comparison, the sales value of export-oriented industries dropped by 3.9 per cent as against the double-digit growth of 10.0 per cent registered in March 2024.

Likewise, the domestic-oriented industries strengthened further by registering strong growth of 11.4 per cent in April 2024 (March 2024: 5.4%). The acceleration was propelled by the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers; and the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment, which surged by 23.1 per cent and 17.0 per cent, respectively. As compared to the previous month, the sales value of domestic-oriented industries decreased by 1.9 per cent, in contrast to the positive 4.7 per cent recorded in March 2024.

Apart from that, the Chief Statistician stated, “There were 2.37 million persons engaged in the Manufacturing sector in April 2024, which rose by 1.0 per cent as compared to 2.35 million persons recorded a year ago (March 2024: 0.5%). The increase was predominantly in the Food, beverages & tobacco (4.7%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (2.3%); and Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (1.3%) sub-sectors. In comparison to the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector increased marginally by 0.4 per cent.”

In line with the increase in the number of employees, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector grew by 1.2 per cent year-on-year to record RM8.11 billion in April 2024. On a month-on-month comparison, the salaries & wages continued to decline by 1.4 per cent from RM8.23 billion recorded in March 2024. The average monthly salaries & wages per employee was RM3,419 in April 2024, an uptick by 0.2 per cent as compared to a year ago, while the sales value per employee improved by 4.6 per cent to record RM64,583.

Elaborating on the overall performance of the Manufacturing sector for the first four months of 2024, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector reached RM610.6 billion, increased by 2.7 per cent as compared to the same period of 2023 (January - April 2023: 5.5%). During this period, the number of employees went up by 1.0 per cent to a total of 2.37 million persons, while salaries & wages grew by 1.2 per cent to RM32.9 billion. Consequently, the sales value per employee stood at RM257,337 during the period, posting a growth of 1.7 per cent.”

Chart 1: Sales Value of the Manufacturing Sector, April 2023 – April 2024




Chart 2: The Growth of Manufacturing Sub-sector, March 2024 and April 2024




Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, April 2023 – April 2024




Chart 4: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, March 2024 and April 2024





Chart 5: Manufacturing Domestic-Oriented by Group, March 2024 and April 2024
