Pengeluaran getah asli Malaysia menurun 20.9 peratus pada April 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 11 Jun 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) menerbitkan **Perangkaan Getah Bulanan, Malaysia, April 2024**. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik pengeluaran, import, eksport, penggunaan domestik, stok, harga, bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah dan produktiviti bagi estet getah.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, pengeluaran getah asli menurun 20.9 peratus pada April 2024 (21,325 tan metrik) berbanding pada Mac 2024 (26,966 tan metrik). Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan pengeluaran getah asli menurun 9.1 peratus (April 2023: 23,460 tan metrik). Pengeluaran getah asli Malaysia pada April 2024 disumbangkan terutamanya oleh sektor pekebun kecil (89.1%) berbanding sektor estet (10.9%).

Jumlah stok getah asli pada April 2024 menurun 5.1 peratus kepada 211,119 tan metrik berbanding 222,455 tan metrik pada Mac 2024. Kilang pemproses getah menyumbang stok akhir sebanyak 92.4 peratus diikuti kilang pengguna getah (7.5%) dan estet getah (0.1%).

Eksport getah asli Malaysia berjumlah 47,796 tan metrik pada April 2024, menurun 18.9 peratus berbanding Mac 2024 (58,965 tan metrik). China terus kekal sebagai destinasi utama untuk eksport getah asli iaitu berjumlah 44.8 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport pada April 2024 diikuti India (11.4%), Jerman (8.0%), Emiriah Arab Bersatu (4.3%) dan Pakistan (3.9%). Prestasi eksport disumbangkan oleh produk berasaskan getah asli seperti sarung tangan getah, tayar, tiub dan benang getah. Produk sarung tangan getah merupakan eksport utama dengan nilai sebanyak RM1.09 billion pada April 2024, menurun 3.8 peratus berbanding Mac 2024 (RM1.14 billion).

Analisis perbandingan harga purata bulanan menunjukkan Lateks Pekat merekodkan penurunan iaitu 0.9 peratus (April 2024: 733.58 sen sekilogram; Mac 2024: 740.37 sen sekilogram) manakala Sekerap menurun sebanyak 0.1 peratus (April 2024: 639.62 sen sekilogram; Mac 2024: 640.54 sen sekilogram). Harga bagi semua jenis Getah Mutu Malaysia (G.M.M) pula menurun antara 0.3 peratus hingga 0.9 peratus. *The World Bank Commodity Price Data* melaporkan harga bagi getah jenis TSR 20 (*Technically Specified Rubber*) menurun 1.2 peratus (daripada USD 1.65/kg kepada USD1.63/kg) dan SGP/MYS (Singapura/Malaysia) menurun 4.8 peratus (daripada USD2.39/kg kepada USD2.28/kg).

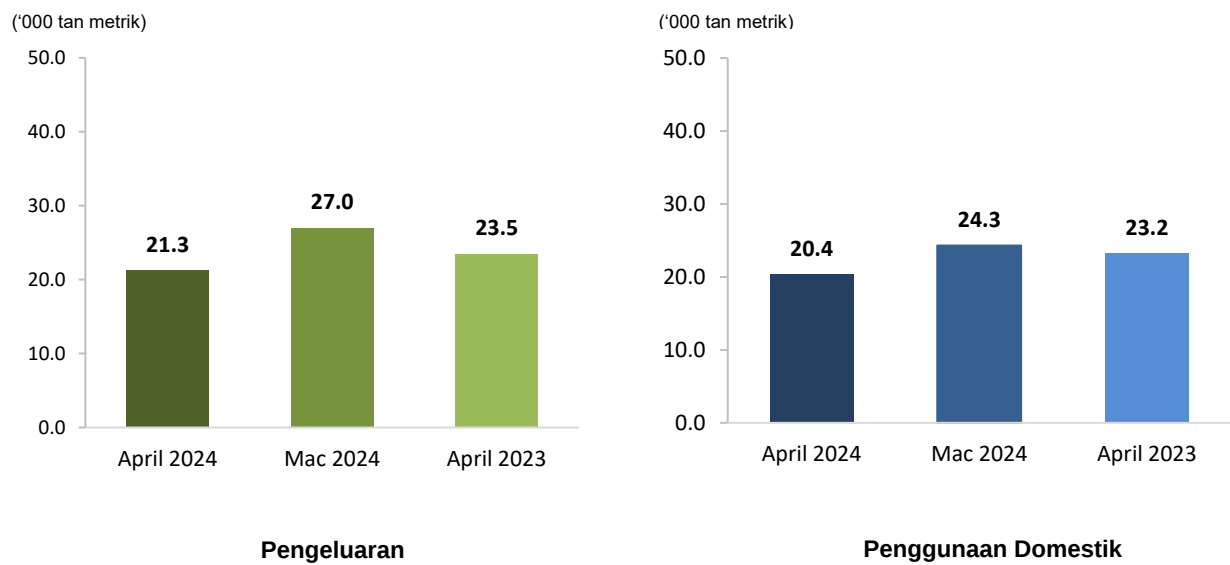
Menurut *Malaysia Rubber Board Digest* keluaran April 2024, pasaran getah Kuala Lumpur bercampur-campur pada bulan April di mana G.M.M 20 bergerak meningkat pada awalnya sebelum berkurangan menjelang penghujung bulan. Pasaran getah asli semakin berkurang berikutan keadaan cuaca di kebanyakan negara pengeluar utama. Namun demikian, data ekonomi China yang merangsangkan, Ringgit lemah berbanding Dollar Amerika serta ramalan ekonomi yang stabil oleh Tabung Kewangan Antarabangsa (*IMF*) turut memberi sokongan kepada sentimen pasaran.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah melancarkan OpenDOSM NextGen sebagai medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

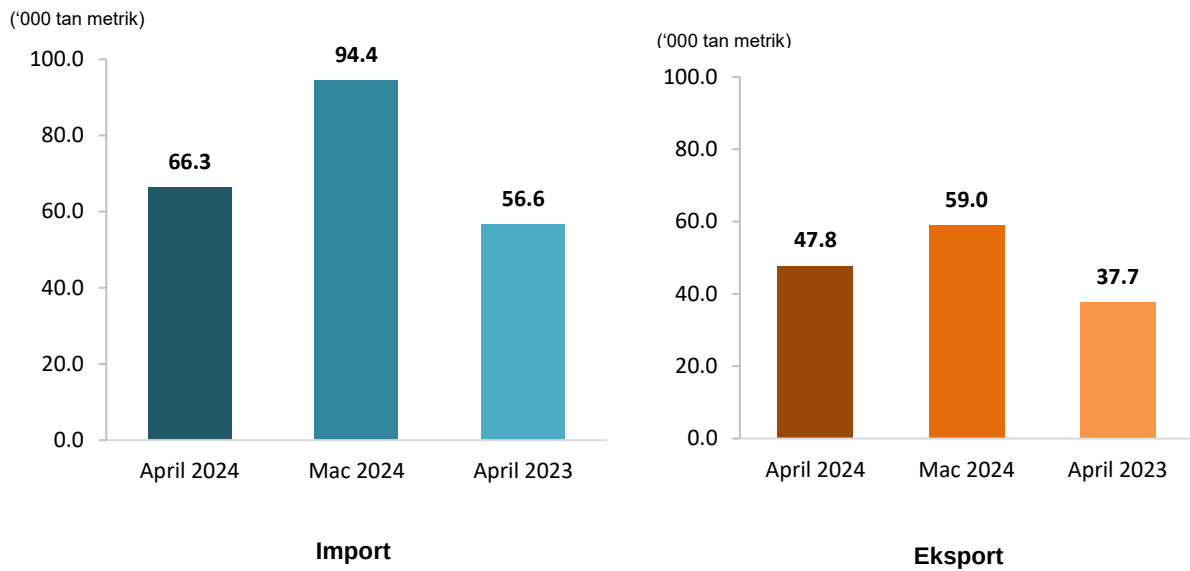

**Malaysia natural rubber production
decreased by 20.9 per cent in April 2024**

PUTRAJAYA, 11 June 2024 – The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) today released the **Monthly Rubber Statistics, Malaysia, April 2024**. This publication consists of statistics on production, imports, exports, domestic consumption, stocks, prices, number of employees, salaries & wages and productivity of rubber estates.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, Natural Rubber (NR) production decreased by 20.9 per cent in April 2024 (21,325 tonnes) as compared to March 2024 (26,966 tonnes). Year-on-year comparison showed that the production of NR decreased by 9.1 per cent (April 2023: 23,460 tonnes). Production of NR in April 2024 for Malaysia was mainly contributed by smallholders sector (89.1%) as compared to estates sector (10.9%).

Total stocks of NR in April 2024 decreased by 5.1 per cent to 211,119 tonnes as compared to 222,455 tonnes in March 2024. Rubber processors factory contributed 92.4 per cent of the stocks followed by rubber consumers factory (7.5%) and rubber estates (0.1%).

Exports of Malaysia's NR amounted to 47,796 tonnes in April 2024, decreased 18.9 per cent as against March 2024 (58,965 tonnes). P.R. China remained as the main destination for NR exports which accounted 44.8 per cent of total exports in April 2024 followed by India (11.4%), Germany (8.0%), the United Arab Emirates (4.3%) and

Pakistan (3.9%). The exports performance was contributed by NR-based product such as gloves, tyre, tube and rubber thread. Gloves were the main exports of rubber-based products with a value of RM1.09 billion in April 2024, a decrease of 3.8 per cent as compared to March 2024 (RM1.14 billion).

Analysis of the average monthly price showed that Concentrated Latex recorded a decrease of 0.9 per cent (April 2024: 733.58 sen per kg; March 2024: 740.37 sen per kg) while Scrap decreased by 0.1 per cent (April 2024: 639.62 sen per kg; March 2024: 640.54 sen per kg). Prices for all Standard Malaysian Rubber (S.M.R) decreased between 0.3 per cent to 0.9 per cent. The World Bank Commodity Price Data reported the prices for TSR 20 (Technically Specified Rubber) has decreased 1.2 per cent (from USD1.65/kg to USD1.63/kg) and SGP/MYS (Singapore/Malaysia) decreased 4.8 per cent (from USD2.39/kg to USD2.28/kg).

According to the Malaysia Rubber Board Digest published in April 2024, The Kuala Lumpur rubber market ruled mixed during April where SMR 20 moved upwards at the beginning before easing towards the end of the month. Natural Rubber market declined due to adverse weather conditions in major producing countries. However, the encouraging Chinese economic data amid continuous support measures from China, a weaker ringgit against the U.S. dollar and steady economic growth forecast by the International Monetary Fund (IMF) gave some support to the market sentiment.

(‘000 tonnes)

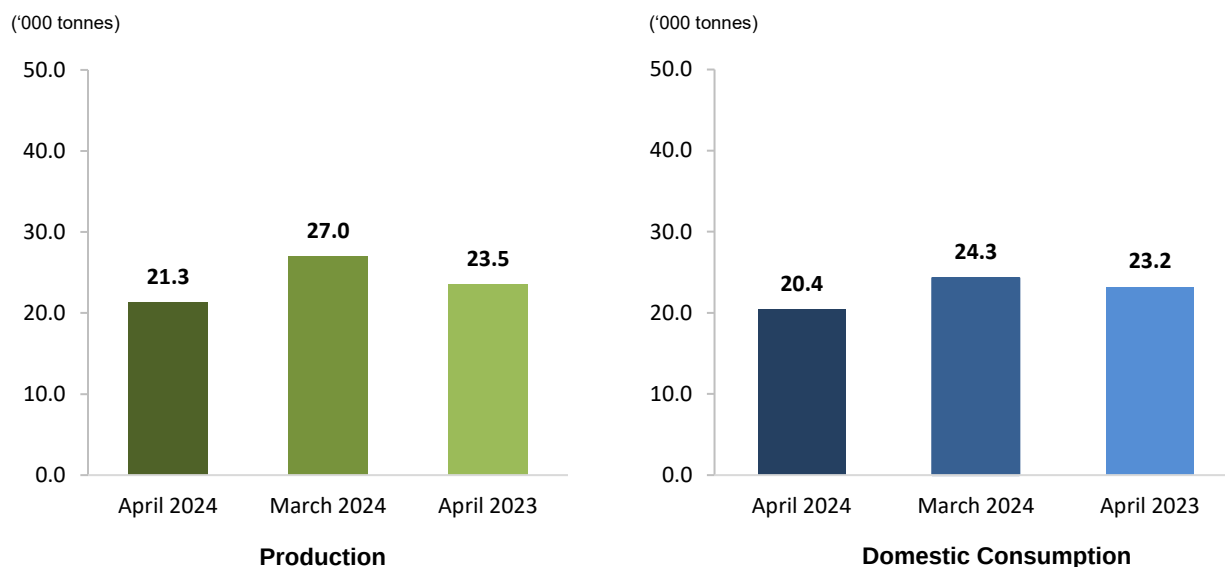
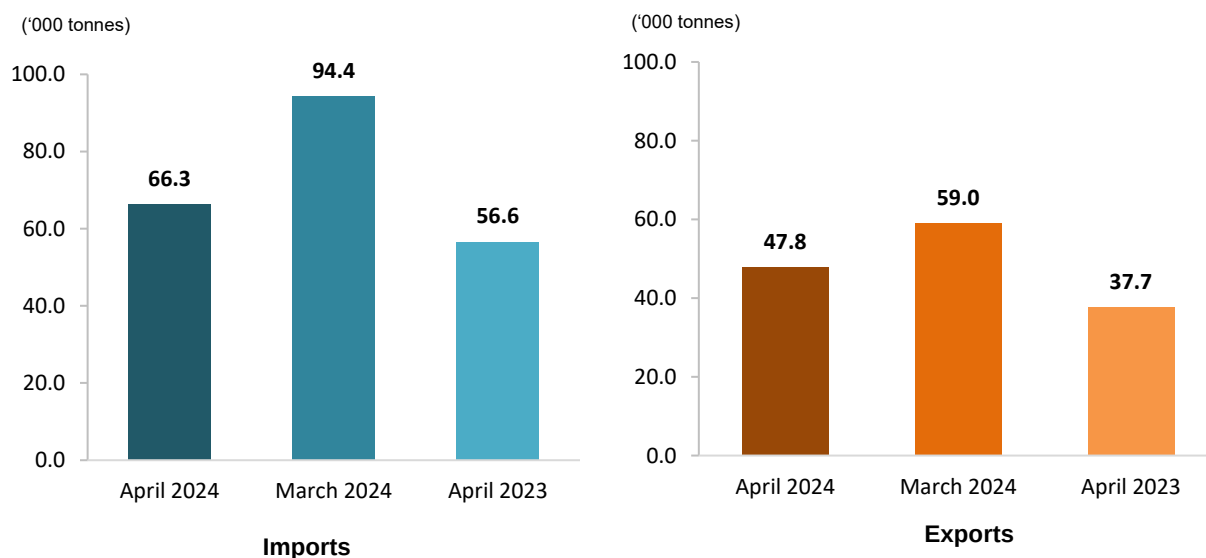


Chart 2: Imports and exports of natural rubber April 2023, March - April 2024
