BAGI INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI,
MALAYSIA, MEI 2024

Harga eksport dan import Malaysia masing-masing meningkat 0.7 peratus dan 0.1 peratus pada Mei 2024 disumbangkan terutamanya oleh minyak galian.

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JUN 2024 – Harga eksport Malaysia pada Mei 2024 meningkat 0.7 peratus daripada 149.2 mata pada bulan sebelumnya kepada 150.3 mata begitu juga, harga import bertambah 0.1 peratus kepada 130.9 mata. Sementara itu, terma perdagangan Malaysia juga bertambah 0.7 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 114.8 mata, sebagaimana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), Mei 2024** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit, indeks volum dan terma perdagangan meliputi 10 seksyen komoditi produk barangan selaras dengan Klasifikasi Standard Perdagangan Antarabangsa (SITC).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan, indeks nilai seunit eksport naik 0.7 peratus pada Mei 2024 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+1.5%), bahan kimia (+0.5%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.3%). Begitu juga, indeks volum eksport meningkat 11.0 peratus selaras dengan peningkatan indeks pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (+21.2%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+11.9%) dan minyak

galian (+7.5%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim turut bertambah 21.7 peratus daripada 141.7 mata kepada 172.5 mata. Merujuk kepada perbandingan tahunan, indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum masing-masing menokok 6.1 peratus dan 1.2 peratus.

Indeks nilai seunit import meningkat 0.1 peratus pada Mei 2024, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+3.3%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+2.3%) dan bahan mentah tidak boleh dimakan (+0.3%). Sementara itu, indeks volum import turut menokok 10.3 peratus pada Mei 2024 berbanding April 2024, disumbangkan oleh peningkatan indeks minyak galian (+26.0%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+10.9%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (+6.0%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim menokok 20.9 peratus daripada 182.6 mata kepada 220.9 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum import masing-masing berkembang 2.4 peratus dan 11.1 peratus.

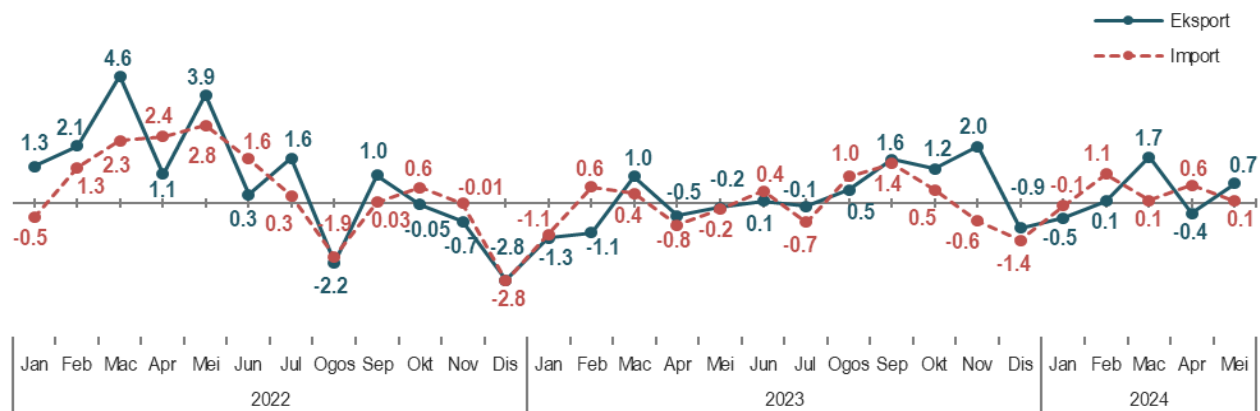
Pada masa yang sama, terma perdagangan Malaysia juga bertambah 0.7 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 114.8 mata pada Mei 2024, didorong oleh kenaikan indeks alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+1.6%), bahan mentah tidak boleh dimakan (+1.2%) dan makanan (+1.0%). Terma perdagangan Malaysia tahun ke tahun naik 3.6 peratus daripada 110.8 mata pada Mei tahun lalu.

Malaysia's export and import prices rose by 0.7 per cent and 0.1 per cent respectively in May 2024, mainly led by mineral fuels.

PUTRAJAYA, JUNE 28, 2024 – Malaysia's export prices in May 2024 increased by 0.7 per cent from 149.2 points in the previous month to 150.3 points. Likewise, import prices rose by 0.1 per cent to 130.9 points. Meanwhile, Malaysia's terms of trade also increased by 0.7 per cent month-on-month to 114.8 points as reported today in ***EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), May 2024***. This publication presents the unit value index, volume index and terms of trade for 10 commodity sections of merchandise products in accordance with the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin highlighted that, the export unit value index went up by 0.7 per cent in May 2024 as compared to the previous month, led by the increase in the index of mineral fuels (+1.5%), chemicals (+0.5%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.3%). Likewise, the export volume index rose by 11.0 per cent in line with the increase in the index of miscellaneous manufactured articles (+21.2%), machinery & transport equipment (+11.9%) and mineral fuels (+7.5%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index also increased by 21.7 per cent from 141.7 points to 172.5 points. With regards to the annual comparison, the unit value index and volume index increased by 6.1 per cent and 1.2 per cent, respectively.

The import unit value index edged up by 0.1 per cent in May 2024, contributed from the increase in the index of mineral fuels (+3.3%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+2.3%) and inedible crude materials (+0.3%). Meanwhile, the import volume index grew by 10.3 per cent in May 2024 as compared to April 2024, attributed from the increment in the index of mineral fuels (+26.0%), machinery & transport equipment (+10.9%) and manufactured goods (+6.0%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index went up by 20.9 per cent from 182.6 points to 220.9 points. Year-on-year comparison showed that the import unit value index and volume index expanded by 2.4 per cent and 11.1 per cent, respectively.

In addition, Malaysia's terms of trade spread by 0.7 per cent month-on-month to 114.8 points in May 2024, driven by the increment in the index of machinery & transport equipment (+1.6%), inedible crude materials (+1.2%) and food (+1.0%). Malaysia's terms of trade edged up by 3.6 per cent year-on-year from 110.8 points in May of the previous year.

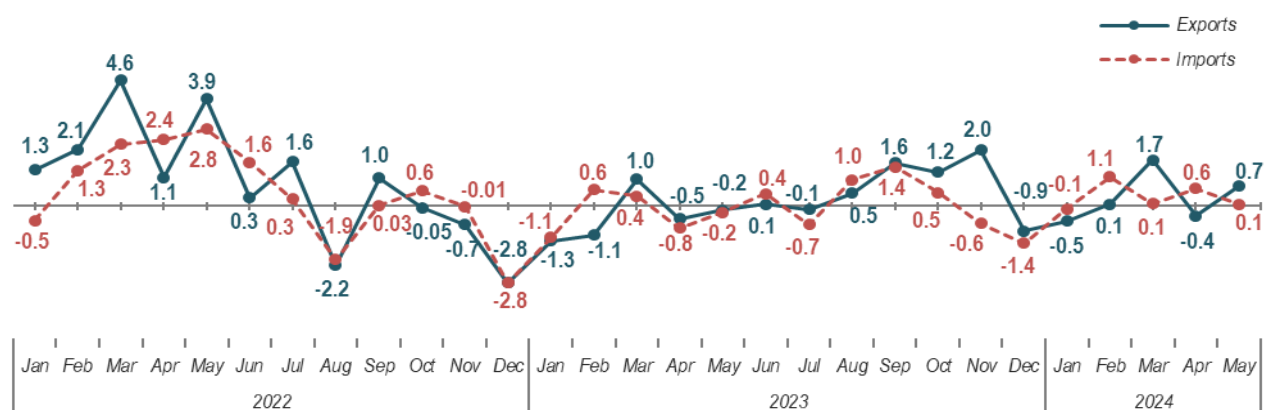


Chart 1: Month-on-Month Percentage Change of Export & Import Unit Value Indices
