LIMA NEGERI MENCATATKAN SUMBANGAN 80.9 PERATUS DARIPADA JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN PADA BULAN MEI 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 Jun 2024 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM246.3 bilion pada Mei 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM128.2 bilion dan RM118.1 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI MEI 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport bernilai RM128.2 bilion pada Mei 2024, meningkat sebanyak RM8.7 bilion (+7.3%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (+RM4.6 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM2.6 bilion), Selangor (+RM1.1 bilion), Perak (+RM779.7 juta), Sabah (+RM711.9 juta), Pahang (+RM549.8 juta), Terengganu (+RM533.5 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM340.9 juta) dan Kedah (+RM332.4 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di W.P. Kuala Lumpur sebanyak RM1.3 bilion, W.P. Labuan (-RM633.1 juta), Sarawak (-RM624.9 juta), Kelantan (-RM360.9 juta), Melaka (-RM201.1 juta) dan Perlis (-RM27.2 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 29.1 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (23.3%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (7.0%) dan Kedah (4.4%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Mei 2024 meningkat RM14.3 bilion (+13.8%) berbanding

bulan yang sama pada 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (+RM5.0 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM3.1 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM2.1 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.5 bilion), Melaka (+RM1.1 bilion), Selangor (+RM1.1 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM816.4 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM92.1 juta), Pahang (+RM89.2 juta), Kelantan (+RM39.6 juta), Perak (+RM34.3 juta) dan Perlis (+RM11.4 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Sarawak sebanyak RM659.3 juta, Terengganu (-RM157.0 juta) dan Sabah (-RM77.2 juta).

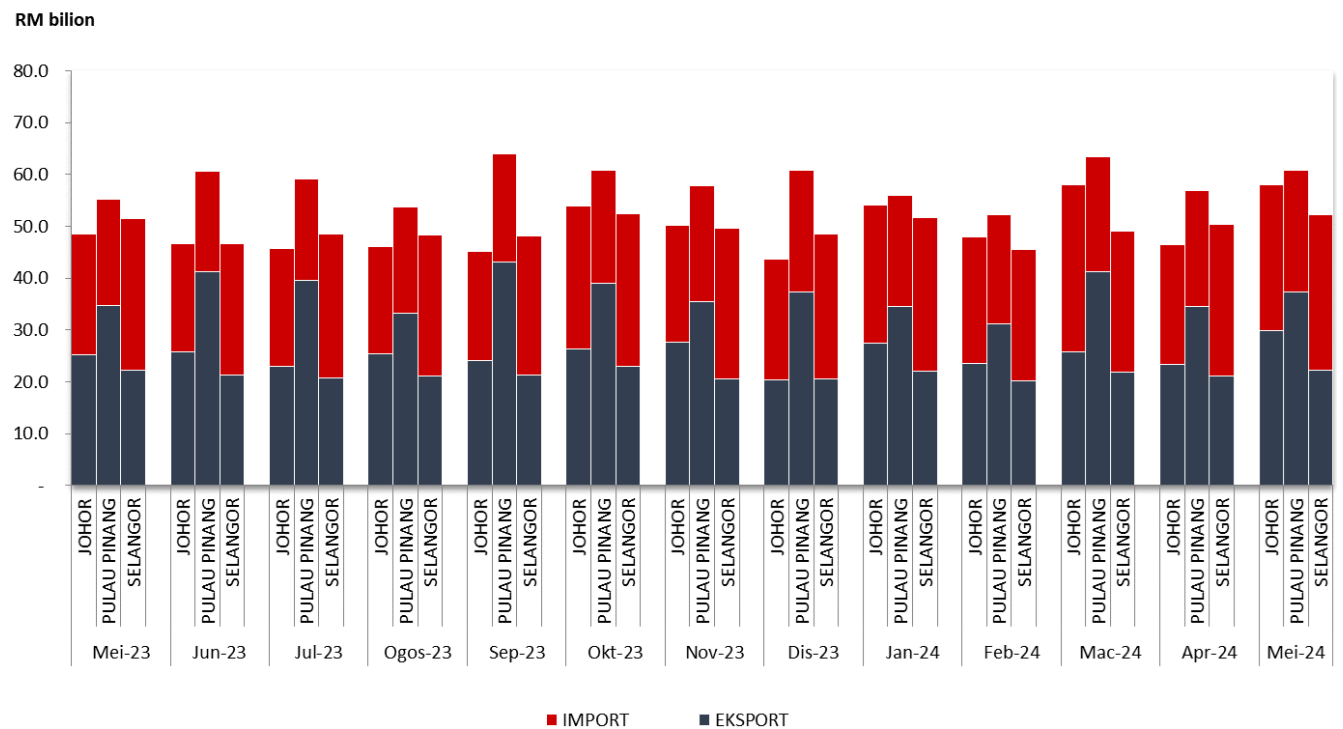
Selangor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 25.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (23.9%), Pulau Pinang (20.0%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.7%) dan Kedah (5.5%).

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE MAY 2024

FIVE STATES REGISTERED A CONTRIBUTION OF 80.9 PER CENT OF TOTAL TRADE IN MAY 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 June 2024 – Malaysia's total trade for May 2024 amounted to RM246.3 billion with exports and imports recorded RM128.2 billion and RM118.1 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE MAY 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM128.2 billion in May 2024, increased RM8.7 billion (+7.3%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in most states such as Johor (+RM4.6 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM2.6 billion), Selangor (+RM1.1 billion), Perak (+RM779.7 billion), Sabah (+RM711.9 million), Pahang (+RM549.8 million), Terengganu (+RM533.5 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM340.9 million) and Kedah (+RM332.4 million). However, exports decreased in W.P. Kuala Lumpur by RM1.3 billion, W.P. Labuan (-RM633.1 million), Sarawak (-RM624.9 million), Kelantan (-RM360.9 million), Melaka (-RM201.1 million) and Perlis (-RM27.2 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 29.1 per cent share, followed by Johor (23.3%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (7.0%) and Kedah (4.4%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in May 2024 increased RM14.3 billion (+13.8%) as compared to the same month in 2023. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such

as Johor (+RM5.0 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM3.1 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM2.1 billion), Kedah (+RM1.5 billion), Melaka (+RM1.1 billion), Selangor (+RM1.1 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM816.4 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM92.1 million), Pahang (+RM89.2 million), Kelantan (+RM39.6 million), Perak (+RM34.3 million) and Perlis (+RM11.4 million). However, imports decreased in Sarawak by RM659.3 million, Terengganu (-RM157.0 million) and Sabah (-RM77.2 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 25.4 per cent, followed by Johor (23.9%), Pulau Pinang (20.0%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.7%) and Kedah (5.5%).

May 2023 – May 2024 (RM Billion)**

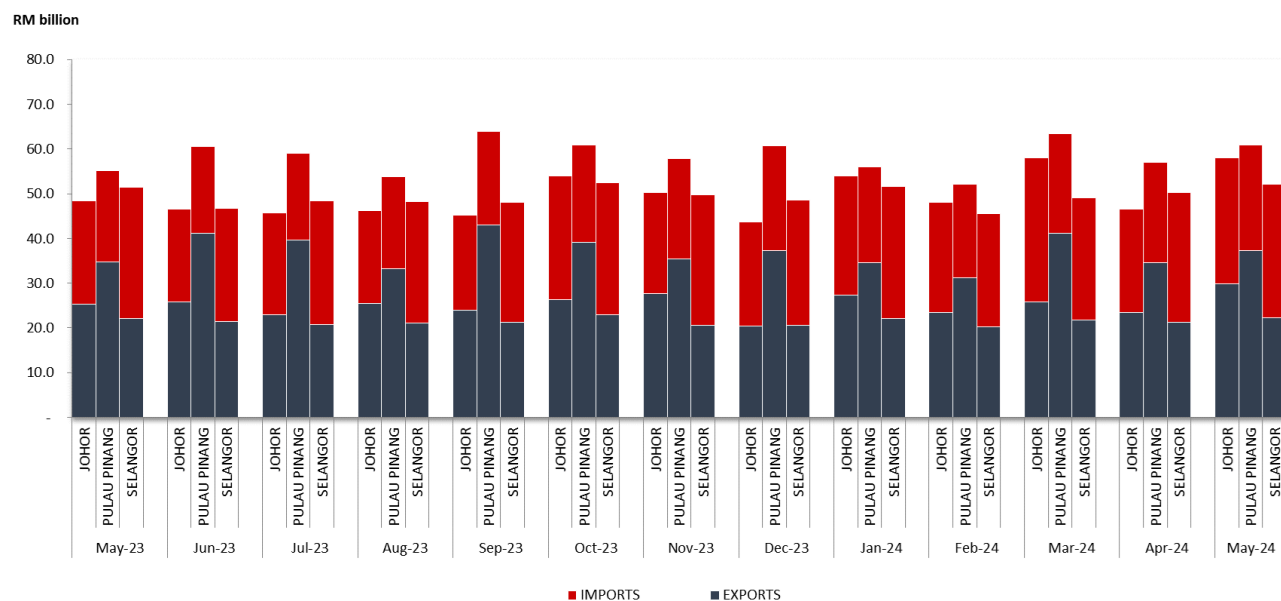


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, May 2024
