Inflasi Malaysia kekal 2.0 peratus pada Jun 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 24 Julai 2024 - Inflasi Malaysia kekal 2.0 peratus pada Jun 2024 dengan mata indeks mencatatkan 133.0 berbanding 130.4 pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan hari ini mengenai keluaran **INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), JUN 2024**.

Peningkatan inflasi pada Jun 2024 telah didorong oleh peningkatan bagi kumpulan utama Restoran & Perkhidmatan Penginapan (3.3%); Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas & Bahan Api Lain (3.2%); Penjagaan Diri, Perlindungan Sosial & Pelbagai Barang & Perkhidmatan (2.8%) dan Makanan & Minuman (2.0%). Manakala, Pakaian & Kasut dan Insurans & Perkhidmatan Kewangan masing-masing menurun kepada negatif 0.1 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menyatakan inflasi Restoran & Perkhidmatan Penginapan meningkat kepada 3.3 peratus (Mei 2024: 3.2%). Ini disebabkan oleh peningkatan subkumpulan utama Perkhidmatan penyediaan minuman kepada 4.2 peratus (Mei 2024: 4.1%). Manakala, inflasi Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas & Bahan Api Lain meningkat pada kadar yang sama seperti bulan sebelumnya pada 3.2 peratus. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh subkumpulan Bekalan air & pelbagai perkhidmatan berkaitan rumah kediaman, 32.1 peratus (Mei 2024: 32.1%).

Inflasi bagi Penjagaan Diri, Perlindungan Sosial & Pelbagai Barang & Perkhidmatan meningkat 2.8 peratus pada Jun 2024 berbanding 3.0 peratus pada Mei 2024. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh kelas perbelanjaan Barang kemas & jam tangan kepada 15.3 peratus (Mei 2024: 16.5%).

Kumpulan Makanan & Minuman yang menyumbang 29.8 peratus daripada keseluruhan wajaran IHP mencatatkan peningkatan 2.0 peratus pada Jun 2024 (Mei 2024: 1.8%). Subkumpulan utama Makanan di rumah meningkat 0.9 peratus pada Jun 2024 berbanding 0.5 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Kelas perbelanjaan Sayur-sayuran merekodkan peningkatan tertinggi sebanyak 6.2 peratus (Mei 2024: 4.8%). Antara sayur-sayuran yang mencatatkan kenaikan dua digit adalah Kacang panjang, Lada bengala dan Timun.

Inflasi bagi kelas perbelanjaan Daging meningkat kepada 0.2 peratus pada Jun 2024 (Mei 2024: -0.3%). Daging ayam segar yang merupakan komponen terbesar merangkumi 32.6 peratus dalam kelas perbelanjaan Daging kembali ke jajaran positif iaitu 1.1 peratus (Mei 2024: -0.8%). Berdasarkan pengumpulan data oleh pihak DOSM, purata harga Ayam standard di Malaysia pada Jun 2024 adalah RM10.58 sekilogram berbanding RM10.54 sekilogram pada bulan Jun 2023 (Mei 2024: RM10.42), manakala, purata harga Ayam standard bagi Semenanjung Malaysia pada Jun 2024 adalah RM9.92 sekilogram berbanding RM9.93 sekilogram pada bulan Jun 2023 (Mei 2024: RM9.71).

Subkumpulan utama Makanan di luar rumah meningkat lebih perlahan sebanyak 3.3 peratus berbanding 3.4 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Antara item yang merekodkan peningkatan lebih rendah berbanding bulan sebelumnya ialah seperti Roti canai dan Masakan ayam.

Selain itu, inflasi Pengangkutan meningkat 1.2 peratus pada Jun 2024 berbanding 0.9 peratus pada Mei 2024. Peningkatan tersebut disumbangkan oleh subkumpulan utama Pengurusan peralatan pengangkutan persendirian yang meningkat kepada 1.7 peratus pada Jun 2024 (Mei 2024: 1.4%). Kerajaan telah menetapkan harga runcit baru bagi Diesel iaitu RM3.35 seliter berbanding RM2.15 seliter bermula 10 Jun 2024 untuk Semenanjung Malaysia. Manakala, harga runcit Diesel bagi Sabah, Sarawak

dan Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan kekal pada RM2.15 seliter. Di samping itu, purata harga Petrol tanpa plumbum RON97 pada Jun 2024 adalah RM3.47 seliter berbanding RM3.37 seliter pada Jun 2023 (Mei 2024: RM3.47).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut menambah, berhubung dengan inflasi di peringkat negeri, kebanyakan negeri merekodkan peningkatan di bawah paras inflasi nasional 2.0 peratus. Walau bagaimanapun, empat negeri merekodkan peningkatan melebihi paras inflasi nasional iaitu Pulau Pinang (3.3%), Sarawak (2.7%), Pahang (2.7%) dan Selangor (2.4%). Kesemua negeri mencatatkan peningkatan inflasi Makanan & Minuman. Peningkatan tertinggi dicatatkan oleh Selangor pada 3.3 peratus, diikuti oleh Pulau Pinang (2.9%) dan Perlis (2.1%). Sementara itu, negeri-negeri lain menunjukkan peningkatan di bawah paras inflasi Makanan & Minuman nasional iaitu 2.0 peratus pada Jun 2024.

Inflasi keseluruhan secara bulanan pada Jun 2024 merekodkan kenaikan 0.2 peratus (Mei 2024: 0.3%). Peningkatan ini didorong terutamanya oleh Pengangkutan (0.5%); Restoran & Perkhidmatan Penginapan (0.3%) dan Rekreasi, Sukan & Kebudayaan (0.3%). Sementara itu, inflasi bagi suku tahun kedua 2024 mencatatkan peningkatan 1.9 peratus (ST1 2024: 1.7%). Bagi perbandingan suku tahunan, inflasi Malaysia mencatatkan peningkatan 0.6 peratus (ST1 2024: 0.7%). Sementara itu, inflasi teras meningkat 1.9 peratus pada Jun 2024, kadar yang sama seperti yang direkodkan pada Mei 2024. Peningkatan ini didorong terutamanya oleh kumpulan utama Restoran & Perkhidmatan Penginapan (3.3%) dan Makanan & Minuman (2.8%).

Bagi perbandingan inflasi dengan negara-negara terpilih, inflasi di Malaysia (2.0%) adalah lebih rendah berbanding inflasi di Vietnam (4.3%), Philippines (3.7%), Indonesia (2.5%) dan Republic of Korea (2.4%). Namun, kadar tersebut lebih tinggi berbanding Thailand (0.6%) dan China (0.2%).




Inflasi Keseluruhan Malaysia, Januari 2011 - Jun 2024



Nota: *Purata inflasi bagi tempoh Januari 2011 hingga Jun 2024




Inflasi bagi Kumpulan Pendapatan Bawah RM3,000, Jun 2023 - Jun 2024



Inflasi mengikut Kuadran, Mei 2024 & Jun 2024





dan Diesel, Jun 2023 - Jun 2024**






Inflasi bagi Makanan & Minuman, Jun 2023 - Jun 2024

Inflasi mengikut Negeri, Mei 2024 & Jun 2024




Inflasi bagi Negara Terpilih, Jun 2023 – Jun 2024

Malaysia's inflation remained at 2.0 per cent in June 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 24 July 2024 – Malaysia's inflation remained at 2.0 per cent in June 2024 with the index points stood at 133.0 as against 130.4 in the same month of the previous year. The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) reported today on the release of **CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), JUNE 2024**.

The increase of inflation in June 2024 was driven by the incline in the main group of Restaurant & Accommodation Services (3.3%); Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels (3.2%); Personal Care, Social Protection & Miscellaneous Goods & Services (2.8%) and Food & Beverages (2.0%). However, Clothing & Footwear and Insurance & Financial Services declined to negative 0.1 per cent respectively as compared to the same month of the previous year.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin informed that, inflation for Restaurant & Accommodation Services increased to 3.3 per cent (May 2024: 3.2%). This was due to the increase in the main subgroup of Beverage preparation services to 4.2 per cent (May 2024: 4.1%). Meanwhile, the inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels increased at the same rate as the previous month at 3.2 per cent. The increase was mainly contributed by the subgroup of Water supply & miscellaneous services relating to dwelling, 32.1 per cent (May 2024: 32.1%).

Inflation for Personal Care, Social Protection & Miscellaneous Goods & Services increased by 2.8 per cent in June 2024 as against to 3.0 per cent in May 2024. The incline was contributed by the expenditure class of Jewellery & watches at 15.3 per cent (May 2024: 16.5%).

The Food & Beverages group which contributes 29.8 per cent of the total CPI weight recorded an increase of 2.0 per cent in June 2024 (May 2024: 1.8%). The main subgroup of Food at home increased 0.9 per cent in June 2024 as compared to 0.5 per cent in the previous month. The expenditure class of Vegetables recorded the highest increase of 6.2 per cent (May 2024: 4.8%). Among the vegetables that recorded a double digit increase were Long Beans, Capsicum and Cucumber.

Inflation for the expenditure class of Meat edged up to 0.2 per cent in June 2024 (May 2024: -0.3%). Chicken as the largest component comprised 32.6 per cent in the expenditure class of Meat returned to positive territory at 1.1 per cent (May 2024: -0.8%). Based on data collected by DOSM, the average price of Standard chicken in Malaysia for June 2024 was RM10.58 per kilogramme as compared to RM10.54 per kilogramme in June 2023 (May 2024: RM10.42), while, the average price of Standard chicken in Peninsular Malaysia for June 2024 was RM9.92 per kilogramme as compared to RM9.93 per kilogramme in June 2023 (May 2024: RM9.71).

The main subgroup of Food away from home showed a slower increase of 3.3 per cent as compared to 3.4 per cent in the previous month. Among the items that recorded a lower increase as compared to the preceding month were Roti canai and Cooked chicken.

Furthermore, inflation for Transport increased 1.2 per cent in June 2024 as compared to 0.9 per cent in May 2024. The increase was contributed by the main subgroup of Operation of personal transport equipment which increased to 1.7 per cent in June 2024 (May 2024: 1.4%). The Government has set the new retail price for Diesel at RM3.35 per litre as compared to RM2.15 per litre effective from 10th June 2024 for Peninsular Malaysia. Meanwhile, the retail price of Diesel for Sabah, Sarawak & Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan remains at RM2.15 per litre.

In addition, the average price of Unleaded petrol RON97 in June 2024 was RM3.47 per litre as against RM3.37 per litre in June 2023 (May 2024: RM3.47).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also added, with regards to inflation at the state level, most of the states recorded increases below the national inflation level of 2.0 per cent. However, four states recorded increases above the national inflation level namely Pulau Pinang (3.3%), Sarawak (2.7%), Pahang (2.7%) and Selangor (2.4%). All states registered an increase in the inflation of Food & Beverages. The highest increase was recorded by Selangor at 3.3 per cent, followed by Pulau Pinang (2.9%) and Perlis (2.1%). Meanwhile, other states showed an increase below the national inflation of Food & Beverages of 2.0 per cent in June 2024.

The overall monthly inflation for June 2024 recorded an increase of 0.2 per cent (May 2024: 0.3%). The increase was mainly driven by inflation for Transport (0.5%); Restaurant & Accommodation Services (0.3%) and Recreation, Sport & Culture (0.3%). Meanwhile, inflation for the second quarter of 2024 recorded an incline of 1.9 per cent (Q1 2024: 1.7%). On a quarterly comparison, Malaysia's inflation increased 0.6 per cent (Q1 2024: 0.7%). Furthermore, the core inflation increased at 1.9 per cent in June 2024 the same rate as recorded in May 2024. The increase was due to the Restaurant & Accommodation Services (3.3%) and Food & Beverages (2.8%).

In comparison to inflation in other selected countries, inflation in Malaysia (2.0%) was lower than inflation in Vietnam (4.3%), Philippines (3.7%), Indonesia (2.5%) and Republic of Korea (2.4%). However, the rate was higher than Thailand (0.6%) and China (0.2%).



Malaysia Headline Inflation, Core Inflation and Inflation without Fuel, June 2023 - June 2024



Inflation for Income Group Below RM3,000, June 2023 - June 2024



Inflation by Quadrant, May 2024 & June 2024



Distribution of Inflation for Food and Non-Food that Increased ≤10%, May 2024 & June 2024




Inflation by Main Group, May 2024 & June 2024



Inflation for Food & Beverages, June 2023 - June 2024




Inflation of Selected Countries, June 2023 - June 2024



