Indeks Pelopor mengekalkan trajektori positifnya dengan 3.8 peratus pada Mei 2024, menggambarkan ekonomi Malaysia yang berdaya tahan

PUTRAJAYA, 25 Julai 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **Penunjuk Ekonomi Malaysia: Indeks Pelopor, Serentak & Susulan bagi Mei 2024**. Indeks Pelopor (IP) ialah alat yang digunakan untuk meramalkan arah aliran ekonomi secara purata empat hingga enam bulan ke hadapan.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Indeks Pelopor mengekalkan pertumbuhan positifnya selama enam bulan berturut-turut, mencapai 3.8 peratus kepada 114.2 mata pada Mei 2024 berbanding 110.0 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya (**Paparan I**). Peningkatan ini disokong terutamanya oleh kenaikan kukuh dalam Indeks Perusahaan Bursa Malaysia (31.8%), diikuti oleh Import Benar Logam Asas Berharga & Logam Bukan Ferus Lain (20.6%). Melihat kepada prestasi bulanan, IP juga meningkat sebanyak 0.8 peratus disumbangkan terutamanya oleh Bilangan Syarikat Baru Didaftar (0.5%)”.

Kadar pertumbuhan IP terlicin pada Mei 2024 kekal konsisten melebihi 100.0 mata (**Paparan II**), mencerminkan ekonomi yang berdaya tahan disokong oleh peningkatan aktiviti perlancongan dan permintaan luar yang memberangsangkan.

Merujuk kepada senario ekonomi semasa, Indeks Serentak (IS) mengekalkan momentum pertumbuhan sebanyak 2.2 peratus kepada 126.1 mata pada Mei 2024 berbanding 123.4 mata pada bulan yang sama setahun yang lalu. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh prestasi teguh dalam Nilai Caruman Benar, KWSP (8.7%). Pada masa yang

sama, perubahan bulanan dalam IS juga mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 0.6 peratus, disokong oleh semua komponen kecuali Kapasiti Penggunaan dalam Pembuatan (-0.2%).





***The Leading Index sustained its positive trajectory with 3.8 per cent
in May 2024, illustrating a resilient Malaysian economy***

PUTRAJAYA, July 25, 2024 - Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia released the **Malaysian Economic Indicators: Leading, Coincident & Lagging Indexes for May 2024**. The Leading Index (LI) is a tool utilised for predicting economic trends for an average of four to six months ahead.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The Leading Index maintained its positive growth for six consecutive months, reaching 3.8 per cent to 114.2 points in May 2024 as compared to 110.0 points in the same month of the previous year (**Exhibit I**). This improvement was primarily supported by a sturdy gain in the Bursa Malaysia Industrial Index (31.8%), followed by Real Imports of Other Basic Precious & Other Non-ferrous Metals (20.6%). Looking at the monthly performance, the LI also edged up 0.8 per cent mainly contributed by the Number of New Companies Registered (0.5%)".

The smoothed growth rate of the LI in May 2024 remained consistently above 100.0 points (**Exhibit II**), reflecting a resilient economy underpinned by increasing tourism activities and promising external demand.

Referring to the current economic scenario, the Coincident Index (CI) maintained its growth momentum of 2.2 per cent to 126.1 points in May 2024 as compared to 123.4 points in the same month a year ago. This increase was driven by the robust performance in the Real Contributions, EPF (8.7%). Simultaneously, the monthly change

in the CI also registered an increase of 0.6 per cent, bolstered by all components except the Capacity Utilisation in Manufacturing (-0.2%).

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index




Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle




Exhibit III: Annual Changes of Leading Index Components
