### **BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JUN 2024**

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#### **PULAU PINANG, JOHOR DAN SELANGOR MENYUMBANG 72.1 PERATUS DARIPADA EKSPORT PADA BULAN JUN 2024**

**PUTRAJAYA, 26 Julai 2024** – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM237.8 bilion pada Jun 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM126.0 bilion dan RM111.8 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JUN 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport bernilai RM126.0 bilion pada Jun 2024, meningkat sebanyak RM2.1 bilion (+1.7%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (+RM2.0 bilion), Terengganu (+RM1.3 bilion), Perak (+RM767.0 juta), Selangor (+RM403.1 juta), Sarawak (+RM397.6 juta), Kedah (+RM337.0 juta), Kelantan (+RM122.1 juta) dan Johor (+RM112.2 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di W.P. Labuan sebanyak RM1.7 bilion, Pahang (-RM1.2 bilion), Melaka (-RM312.0 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM206.7 juta), Sabah (-RM71.6 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM54.4 juta) dan Perlis (-RM23.6 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 34.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (20.6%), Selangor (17.3%), Sarawak (6.5%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.2%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Jun 2024 meningkat RM16.9 bilion (+17.8%) berbanding

bulan yang sama pada 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (+RM4.6 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM4.1 bilion), Selangor (+RM3.3 bilion), Kedah (+RM2.3 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.5 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.2 bilion), Terengganu (+RM101.4 juta), Perlis (+RM82.3 juta) dan Kelantan (+RM36.6 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Melaka sebanyak RM3.5 billion, Sarawak (-RM264.5 juta), Perak (-RM249.1 juta), Sabah (-RM170.6 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM110.5 juta) dan Pahang (-RM5.2 juta).

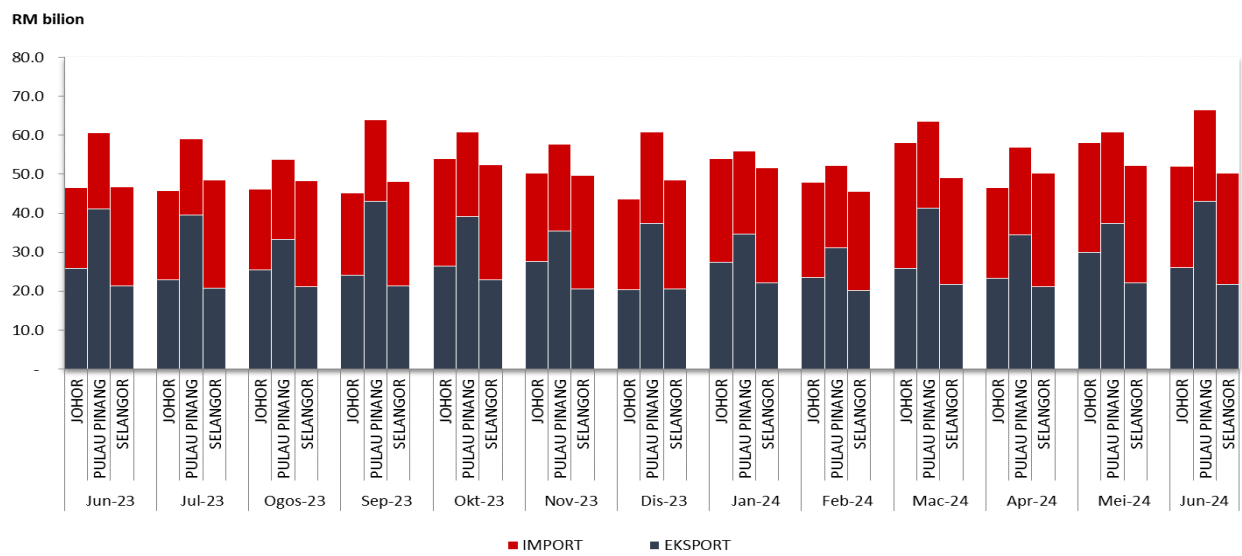
Selangor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 25.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (23.3%), Pulau Pinang (20.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.6%) dan Kedah (6.3%).

## **PRESS STATEMENT**

### **FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JUNE 2024**

#### **EXPORTS OF PULAU PINANG, JOHOR AND SELANGOR CONTRIBUTED 72.1 PER CENT IN JUNE 2024**

**PUTRAJAYA, 26 July 2024** – Malaysia's total trade for June 2024 amounted to RM237.8 billion with exports and imports recorded RM126.0 billion and RM111.8 billion respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JUNE 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM126.0 billion in June 2024, increased RM2.1 billion (+1.7%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM2.0 billion), Terengganu (+RM1.3 billion), Perak (+RM767.0 million), Selangor (+RM403.1 million), Sarawak (+RM397.6 million), Kedah (+RM337.0 million), Kelantan (+RM122.1 million) and Johor (+RM112.2 million). However, exports decreased in W.P. Labuan by RM1.7 billion, Pahang (-RM1.2 billion), Melaka (-RM312.0 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM206.7 million), Sabah (-RM71.6 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM54.4 million) and Perlis (-RM23.6 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 34.2 per cent share, followed by Johor (20.6%), Selangor (17.3%), Sarawak (6.5%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.2%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in June 2024 increased RM16.9 billion (+17.8%) as compared to the same month in 2023. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as Johor (+RM4.6 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM4.1 billion), Selangor (+RM3.3 billion), Kedah (+RM2.3 billion),

*W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.5 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.2 billion), Terengganu (+RM101.4 million), Perlis (+RM82.3 million) and Kelantan (+RM36.6 million). However, imports decreased in Melaka by RM3.5 billion, Sarawak (-RM264.5 million), Perak (-RM249.1 million), Sabah (-RM170.6 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM110.5 million) and Pahang (-RM5.2 million).*

*Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 25.5 per cent, followed by Johor (23.3%), Pulau Pinang (20.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.6%) and Kedah (6.3%).*

June 2023 – June 2024 (RM Billion)**

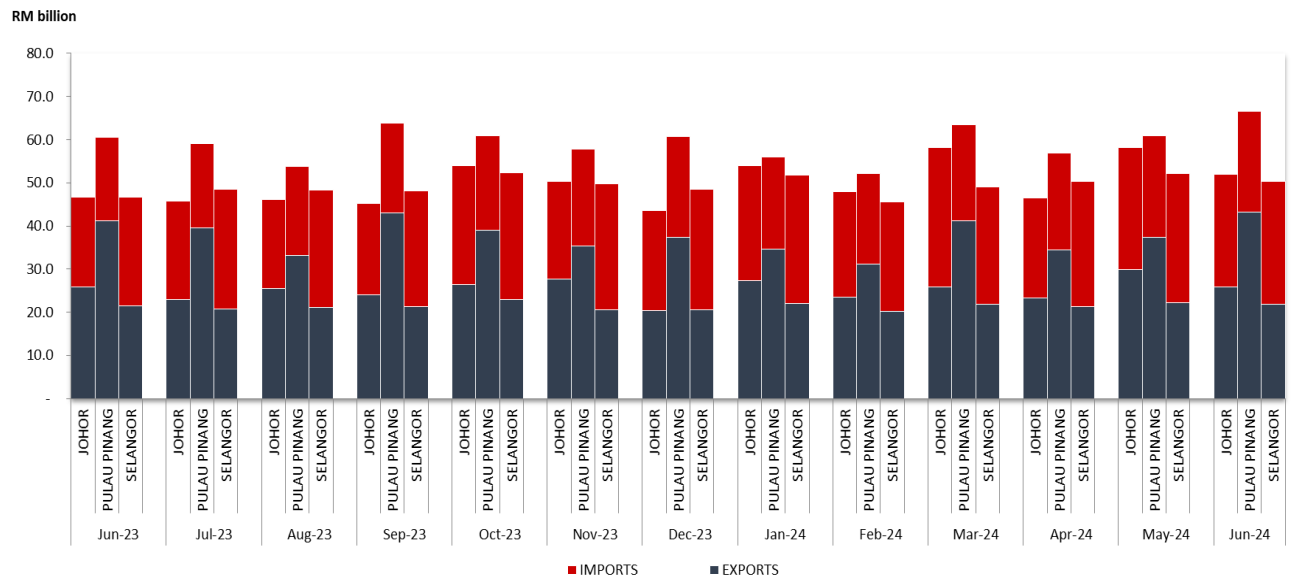


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, June 2024
