BAGI STATISTIK PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI SABAH 2024

Jumlah perdagangan Sabah pada tahun 2023 melempi parasi RM100 bilion bagi dua tahun berturut-turut

PUTRAJAYA, 30 JULAI 2024 – Laporan **STATISTIK PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI SABAH BAGI TAHUN RUJUKAN 2023** yang dikeluarkan hari ini memaparkan statistik perdagangan luar negeri Sabah dengan rakan dagangan mengikut klasifikasi komoditi yang terperinci. Laporan ini menunjukkan jumlah perdagangan Sabah kekal melepasi parasi RM100 bilion tahun 2023.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata "Perdagangan Sabah telah melepasi aras RM100 bilion bagi dua tahun berturut-turut dengan jumlah perdagangan Sabah mencatatkan RM105 bilion pada tahun 2023. Seiring dengan penurunan perdagangan peringkat Malaysia, perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan perdagangan Sabah menurun sebanyak 11.1 peratus daripada RM118 bilion pada tahun 2022. Eksport Sabah menurun 18.5 peratus kepada RM62.8 bilion berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Sementara itu, import Sabah mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 3.0 peratus daripada RM40.9 bilion kepada RM42.2 bilion pada tahun 2023, manakala lebihan dagangan berjumlah RM20.6 bilion, menurun 43.1 peratus".

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia juga melaporkan penyumbang utama eksport Sabah adalah petroleum mentah bernilai RM24.7 bilion, minyak kelapa sawit (RM16.0 bilion) dan gas asli cecair (RM5.1 bilion). Eksport tiga produk utama ini bernilai RM45.7 bilion dan menyumbang 72.8 peratus kepada jumlah eksport Sabah. Manakala penyumbang utama import pula adalah jentera dan kelengkapan pengangkutan sebanyak RM14.3 bilion, makanan dan binatang hidup (RM6.6 bilion) dan barangan keluaran kilang mengikut jenis bahan (RM5.5 bilion).

Mengulas lebih lanjut, lima rakan dagangan utama yang menyumbang sebanyak 71.2 peratus kepada jumlah perdagangan luar negeri Sabah terdiri daripada Semenanjung Malaysia (45.9%), China (11.2%), Thailand (5.9%), Republik Korea (4.2%) dan India (3.9%).

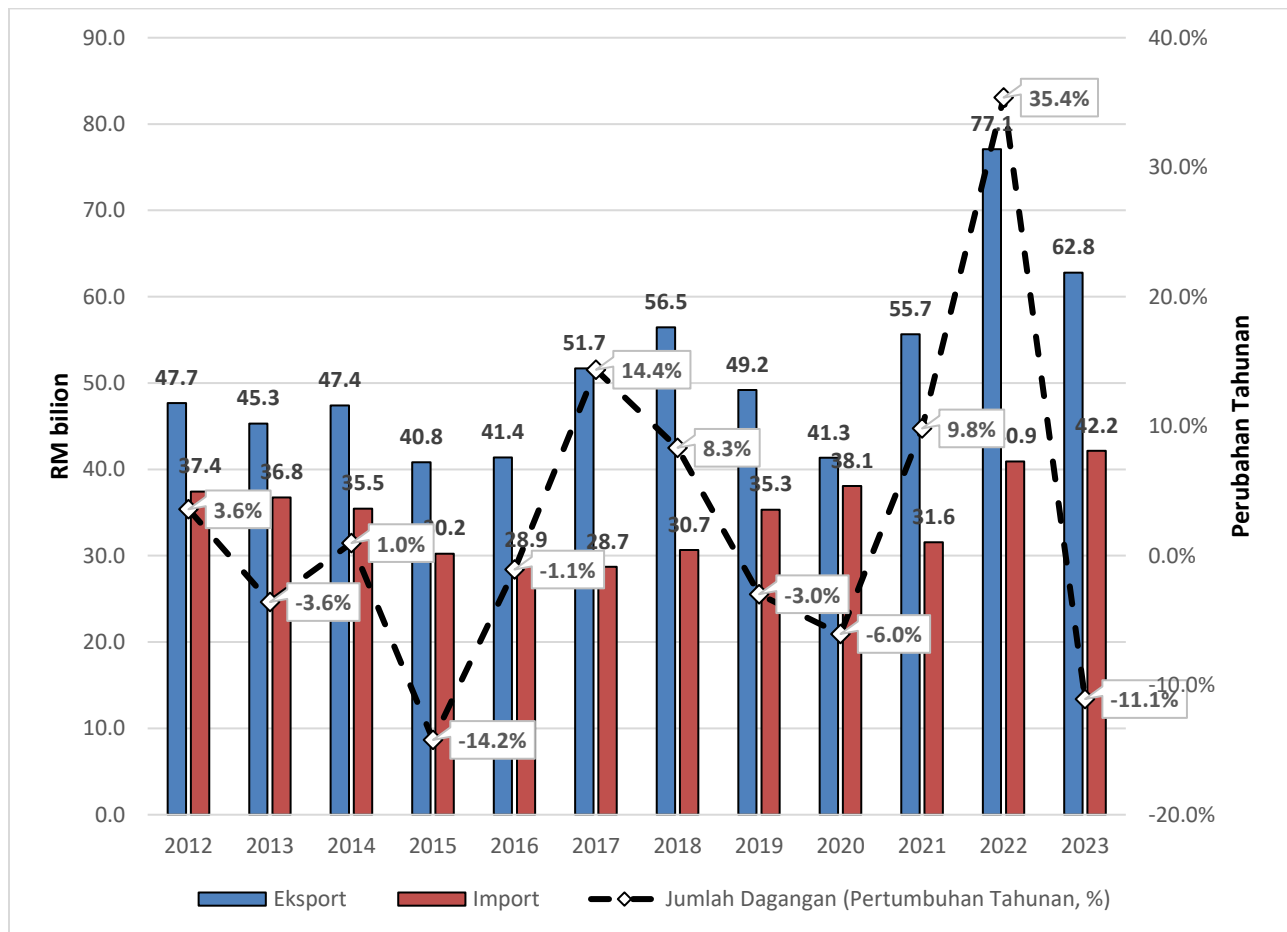

FOR SABAH EXTERNAL TRADE STATISTICS 2024

Sabah's total trade in 2023 surpassing RM100 billion for the second consecutive year

PUTRAJAYA, JULY 30, 2024 – Sabah External Trade Statistics Report for the reference year 2022 released today displays Sabah's external trade statistics with trading partners according to a detailed commodity classification. This report shows that Sabah's total trade surpassed the RM100 billion level in 2023.

Commenting on the report, the Chief Statistician of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, said, "Sabah's total trade was valued at RM105 billion in 2023. Along with the negative growth in Malaysia's total trade, year on year comparison shows that Sabah's total trade decreased 11.1 per cent from RM118 billion in 2022. Sabah's exports decreased 18.5 per cent to RM62.8 billion compared to the previous year. On the other hand, imports recorded a 3.0 per cent increase from RM40.9 billion to RM42.2 billion in 2023 with a trade surplus amounting to RM20.6 billion, down 43.1 per cent"

The Department of Statistics Malaysia also reported that the main contributor of Sabah's total exports were crude petroleum, valued at RM24.7 billion, palm oil (RM16.0 billion) and liquefied natural gas (RM5.1 billion). Exports of these three major products amounting to RM45.7 billion and accounted for 72.8 per cent of Sabah's total exports. Meanwhile, total imports were dominated by machinery and transport equipment of RM14.3 billion, food and live animals products (RM6.6 billion) and manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (RM5.5 billion).

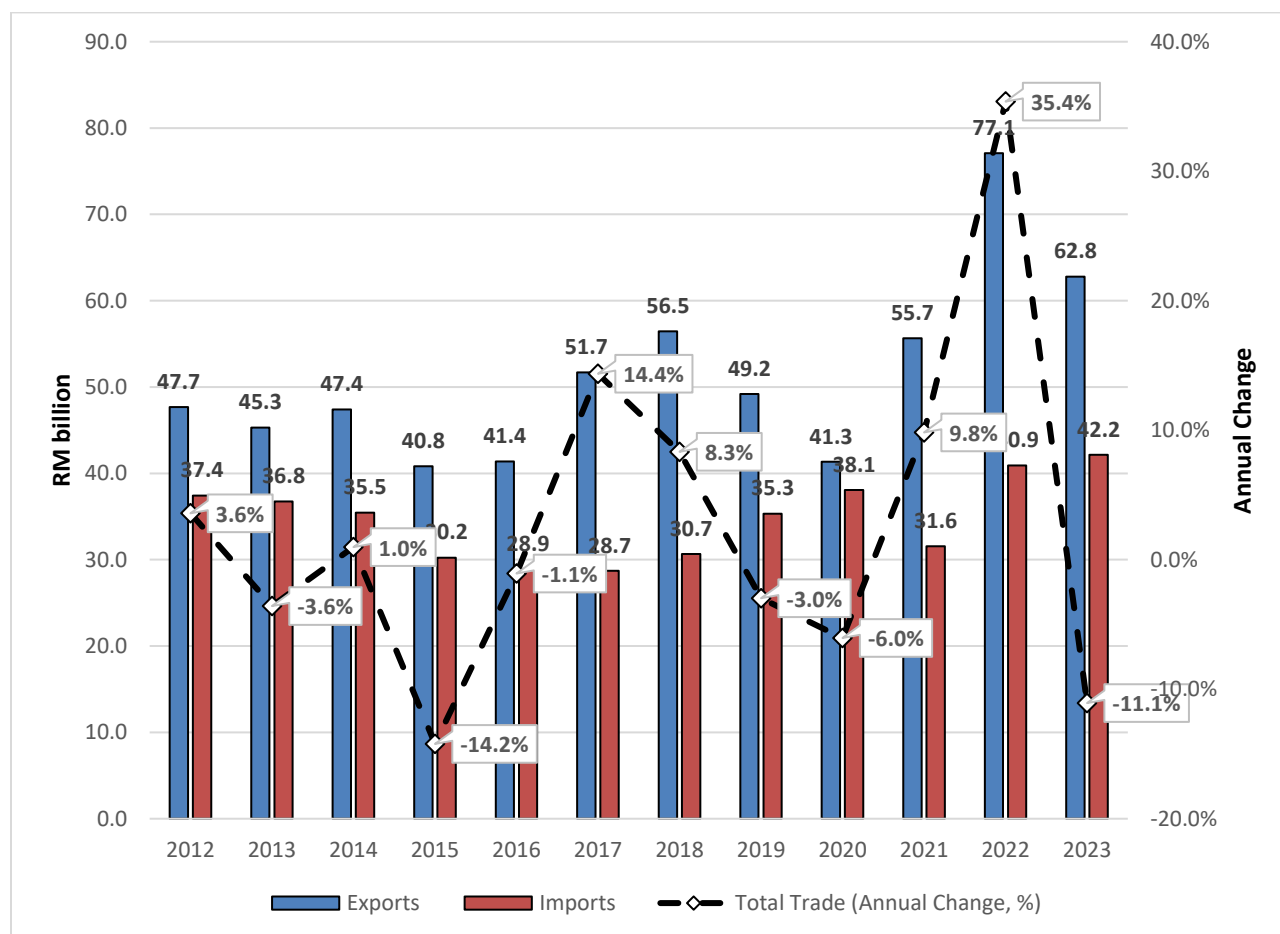
Five major trading partners contributed 71.2 per cent to Sabah's total external trade comprising Peninsular Malaysia (45.9%), China (11.2%), Thailand (5.9%), Republic of Korea (4.2%) and India (3.9%).
