## Prices of aggregates, cement up in June

KUALA LUMPUR: The Statistics Department said prices of cement, aggregates and steel increased month-on-month in June. The unit price index of cement rose 0.1 to 2.1 per cent for almost all areas in Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak. The unit price index of aggregates was up between 0.4 and 0.6 per cent. There was a slight increase in the unit price index of steel in several areas, with decreases in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Melaka, Negri Sembilan, Terengganu and Kelantan. The average price per unit of steel remained unchanged at an average of RM3,730.49 per tonne.
