PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN BORONG & RUNCIT, MALAYSIA, JUN 2024

**Jualan Perdagangan borong & runcit melonjak 5.4 peratus pada Jun 2024,
mencapai RM146.0 bilion**

PUTRAJAYA, 8 OGOS 2024 – Perdagangan borong & runcit Malaysia mencatatkan nilai jualan bulanan RM146.0 bilion, meningkat 5.4 peratus pada Jun 2024. Ini dilaporkan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) hari ini dalam siaran **PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN BORONG & RUNCIT, JUN 2024**. Laporan ini juga memaparkan statistik nilai jualan dan indeks volum bagi Perdagangan borong & runcit mengikut subsektor serta indeks jualan runcit melalui internet.

Dalam satu kenyataan hari ini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Peningkatan sebanyak 5.4 peratus tahun ke tahun bagi Perdagangan borong & runcit pada Jun 2024 dipacu oleh subsektor Perdagangan runcit yang meningkat 7.9 peratus kepada RM64.1 bilion. Perdagangan borong juga bertumbuh 4.0 peratus untuk mencatatkan RM64.9 bilion, diikuti oleh Kenderaan bermotor dengan peningkatan 2.0 peratus untuk mencapai RM17.0 bilion. Bagi perbandingan bulanan, Perdagangan borong

& runcit turun -1.3 peratus berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disebabkan oleh Kenderaan bermotor yang menurun -9.4 peratus.”

Beralih kepada prestasi mengikut subsektor, Ketua Perangkawan memaklumkan, “Pertumbuhan 7.9 peratus tahun ke tahun bagi Perdagangan runcit disumbangkan oleh Jualan runcit di kedai penghususan yang tumbuh 12.6 peratus untuk mencapai RM13.5 bilion. Kumpulan lain dalam subsektor ini yang turut menyumbang kepada pertumbuhan ini adalah Jualan runcit di kedai bukan penghususan (8.8%), Jualan runcit makanan, minuman & tembakau (8.7%) dan Jualan runcit barang isi rumah (7.3%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, jualan subsektor ini naik 0.2 peratus, disokong oleh Jualan runcit di kedai penghususan (1.2%), Jualan runcit barang isi rumah (1.4%) dan Jualan runcit barang kesenian & rekreasi (1.3%).”

Mengulas lanjut mengenai subsektor Perdagangan borong, kenaikan 4.0 peratus tahun ke tahun pada bulan ini disokong oleh Jual borong bahan mentah pertanian & haiwan hidup yang meningkat 7.9 peratus kepada RM5.9 bilion. Ini diikuti oleh Jualan borong makanan, minuman & tembakau (6.7%), Perdagangan borong tanpa penghususan (6.2%) dan Jualan borong barang isi rumah (5.6%). Walau bagaimanapun, bagi perbandingan bulanan, Perdagangan borong jatuh -0.3 peratus, terutamanya disebabkan oleh penurunan dalam Jual borong bahan mentah pertanian & haiwan hidup (-3.0%), Jualan borong makanan, minuman & tembakau (-0.3%) dan Jualan borong barang isi rumah (-0.2%).

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut menerangkan, “Pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 2.0 peratus bagi subsektor Kenderaan bermotor pada Jun dipacu oleh Penyelenggaraan & pemberian kenderaan bermotor dan Jualan komponen & aksesori kenderaan bermotor, masing-masing melonjak 10.0 peratus dan 9.2 peratus. Walau bagaimanapun, Jualan kenderaan bermotor menurun -3.4 peratus pada bulan ini. Bagi perbandingan bulanan, subsektor ini menyusut

-9.4 peratus, disumbangkan oleh penguncutan dalam semua kumpulan terutamanya Jualan kenderaan bermotor (-17.2%).”

Mengulas lanjut berkenaan prestasi suku tahunan, peningkatan 6.4 peratus pada suku tahun kedua bagi Perdagangan borong & runcit didorong oleh subsektor Perdagangan runcit yang meningkat 7.4 peratus kepada RM191.8 bilion. Ini diikuti Perdagangan borong yang tumbuh 4.5 peratus untuk mencatatkan RM193.8 bilion. Subsektor Kenderaan bermotor juga merekodkan pertumbuhan positif dengan 9.9 peratus untuk mencapai RM53.1 bilion pada suku tahun ini. Bagi perbandingan suku tahun ke suku tahun, sektor ini naik 2.2 peratus.

Bagi indeks jualan runcit melalui internet, indeks ini bertumbuh 4.8 peratus tahun ke tahun pada Jun 2024 berbanding 5.2 peratus pada Mei 2024. Bagi nilai pelarasan musim, indeks ini menokok 0.5 peratus berbanding bulan sebelum.


Dari segi indeks volum, Perdagangan borong & runcit pada Jun 2024 mencatatkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 4.5 peratus. Pengembangan ini disumbangkan oleh semua subsektor iaitu Perdagangan runcit (6.3%), Perdagangan borong (3.2%) dan Kenderaan bermotor (1.2%). Sebaliknya, bagi indeks volum pelarasan musim, ia jatuh -0.8 peratus bulan ke bulan.




Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Perdagangan Borong & Runcit




Carta 2: Nilai Jualan Perdagangan Borong




Carta 3: Nilai Jualan Perdagangan Runcit

FOR PERFORMANCE OF WHOLESALE & RETAIL TRADE, MALAYSIA, JUNE 2024

Wholesale & retail trade sales surged 5.4 per cent in June 2024, reaching a total of RM146.0 billion

PUTRAJAYA, AUGUST 8, 2024 – Malaysia’s Wholesale & retail trade registered monthly sales value of RM146.0 billion, grew 5.4 per cent in June 2024. This is reported by Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) in today’s release of **PERFORMANCE OF WHOLESALE & RETAIL TRADE, JUNE 2024**. The report also presents statistics on sales value and volume index of Wholesale & retail trade by sub-sector as well as index of retail sales over the internet.

In a statement today, Dato’ Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “The increase of 5.4 per cent year-on-year for Wholesale & retail trade in June 2024 was driven by Retail trade sub-sector, which rose 7.9 per cent to register RM64.1 billion. Wholesale trade also went up by 4.0 per cent to register RM64.9 billion, followed by Motor vehicles with an increase of 2.0 per cent to settle at RM17.0 billion. For monthly comparison, Wholesale & retail trade experienced a slight decline of -1.3 per cent from the previous month, due to Motor vehicles which decreased -9.4 per cent.”

Looking at the performance across sub-sectors, the Chief Statistician informed, “The growth of 7.9 per cent year-on-year in Retail trade was led by Retail sales in specialised stores which grew 12.6 per cent to reach RM13.5 billion. Other groups in this sub-sector that also contributed to this growth were Retail sales in non-specialised stores (8.8%), Retail sales of food, beverages & tobacco (8.7%), and Retail sales of household goods (7.3%). For month-on-month comparison, sales of this sub-sector saw a 0.2 per cent increase, supported by gains in Retail sales in specialised stores (1.2%), Retail sales of household goods (1.4%), and Retail sales of cultural & recreation goods (1.3%).”

Commenting further on Wholesale trade sub-sector, the increase of 4.0 per cent year-on-year in this month was supported by Wholesale of agricultural raw materials & live animals which rose 7.9 per cent to RM5.9 billion. This was followed by Wholesale of food, beverages & tobacco (6.7%), Non-specialised wholesale trade (6.2%), and Wholesale of household goods (5.6%). On the other hand, for monthly comparison, Wholesale trade slipped -0.3 per cent, mainly due to the decrease in Wholesale of agricultural raw materials & live animals (-3.0%), Wholesale of food, beverages & tobacco (-0.3%), and Wholesale of household goods (-0.2%).

Dato’ Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also informed, “The year-on-year growth of 2.0 per cent for Motor vehicles sub-sector in June was attributed to Maintenance & repair of motor vehicles and Sales of motor vehicles parts & accessories which soared 10.0 per cent and 9.2 per cent, respectively. However, Sales of motor vehicles declined -3.4 per cent in this month. For monthly comparison, this sub-sector decreased -9.4 per cent, contributed by the contraction in all groups mainly Sales of motor vehicles (-17.2%).”

Elaborating further on quarterly performance, the 6.4 per cent increase in second

quarter this year for Wholesale & retail trade was underpinned by Retail trade sub-sector which rose 7.4 per cent to RM191.8 billion. This was followed by Wholesale trade which grew 4.5 per cent to record RM193.8 billion. Motor vehicle sub-sector also recorded a positive growth of 9.9 per cent to reach RM53.1 billion in this quarter. As for quarter-on-quarter comparison, this sector climbed 2.2 per cent.

For index of retail sale over the internet, the index grew 4.8 per cent year-on-year in June 2024 as compared to 5.2 per cent in May 2024. For seasonally adjusted value, the index inched up 0.5 per cent as against the previous month.

In terms of volume index, Wholesale & retail trade for June 2024 registered a year-on-year growth of 4.5 per cent. The expansion was contributed by all sub-sectors namely Retail trade (6.3%), Wholesale trade (3.2%), and Motor vehicles (1.2%). Conversely, for seasonally adjusted volume index, it went down -0.8 per cent month-on-month.

Chart 1: Sales Value of Wholesale & Retail Trade




Chart 2: Sales Value of Wholesale Trade




Chart 3: Sales Value of Retail Trade




Chart 4: Sales Value of Motor Vehicles





Chart 5: Index of Retail Sale Over the Internet
