PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA JUN 2024

Pertumbuhan nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan kekal stabil dengan peningkatan 5.9 peratus, berjumlah RM156.1 bilion pada Jun 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 9 OGOS 2024 – Pertumbuhan nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan kekal stabil dengan peningkatan 5.9 peratus, berjumlah RM156.1 bilion pada Jun 2024. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Jun 2024**.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Momentum pertumbuhan dalam nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan kekal positif sejak Januari, meningkat sebanyak 5.9 peratus (Mei 2024: 5.5%) kepada sejumlah RM156.1 bilion pada Jun 2024. Kenaikan tersebut dipacu terutamanya oleh subsektor Produk peralatan elektrik & elektronik, yang meningkat sebanyak 7.1 peratus selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 12.2 peratus pada Mei 2024. Pertumbuhan tersebut juga disokong oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau, dengan peningkatan 8.6 peratus, dan Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas dan produk logam yang direka, yang meningkat 11.1 peratus. Berasaskan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan tumbuh 0.8 peratus dari RM154.9 bilion pada Mei 2024."

Nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport, yang menyumbang 73.1 peratus, terus berkembang pada kadar yang lebih pantas iaitu sebanyak 6.0 peratus pada

Jun 2024 (Mei 2024: 4.6%). Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal (8.8%); dan Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (10.9%) merupakan penyumbang utama kepada pertumbuhan industri berorientasikan eksport pada bulan tersebut. Sementara itu, nilai jualan Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis pulih kepada pertumbuhan positif 1.6 peratus daripada negatif 17.6 peratus pada Mei 2024. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport meningkat sebanyak 3.9 peratus (Mei 2024: 2.5%).

Sementara itu, industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat sederhana sebanyak 5.5 peratus (Mei 2024: 7.9%) dipengaruhi oleh penurunan 5.2 peratus dalam nilai jualan industri Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler dan semi treler. Sebaliknya, Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (13.5%) menyokong pertumbuhan; dituruti dengan Pembuatan pemprosesan makanan (5.2%); dan Pembuatan logam asas (12.3%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan domestik kekal dengan trend penurunan bagi tiga bulan berturut-turut, mencatatkan negatif 6.7 peratus pada Jun 2024 (Mei 2024: -2.2%).

Ketua Perangkawan menambah, "Terdapat seramai 2.37 juta orang pekerja dalam sektor Pembuatan pada Jun 2024, menunjukkan peningkatan 1.0 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan 0.9 peratus pada Mei 2024. Peningkatan tersebut sebahagian besarnya dapat dilihat dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (4.0%); serta Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (2.3%). Sebaliknya, bilangan pekerja yang terlibat dalam Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal berkurang sebanyak 0.9 peratus (Mei 2024: -1.1%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini susut secara marginal sebanyak 0.3 peratus (Mei 2024: 0.2%).

Begitu juga, pada Jun 2024, gaji & upah sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 1.8 peratus, mencapai sejumlah RM8.20 billion. Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, gaji & upah meningkat sedikit 0.1 peratus, susulan pertumbuhan 1.0 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Mei 2024. Ini menyebabkan peningkatan dalam purata gaji & upah bulanan bagi setiap pekerja iaitu sebanyak 0.8 peratus kepada RM3,459. Pada masa yang sama, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja meningkat 4.8 peratus untuk merekodkan RM65,874."

Merumuskan kenyataan beliau, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Bagi suku kedua 2024, nilai jualan bagi sektor Pembuatan mencapai RM464.2 bilion, mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 5.7 peratus (ST1 2024: 1.8%). Peningkatan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh subsektor Produk peralatan elektrik & elektronik (7.3%); dan Makanan, minuman dan tembakau (8.2%). Selain itu, bilangan pekerja dan gaji & upah yang dibayar pada suku ini masing-masing meningkat sebanyak 1.0 peratus (ST1 2024: 0.5%) dan 1.4 peratus (ST1 2024: 1.2%).


Sementara itu, sepanjang enam bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – Jun 2024), nilai jualan bagi sektor Pembuatan mencapai RM921.5 bilion, meningkat 3.7 peratus berbanding tempoh masa yang sama pada tahun 2023 (Januari – Jun 2023: 3.5%). Bilangan pekerja bertambah sebanyak 1.0 peratus kepada sejumlah 2.37 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah meningkat 1.3 peratus kepada RM49.3 bilion. Selanjutnya, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja mencatatkan RM388,904, merekodkan pertumbuhan 2.7 peratus.”




**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan,
Jun 2023 - Jun 2024**




**Carta 2: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan,
ST2 2020 – ST2 2024**




**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan,
Mei 2024 dan Jun 2024**





MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA JUNE 2024

The Manufacturing sector sales value remained on a steady growth with an increase of 5.9 per cent, totalling RM156.1 billion in June 2024

PUTRAJAYA, AUGUST 9, 2024 – The Manufacturing sector sales value remained on a steady growth with an increase of 5.9 per cent, totalling RM156.1 billion in June 2024. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, June 2024**.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “The growth momentum in the Manufacturing sector’s sales value has remained positive since January, increasing by 5.9 per cent (May 2024: 5.5%) to a total RM156.1 billion in June 2024. The rise was primarily driven by the Electrical & electronics products sub-sector, which grew by 7.1 per cent after registering a 12.2 per cent growth in May 2024. The growth was also supported by the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector, with an increase of 8.6 per cent, and the Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products, which rose by 11.1 per cent. On a month-on-month basis, the sales value grew by 0.8 per cent from RM154.9 billion in May 2024.”

Sales value for the export-oriented industries, which accounted for 73.1 per cent, continued to expand at a faster pace of 6.0 per cent in June 2024 (May 2024: 4.6%).

The Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (8.8%); and the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (10.9%) were the key contributors to the growth of export-oriented industries during the month. Meanwhile, the sales value for the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products turned around to positive growth of 1.6 per cent from negative 17.6 per cent in May 2024. For a month-on-month comparison, the sales value of the export-oriented industries grew by 3.9 per cent (May 2024: 2.5%).

Meanwhile, domestic-oriented industries grew modestly by 5.5 per cent (May 2024: 7.9%) influenced by a decline of 5.2 per cent in the sales value of Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers industry. On the other hand, the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (13.5%) supported the growth, followed by the Manufacture of food processing products (5.2%) and the Manufacture of basic metals (12.3%). As compared to the previous month, the sales value of domestic-oriented industries remained on a declining trend for three consecutive months, registering a negative 6.7 per cent in June 2024 (May 2024: -2.2%).

The Chief Statistician added, "There were 2.37 million employees in the Manufacturing sector in June 2024, marking a 1.0 per cent increase compared to a 0.9 per cent growth in May 2024. The increase was observed largely in the Food, beverages & tobacco (4.0%); and the Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (2.3%). On the contrary, the number of persons engaged in the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products decreased by 0.9 per cent (May 2024: -1.1%). In comparison with the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector declined marginally by 0.3 per cent (May 2024: 0.2%).

Likewise, in June 2024, the salaries & wages in the Manufacturing sector rose by 1.8 per cent, reaching a total of RM8.20 billion. Compared to the previous month, the salaries & wages increased slightly by 0.1 per cent, following a 1.0 per cent growth observed in May 2024. This resulted in the increase of average monthly salaries & wages per employee by 0.8 per cent to RM3,459. Simultaneously, the sales value per employee rose by 4.8 per cent to record RM65,874."

Concluding his statement, the Chief Statistician said, “For the second quarter of 2024, the sales of the Manufacturing sector reached RM464.2 billion, reflecting a growth of 5.7 per cent (Q1 2024: 1.8%). The increase was primarily attributable to the Electrical & electronics products (7.3%); and the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector (8.2%) sub-sectors. Furthermore, the number of employees and salaries & wages paid during the quarter went up by 1.0 per cent (Q1 2024: 0.5%) and 1.4 per cent (Q1 2024: 1.2%) respectively.


In the meantime, throughout the first six months this year (January – Jun 2024), the sales value of the Manufacturing sector reached RM921.5 billion, increased by 3.7 per cent as compared to the same period of 2023 (January - June 2023: 3.5%). The number of employees went up by 1.0 per cent to a total of 2.37 million persons, while salaries & wages grew by 1.3 per cent to RM49.3 billion. Subsequently, the sales value per employee stood at RM388,904, posting a growth of 2.7 per cent.”



May 2024 and June 2024**







Chart 4: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, June 2023 – June 2024
