BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JULAI 2024

PULAU PINANG, JOHOR DAN SELANGOR MENYUMBANG 70.6 PERATUS DARIPADA EKSPORT PADA BULAN JULAI 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 OGOS 2024 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM255.9 bilion pada Julai 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM131.1 bilion dan RM124.7 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JULAI 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport bernilai RM131.1 bilion pada Julai 2024, meningkat sebanyak RM14.4 bilion (+12.3%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (+RM5.2 bilion), Selangor (+RM2.3 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM1.9 bilion), Sarawak (+RM1.8 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.3 bilion), Perak (+RM1.2 bilion), Terengganu (+RM1.0 bilion), Kedah (+RM457.7 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM105.2 juta), Melaka (+RM63.9 juta) dan Pahang (+RM59.0 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di W.P. Labuan sebanyak RM1.1 bilion, Sabah (-RM150.4 juta), Perlis (-RM34.8 juta) dan Kelantan (-RM26.3 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 31.6 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (21.4%), Selangor (17.6%), Sarawak (7.6%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Julai 2024 meningkat RM25.3 bilion (+25.4%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (+RM8.4 bilion), Johor (+RM5.6 bilion), Selangor (+RM5.4 bilion), Kedah (+RM2.3 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.5 bilion), Melaka (+RM440.6 juta), Perak (+RM380.8 juta), Sarawak (+RM138.6 juta), Kelantan (+RM81.2 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM64.8 juta), Perlis (+RM60.9 juta), Terengganu (+RM55.6 juta) dan Pahang (+RM26.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Sabah sebanyak RM43.7 juta dan W.P. Labuan (-RM36.8 juta).

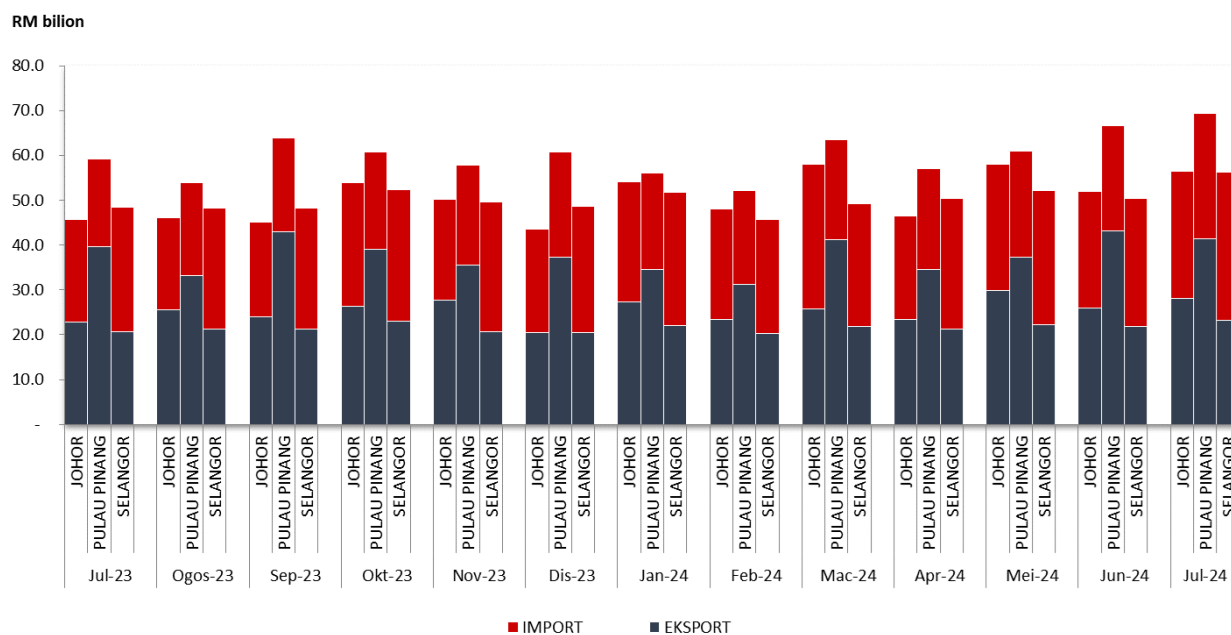
Selangor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 26.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (22.7%), Pulau Pinang (22.3%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.0%) dan Kedah (5.8%).

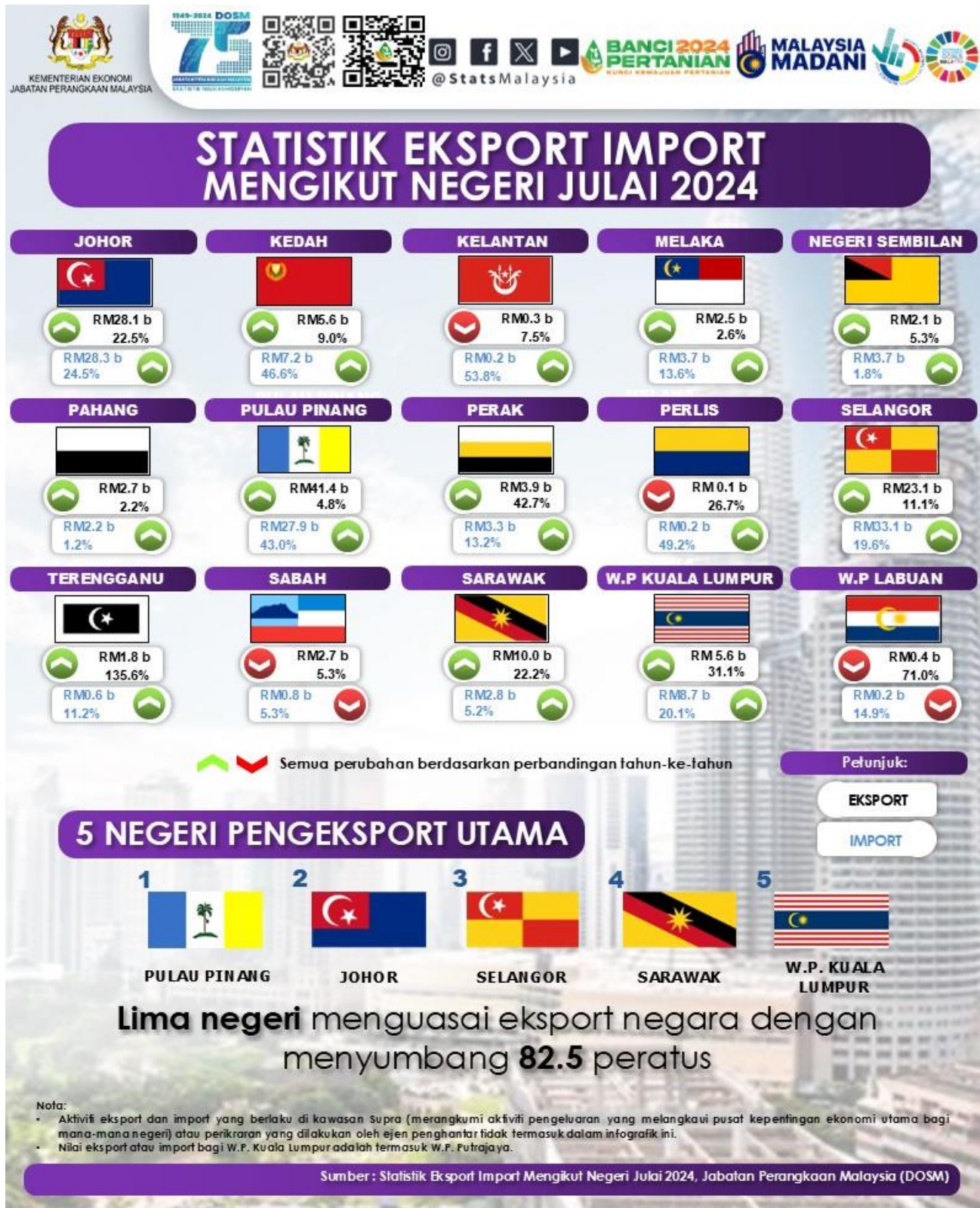

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JULY 2024

PULAU PINANG, JOHOR AND SELANGOR CONTRIBUTED 70.6 PER CENT OF EXPORTS IN JULY 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 August 2024 – Malaysia's total trade for July 2024 amounted to RM255.9 billion with exports and imports recorded RM131.1 billion and RM124.7 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JULY 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM131.1 billion in July 2024, increased RM14.4 billion (+12.3%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in most states such as Johor (+RM5.2 billion), Selangor (+RM2.3 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM1.9 billion), Sarawak (+RM1.8 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.3 billion), Perak (+RM1.2 billion), Terengganu (+RM1.0 billion), Kedah (+RM457.7 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM105.2 million), Melaka (+RM63.9 million) and Pahang (+RM59.0 million). However, exports decreased in W.P. Labuan by RM1.1 billion, Sabah (-RM150.4 million), Perlis (-RM34.8 million) and Kelantan (-RM26.3 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 31.6 per cent share, followed by Johor (21.4%), Selangor (17.6%), Sarawak (7.6%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in July 2024 increased RM25.3 billion (+25.4%) as compared to the same month in 2023. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM8.4 billion), Johor (+RM5.6 billion), Selangor (+RM5.4 billion), Kedah (+RM2.3 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.5 billion), Melaka (+RM440.6 million), Perak (+RM380.8 million), Sarawak (+RM138.6 million), Kelantan (+RM81.2 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM64.8 million), Perlis (+RM60.9 million), Terengganu (+RM55.6 million) and Pahang (+RM26.7 million). However, imports decreased in Sabah by RM43.7 million and W.P. Labuan (-RM36.8 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 26.5 per cent, followed by Johor (22.7%), Pulau Pinang (22.3%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.0%) and Kedah (5.8%).

July 2023 – July 2024 (RM Billion)**

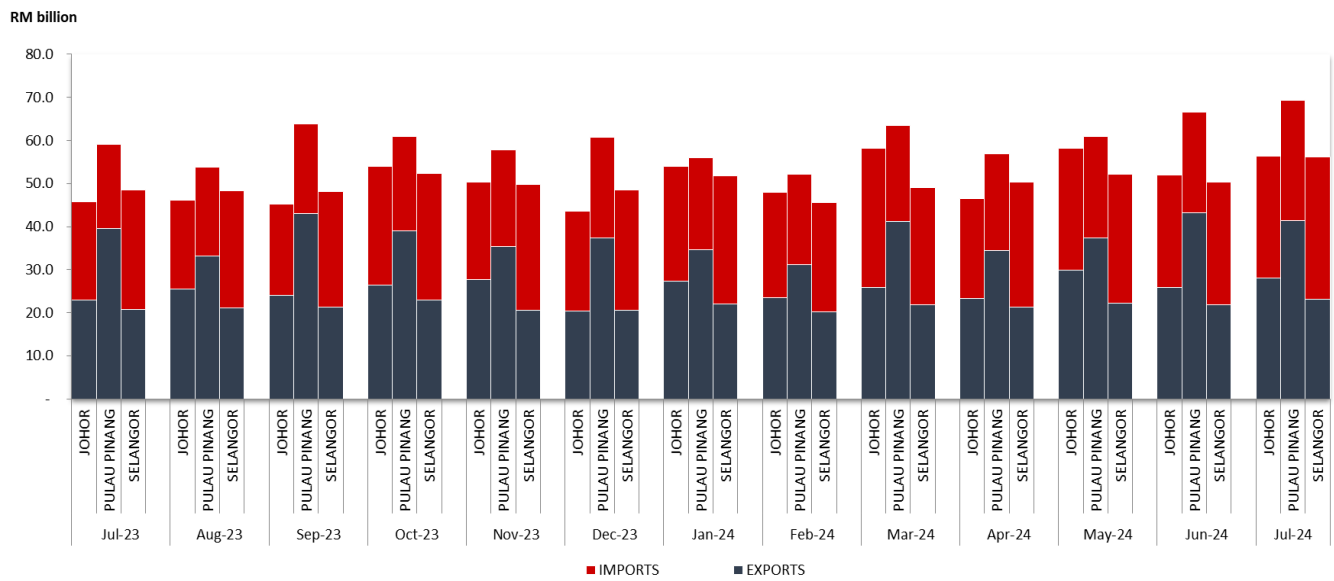
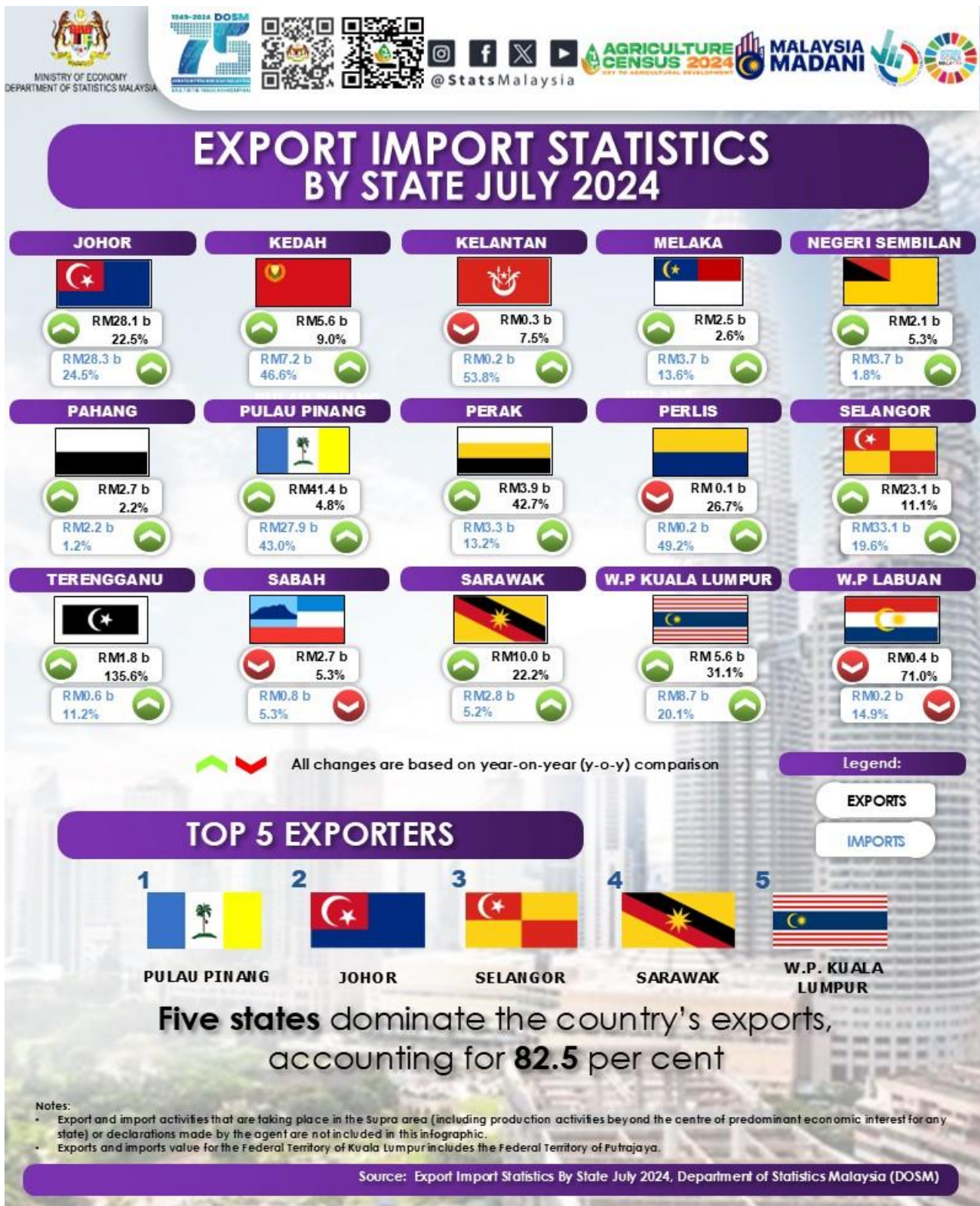


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, July 2024
