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INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN, MALAYSIA JULAI 2024

Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat 5.3 peratus pada Julai 2024, dipacu oleh pertumbuhan kukuh output sektor Pembuatan

PUTRAJAYA, 10 SEPTEMBER 2024 – Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat 5.3 peratus pada Julai 2024, dipacu oleh pertumbuhan kukuh output sektor Pembuatan. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP), Malaysia, Julai 2024** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor iaitu Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) meningkat sebanyak 5.3 peratus pada Julai 2024 selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 5.0 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Pengembangan ini dipacu oleh peningkatan kukuh output Pembuatan sebanyak 7.7 peratus (Jun 2024: 5.2%) dan pertumbuhan output Elektrik sebanyak 7.0 peratus (Jun 2024: 3.5%). Sementara itu, pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan menurun 5.0 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan positif 4.9 peratus pada Jun 2024. Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, IPP menurun 1.5 peratus daripada pertumbuhan 4.8 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya."

Kedua-dua industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik menunjukkan prestasi yang baik pada Julai 2024 dengan masing-masing merekodkan pertumbuhan 7.8 peratus (Jun 2024: 5.4%) dan 7.5 peratus (Jun 2024: 4.6%). Pertumbuhan industri berorientasikan eksport disokong oleh pengembangan merentasi semua industri, terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan dua digit dalam Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan sebanyak 21.9 peratus (Jun 2024: 11.0%); dan diikuti oleh Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal sebanyak 5.0 peratus (Jun 2024: 4.9%). Selain itu, Pembuatan kok

dan produk petroleum bertapis turut kekal tinggi, dengan pertumbuhan sebanyak 11.7 peratus (Jun 2024: 12.5%). Pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun industri yang berorientasikan eksport dicerminkan oleh prestasi eksport barangan perkilangan negara, yang meningkat 10.6 peratus pada Julai 2024. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport menurun 3.3 peratus daripada pertumbuhan 11.8 peratus pada Jun 2024.

Peningkatan dalam industri berorientasikan domestik didorong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan kukuh dalam Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain; dan Pembuatan logam asas, yang masing-masing mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 12.2 peratus dan 10.5 peratus. Tambahan lagi, Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler memulih dengan pertumbuhan 3.9 peratus (Jun 2024: -10.7%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat 1.0 peratus (Jun 2024: -5.4%).

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menambah, "Penurunan 5.0 peratus dalam sektor Perlombongan adalah berikutan penyusutan 5.4 peratus (Jun 2024: 6.0%) pengeluaran Gas Asli dan kejatuhan 4.4 peratus (Jun 2024: 3.4%) dalam output Minyak Mentah & Kondensat pada bulan tersebut. Indeks Perlombongan menurun 2.1 peratus bulan ke bulan, berbanding pertumbuhan positif 4.0 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Sementara itu, penjanaan Elektrik meningkat 7.0 peratus (Jun 2024: 3.5%) tahun ke tahun pada Julai 2024. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, indeks Elektrik memulih 5.4 peratus (Jun 2024: -6.2%)."

Di peringkat global, IPP bagi beberapa negara meningkat pada Julai 2024, termasuk Korea Selatan, Singapura, Jepun, Vietnam, dan Thailand, dengan pertumbuhan yang lebih perlahan dilihat di China dan Taiwan. Sebaliknya, Amerika Syarikat mengalami penurunan marginal pada Julai 2024.

Merumuskan kenyataan beliau, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, "Bagi tempoh tujuh bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – Julai 2024), IPP meningkat 4.1 peratus (Januari – Julai 2023: 1.1%) dengan kesemua sektor mencatatkan peningkatan, iaitu indeks Perlombongan (2.9%); indeks Pembuatan (4.1%); dan indeks Elektrik (7.1%)."

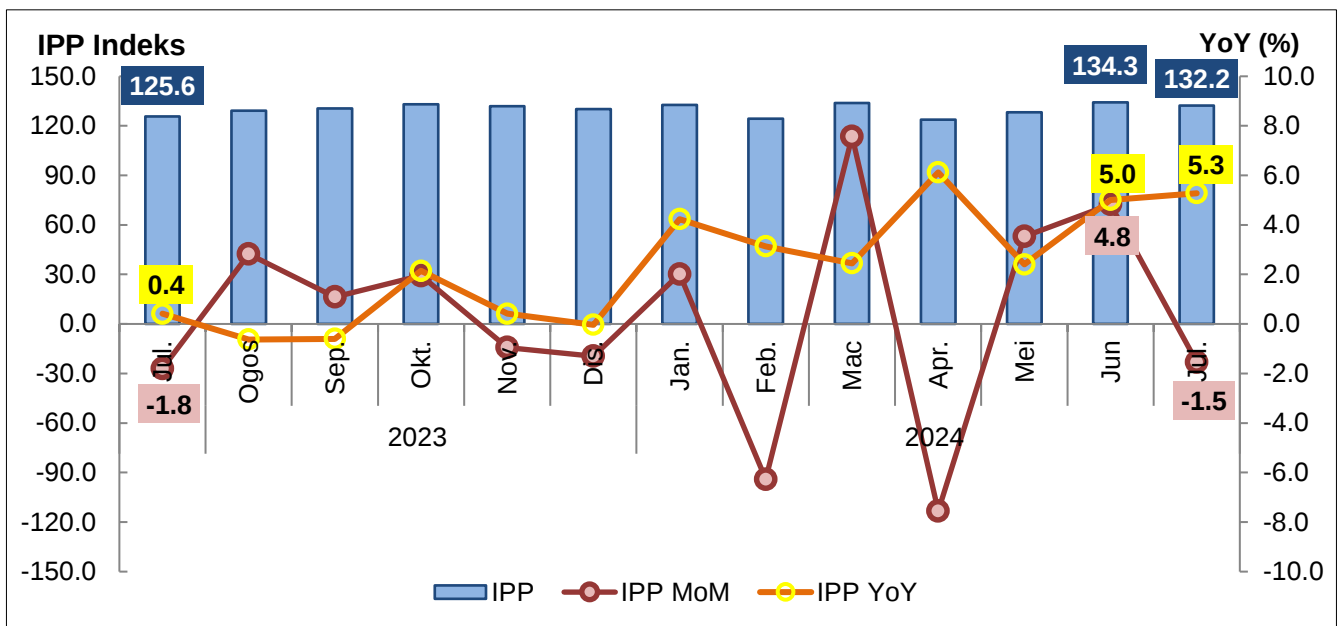

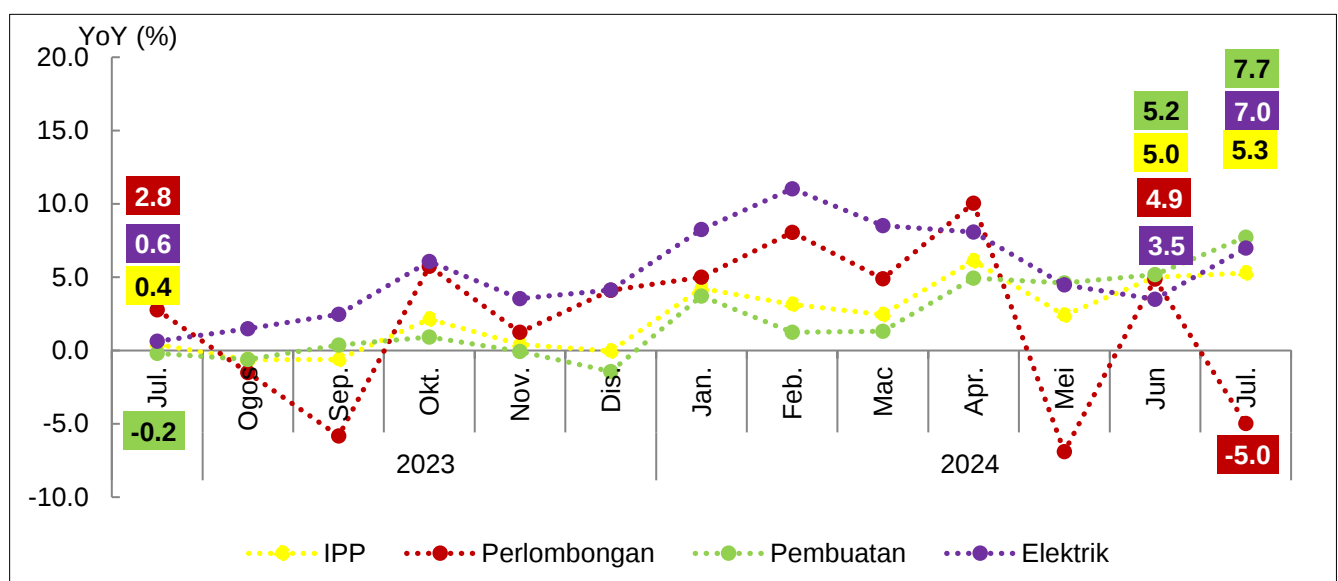

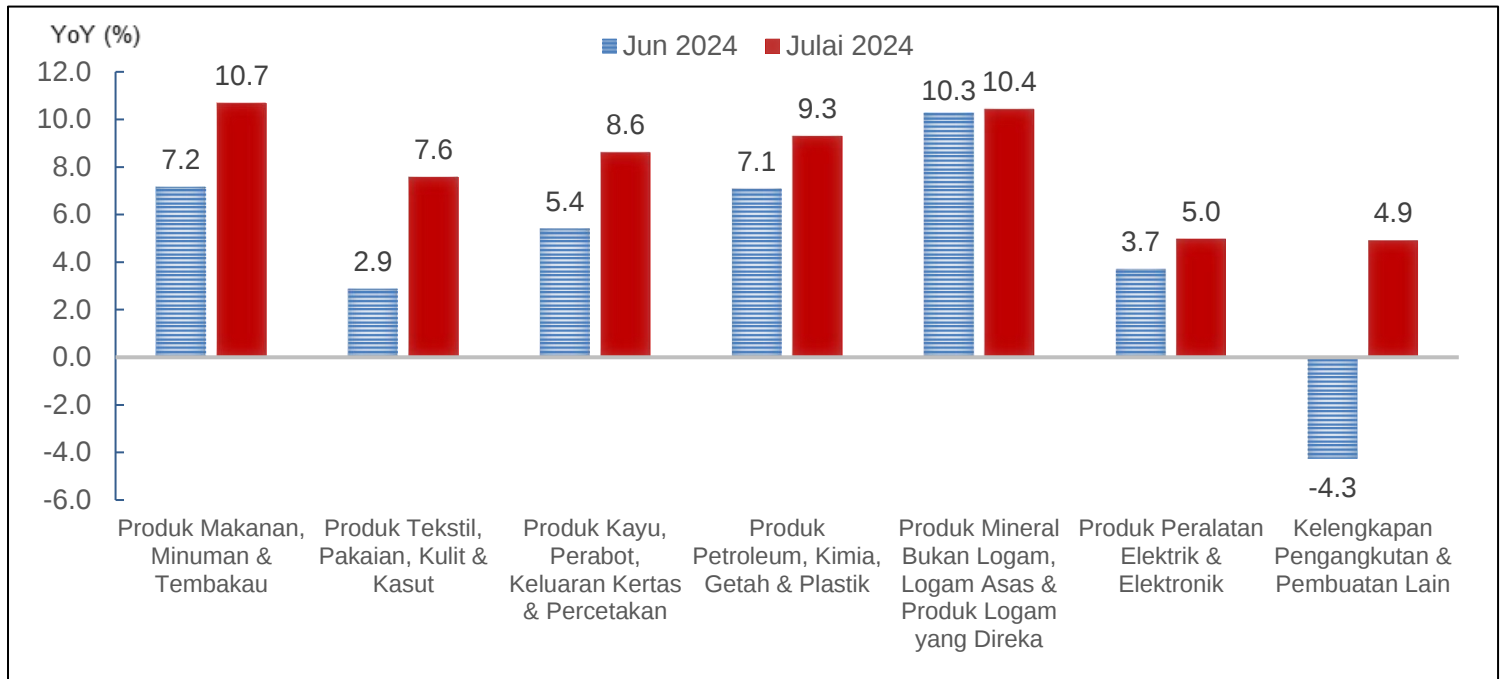
Carta 1: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian, Malaysia, Julai 2023 - Julai 2024



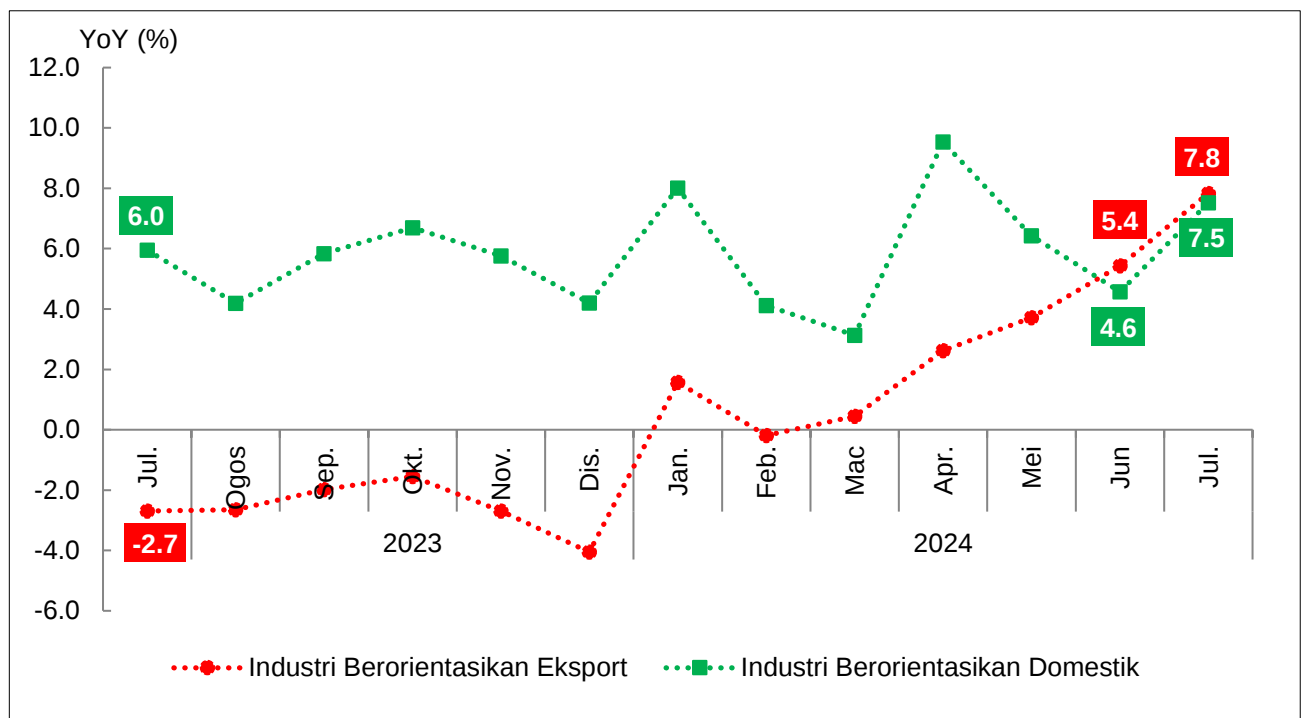
Carta 2: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian dan Komponennya, Malaysia Julai 2023 - Julai 2024



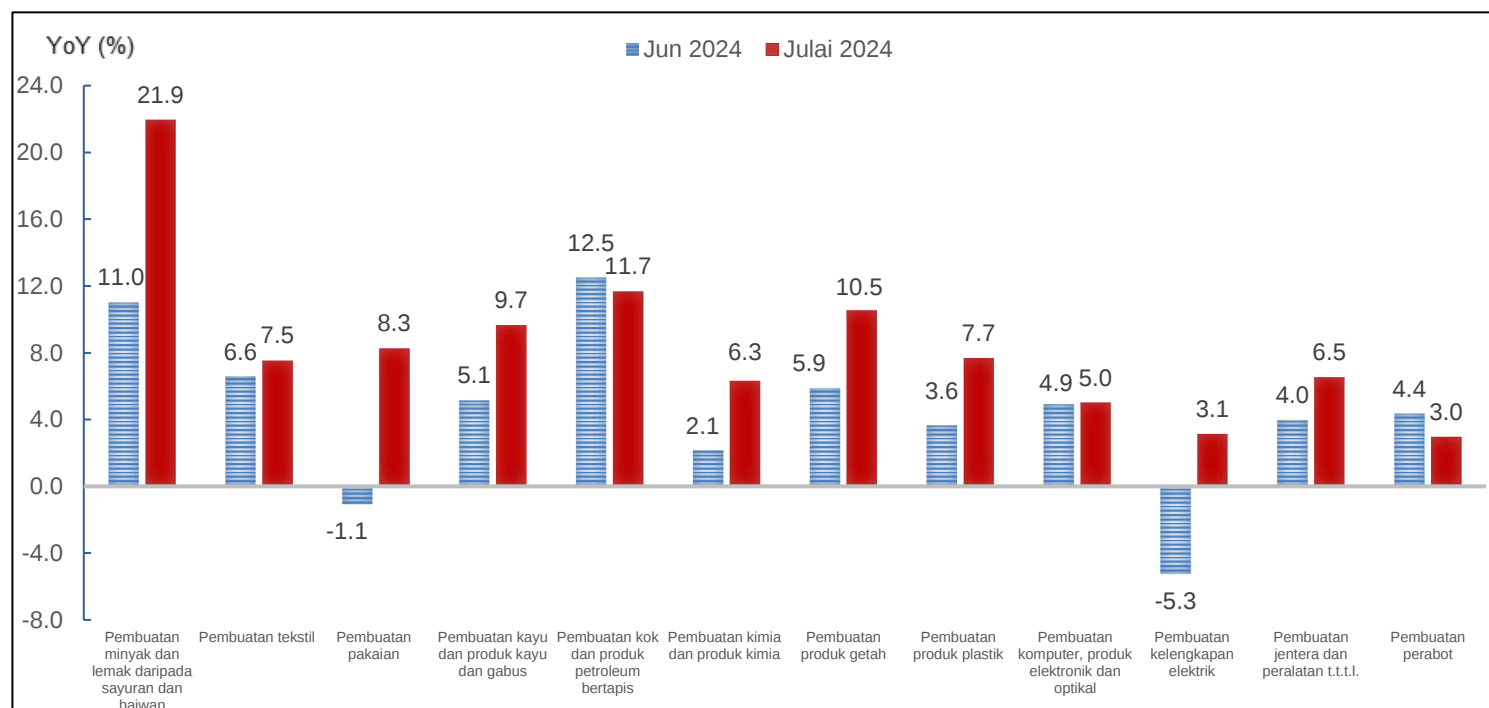
**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Subsektor, Malaysia
Jun 2024 dan Julai 2024**



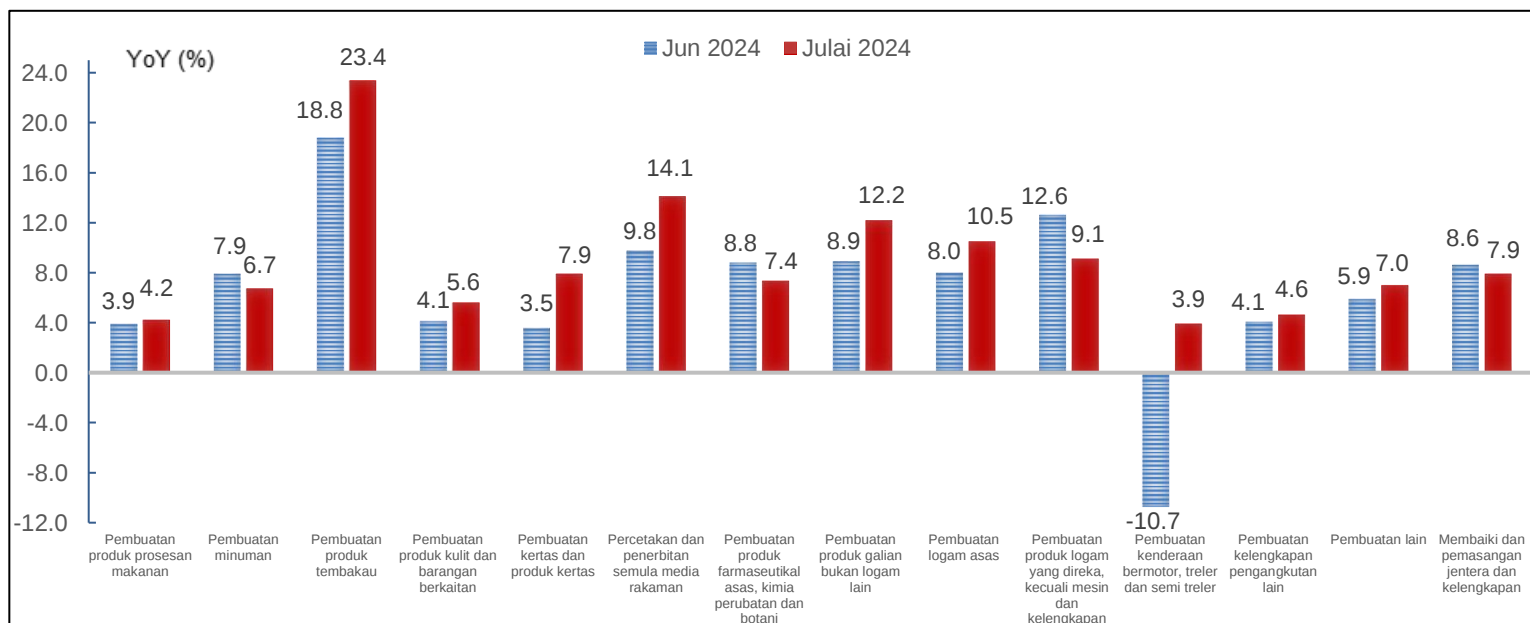

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INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA

JULY 2024

The Industrial Production Index expanded by 5.3 per cent in July 2024, driven by strong growth in the Manufacturing sector output

PUTRAJAYA, 10TH SEPTEMBER 2024 – The Industrial Production Index expanded by 5.3 per cent in July 2024, driven by strong growth in the Manufacturing sector output. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of the **Industrial Production Index (IPI), Malaysia, July 2024**. The publication presents IPI statistics, consisting of three sectors namely Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “The Industrial Production Index (IPI) expanded 5.3 per cent in July 2024 after registering 5.0 per cent growth in the preceding month. The expansion was attributable to the strong increase in the Manufacturing output 7.7 per cent (June 2024: 5.2%) and a 7.0 per cent growth (June 2024: 3.5%) in Electricity output. Meanwhile, the production of the Mining sector declined 5.0 per cent as against positive growth of 4.9 per cent in June 2024. In comparison with the preceding month, the IPI dropped 1.5 per cent from 4.8 per cent growth in the previous month.”

Both export-oriented and domestic-oriented industries perform favourably in July 2024 by recording 7.8 per cent (June 2024: 5.4%) and 7.5 per cent (June 2024: 4.6%) growths, respectively. The growth in export-oriented industries was underpinned by broad-based expansion across all industries particularly by a double-digit growth of 21.9 per cent (June 2024: 11.0%) in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats; and followed by Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products at 5.0 per cent (June 2024: 4.9%). In addition, the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products also remained high, with

a growth of 11.7 per cent (June 2024: 12.5%). The year-on-year expansion of export-oriented industries mirrored the performance of the country's export of manufactured goods, which increased by 10.6 per cent in July 2024. On a month-on-month comparison, the export-oriented industries fell 3.3 per cent from 11.8 per cent growth in June 2024.

The upturn in domestic-oriented industries was primarily driven by a robust growth in the Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products; and the Manufacture of basic metals, which registered increases of 12.2 per cent and 10.5 per cent, respectively. Additionally, the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers rebounded with a growth of 3.9 per cent (June 2024: -10.7%). In comparison to the preceding month, the domestic-oriented industries increased 1.0 per cent (June 2024: -5.4%).

Elaborating further, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The contraction of 5.0 per cent in the Mining sector was due to a decline in Natural Gas production 5.4 per cent (June 2024: 6.0%) and a drop of 4.4 per cent (June 2024: 3.4%) in the Crude Oil & Condensate output during the month. The Mining index decreased 2.1 per cent month-on-month, contrasting with the positive growth of 4.0 per cent in the previous month. Meanwhile, the generation of Electricity rose by 7.0 per cent (June 2024: 3.5%) year-on-year in July 2024. On a month-on-month basis, the Electricity index rebounded by 5.4 per cent (June 2024: -6.2%)."

On a global scale, the IPI for several countries surged in July 2024, including South Korea, Singapore, Japan, Vietnam, and Thailand, with slower growth seen in China and Taiwan. Conversely, the United States experienced a marginal decline in July 2024.

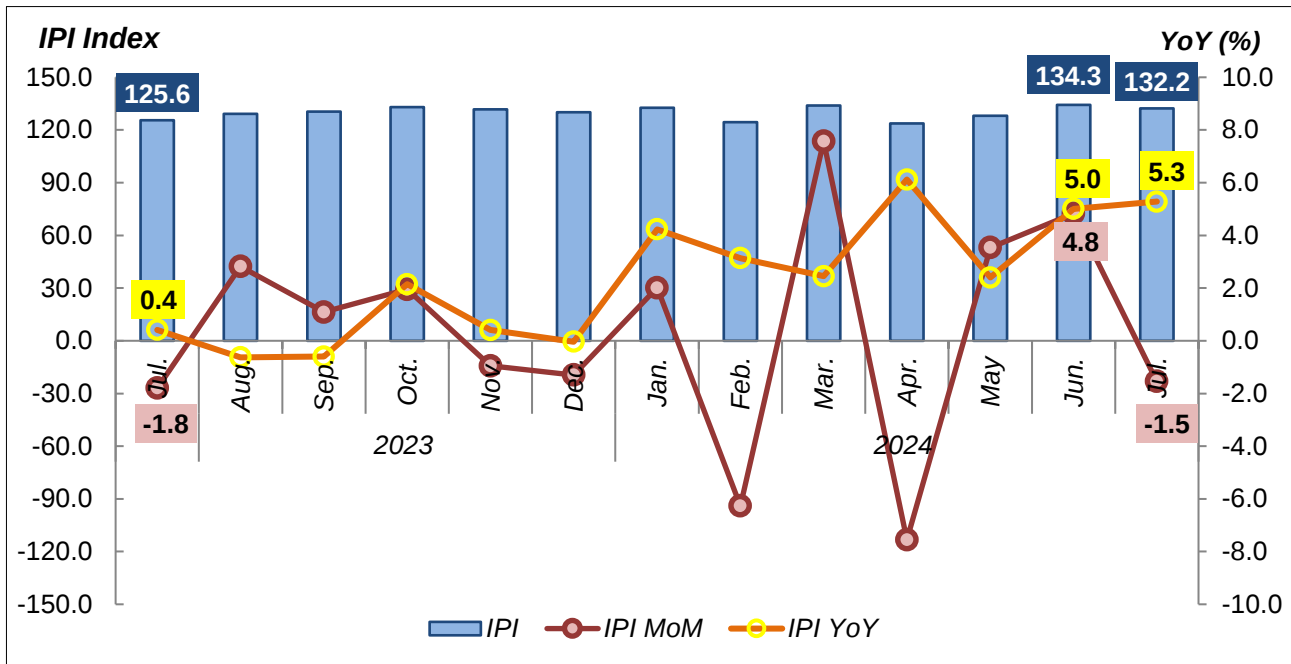
Concluding his statement, the Chief Statistician said, "For the first seven months this year (January – July 2024), the IPI improved 4.1 per cent (January - July 2023: 1.1%), with all sectors posting increases, namely the Mining index (2.9%); Manufacturing index (4.1%); and Electricity index (7.1%)."

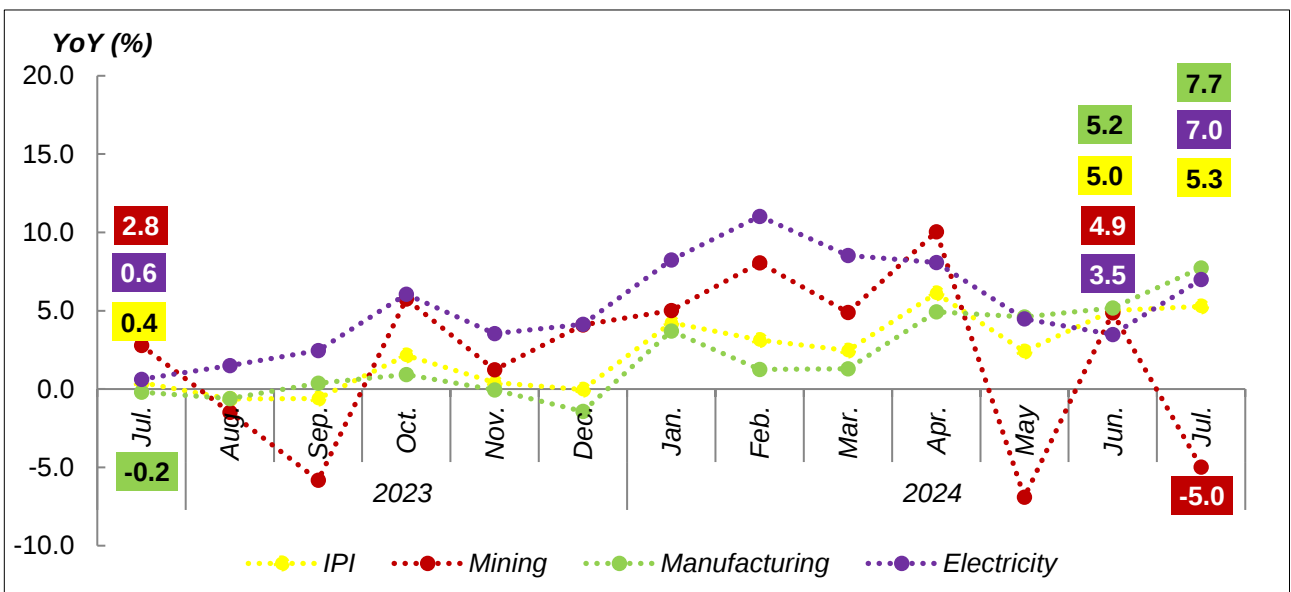

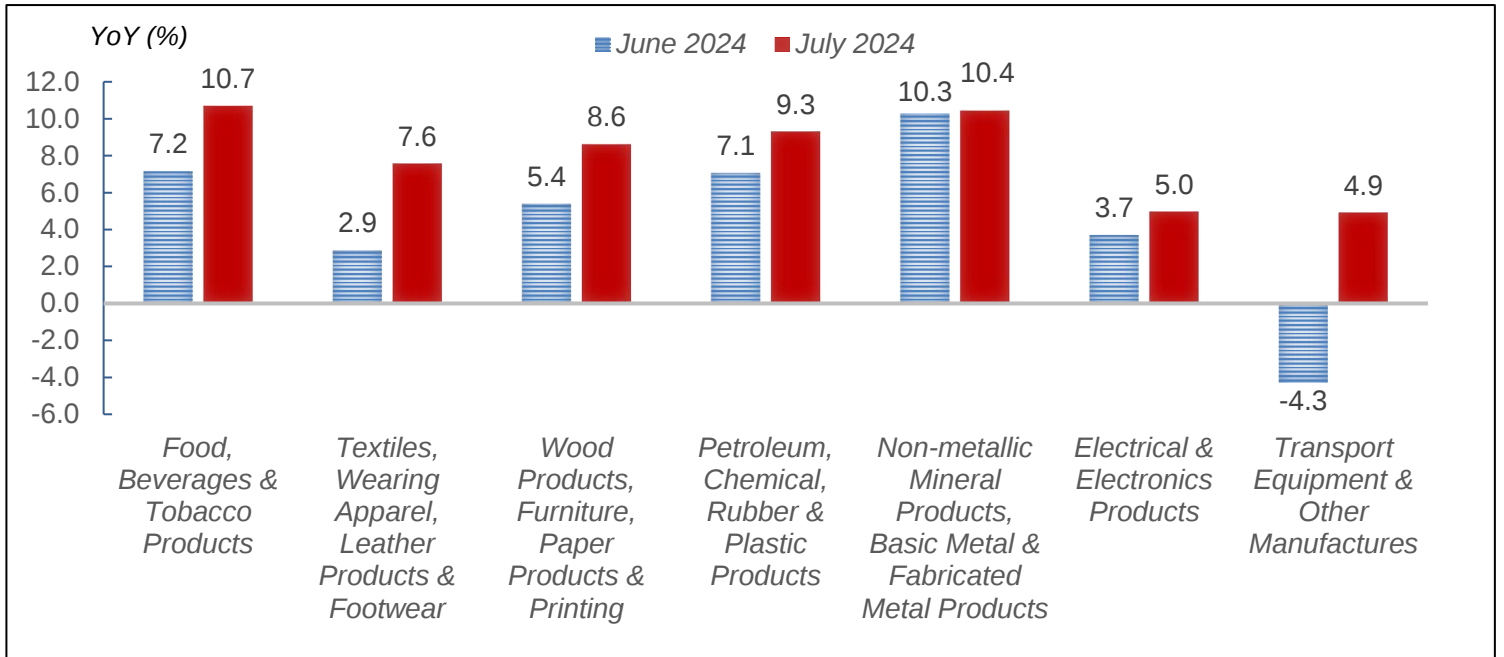
**Chart 1: Industrial Production Index, Malaysia,
July 2023 – July 2024**



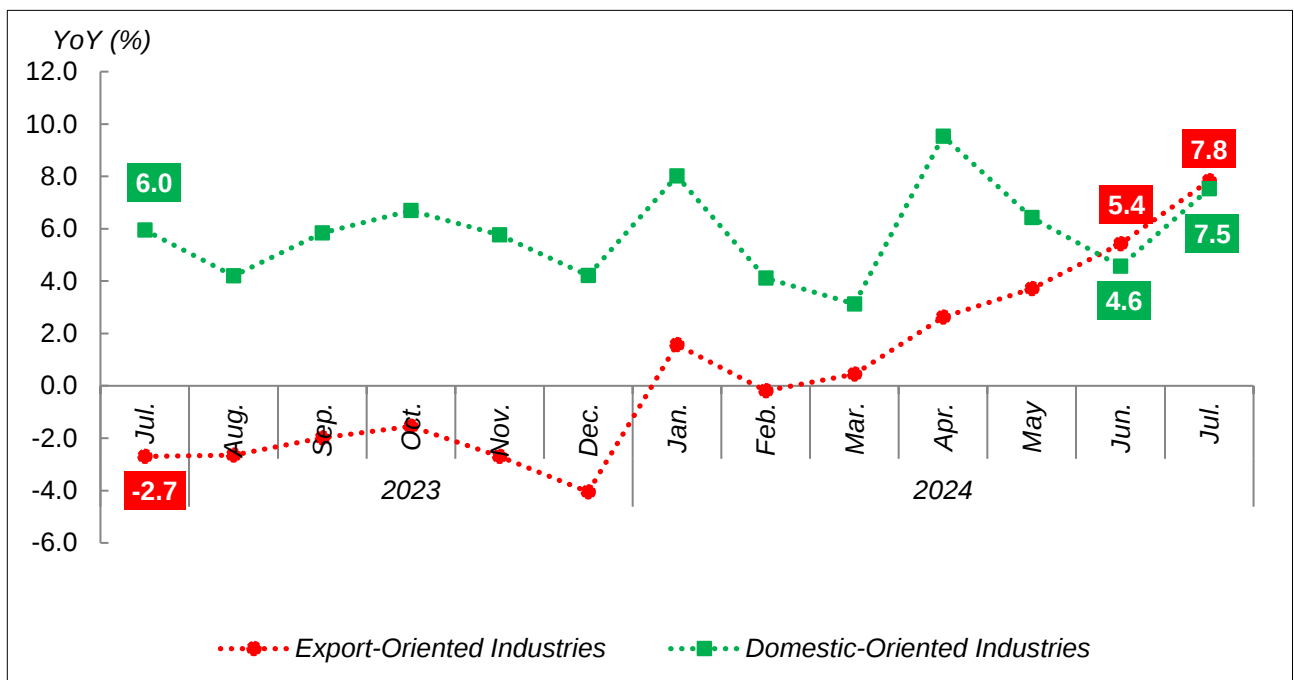
**Chart 2: Industrial Production Index and Its Components, Malaysia
July 2023 – July 2024**



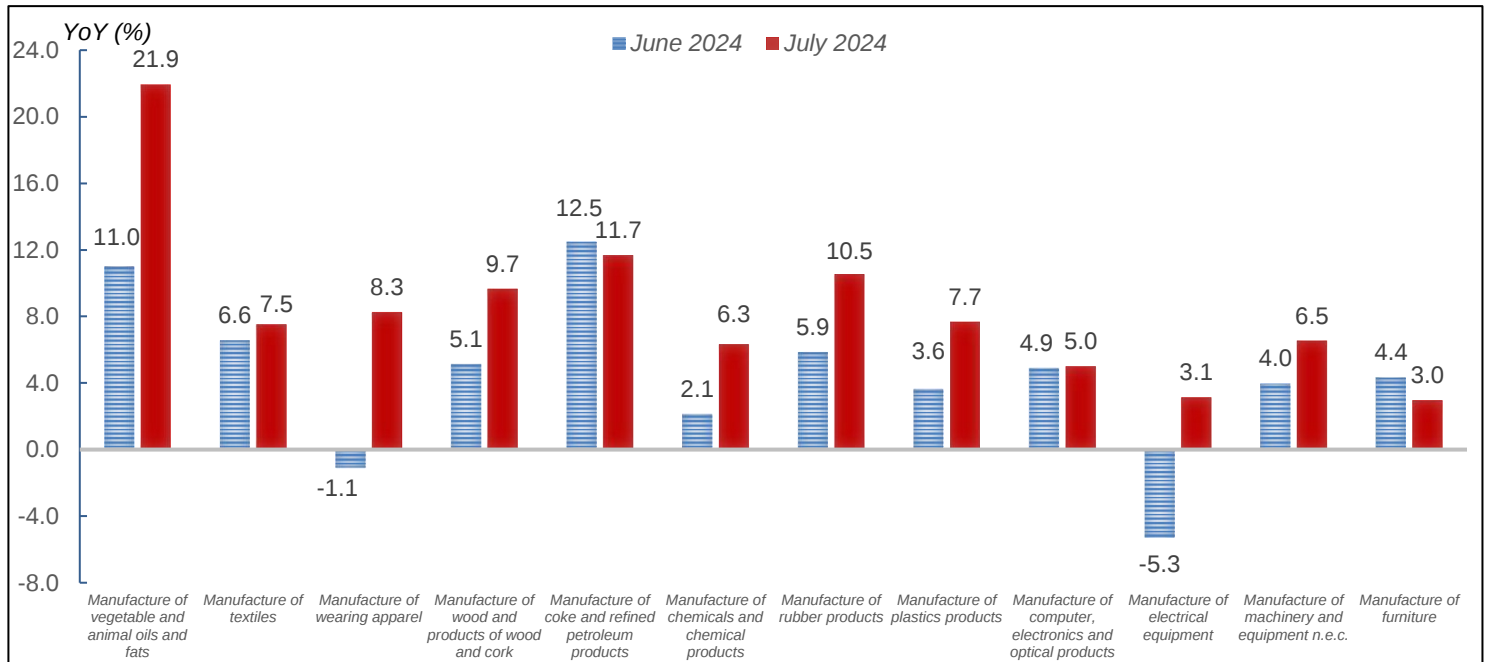
**Chart 3: Manufacturing Index Growth by Subsector, Malaysia,
June 2024 and July 2024**



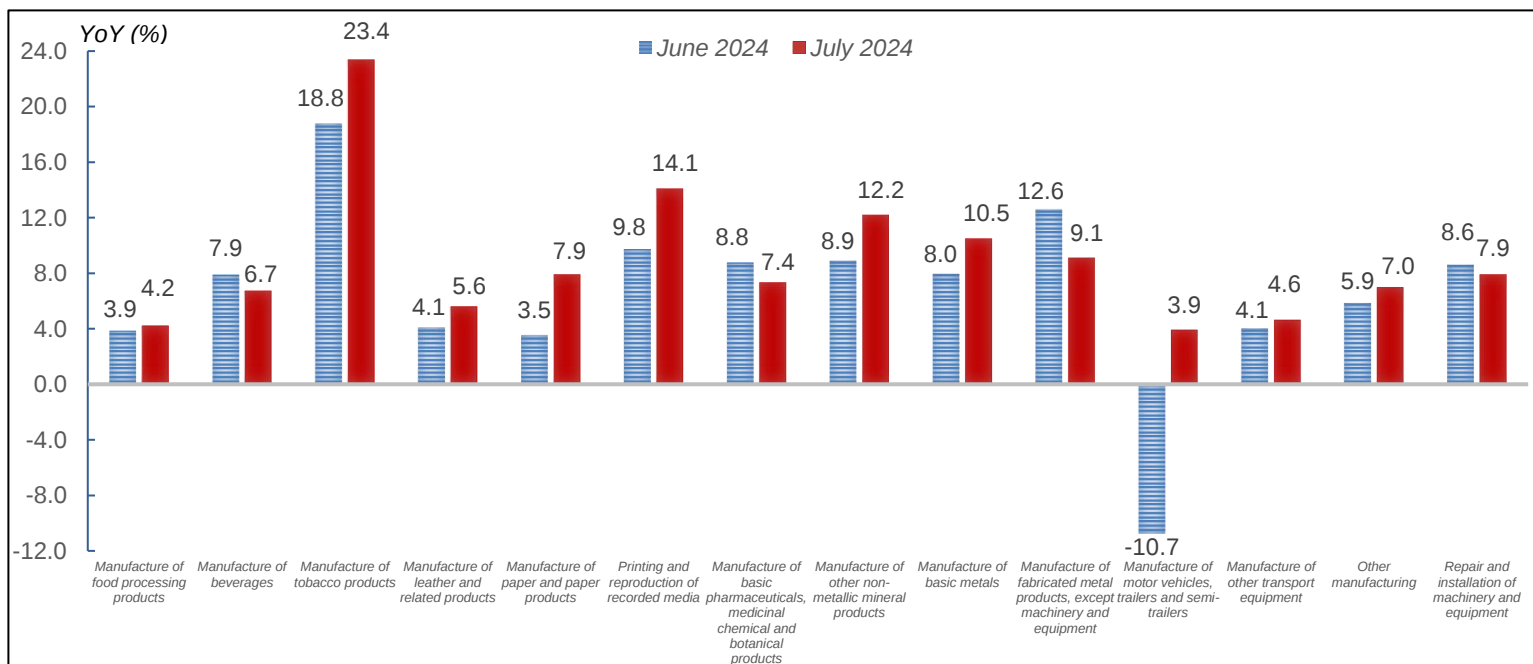
**Chart 5: Manufacturing Index by Export and Domestic Oriented Industries,
