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PERANGKAAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA JULAI 2024

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencapai RM157.1 bilion pada Julai 2024, mencatatkan peningkatan 9.1 peratus berbanding setahun yang lalu

PUTRAJAYA, 10 SEPTEMBER 2024 – Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencapai RM157.1 bilion pada Julai 2024, mencatatkan peningkatan 9.1 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Julai 2024**.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat 9.1 peratus untuk mencapai RM157.1 bilion pada Julai 2024 (Julai 2023: -3.0%), menunjukkan pertumbuhan tertinggi sejak Februari 2023 (10.3%). Peningkatan ini sebahagian besarnya dipacu oleh pertumbuhan dua digit iaitu sebanyak 16.0 peratus (Jun 2024: 8.6%) dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau; diikuti oleh subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (8.2 peratus); dan Petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik (6.2 peratus). Berasaskan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan tumbuh sebanyak 0.6 peratus daripada RM156.1 bilion pada Jun 2024 (0.8%)."

Industri berorientasikan eksport yang merangkumi 72.3 peratus daripada jumlah nilai jualan, kekal kukuh dengan pertumbuhan 9.4 peratus pada Julai 2024 selepas mencatatkan peningkatan 6.0 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Prestasi yang lebih

baik ini disebabkan terutamanya oleh peningkatan dalam industri Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal (9.1%); Pembuatan minyak dan lemak daripada sayuran dan haiwan (23.5%); dan Pembuatan kok dan produk petroleum bertapis (4.8%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport turun sedikit sebanyak 0.5 peratus (Jun 2024: 3.9%).

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik mengukuh pada 8.4 peratus (Jun 2024: 5.5%), dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh Pembuatan produk makanan pada 7.0 peratus. Dalam pada itu, industri Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler dan semi treler memulih kepada 6.2 peratus daripada penurunan 5.2 peratus yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Bagi perbandingan secara bulanan, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat semula sebanyak 3.7 peratus selepas kekal pada trend menurun sejak April 2024 (Jun 2024: -6.7%).

Ketua Perangkawan menambah, “Terdapat 2.37 juta pekerja terlibat dalam sektor Pembuatan pada Julai 2024, meningkat 1.3 peratus (Jun 2024: 1.0%) berbanding setahun lalu. Pertumbuhan itu sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh Makanan, minuman & tembakau (4.0%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (2.3%); dan Kayu, perabot, produk kertas & percetakan (1.2%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini merosot sedikit 0.01 peratus (Jun 2024: -0.3%).

Pada masa yang sama, gaji & upah dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 2.4 peratus, mencecah jumlah RM8.12 bilion. Ini menjadikan kenaikan purata gaji & upah bulanan setiap pekerja adalah sebanyak 1.2 peratus kepada RM3,429 (Jun 2024: 0.8%; RM3,459). Selari dengan itu, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja meningkat sebanyak 7.8 peratus untuk merekodkan RM66,285 (Jun 2024: 4.8%; RM65,874).”

Merumuskan kenyataan beliau, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Dalam tempoh tujuh bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – Julai 2024), nilai jualan kumulatif sektor Pembuatan mencatatkan RM1,078.6 bilion, meningkat 4.5 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama 2023 (Januari - Julai 2023: RM1,032.6 bilion; 2.5%). Bilangan pekerja meningkat 1.3 peratus kepada sejumlah 2.37 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah

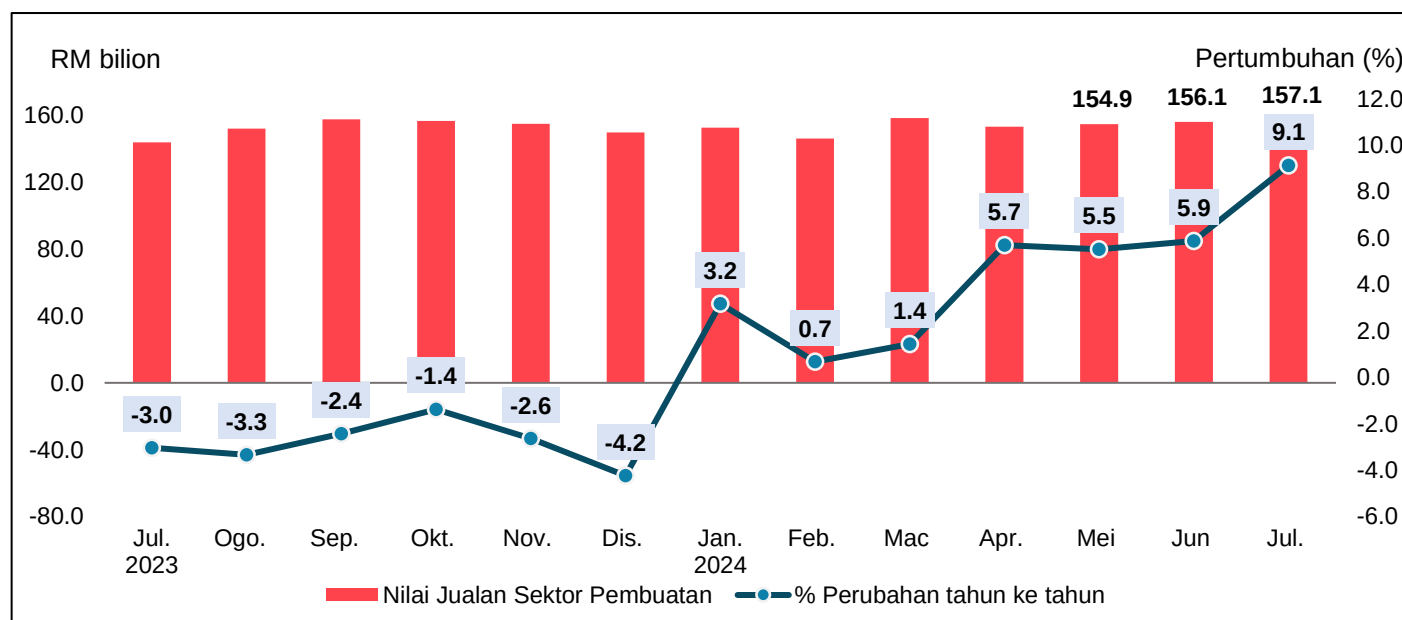
tumbuh 1.5 peratus kepada RM57.4 bilion. Selain itu, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja berjumlah RM455,213, mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak 3.2 peratus.”

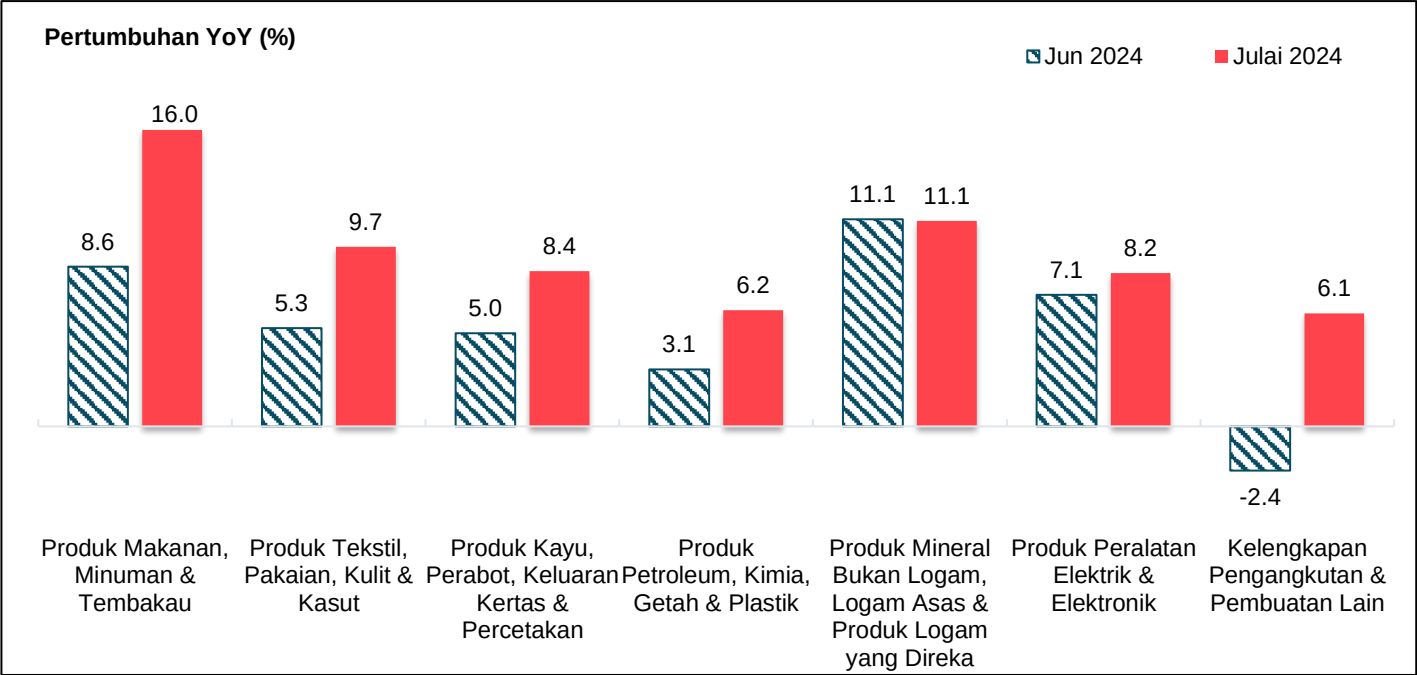

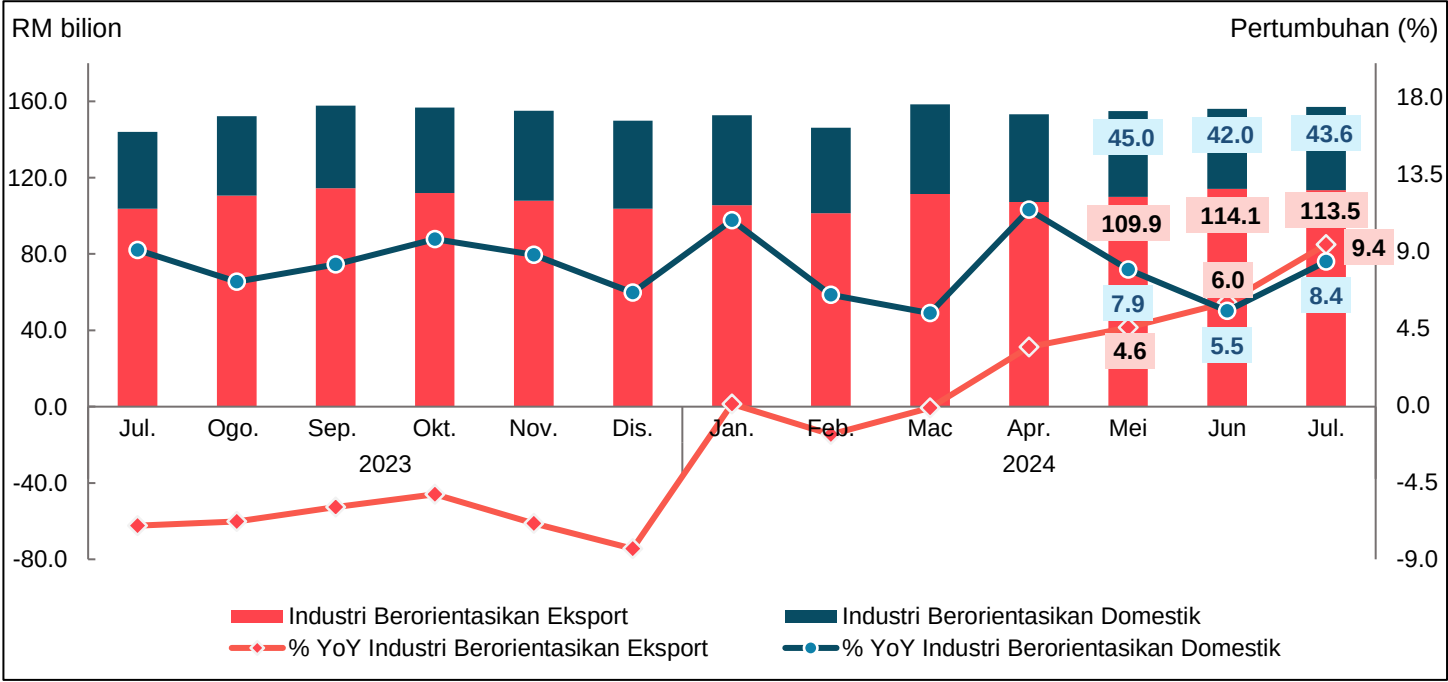
Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Julai 2023 - Julai 2024



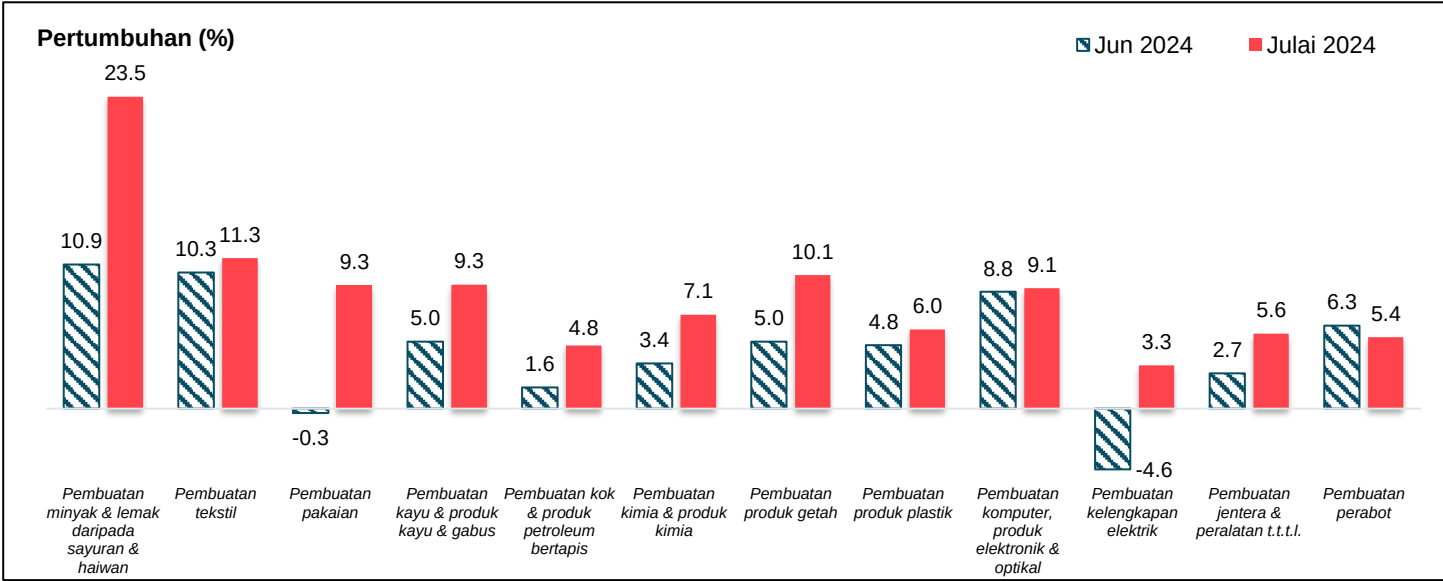
Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan,
Jun 2024 dan Julai 2024



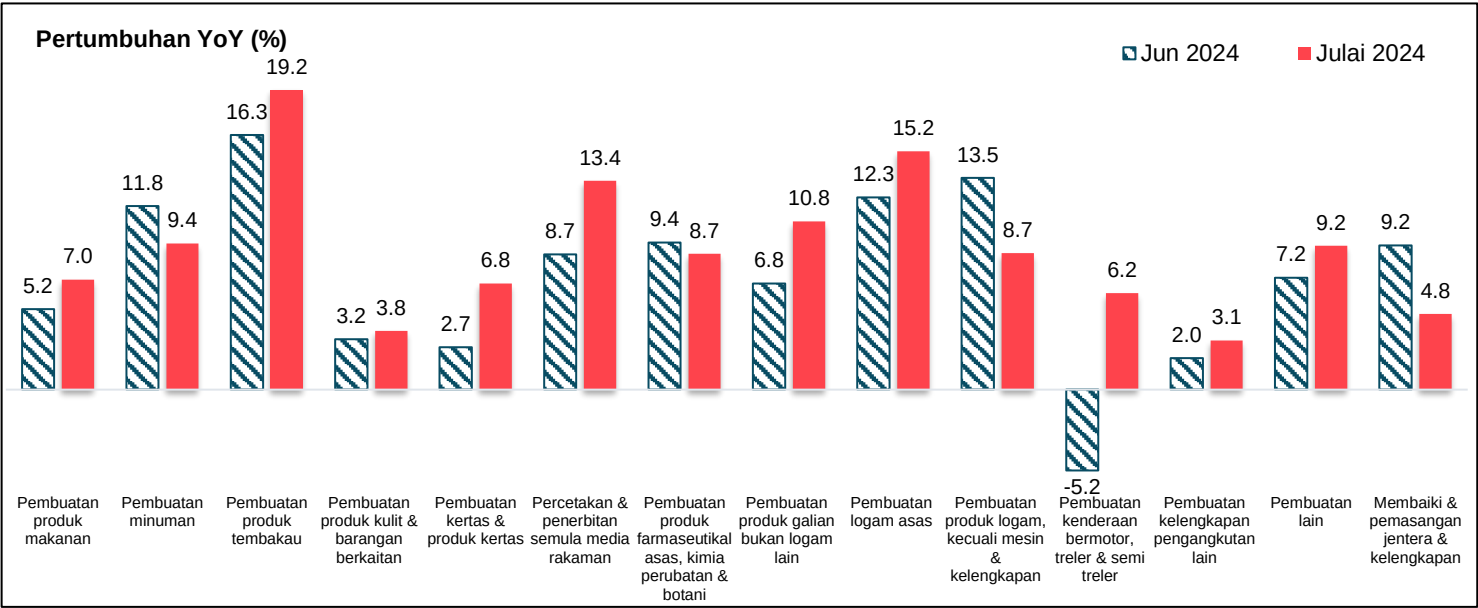
Carta 3: Nilai Jualan Industri Berorientasikan Eksport dan Domestik bagi

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MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA JULY 2024

The Manufacturing sector's sales value reached RM157.1 billion in July 2024, registering a surge of 9.1 per cent compared a year ago

PUTRAJAYA, SEPTEMBER 10, 2024 – The Manufacturing sector's sales value reached RM157.1 billion in July 2024, registering a surge of 9.1 per cent compared to the same month of last year. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, July 2024**.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The Manufacturing sector's sales value surged by 9.1 per cent to reach RM157.1 billion in July 2024 (July 2023: -3.0%), marking the highest growth since February 2023 (10.3%). The increase was driven largely by a double-digit growth of 16.0 per cent (June 2024: 8.6%) in the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector; followed by the sub-sector of Electrical & electronics products (8.2 per cent); and the Petroleum chemical, rubber & plastic (6.2 per cent). On a month-to-month basis, the sales value grew by 0.6 per cent from RM156.1 billion in June 2024 (0.8%)."

Export-oriented industries which constituted 72.3 per cent of the total sales value, stayed robust with a 9.4 per cent growth in July 2024 after registering 6.0 per cent in the preceding month. The better performance was attributable to the increase in the

Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (9.1%); Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (23.5%); and Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products (4.8%) industries. For a month-on-month comparison, the sales value of the export-oriented industries dropped marginally by 0.5 per cent (June 2024: 3.9%).

Similarly, domestic-oriented industries strengthened at 8.4 per cent (June 2024: 5.5%), mainly influenced by the Manufacture of food processing products at 7.0 per cent. In the meantime, the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers industry rebounded to 6.2 per cent from a decline of 5.2 per cent recorded in the preceding month. For a comparison on a monthly basis, the sales value of domestic-oriented industries turned upward by 3.7 per cent after registering a declining trend since April 2024 (June 2024: -6.7%).

The Chief Statistician added, “There were 2.37 million employees engaged in the Manufacturing sector in July 2024, an increase of 1.3 per cent (June 2024: 1.0%) as compared to a year ago. The growth was predominantly attributed to Food, beverages & tobacco (4.0%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (2.3%); and Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (1.2%). In comparison with the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector declined slightly by 0.01 per cent (June 2024: -0.3%).

In the meantime, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector rose by 2.4 per cent, reaching a total of RM8.12 billion. This resulted in the increase of average monthly salaries & wages per employee by 1.2 per cent year-on-year to RM3,429 (June 2024: 0.8%; RM3,459). Simultaneously, the sales value per employee rose by 7.8 per cent to record RM66,285 (June 2024: 4.8%; RM65,874).”

Concluding his statement, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “For the first seven months of this year (January – July 2024), the Manufacturing sector's cumulative sales value reached RM1,078.6 billion, increased by 4.5 per cent as compared to the same period of 2023 (January - July 2023: RM1,032.6 billion; 2.5%). The number of employees went up by 1.3 per cent to a total of 2.37 million persons, while salaries & wages grew by

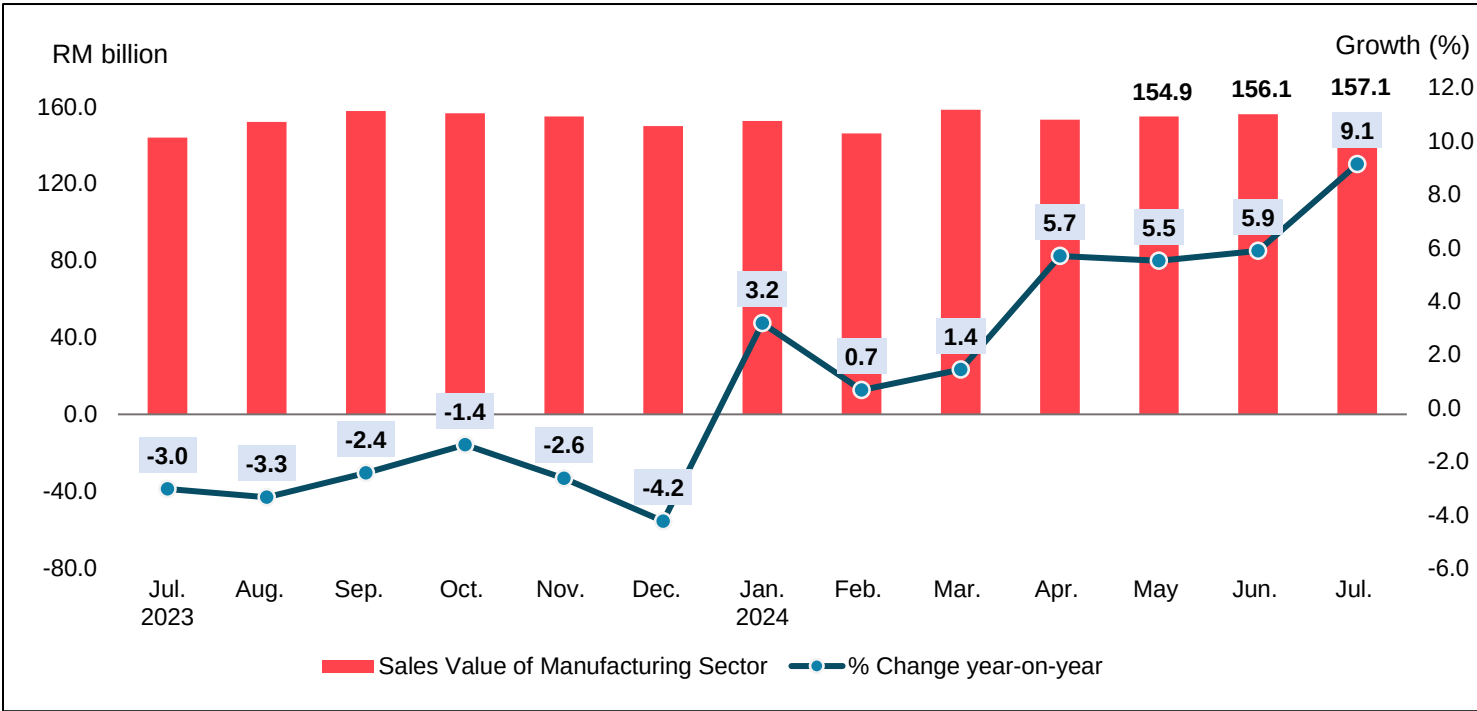
1.5 per cent to RM57.4 billion. Subsequently, the sales value per employee stood at RM455,213, posting a growth of 3.2 per cent.”

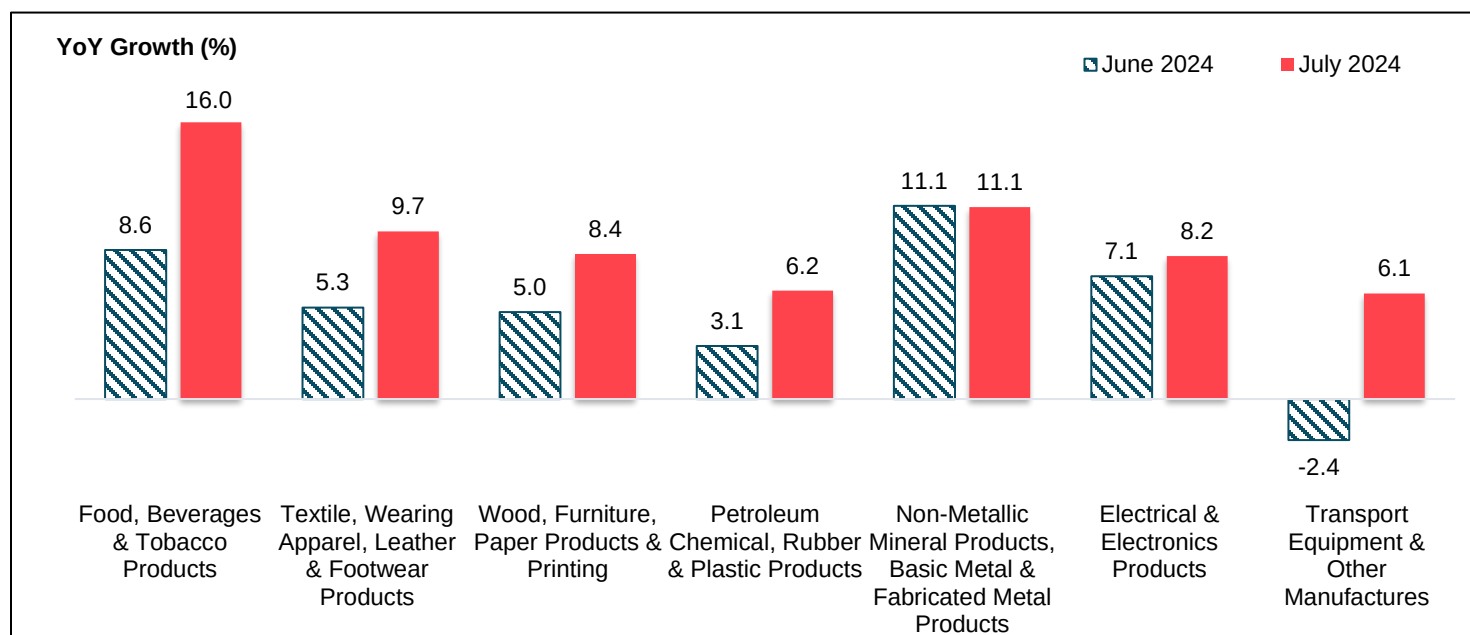

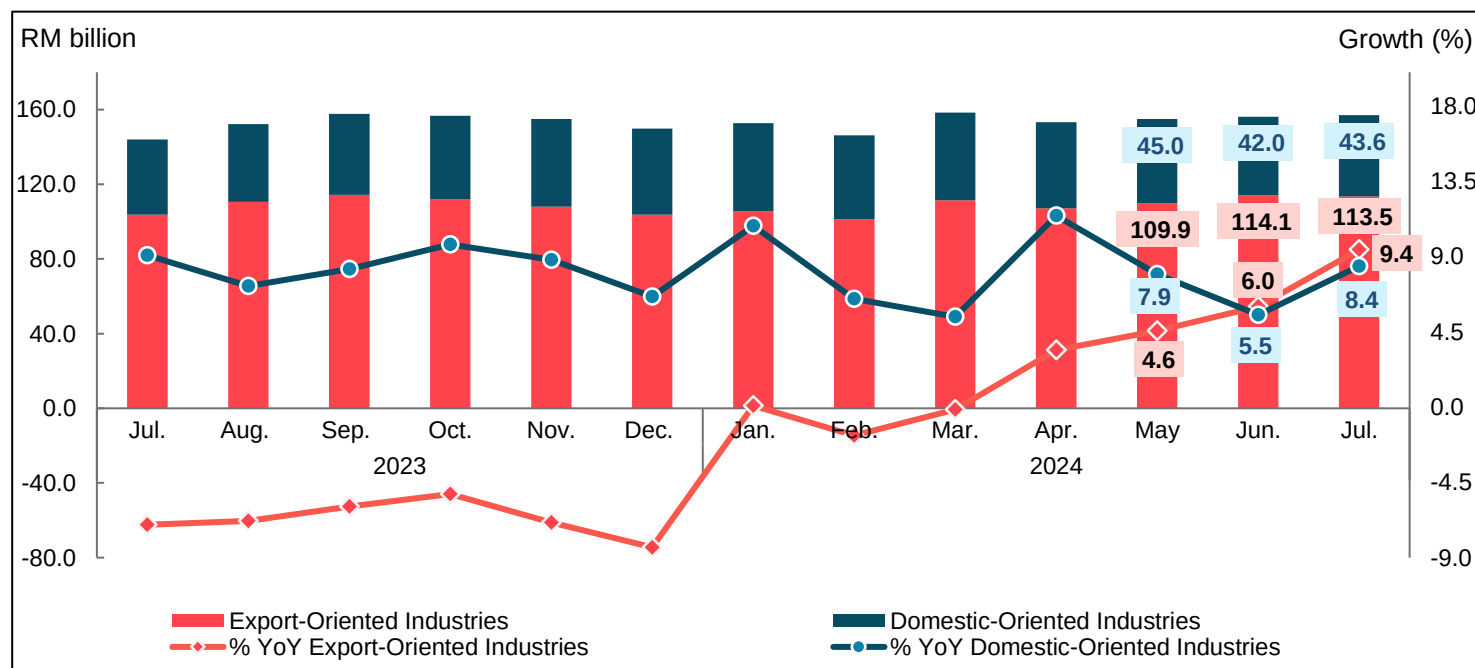
**Chart 1: Sales Value of the Manufacturing Sector,
July 2023 – July 2024**



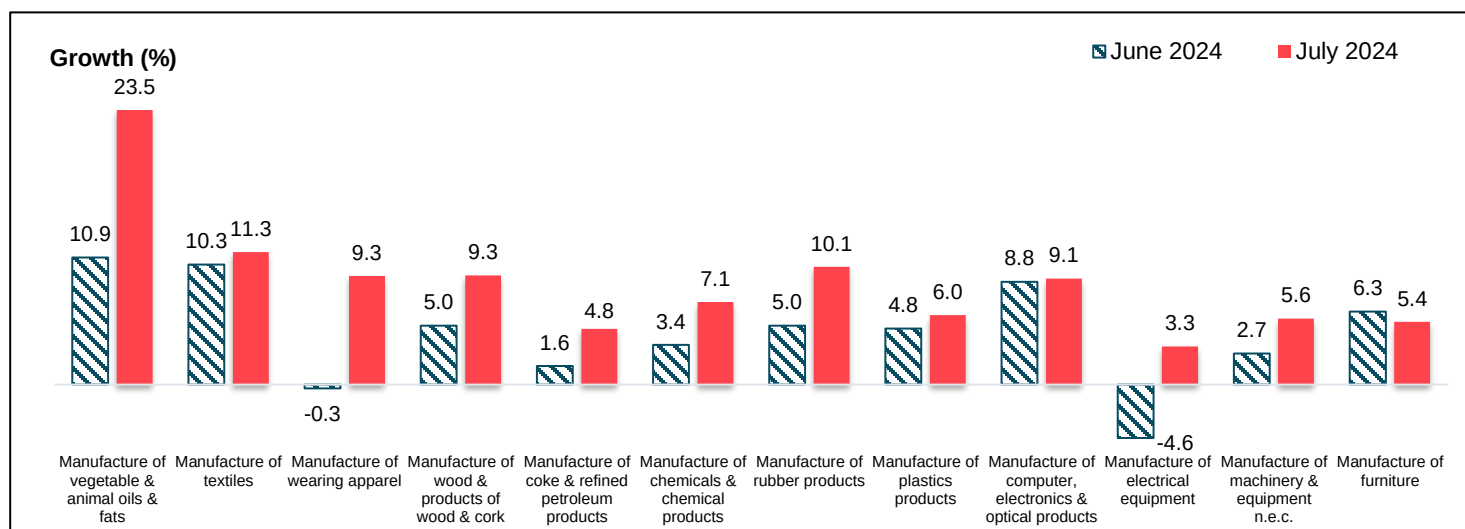
**Chart 2: The Growth of Manufacturing Sub-sector,
June 2024 and July 2024**



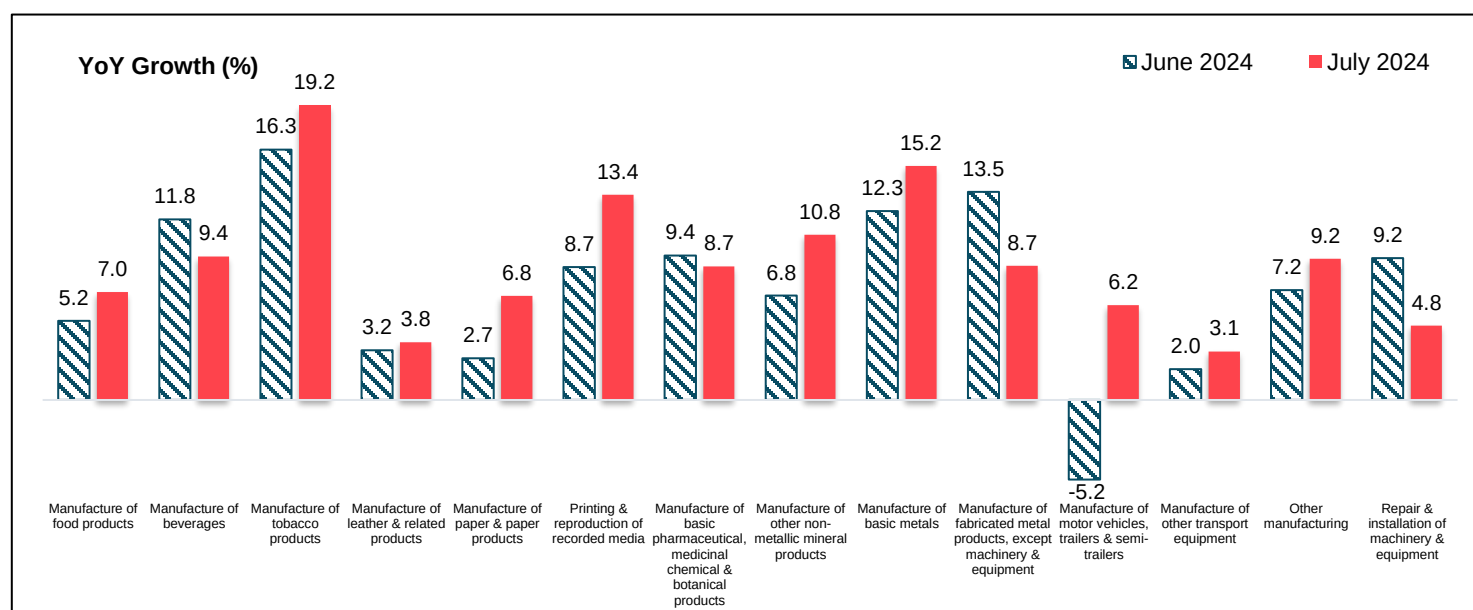
**Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for
