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INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN, MALAYSIA OGOS 2024

Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat 4.1 peratus pada Ogos 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 11 OKTOBER 2024 – Indeks Pengeluaran Industri meningkat 4.1 peratus pada Ogos 2024, didorong oleh pertumbuhan sederhana dalam sektor Pembuatan. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP), Malaysia, Ogos 2024** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor iaitu Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) menyederhana kepada 4.1 peratus pada Ogos 2024 berbanding peningkatan 5.3 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini terutamanya disokong oleh perkembangan bagi output sektor Pembuatan pada 6.5 peratus (Julai 2024: 7.7%); diikuti dengan pertumbuhan positif 4.1 peratus (Julai 2024: 7.0%) dalam pengeluaran sektor Elektrik. Sebaliknya, pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan terus susut tahun ke tahun selama dua bulan berturut-turut, dengan mencatatkan negatif 6.4 peratus pada Ogos 2024 (Julai 2024: -5.0%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, IPP pulih kepada 1.7 peratus, selepas berkurang 1.5 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya.”

Peningkatan dalam pengeluaran sektor Pembuatan pada Ogos 2024 disokong oleh pengeluaran dari industri berorientasikan eksport, yang tumbuh perlahan kepada 6.3 peratus berbanding 7.8 peratus yang direkodkan pada Julai 2024. Pertumbuhan ini disokong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan kukuh dalam industri Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan yang mencatatkan peningkatan 22.6 peratus (Julai 2024: 21.9%); dan Pembuatan produk getah sebanyak 11.1 peratus (Julai 2024: 10.5%). Tambahan lagi, Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal turut menyumbang

kepada peningkatan tersebut dengan mencatatkan pertumbuhan 8.7 peratus (Julai 2024: 5.0%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport bertambah baik sebanyak 3.0 peratus (Julai 2024: -3.3%).

Industri berorientasikan domestik terus mencatat peningkatan sebanyak 7.1 peratus, lebih perlahan sedikit berbanding 7.5 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Prestasi kukuh ini sebahagian besar dipengaruhi oleh pertumbuhan yang memberangsangkan dalam Pembuatan produk logam kecuali mesin dan kelengkapan; dan Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler dengan masing-masing meningkat sebanyak 10.3 peratus (Julai 2024: 9.1%) dan 7.7 peratus (Julai 2024: 3.9%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, industri berorientasikan domestik terus meningkat kepada 6.1 peratus (Julai 2024: 1.0%).

Mengulas lebih lanjut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Pertumbuhan pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan semakin perlahan kepada negatif 6.4 peratus pada Ogos 2024, yang dipengaruhi dengan ketara oleh penurunan dalam pengeluaran Gas Asli dan Minyak Mentah & Kondensat, masing-masing mencatatkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun pada kadar negatif 7.0 peratus (Julai 2024: -5.4%) dan negatif 5.7 peratus (Julai 2024: -4.4%) pada bulan tersebut. Oleh itu, indeks Perlombongan terus menguncup bulan ke bulan pada 6.9 peratus (Julai 2024: -2.1%). Sementara itu, penjanaan Elektrik kekal meningkat 4.1 peratus (Julai 2024: 7.0%) tahun ke tahun pada Ogos 2024. Berdasarkan perbandingan bulanan, indeks Elektrik jatuh 2.0 peratus (Julai 2024: 5.4%)."

Diperingkat prestasi global, IPP bagi beberapa negara termasuk Singapura, Amerika Syarikat, dan Taiwan mencatatkan pertumbuhan output yang lebih tinggi pada bulan Ogos 2024, sementara China, Korea Selatan, dan Vietnam terus berkembang tetapi pada kadar yang lebih perlahan berbanding bulan sebelumnya. Namun begitu, Jepun dan Thailand susut pada bulan tersebut.

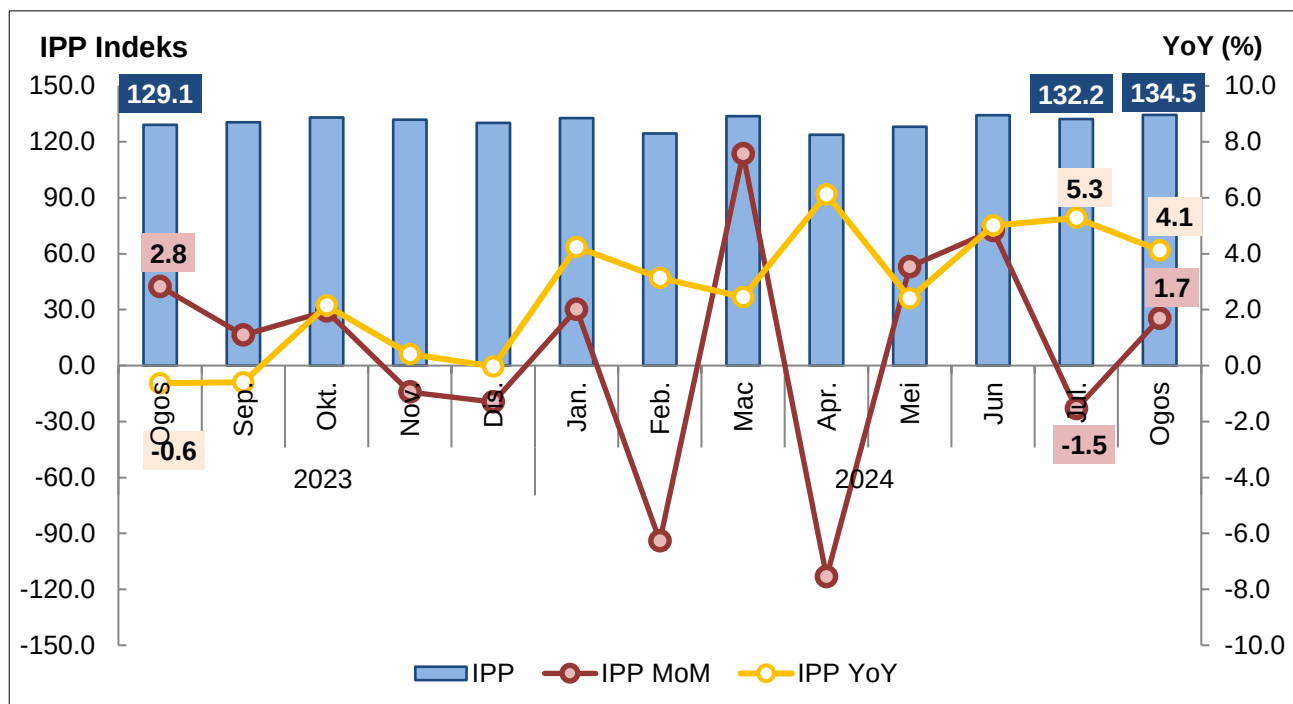
Secara kumulatif, sepanjang lapan bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – Ogos 2024), IPP meningkat sebanyak 4.1 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun 2023, dengan semua sektor menunjukkan pengembangan, iaitu indeks Perlombongan (1.8%); indeks Pembuatan (4.4%); dan indeks Elektrik (6.7%).

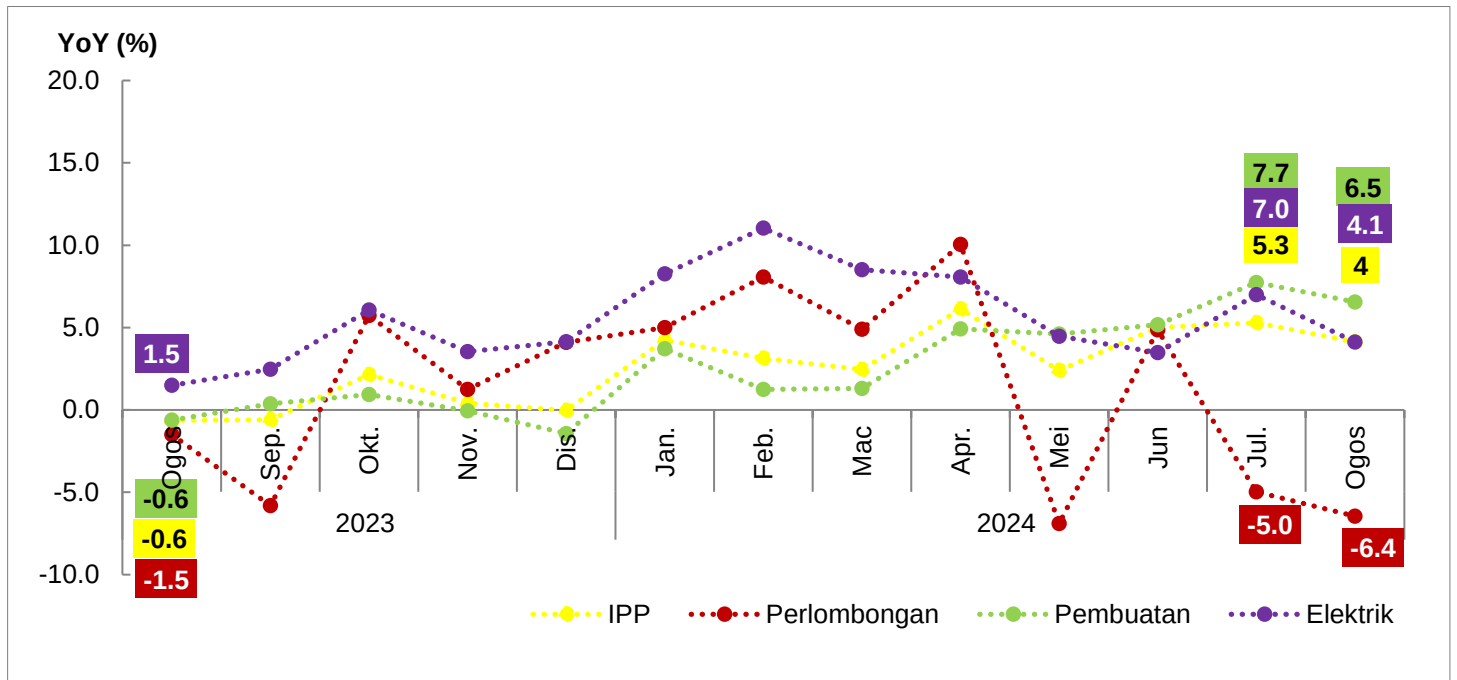

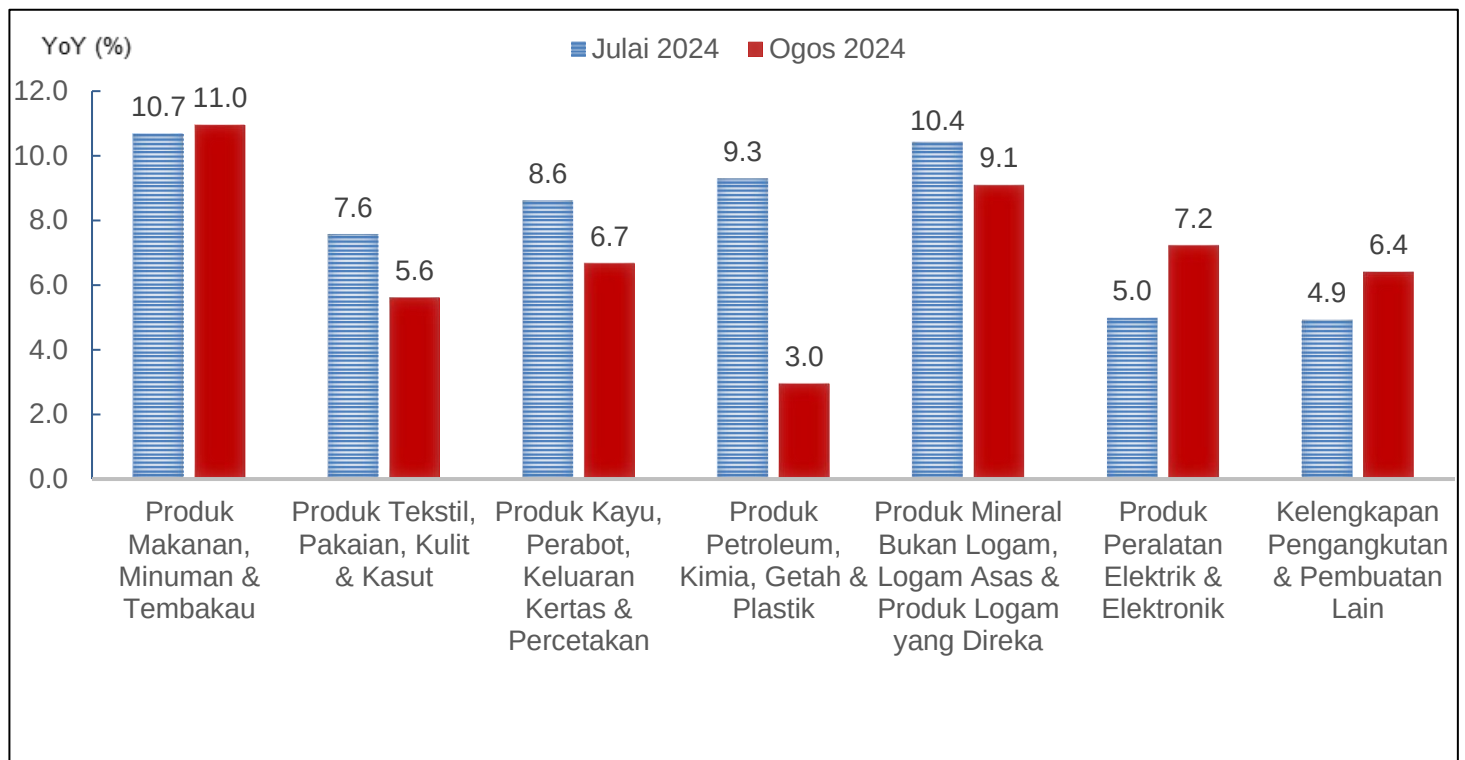
Carta 1: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian, Malaysia, Ogos 2023 - Ogos 2024



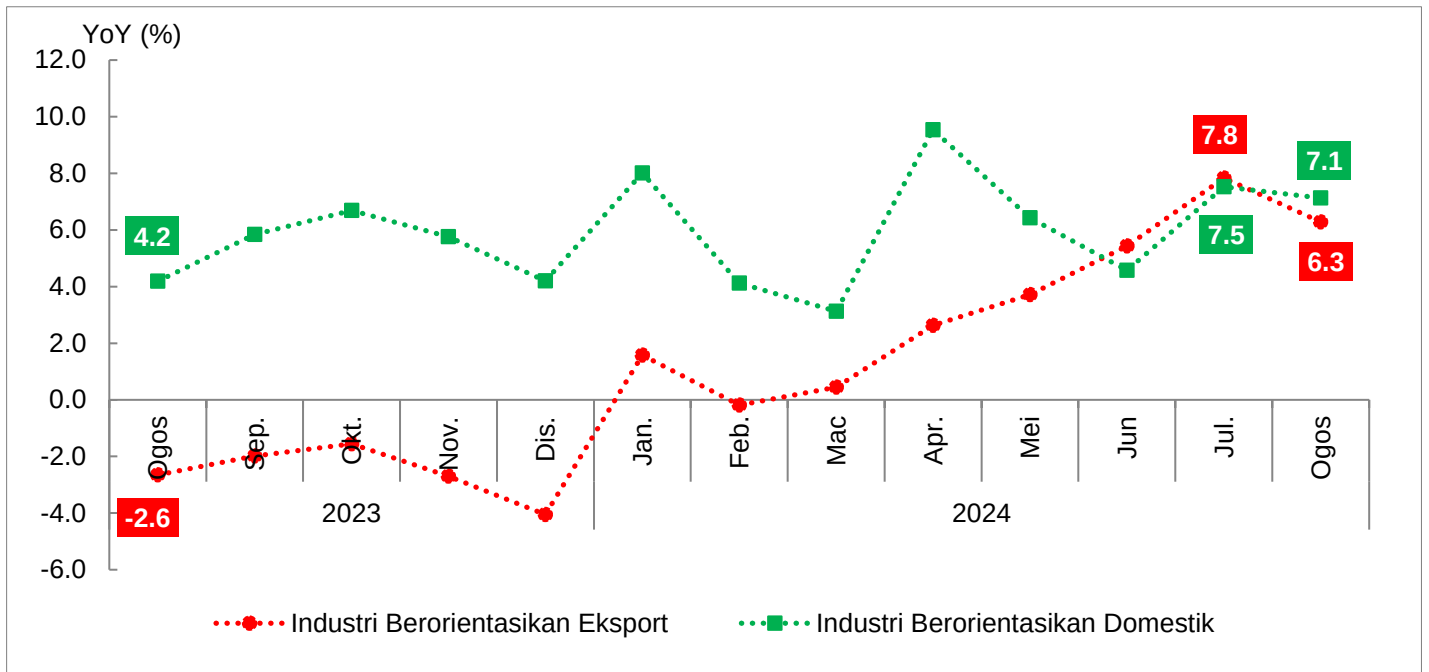
**Carta 2: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian dan Komponennya, Malaysia
Ogos 2023 - Ogos 2024**



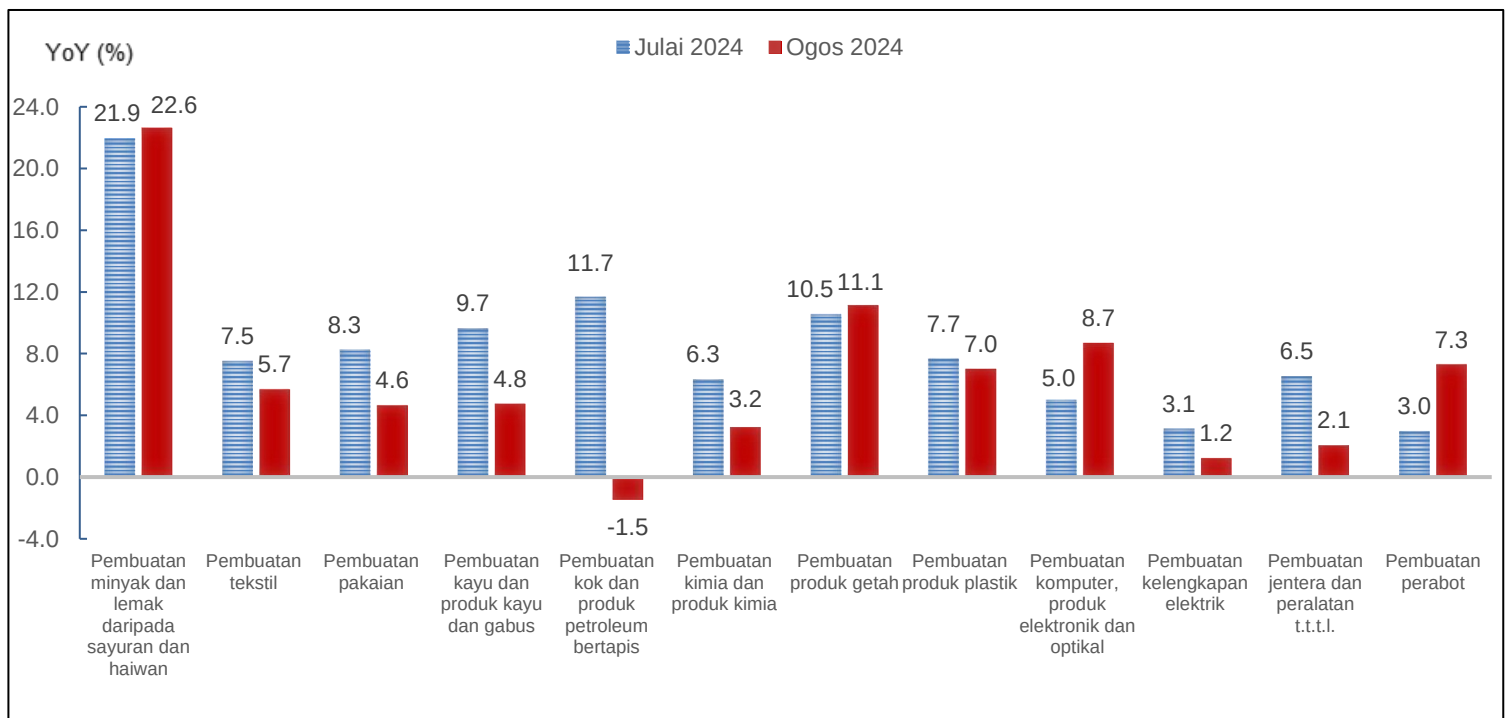
**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Subsektor, Malaysia
Julai 2024 dan Ogos 2024**



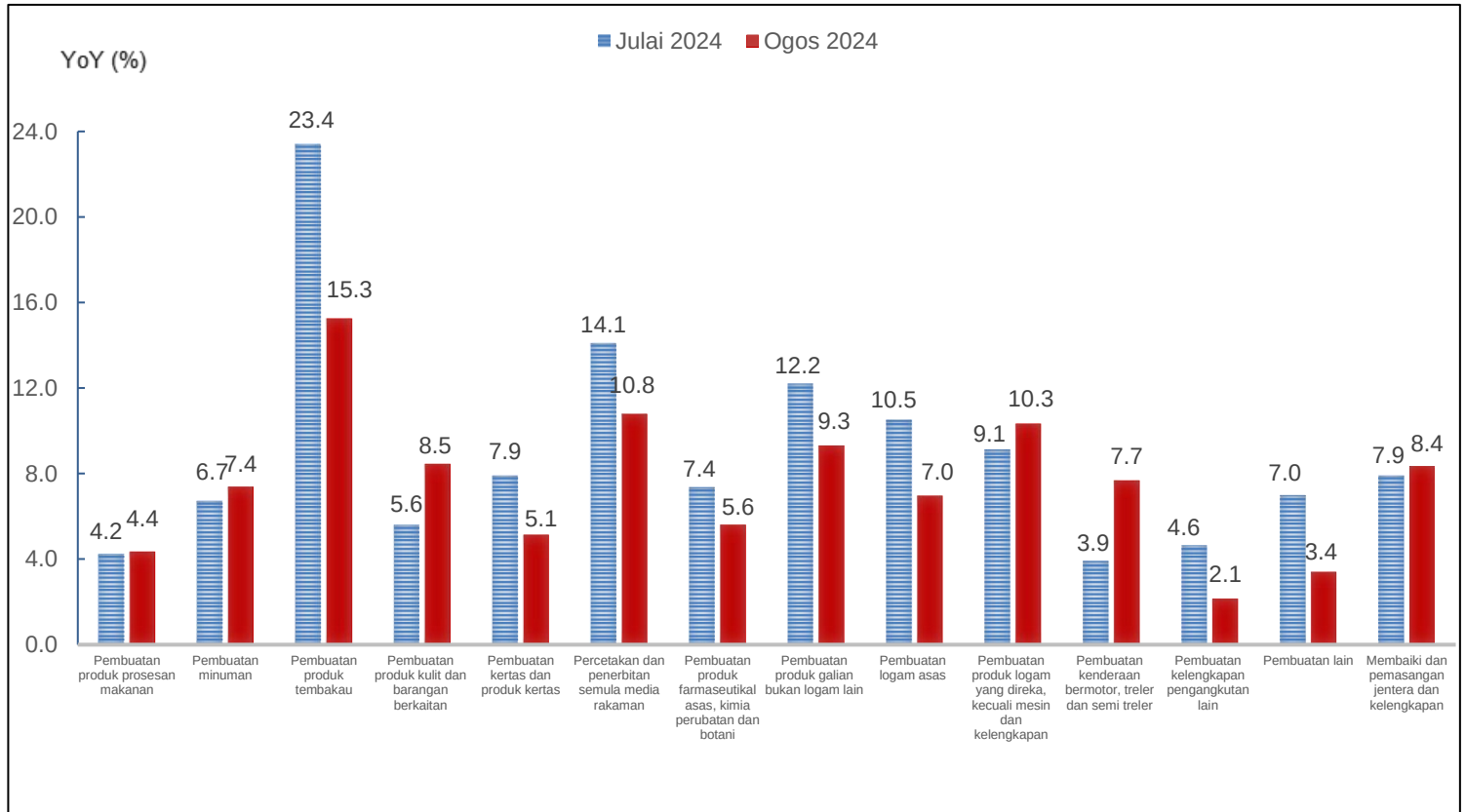

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INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION MALAYSIA AUGUST 2024

The Industrial Production Index rose 4.1 per cent in August 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 11TH OCTOBER 2024 – The Industrial Production Index rose 4.1 per cent in August 2024, propelled by the moderate growth in the Manufacturing sector. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of the **Industrial Production Index (IPI), Malaysia, August 2024**. The publication presents IPI statistics, consisting of three sectors namely Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The Industrial Production Index (IPI) moderated to 4.1 per cent in August 2024, as compared to an increase of 5.3 per cent in the preceding month. The increase was primarily supported by the expansion of the output in Manufacturing sector at 6.5 per cent (July 2024: 7.7%); followed by the positive growth of 4.1 per cent (July 2024: 7.0%) in Electricity output. Inversely, the output of the Mining sector continued to decline year-on-year for two consecutive months, by recording a negative 6.4 per cent in August 2024 (July 2024: -5.0%). For a month-on-month comparison, the IPI rebounded to 1.7 per cent, after declined by 1.5 per cent in the previous month."

The increase in Manufacturing output in August 2024 was supported by the production in export-oriented industries, which softened to 6.3 per cent growth as against 7.8 per cent recorded in July 2024. The growth was mainly supported by the resilient growth observed in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats which recorded an increase of 22.6 per cent (July 2024: 21.9%); and Manufacturing of rubber products at 11.1 per cent (July 2024: 10.5%). In addition, the Manufacturing of computers, electronics & optical products also contributed the increase by recording 8.7 per cent growth (July 2024: 5.0%). On a

month-on-month comparison, the export-oriented industries improved by 3.0 per cent (July 2024: -3.3%).

Additionally, the domestic-oriented industries continued to rise by registering 7.1 per cent, slightly slower as compared to 7.5 per cent in the preceding month. This robust performance was largely influenced by a favourable growth in the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment; and the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers which increased by 10.3 per cent (July 2024: 9.1%) and 7.7 per cent (July 2024: 3.9%), respectively. In comparison to the preceding month, the domestic-oriented industries kept increasing to 6.1 per cent (July 2024: 1.0%).

Adding further, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The output growth for Mining sector eased further to negative 6.4 per cent in August 2024, significantly influenced by the decrease in Natural Gas and Crude Oil & Condensate productions, which both recorded year-on-year growth at negative 7.0 per cent (July 2024: -5.4%) and negative 5.7 per cent (July 2024: -4.4%) during the month, respectively. Consequently, the Mining index continued to shrink by month-on-month basis at 6.9 per cent (July 2024: -2.1 per cent). Meanwhile, the generation of Electricity remained to increase year-on-year by 4.1 per cent (July 2024: 7.0%) in August 2024. Based on the monthly comparison, the Electricity index dropped by 2.0 per cent (July 2024: 5.4%)."

On a global scale, the IPI for several other countries including Singapore, United States and Taiwan experienced the higher output growth in August 2024, while China, South Korea and Vietnam remained to grow but slower than the growth recorded in the preceding month. Conversely, Japan and Thailand declined during the month.

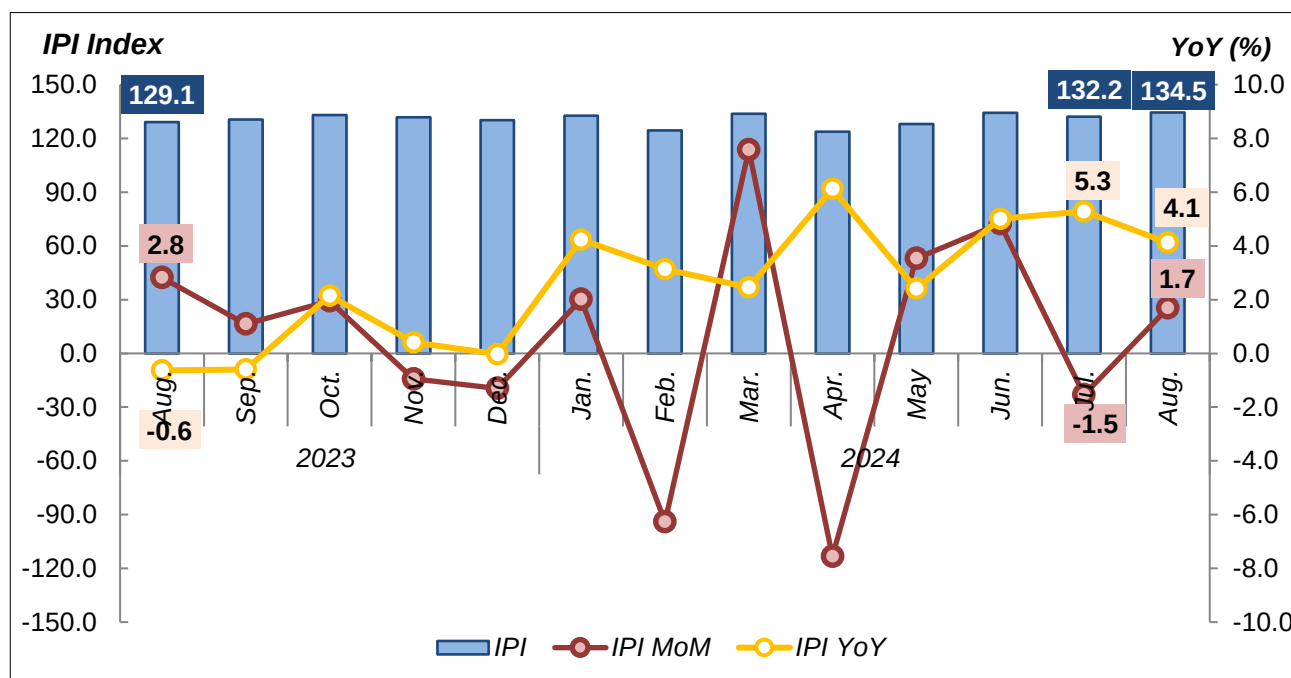
Cumulatively, throughout the first eight months this year (January – August 2024), the IPI picked up by 4.1 per cent as compared to the same period in 2023, with all sectors posting an expansion, namely the Mining index (1.8%); Manufacturing index (4.4%); and Electricity index (6.7%).

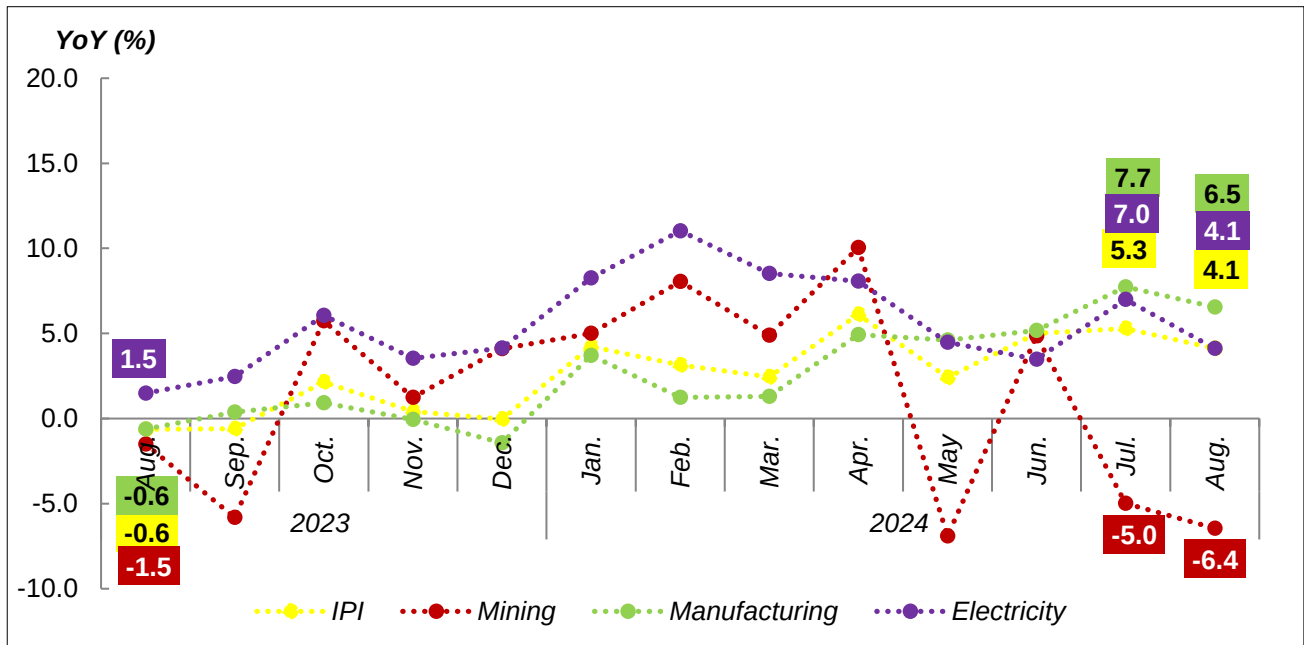

July 2024 and August 2024**

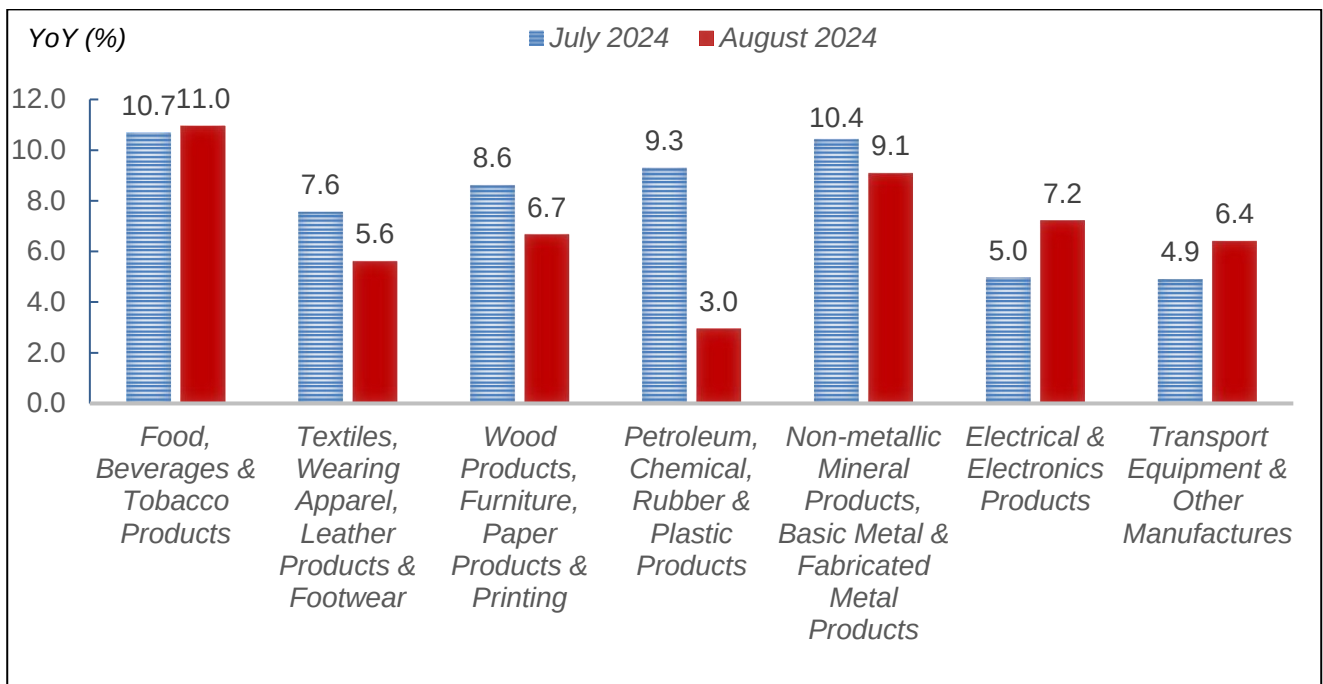


Chart 4: Manufacturing Index by Export and Domestic Oriented Industries, Malaysia, August 2023 – August 2024

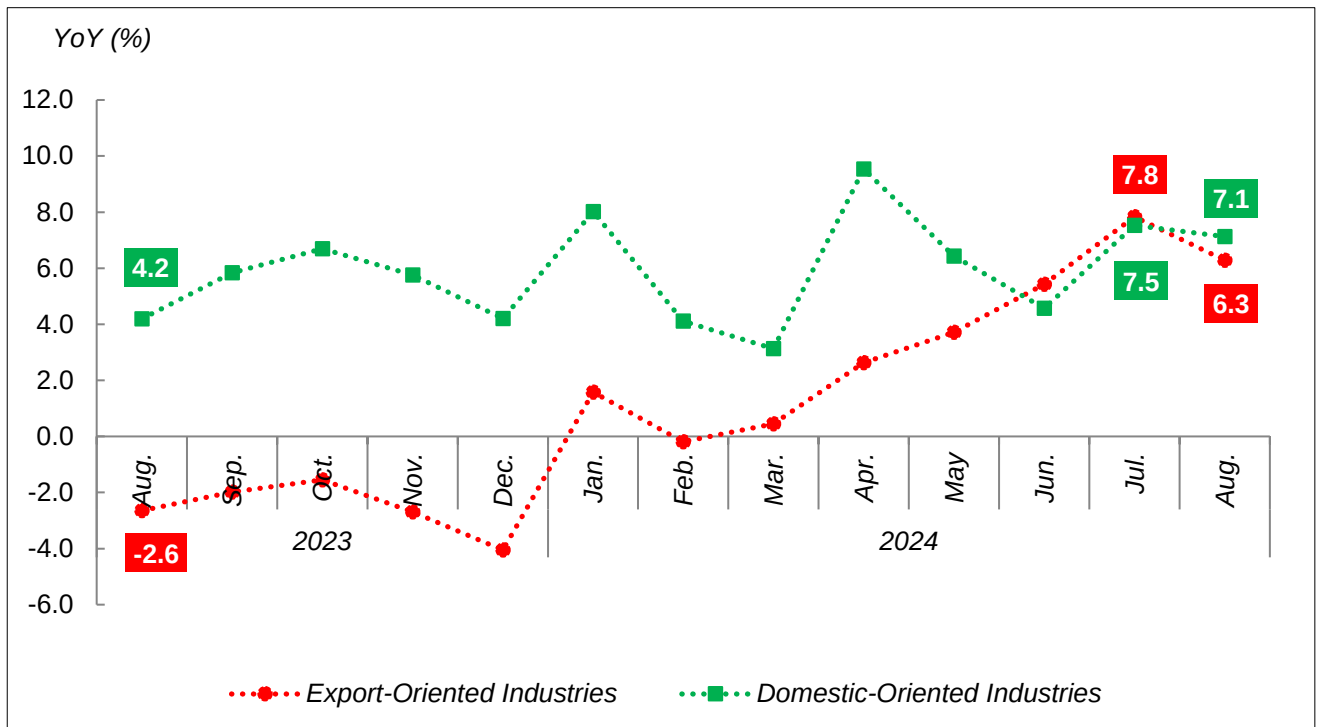
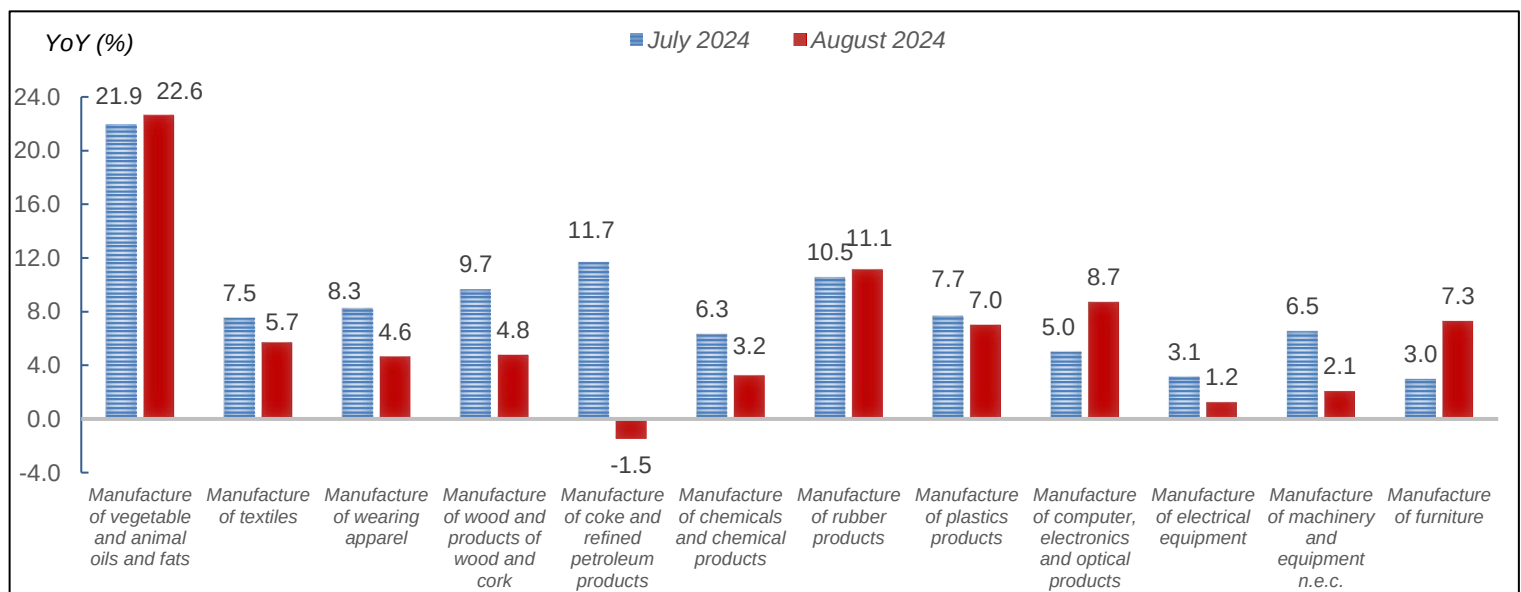
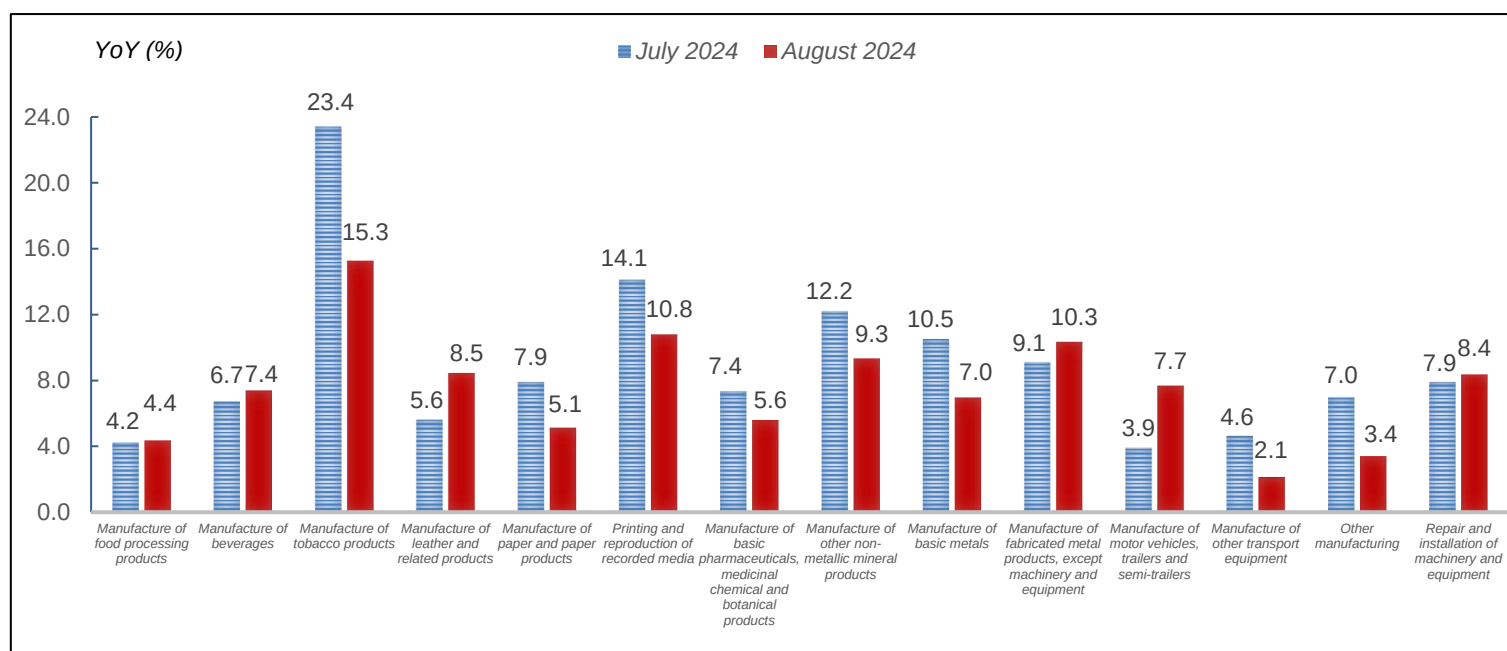


Chart 5: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, July 2024 and August 2024
