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PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA OGOS 2024

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan berjumlah RM163.9 bilion pada Ogos 2024, meningkat 7.7 peratus

PUTRAJAYA, 11 OKTOBER 2024 – Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan berjumlah RM163.9 bilion pada Ogos 2024, menunjukkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 7.7 peratus. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Ogos 2024**.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menyederhana kepada 7.7 peratus untuk mencapai RM163.9 bilion pada Ogos 2024 (Ogos 2023: -3.3%), berbanding dengan pertumbuhan 9.1 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh pertumbuhan dua digit yang direkodkan dalam sub-sektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau; dan Produk Elektrik & elektronik, masing-masing pada 16.1 peratus (Julai 2024: 16.0%) dan 10.4 peratus (Julai 2024: 8.2%). Berasaskan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan tumbuh sebanyak 4.4 peratus selepas peningkatan sebelumnya sebanyak 0.6 peratus berjumlah RM157.1 bilion pada Julai 2024."

Industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili 72.7 peratus daripada jumlah nilai jualan, tumbuh 7.8 peratus pada Ogos 2024, peningkatan sederhana dari 9.4 peratus yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Prestasi ini dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh peningkatan dalam industri Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal (12.0%); Pembuatan minyak dan lemak daripada sayuran dan haiwan (23.3%); dan

Pembuatan produk getah (11.6%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport pulih kepada 5.0 peratus dari penurunan sedikit sebanyak 0.5 peratus pada Julai 2024.

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik berkembang 7.6 peratus (Julai 2024: 8.4%), dipacu terutamanya oleh Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler dan semi treler pada 10.4 peratus; diikuti oleh Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan (7.5%); dan Pembuatan produk logam yang direka, kecuali mesin dan kelengkapan (9.7%). Bagi perbandingan secara bulanan, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan domestik terus meningkat dengan mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak 2.7 peratus (Julai 2024: 3.7%).

Ketua Perangkawan menambah, “Terdapat 2.38 juta pekerja terlibat dalam sektor Pembuatan pada Ogos 2024, meningkat 1.0 peratus (Julai 2024: 1.3%) berbanding setahun lalu. Pertumbuhan itu sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh Makanan, minuman & tembakau (3.9%); Kayu, perabot, produk kertas & percetakan (1.1%); dan Tekstil, pakaian, Kulit & Kasut (1.5%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini bertambah baik sebanyak 0.4 peratus (Julai 2024: - 0.01%).

Selaras dengan peningkatan bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 1.5 peratus, mencecah jumlah RM8.12 bilion. Ini menjadikan kenaikan purata gaji & upah bulanan setiap pekerja adalah sebanyak 0.6 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM3,417 (Julai 2024: 1.2%; RM3,429). Dengan itu, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja meningkat sebanyak 6.7 peratus untuk merekodkan RM66,950 (Julai 2024: 7.8%; RM66,285).”

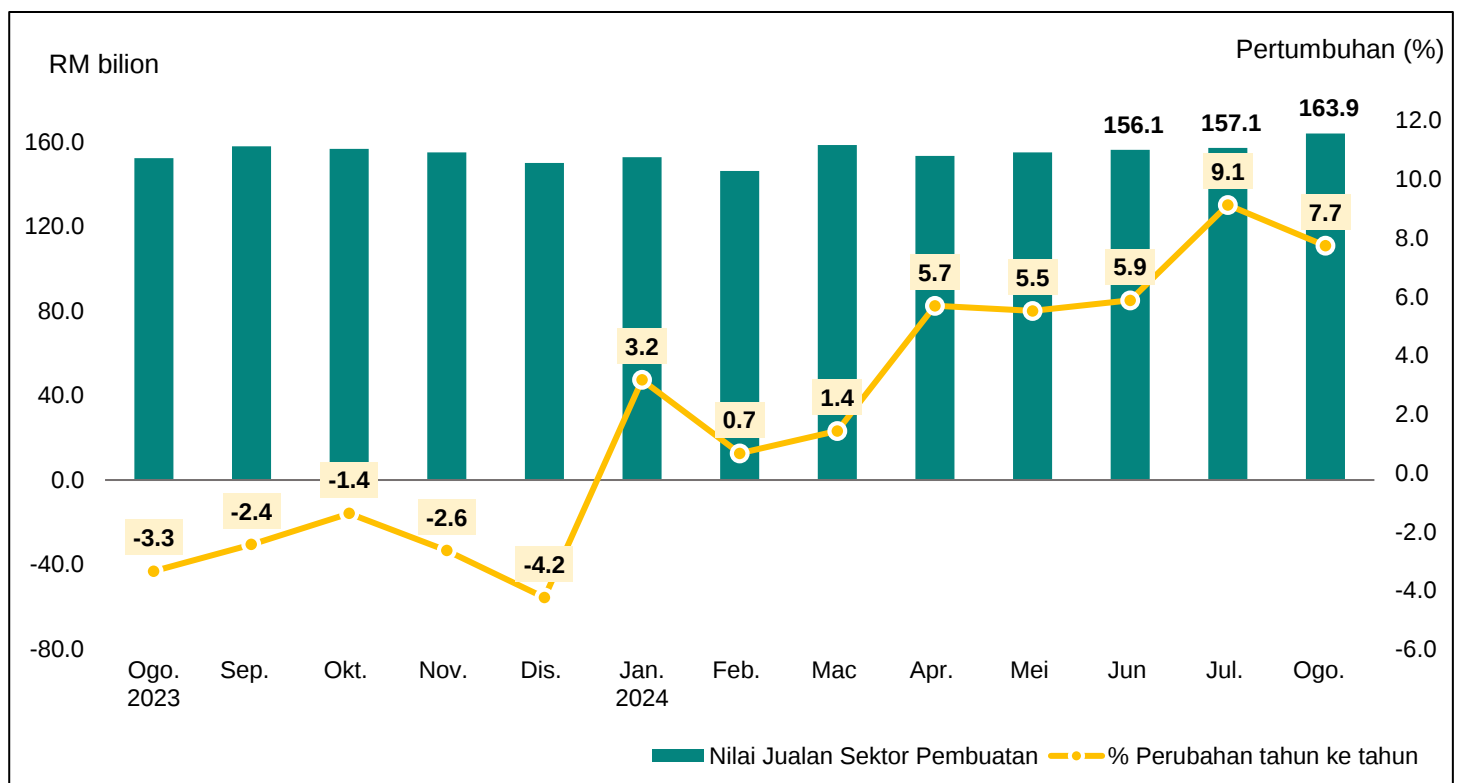
Merumuskan kenyataan beliau, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Dalam tempoh lapan bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – Ogos 2024), nilai jualan kumulatif sektor Pembuatan mencatatkan RM1,242.6 bilion, meningkat 4.9 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama 2023 (Januari - Ogos 2023: RM1,184.7 bilion; 1.7%). Bilangan pekerja meningkat 1.0 peratus kepada sejumlah 2.38 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah tumbuh 1.5 peratus kepada RM65.6 bilion. Selain itu, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja berjumlah RM522,573, mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak 3.9 peratus.”

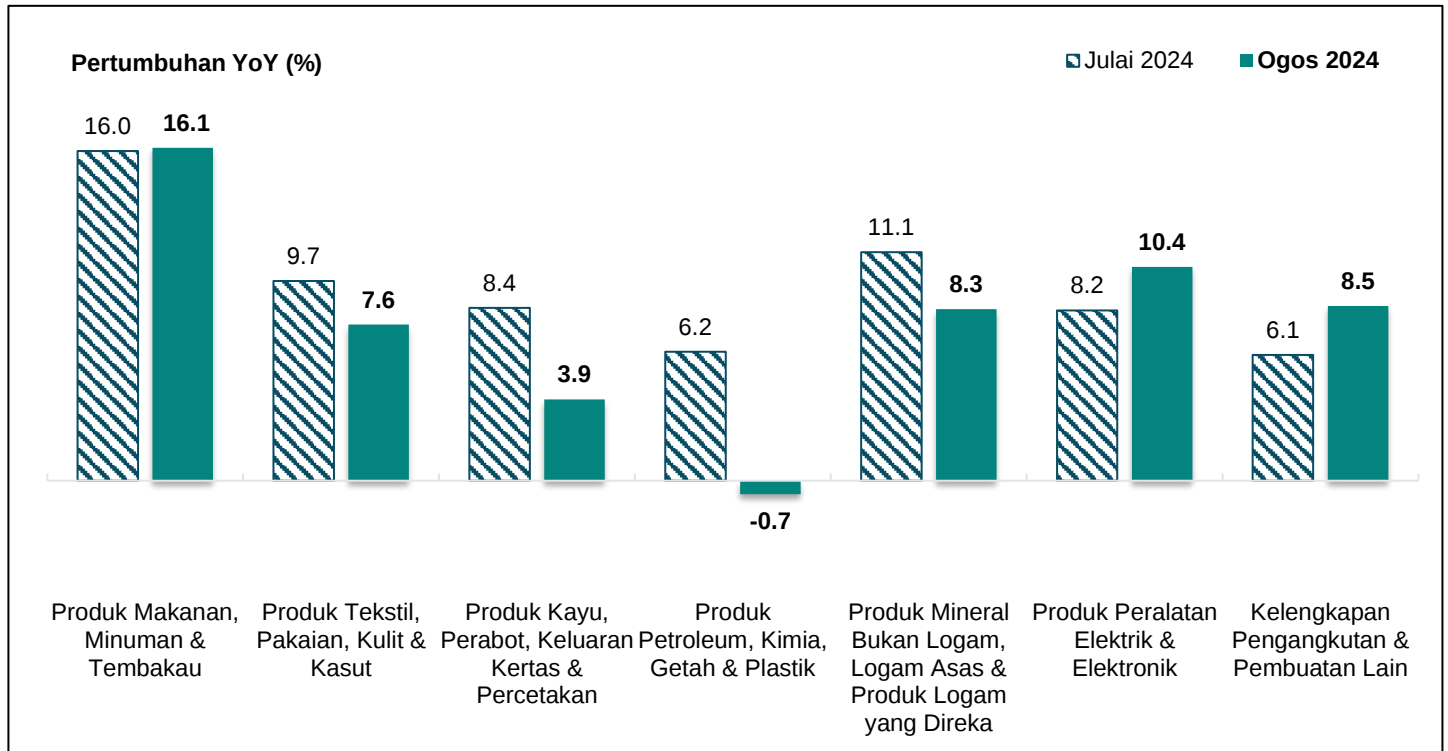

Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Ogos 2023 - Ogos 2024

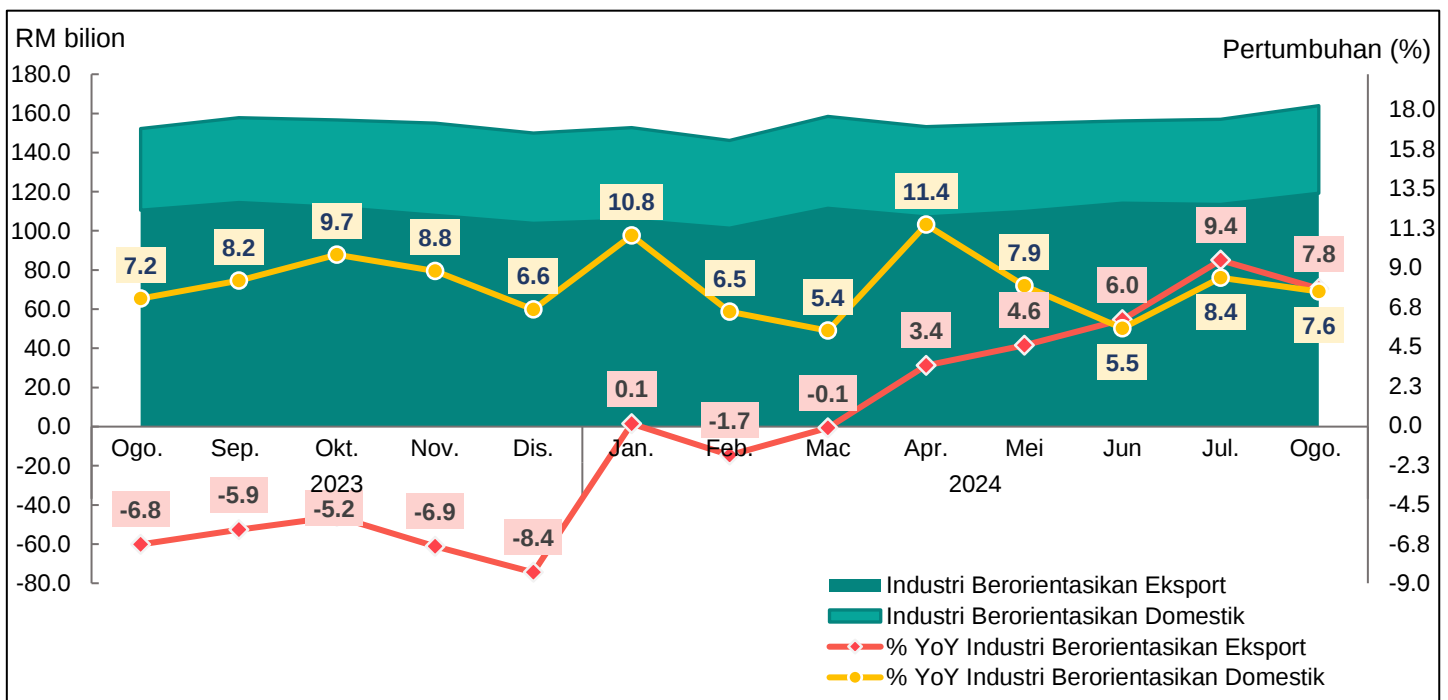


Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan, Julai 2024 dan Ogos 2024

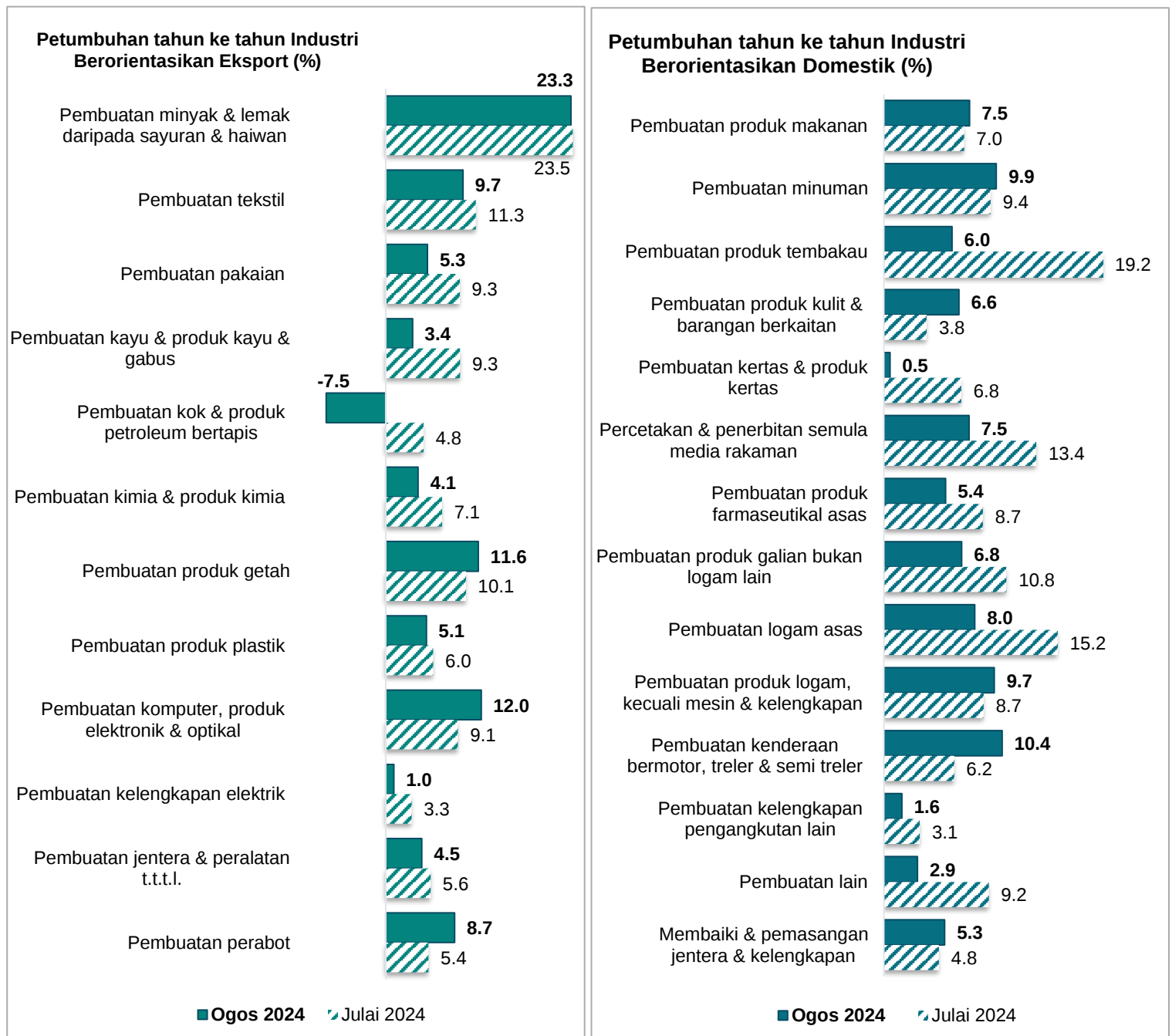

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MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA AUGUST 2024

The sales value in the Manufacturing sector stood at RM163.9 billion in August 2024, increased 7.7 per cent

PUTRAJAYA, OCTOBER 11, 2024 – The sales value in the Manufacturing sector stood at RM163.9 billion in August 2024, reflecting a year-on-year increase of 7.7 per cent. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, August 2024**.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The Manufacturing sector's sales value moderated to 7.7 per cent to reach RM163.9 billion in August 2024 (August 2023: -3.3%), as against 9.1 per cent growth observed in the preceding month. The increase was primarily due to the double-digit growth recorded in the Food, beverages & tobacco; and Electrical & electronics products sub-sectors at 16.1 per cent (July 2024: 16.0%) and 10.4 per cent (July 2024: 8.2%), respectively. On a month-to-month basis, the sales value grew by 4.4 per cent after a prior increase of 0.6 per cent at RM157.1 billion in July 2024."

Export-oriented industries which representing 72.7 per cent of the total sales value, grew by 7.8 per cent in August 2024, a modest rise from 9.4 per cent recorded in the previous month. The performance was mainly influenced by the increase in the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (12.0%); Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils

& fats (23.3%); and Manufacture of rubber products (11.6%) industries. For a month-on-month comparison, the sales value of the export-oriented industries recovering to 5.0 per cent from a marginal drop of 0.5 per cent in July 2024.

Similarly, domestic-oriented industries expanded 7.6 per cent (July 2024: 8.4%), mainly driven by the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers industry at 10.4 per cent; followed by the Manufacture of food processing products (7.5%); and Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (9.7%). In comparison on a monthly basis, the sales value of domestic-oriented industries remained on the rise by recording a growth of 2.7 percent (July 2024: 3.7%).

The Chief Statistician added, “There were 2.38 million employees engaged in the Manufacturing sector in August 2024, an increase of 1.0 per cent (July 2024: 1.3%) as compared to a year ago. The growth was predominantly attributed to Food, beverages & tobacco (3.9%); Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (1.1%); and Textile, Wearing Apparel, Leather & Footwear (1.5%). In comparison with the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector improved by 0.4 per cent (July 2024: -0.01%).

In line with the increase in the number of employees, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector rose by 1.5 per cent, reaching a total of RM8.12 billion. This resulted in the increase of average monthly salaries & wages per employee by 0.6 per cent year-on-year to RM3,417 (July 2024: 1.2%; RM3,429). Simultaneously, the sales value per employee rose by 6.7 per cent to record RM66,950 (July 2024: 7.8%; RM66,285).”

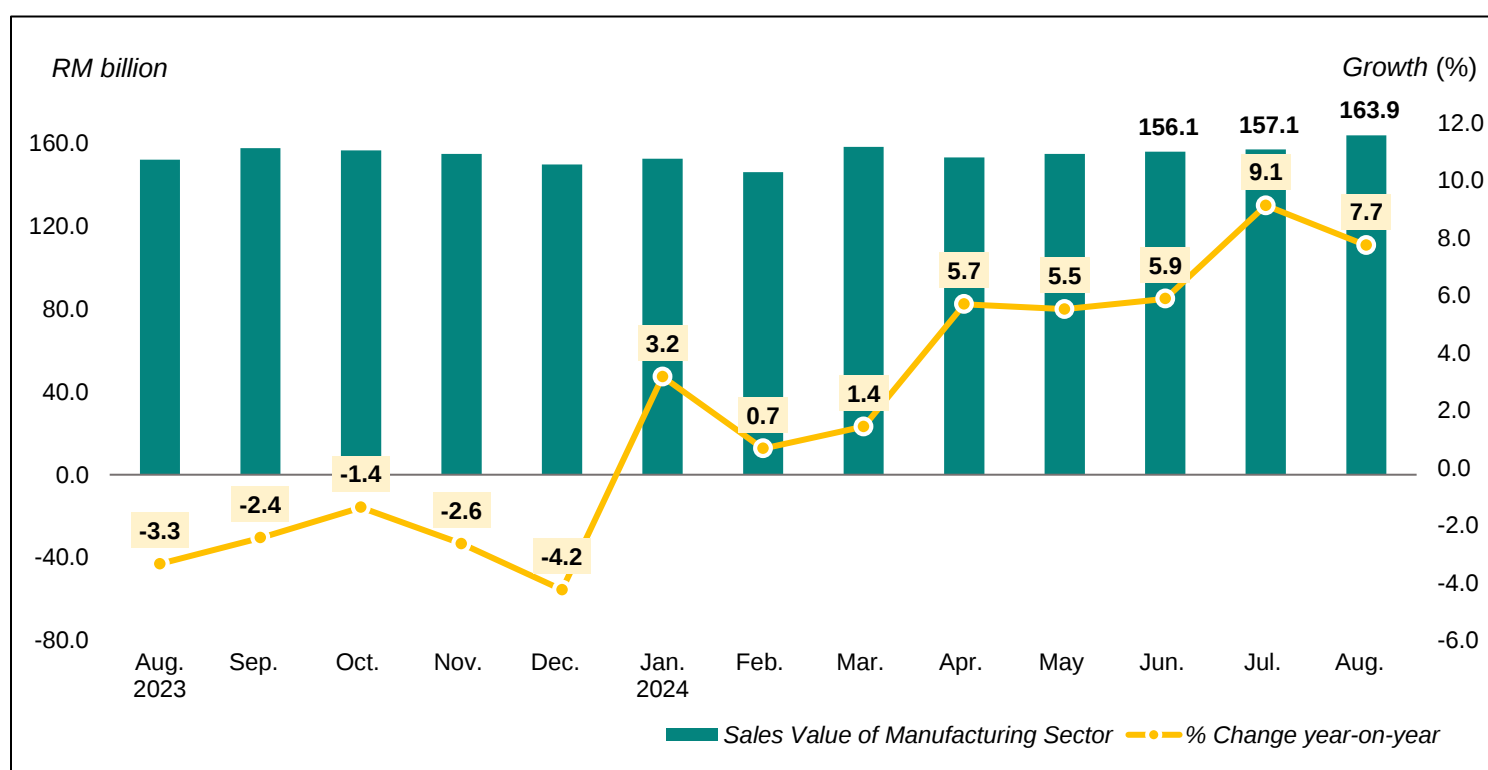
Concluding his statement, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “For the first eight months of this year (January – August 2024), the Manufacturing sector's cumulative sales value reached RM1,242.6 billion, increased by 4.9 per cent as compared to the same period of 2023 (January - August 2023: RM1,184.7 billion; 1.7%). The number of employees went up by 1.0 per cent to a total of 2.38 million persons, while salaries & wages grew by 1.5 per cent to RM65.6 billion. Subsequently, the sales value per employee was RM522,573, posting a growth of 3.9 per cent.”

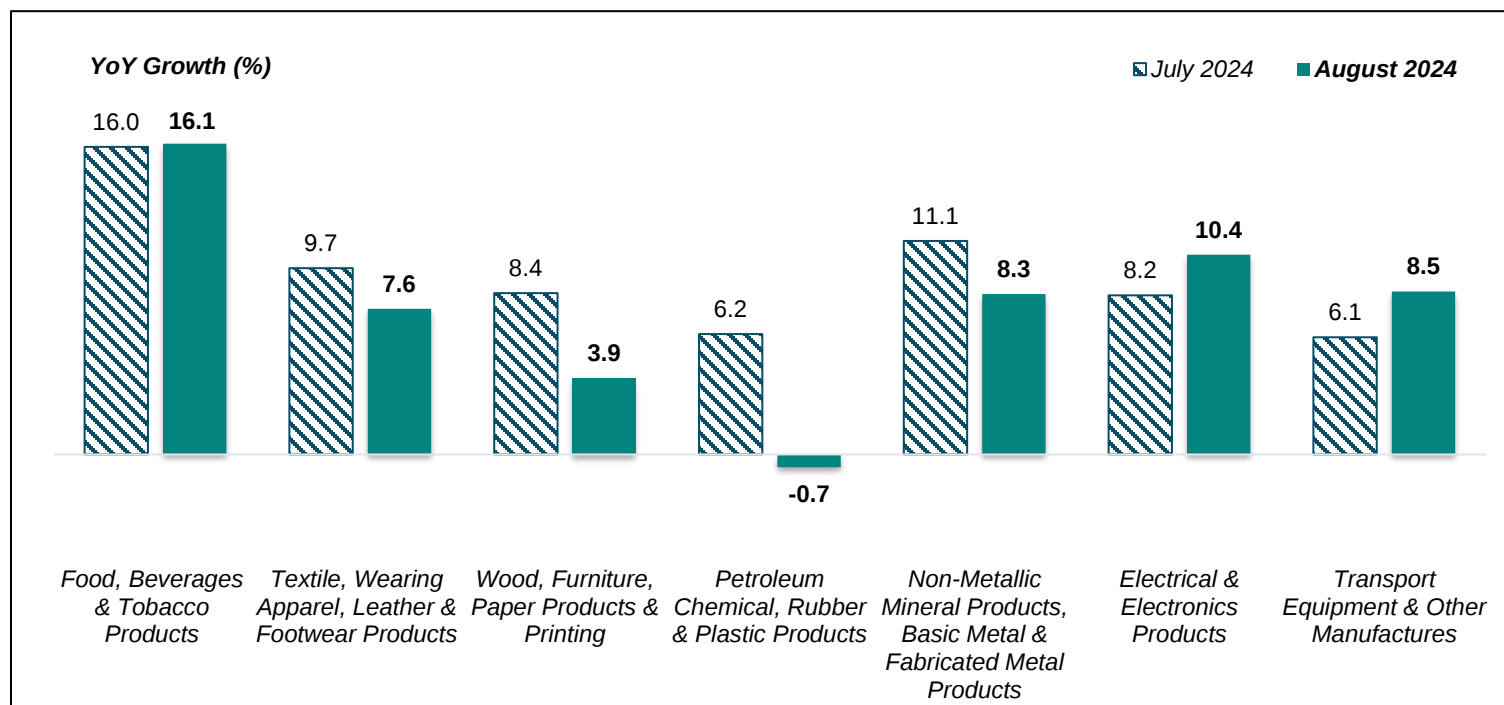

Manufacturing Sector, August 2023 – August 2024**

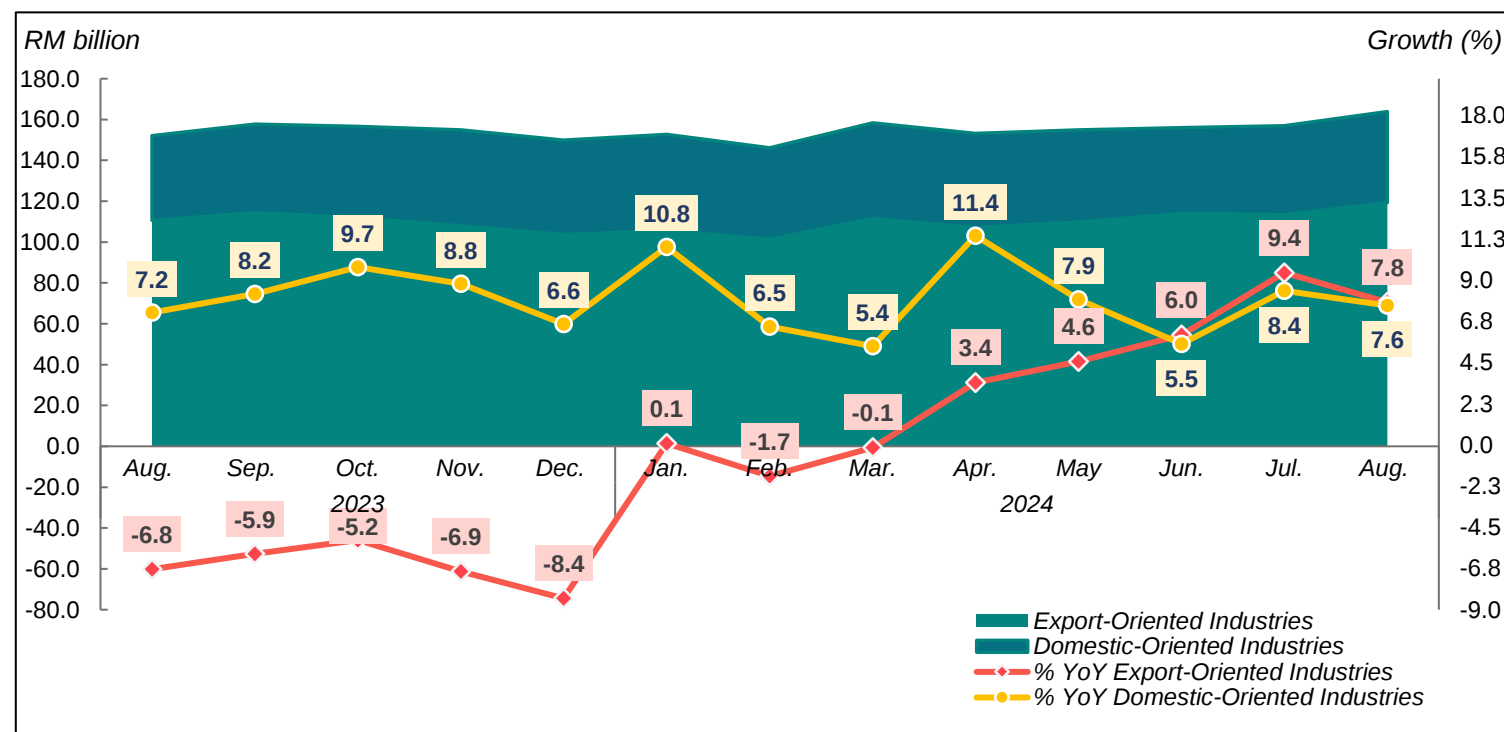
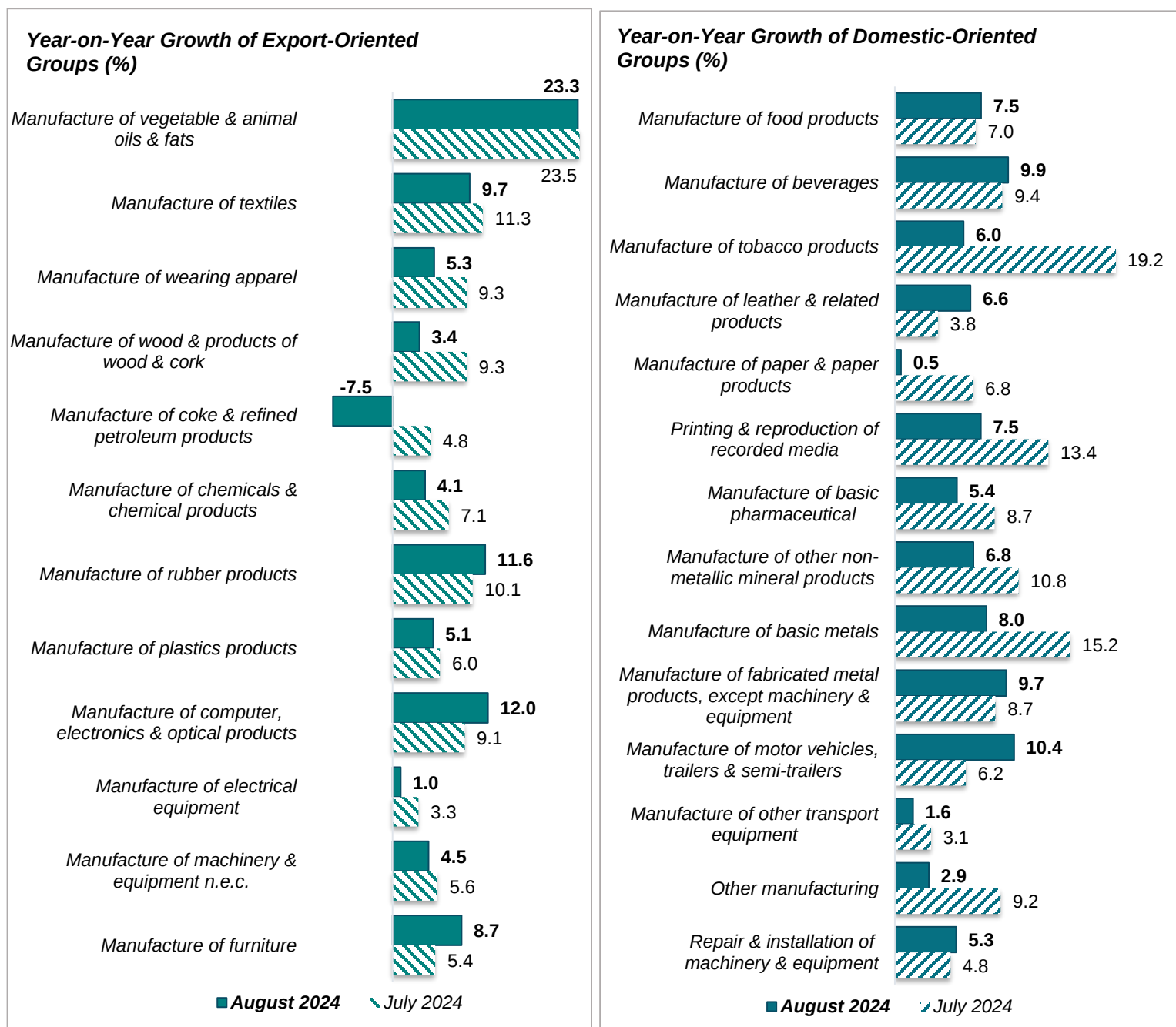


Chart 4: Sales Value of Manufacturing Export and Domestic-Oriented Groups, July 2024 and August 2024
