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BANCI EKONOMI 2023 STATISTIK PERTUBUHAN

Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur dan Johor secara kumulatif menyumbang 49.1 peratus daripada jumlah bilangan pertubuhan di Malaysia pada tahun 2022

PUTRAJAYA, 29 Oktober 2024 – Hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah menerbitkan penerbitan **Banci Ekonomi 2023 Statistik Pertubuhan**. Penerbitan ini memaparkan bilangan pertubuhan di Malaysia bagi tahun rujukan 2022. Penerbitan ini juga membentangkan bilangan pertubuhan mengikut sektor, negeri dan daerah pentadbiran di Malaysia, ia merangkumi aktiviti ekonomi dalam sektor Pertanian, Perlombongan & pengkuarian, Pembuatan, Pembinaan dan Perkhidmatan.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Berdasarkan Banci Ekonomi 2023, bilangan pertubuhan yang beroperasi pada tahun 2022 berjumlah 1,091,867 pertubuhan berbanding 920,630 pertubuhan pada tahun 2015 dengan kadar pertumbuhan tahunan sebanyak 2.5 peratus. Sektor Perkhidmatan merupakan penyumbang tertinggi kepada pertumbuhan bilangan pertubuhan dengan komposisi 87.2 peratus, diikuti oleh sektor Pembinaan (6.5%) dan sektor Pembuatan (5.0%). Dari segi pertumbuhan tahunan mengikut sektor, sektor Pembinaan dan Perlombongan & pengkuarian masing-masing meningkat 8.3 peratus dan 5.0 peratus. Ini diikuti dengan sektor Perkhidmatan (2.2%), Pertanian (1.6%) dan Pembuatan (1.5%)".

Pada tahun 2022, Selangor mencatatkan bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi sebanyak 270,363 pertubuhan, diikuti oleh W.P. Kuala Lumpur (136,305 pertubuhan) dan Johor (129,425 pertubuhan). Ketiga-tiga negeri ini secara kumulatif menyumbang 49.1 peratus daripada jumlah bilangan pertubuhan di Malaysia. Dari segi sektoral, sektor Perkhidmatan diterajui oleh Selangor dengan 232,206 pertubuhan. Begitu juga, Pembuatan, Pembinaan dan Perlombongan & pengkuarian didominasi oleh Selangor dengan masing-masing 16,808 pertubuhan, 19,770 pertubuhan dan 391 pertubuhan. Bagi sektor Pertanian, Johor mempunyai bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi dengan 2,254 pertubuhan.

Mengulas lebih lanjut, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Berdasarkan Banci Ekonomi 2023, tiga negeri dengan bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi adalah Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur dan Johor. Trend ini juga ketara di peringkat daerah, di mana Johor Bahru dan Petaling mencatatkan bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi merentasi kesemua sektor. Kedua-dua daerah ini mempunyai sumbangan besar dalam sektor Perkhidmatan dan Pembinaan. Dalam sektor Perkhidmatan, Petaling mencatatkan bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi pada tahun 2022, dengan 101,695 pertubuhan, diikuti oleh Johor Bahru (45,898 pertubuhan). Bagi sektor Pembinaan, daerah-daerah ini juga mencatatkan bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi, iaitu Petaling dengan 10,441 pertubuhan dan Johor Bahru (5,038 pertubuhan). Ini menekankan kepentingan daerah-daerah ini sebagai hab ekonomi yang berkembang pesat, terutamanya dalam sektor Perkhidmatan yang merangkumi pelbagai industri dan perniagaan”.

Sementara itu, Petaling dan Johor Bahru kekal di kedudukan teratas dalam sektor Pembuatan, dengan masing-masing 7,324 dan 4,137 pertubuhan. Dalam sektor Perlombongan & pengkuarian, Petaling mencatatkan kedudukan tertinggi dengan 230 pertubuhan daripada 1,440 pertubuhan. Manakala, bagi sektor Pertanian, Johor Bahru mencatatkan bilangan pertubuhan tertinggi, dengan 498 pertubuhan daripada 12,998 pertubuhan.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah melancarkan OpenDOSM NextGen sebagai medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day) pada 20 Oktober. Tema sambutan MyStats Day adalah “Statistik Nadi Kehidupan”. DOSM menyambut ulang tahun ke-75 Jubli Intan pada tahun 2024.

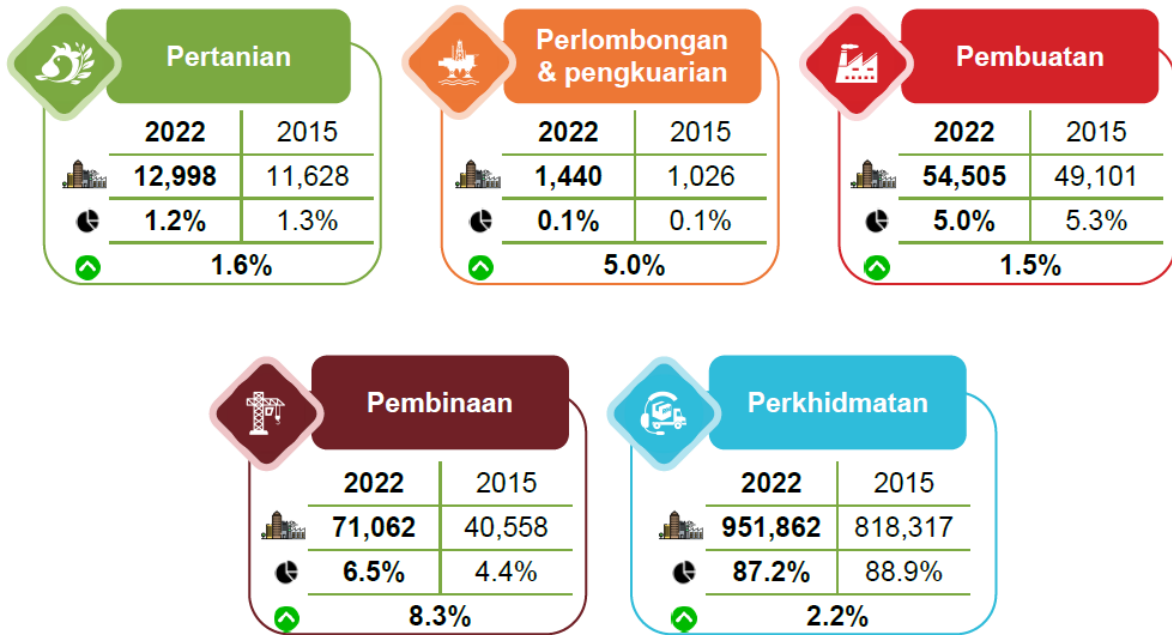
Paparan 1 : Bilangan Pertubuhan Keseluruhan Sektor, 2015 & 2022

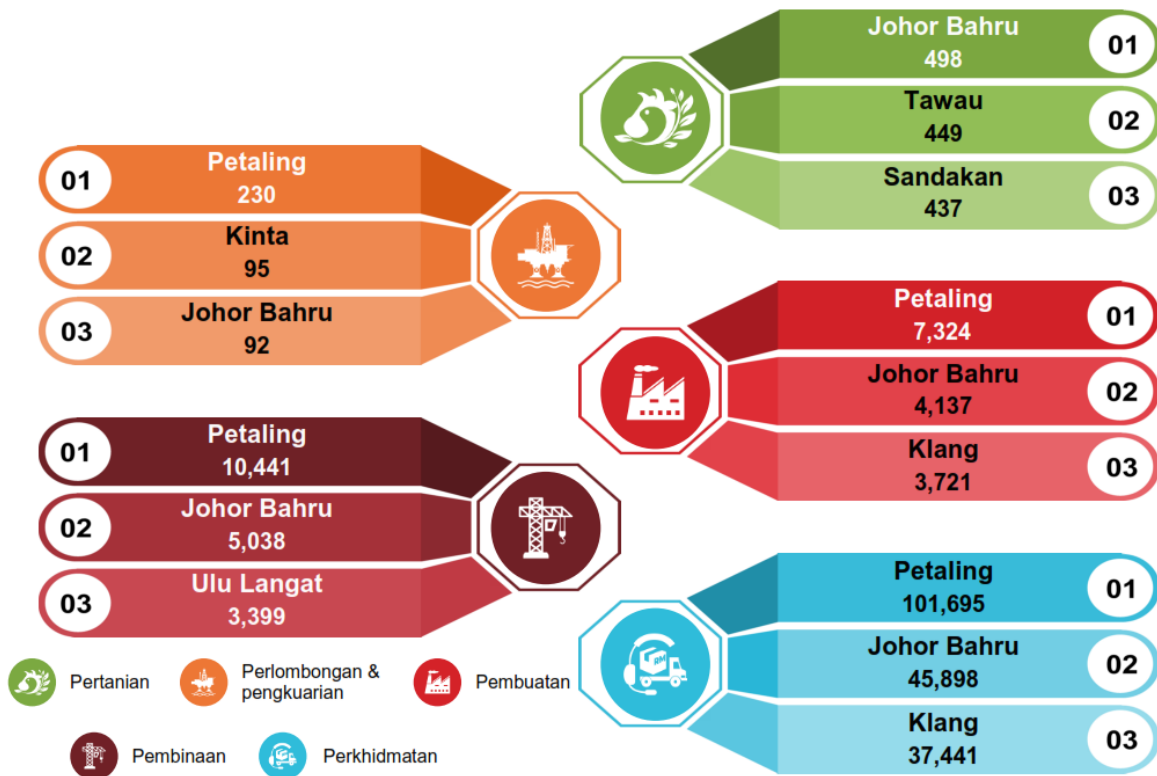

Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur and Johor collectively accounted for 49.1 per cent of the total number of establishments in Malaysia in 2022

PUTRAJAYA, 29th October 2024 – Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) released the **Economic Census 2023 Establishment Statistics** publication. This publication presents the number of establishments in Malaysia for the reference year 2022. This publication also presents the number of establishments by sector, state and administrative district in Malaysia, it covers economic activities in the Agriculture, Mining & quarrying, Manufacturing, Construction and Services sectors.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Based on the Economic Census 2023, the number of establishments operating in 2022 stood at 1,091,867 establishments as compared to 920,630 establishments in 2015 with an annual growth rate of 2.5 per cent. The Services sector was the highest contributor to the number of establishments with a share of 87.2 per cent, followed by the Construction sector (6.5%) and the Manufacturing sector (5.0%). In terms of annual growth rate by sector, the Construction and Mining & quarrying sectors increased by 8.3 per cent and 5.0 per cent, respectively. This was followed by Services (2.2%), Agriculture (1.6%) and Manufacturing (1.5%)".

Selangor recorded the highest number of establishments in 2022 with 270,363 establishments, followed by W.P. Kuala Lumpur (136,305 establishments) and Johor (129,425 establishments). These three states collectively accounted for 49.1 per cent of the total number of establishments in Malaysia. In terms of sectoral, Services sector was led by Selangor, with 232,206 establishments. Similarly, Selangor dominated the Manufacturing, Construction, and Mining & quarrying sectors with 16,808 establishments, 19,770 establishments and 391 establishments, respectively. For the Agriculture sector, Johor had the highest number of establishments with 2,254 establishments.

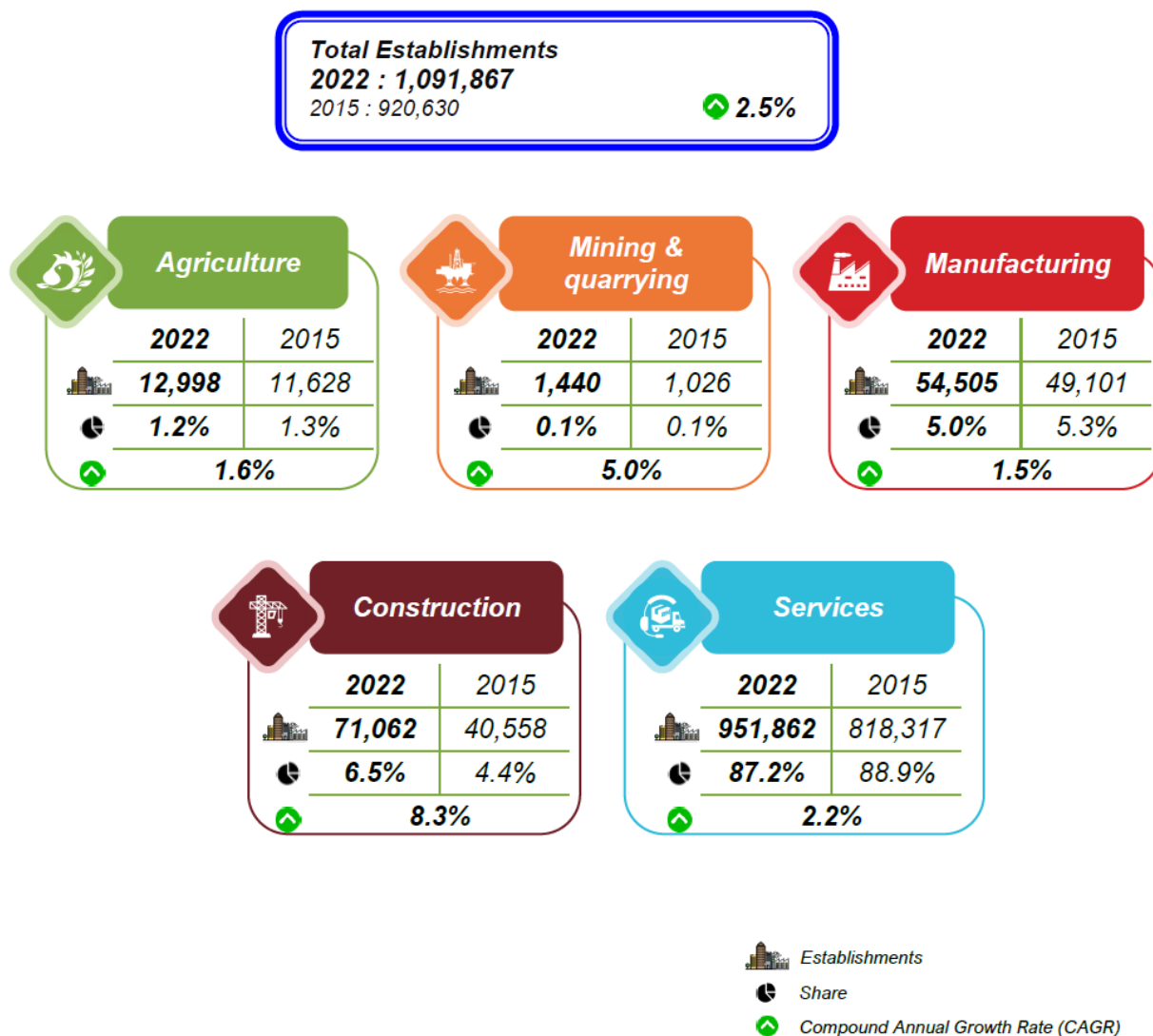
Elaborating further, the Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “Based on the Economic Census 2023, the three states with the highest number of establishments were Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur and Johor. This trend is also noticeable at the district level, where Johor Bahru and Petaling had the highest number of establishments across all sectors. These two districts have significant contribution in the Services and Construction sectors. In the Services sector, Petaling recorded the highest number of establishments in 2022, with 101,695 establishments, followed by Johor Bahru (45,898 establishments). For the Construction sector, these districts also had the highest number of establishments mainly Petaling with 10,441 establishments and Johor Bahru (5,038 establishments). This emphasises the importance of these districts as rapidly growing economic hubs, particularly in the Services sector, which covers a diverse array of industries and businesses”.

Meanwhile, Petaling and Johor Bahru remained at the top positions in the Manufacturing sector, with 7,324 establishments and 4,137 establishments, respectively. In the Mining & quarrying sector, Petaling ranked the highest with 230 establishments out of 1,440 establishments. Meanwhile, for the Agriculture sector, Johor Bahru recorded the highest number of establishments, with 498 establishments out of 12,998 establishments.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) has launched OpenDOSM NextGen as a medium that provides data catalogue and visualisations to facilitate users' analysis and can be accessed through <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

The Government of Malaysia has declared National Statistics Day (MyStats Day) on October 20th. MyStats Day theme is “Statistics is the Essence of Life”. DOSM commemorates its 75th Diamond Jubilee in 2024.

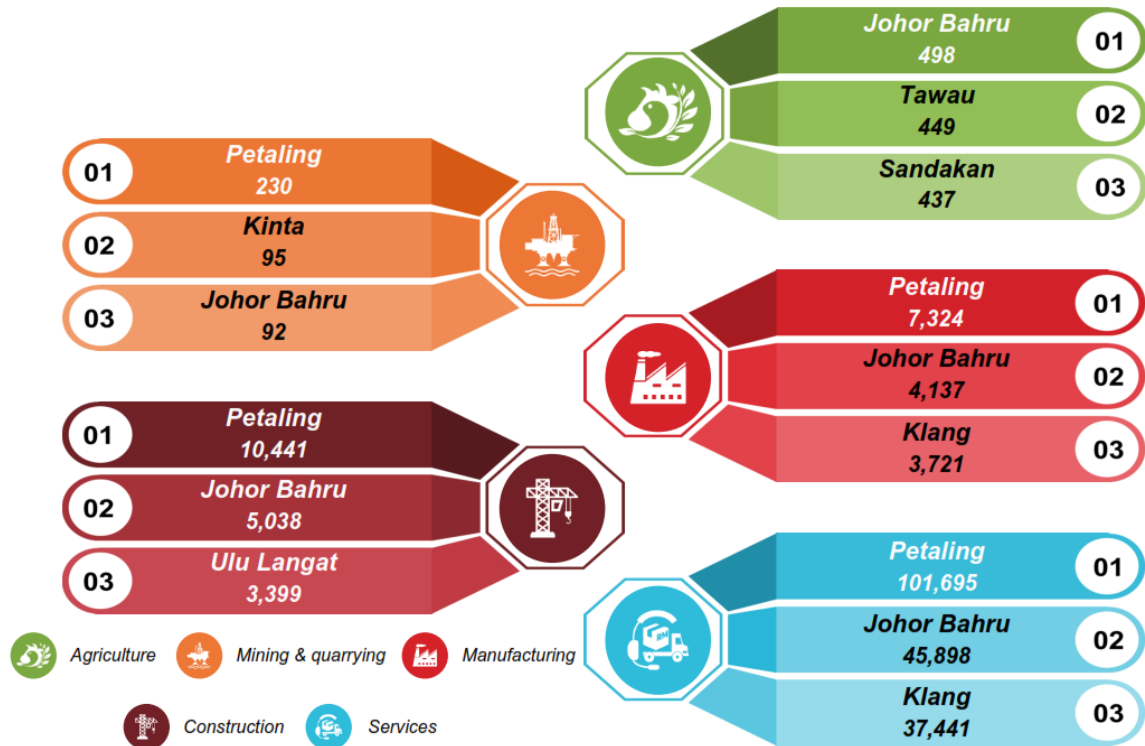
