INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI, MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2024

Terma Perdagangan Malaysia berkembang 0.4 peratus pada November 2024, dipengaruhi oleh bahan kimia.

PUTRAJAYA, 27 DISEMBER 2024 – Harga eksport Malaysia pada November 2024 meningkat 0.9 peratus daripada 147.8 mata pada bulan sebelumnya kepada 149.1 mata. Begitu juga, harga import naik 0.5 peratus daripada 126.3 mata kepada 126.9 mata dan terma perdagangan Malaysia bertambah 0.4 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 117.5 mata pada November 2024, sebagaimana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), NOVEMBER 2024** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit, indeks volum dan terma perdagangan meliputi 10 seksyen komoditi produk barang selaras dengan Klasifikasi Standard Perdagangan Antarabangsa (SITC).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan, indeks nilai seunit eksport naik 0.9 peratus pada November 2024 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+4.7%), minyak galian (+1.9%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (+1.1%). Namun begitu, indeks volum eksport jatuh 2.1 peratus selaras dengan kejatuhan indeks makanan (-11.7%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (-3.5%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-2.3%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim berkembang 1.5 peratus daripada 156.9 mata kepada 159.3 mata. Merujuk kepada perbandingan

tahunan, indeks nilai seunit berkurang 0.1 peratus manakala indeks volum bertambah 4.2 peratus.

Indeks nilai seunit import meningkat 0.5 peratus pada November 2024, disumbangkan oleh peningkatan indeks minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+7.9%), minyak galian (+1.7%) dan makanan (+0.7%). Manakala, indeks volum import susut 4.8 peratus pada November 2024 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh penurunan dalam indeks minyak galian (-12.9%), bahan kimia (-7.4%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-5.8%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim merosot 1.3 peratus daripada 209.9 mata kepada 199.9 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan indeks nilai seunit import menyusut 2.7 peratus dan indeks volum bertambah 4.5 peratus.

Terma perdagangan Malaysia melonjak 0.4 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 117.5 mata pada November 2024, didorong oleh kenaikan indeks bahan kimia (+1.2%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (+1.1%) dan makanan (+1.1%). Sementara itu, terma perdagangan Malaysia tahun ke tahun menokok 2.6 peratus daripada 114.5 mata pada November tahun lalu.

EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES, MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2024

***Malaysia's Terms of Trade grew 0.4 per cent in November 2024,
driven by chemicals.***

PUTRAJAYA, DECEMBER 27, 2024 – Malaysia's export prices in November 2024 went up by 0.9 per cent from 147.8 points in the previous month to 149.1 points. Likewise, import prices increased 0.5 per cent from 126.3 per cent to 126.9 points and Malaysia's terms of trade rose 0.4 per cent month-on-month to 117.5 points in November 2024 as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), NOVEMBER 2024**. This publication presents the unit value index, volume index and terms of trade for 10 commodity sections of merchandise products in accordance with the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin highlighted that the export unit value index edged up by 0.9 per cent in November 2024 as compared to the previous month. This increase was primarily driven by an increment in the indices of animal & vegetable oils & fats (+4.7%), mineral fuels (+1.9%) and manufactured goods (+1.1%). However, the export volume index fell by 2.1 per cent in line with the decrease in the index of food (-11.7%), manufactured goods (-3.5%) and machinery & transport equipment (-2.3%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index expanded by 1.5 per cent from 156.9 points to 159.3 points. Referring to the annual comparison, the unit value index decreased by 0.1 per cent while volume index increased by 4.2 per cent.

The index of animal & vegetable oils & fats (+7.9%), mineral fuels (+1.7%) and food (+0.7%) all contributed to a 0.5 per cent increase in the import unit value index in November 2024. The import volume index slipped by 4.8 per cent in November 2024 as compared to the previous month, contributed by the declined in the index of mineral fuels (-12.9%), chemicals (-7.4%) and machinery & transport equipment (-5.8%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index went down by 1.3 per cent from 209.9 points to 199.9 points. A year-on-year comparison showed that the unit value index down by 2.7 per cent and volume index up by 4.5 per cent.

Malaysia's terms of trade rebounded 0.4 per cent month-on-month to 117.5 points in November 2024, driven by the increased in the index of chemicals (+1.2%), manufactured goods (+1.1%) and food (+1.1%), Meanwhile, Malaysia's terms of trade climbed 2.6 per cent year-on-year from 114.5 points in November previous year.




Chart 1: Month-on-Month Percentage Change of Export & Import Unit Value Indices
