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INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN, MALAYSIA NOVEMBER 2024

Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat 3.6 peratus pada November 2024, didorong oleh pertumbuhan output yang berterusan dalam sektor Pembuatan

PUTRAJAYA, 10 JANUARI 2025 – Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat 3.6 peratus tahun ke tahun pada November 2024, didorong oleh pertumbuhan output yang berterusan dalam sektor Pembuatan. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP), Malaysia, November 2024** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor iaitu Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Pertumbuhan IPP terus meningkat 3.6 peratus pada November 2024 selepas mencatatkan 2.0 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya, mengekalkan momentum positif selama sebelas bulan berturut-turut. Peningkatan ini disokong oleh sektor Pembuatan yang berkembang sebanyak 4.6 peratus (Oktober 2024: 3.3%), disertai dengan peningkatan 3.9 peratus dalam output Elektrik (Oktober 2024: 1.9%). Namun begitu, pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan kekal dalam aliran menurun walaupun dengan pertumbuhan negatif yang lebih kecil iaitu 0.8 peratus pada November 2024 (Oktober 2024: -2.8%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, IPP bertumbuh 0.5 peratus daripada 1.7 peratus pada Oktober 2024."

Output berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang dua pertiga daripada sektor Pembuatan berkembang sebanyak 5.6 peratus pada November 2024 berbanding 3.3 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Pengembangan ini disokong terutamanya oleh Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal yang meningkat 8.8 peratus; diikuti oleh Pembuatan kok dan produk petroleum bertapis pada 2.8 peratus; dan Pembuatan produk plastik yang meningkat 8.7 peratus. Pengembangan tahun ke tahun ini mencerminkan prestasi eksport negara yang melonjak 10.3 peratus pada November 2024. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport memulih 0.1 peratus selepas merekodkan negatif 1.4 peratus pada Oktober 2024.

Namun begitu, industri berorientasikan domestik terus bertumbuh sederhana sebanyak 2.6 peratus selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 3.3 peratus pada Oktober 2024. Peningkatan industri ini diterajui terutamanya oleh Pembuatan produk prosesan makanan (5.6%); Pembuatan produk logam yang direka, kecuali mesin dan kelengkapan (4.9%); dan Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain (2.9%). Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, industri berorientasikan domestik mencatatkan pemulihan sebanyak 3.0 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan negatif 0.9 peratus pada bulan Oktober 2024.

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menambah, "Pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan pada November 2024 menurun sebanyak 0.8 peratus dipengaruhi oleh penurunan dalam indeks Minyak Mentah & Kondensat sebanyak 3.8 peratus (Oktober 2024: -7.5%) manakala, indeks Gas Asli meningkat 1.2 peratus (Oktober 2024: 0.4%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, indeks Perlombongan bertumbuh marginal 0.2 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan 14.7 peratus yang direkodkan pada Oktober 2024. Sementara itu, penjanaan Elektrik berkembang 3.9 peratus tahun ke tahun pada November 2024 selepas mencatatkan peningkatan 1.9 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Perbandingan dengan bulan Oktober 2024, indeks Elektrik menurun 3.9 peratus berbanding positif 3.6 peratus pada Oktober 2024."

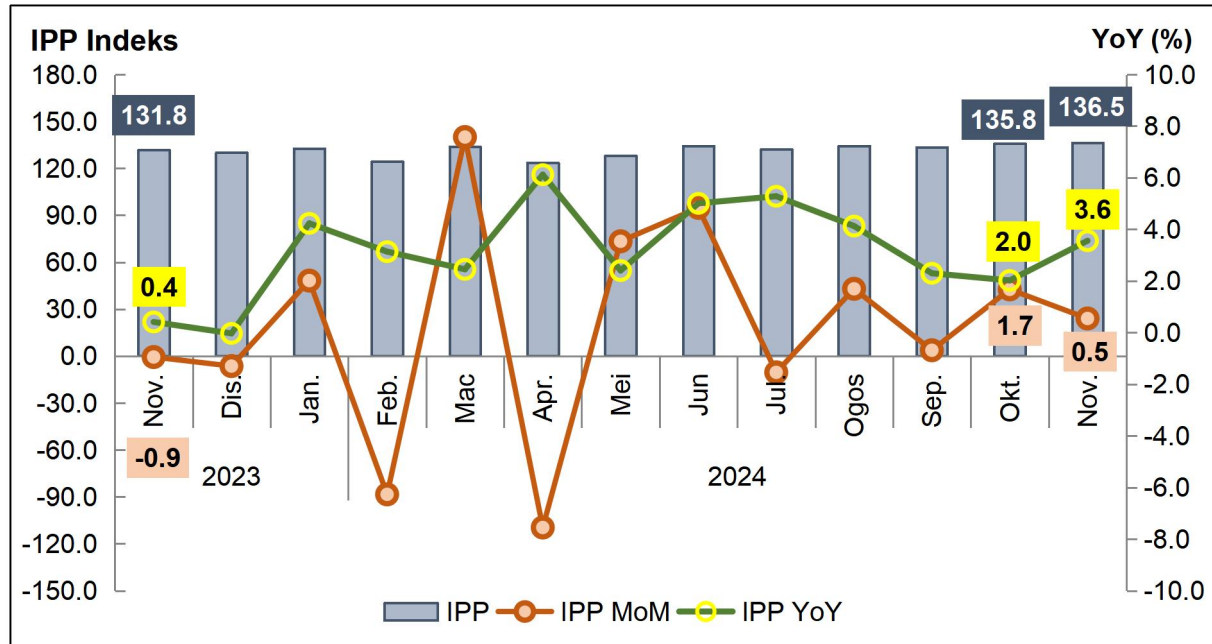
Di peringkat global, IPP bagi beberapa negara meningkat termasuk China, Singapura, Vietnam dan Taiwan sementara, Korea Selatan terus meningkat dengan pertumbuhan marginal pada November 2024. Sebaliknya, Amerika Syarikat, Japan dan Thailand mengalami penurunan pada bulan ini.

Merumuskan kenyataan beliau, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Bagi tempoh sebelas bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – November 2024), IPP bertumbuh lebih baik kepada 3.7 peratus (Januari – November 2023: 0.8%) dengan kesemua sektor mencatatkan peningkatan, iaitu indeks Perlombongan (0.7%); indeks Pembuatan (4.2%); dan indeks Elektrik (5.8%).”

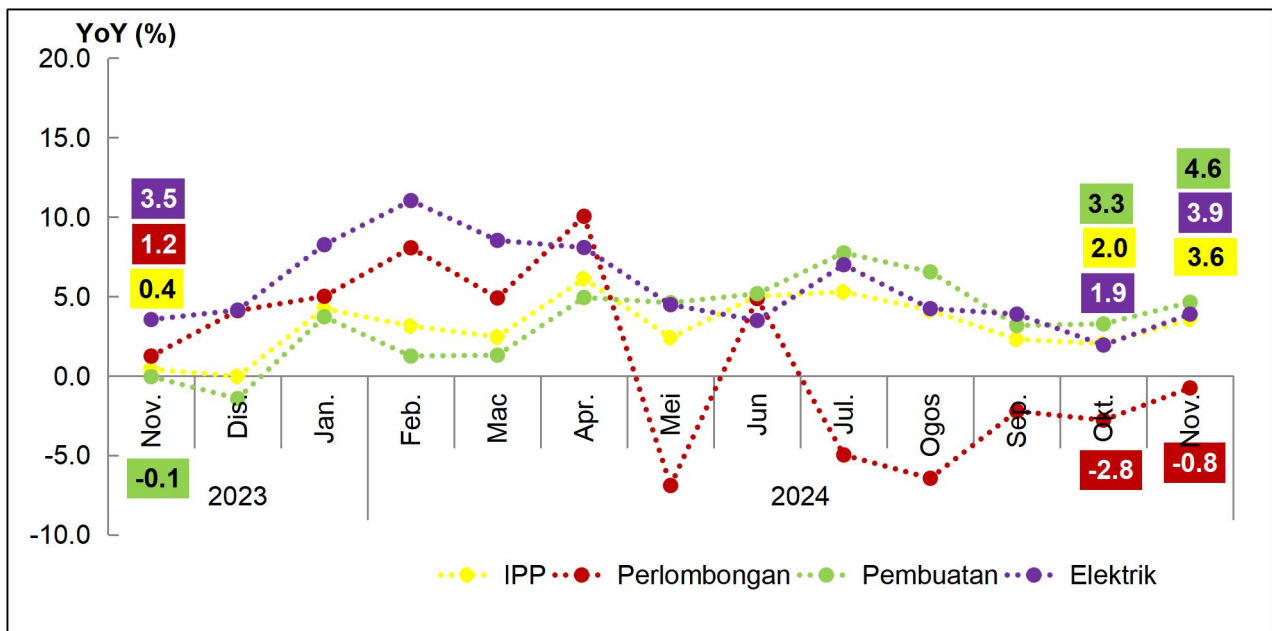

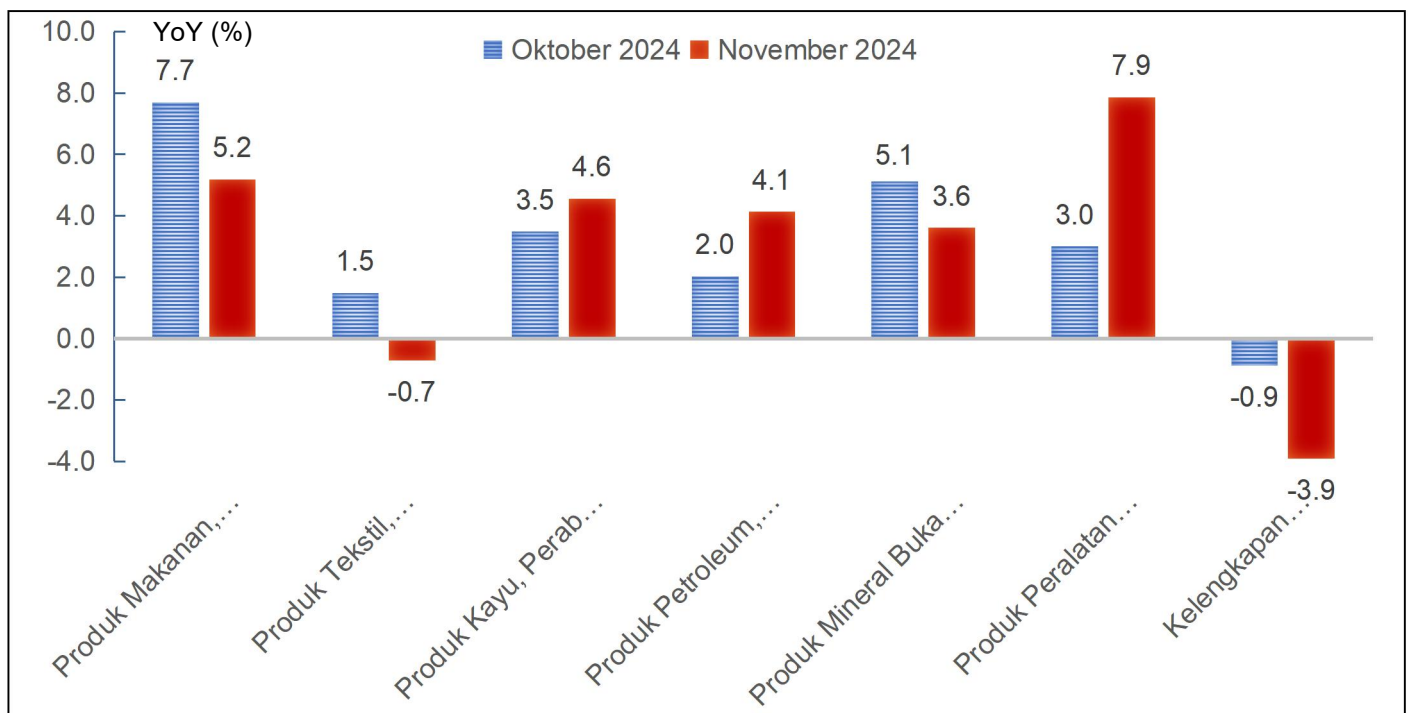
**Carta 1: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian, Malaysia,
November 2023 - November 2024**



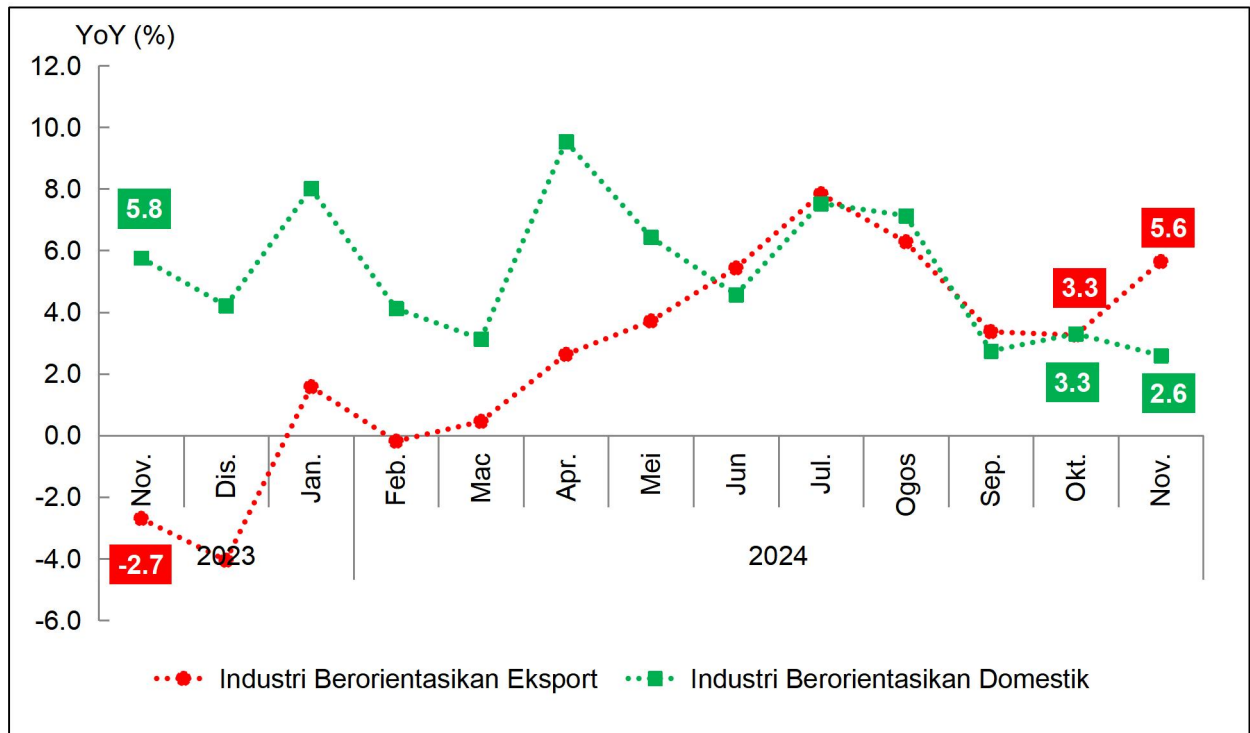
**Carta 2: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian dan Komponennya, Malaysia
November 2023 - November 2024**



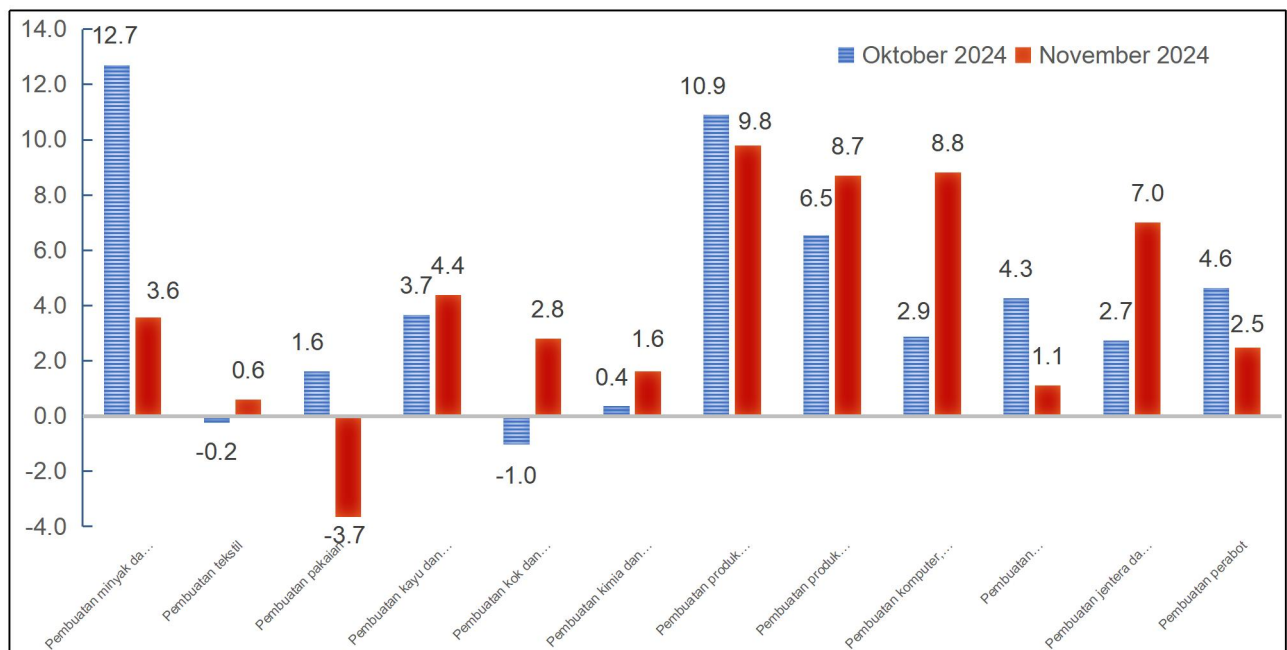
**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Subsektor, Malaysia
Oktober 2024 dan November 2024**



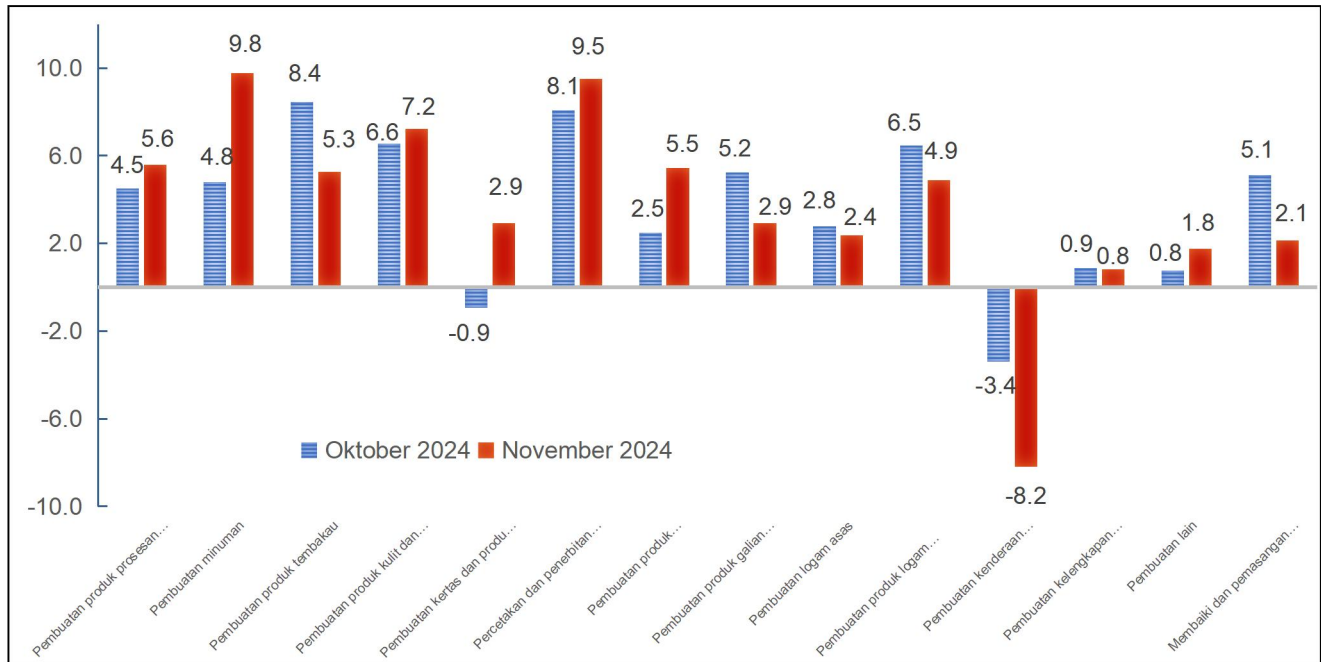
Carta 4: Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Industri Berorientasikan Eksport dan Domestik, Malaysia, November 2023 - November 2024

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INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA NOVEMBER 2024

The Industrial Production Index increased by 3.6 per cent in November 2024, driven by sustained output growth in Manufacturing sector

PUTRAJAYA, 10TH JANUARY 2025 – The Industrial Production Index increased by 3.6 per cent year-on-year in November 2024, driven by sustained output growth in Manufacturing sector. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of the **Industrial Production Index (IPI), Malaysia, November 2024**. The publication presents IPI statistics, consisting of three sectors, namely Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The IPI's growth further increased by 3.6 per cent in November 2024 after registering 2.0 per cent in the previous month, sustaining a positive momentum for eleven consecutive months. The expansion was supported by the Manufacturing sector, which expanded by 4.6 per cent (October 2024: 3.3%) coupled with the rise of 3.9 per cent in Electricity output (October 2024: 1.9%). However, the Mining sector production remained on a downward trend, albeit with a smaller negative growth of 0.8 per cent in November 2024 (October 2024: -2.8%). In terms of month-on-month, the IPI grew 0.5 per cent from 1.7 per cent in October 2024."

The output for the export-oriented industries which accounted for two-thirds of Manufacturing sector, expanded by 5.6 per cent in November 2024 as compared to 3.3 per cent registered in the previous month. The expansion was supported mainly by

the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products which soared by 8.8 per cent; followed by the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products at 2.8 per cent; and the Manufacture of plastic products which increased by 8.7 per cent. The year-on-year expansion mirrored the country's export performance, which surged by 10.3 per cent in November 2024. On a month-on-month comparison, the export-oriented industries rebounded by 0.1 per cent after recording a negative 1.4 per cent growth in October 2024.

Nevertheless, the domestic-oriented industries continued to grew modestly, at 2.6 per cent after registering growth of 3.3 per cent in October 2024. The increase in these industries was primarily led by Manufacture of food processing products (5.6%); the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (4.9%); and the Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (2.9%). In comparison to the preceding month, the domestic-oriented industries turned around by 3.0 per cent as against the negative growth of 0.9 per cent recorded in October 2024.”

Elaborating further, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The production of Mining sector in November 2024 edged down by 0.8 per cent influenced by a decline in the Crude Oil & Condensate index dropped by 3.8 per cent (October 2024: -7.5%) while the Natural Gas index increased by 1.2 per cent (October 2024: 0.4%). As compared to the previous month, the Mining index grew at a marginal 0.2 per cent as compared to the growth of 14.7 per cent recorded in October 2024. Meanwhile, the generation of Electricity expanded by 3.9 per cent year-on-year in November 2024 after registering an increase of 1.9 per cent in the preceding month. In comparison with October 2024, the Electricity index went down by 3.9 per cent as against the positive 3.6 per cent in October 2024.”

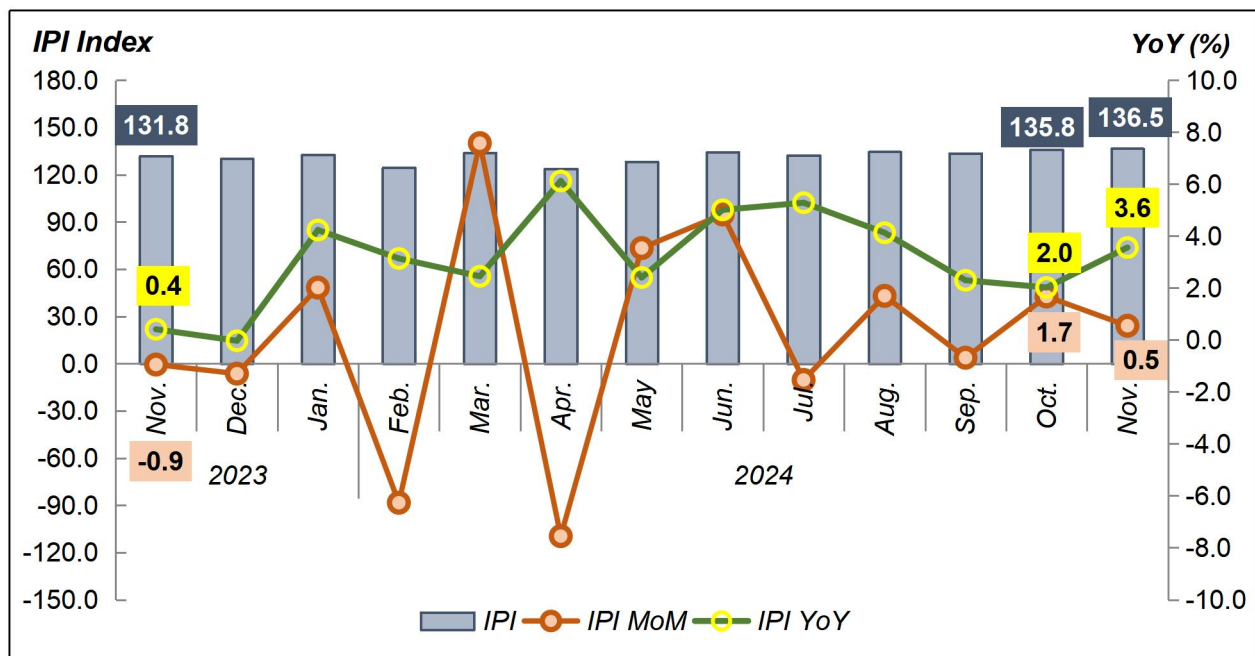
On a global scale, the IPI for several countries increased, including China, Singapore, Vietnam, and Taiwan, while South Korea continued to increase with a marginal growth in November 2024. Conversely, the United States, Japan and Thailand experienced a decline during this month.

Concluding his statement, the Chief Statistician said, “For the first eleven months this year (January – November 2024), the IPI improved to 3.7 per cent (January - November 2023: 0.8%), with all sectors posting increases, namely the Mining index (0.7%); Manufacturing index (4.2%); and Electricity index (5.8%).”

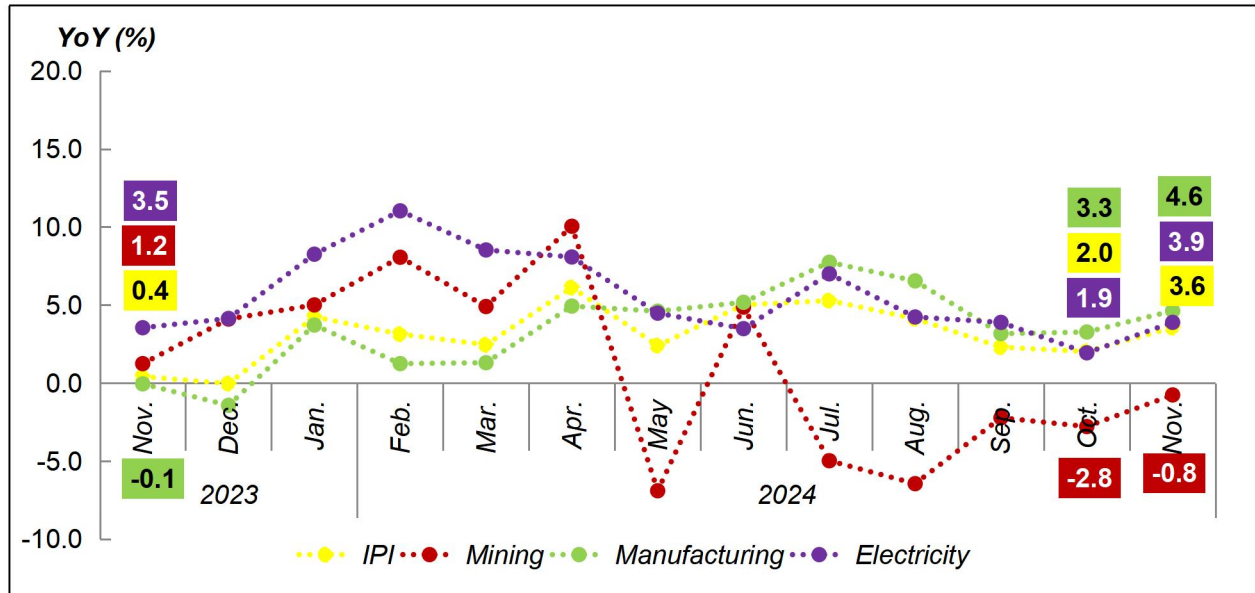

October 2024 and November 2024**

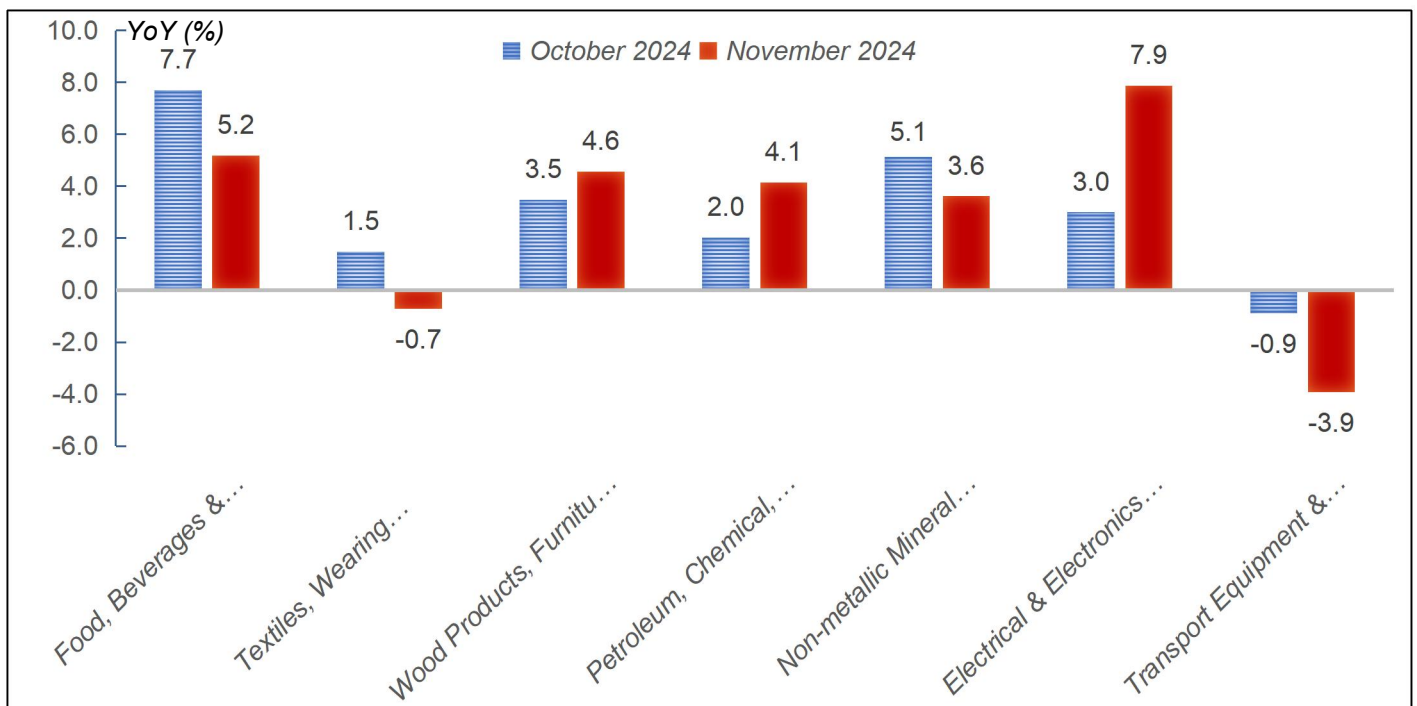


Chart 4: Manufacturing Index by Export and Domestic Oriented Industries, Malaysia, November 2023 – November 2024

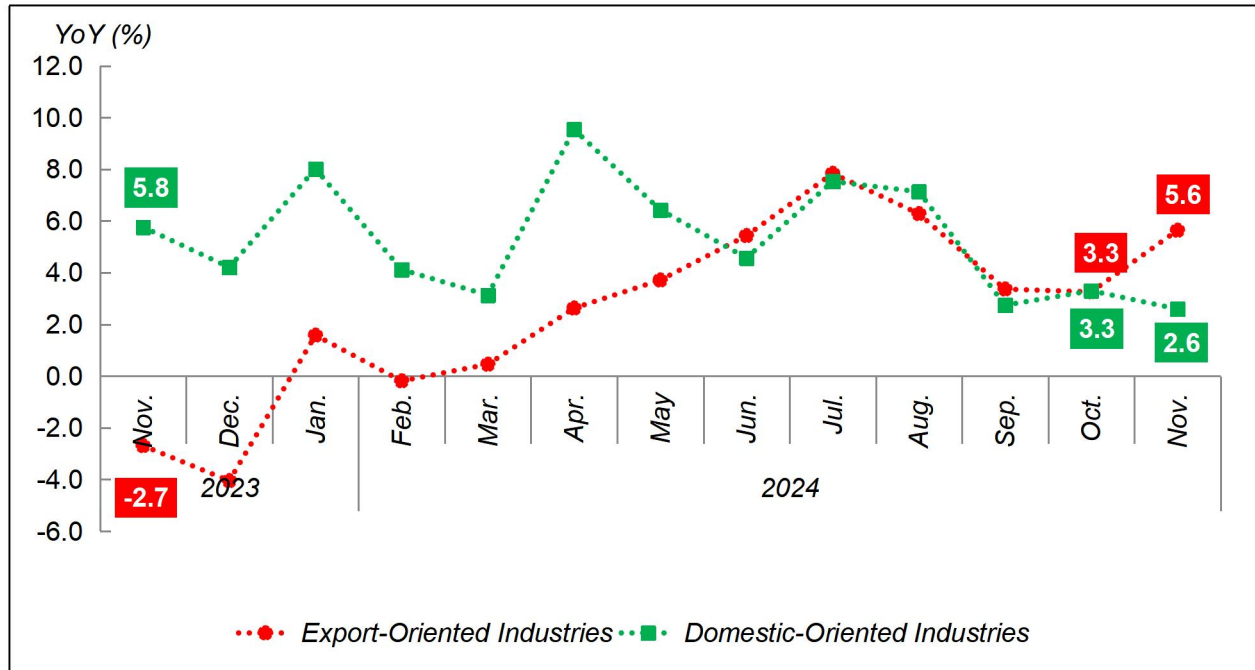
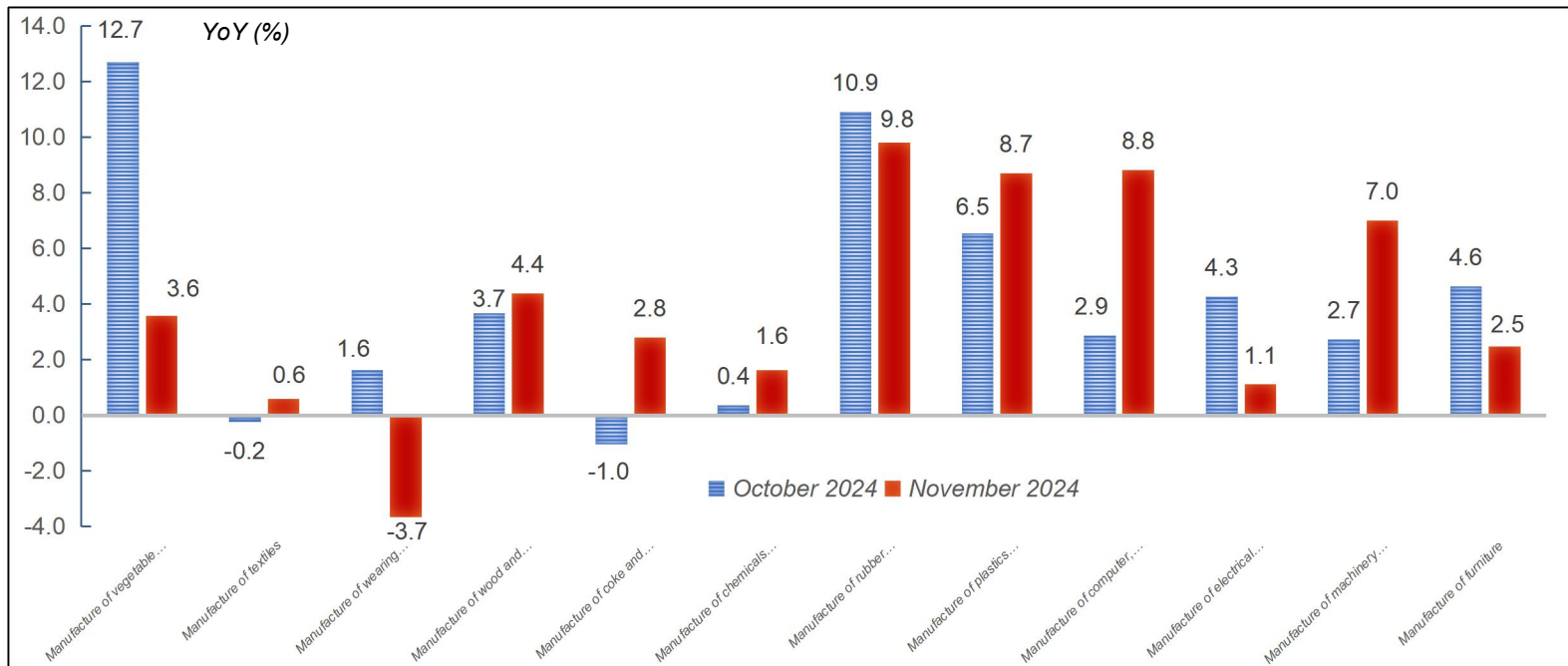
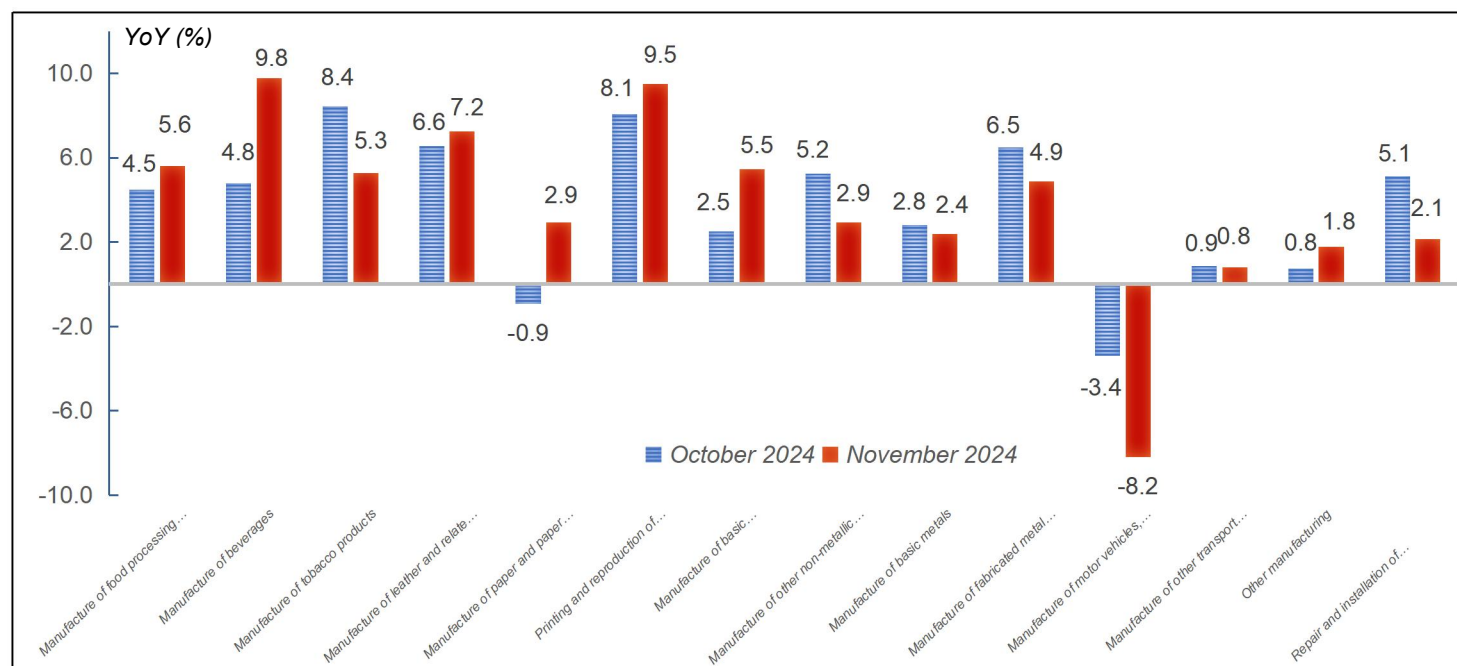


Chart 5: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, October 2024 and November 2024
