PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA NOVEMBER 2024

**Jualan sektor Pembuatan berkembang 4.5 peratus;
berjumlah RM161.9 bilion pada November 2024**

PUTRAJAYA, 10 JANUARI 2025 – Jualan sektor Pembuatan berkembang 4.5 peratus, berjumlah RM161.9 bilion pada November 2024. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan hari ini dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, November 2024**.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Pertumbuhan sektor Pembuatan pada November 2024 dipacu terutamanya oleh peningkatan dua angka sebanyak 12.3 peratus dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (Oktober 2024: 11.2%); dan diperkukuhkan oleh kenaikan 7.1 peratus dalam subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (Oktober 2024: 3.2%). Berdasarkan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan meningkat 0.3 peratus daripada RM161.4 bilion yang dicatatkan pada Oktober 2024."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang 71.5 peratus daripada jumlah jualan pembuatan bertambah 5.6 peratus, meningkat daripada 3.0 peratus pada Oktober 2024. Pertumbuhan yang stabil ini sebahagian besarnya disumbangkan oleh prestasi kukuh dalam industri Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (15.0%); Pembuatan produk getah (10.5%); serta

Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal (7.6%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport susut 1.2 peratus pada November 2024.

Sementara itu, industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat 1.8 peratus (Oktober 2024: 3.0%). Industri Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan merekodkan peningkatan 8.7 peratus berbanding 8.1 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Walau bagaimanapun, Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin dan kelengkapan mencatatkan pertumbuhan sederhana 4.1 peratus berbanding 6.1 peratus pada Oktober 2024. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan domestik terus berkembang, merekodkan 4.1 peratus pada November 2024.

Ketua Perangkawan menambah, “Seramai 2.40 juta pekerja terlibat dalam sektor Pembuatan pada November 2024, mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 1.0 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan 0.9 peratus pada Oktober 2024. Peningkatan ini terutamanya boleh dilihat dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (2.1%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (1.3%); dan Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas, percetakan (1.0%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini bertambah sedikit sebanyak 0.1 peratus pada November 2024 (Oktober 2024: 0.4%).

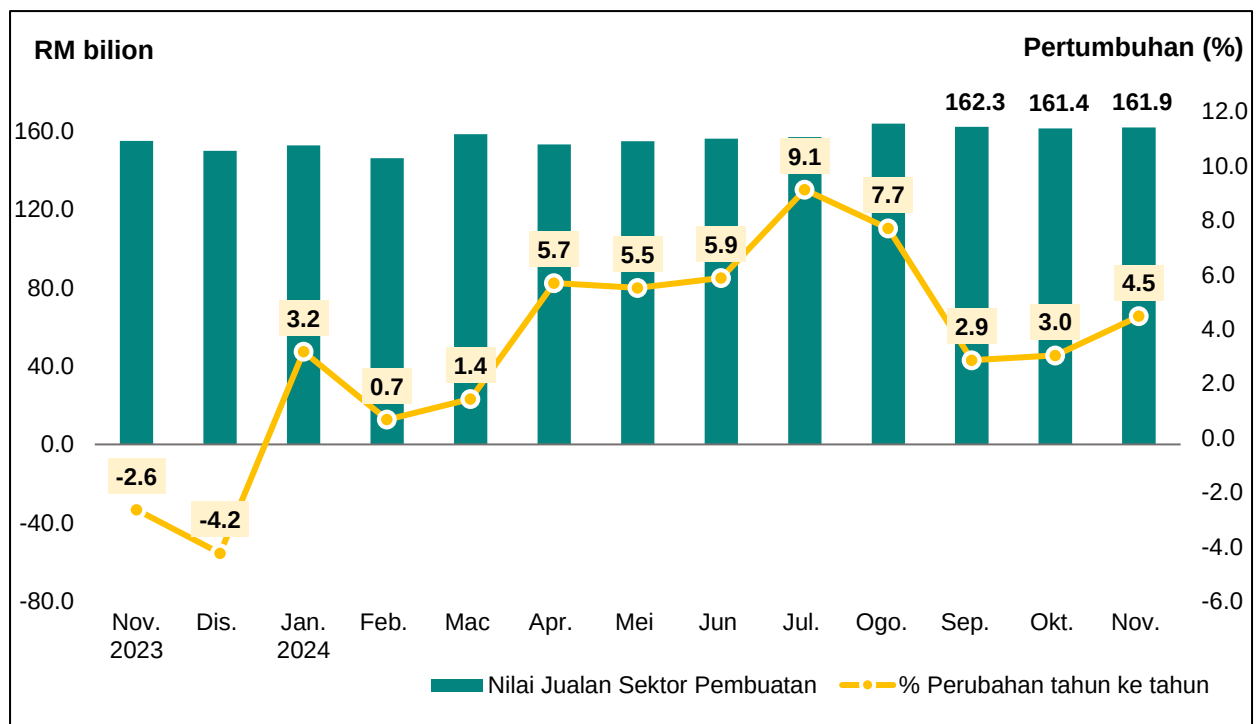
Pada November 2024, gaji & upah dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat kepada RM8.30 bilion (Oktober 2024: RM8.28 bilion). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, gaji & upah meningkat sebanyak 0.2 peratus. Bagi tempoh yang sama, purata gaji & upah bulanan setiap pekerja meningkat 0.8 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM3,455. Sementara itu, nilai jualan setiap pekerja meningkat 3.4 peratus, mencatatkan RM67,414.”

Sepanjang sebelas bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – November 2024), nilai jualan bagi sektor Pembuatan adalah berjumlah RM1,728.1 bilion, meningkat sebanyak 4.5 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun 2023 (Januari – November 2023: 0.6%). Bilangan pekerja menokok sebanyak 1.0 peratus kepada 2.40 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah meningkat 1.5 peratus kepada RM90.4 bilion dengan nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja berjumlah RM719,493, merekodkan pertumbuhan 3.4 peratus.

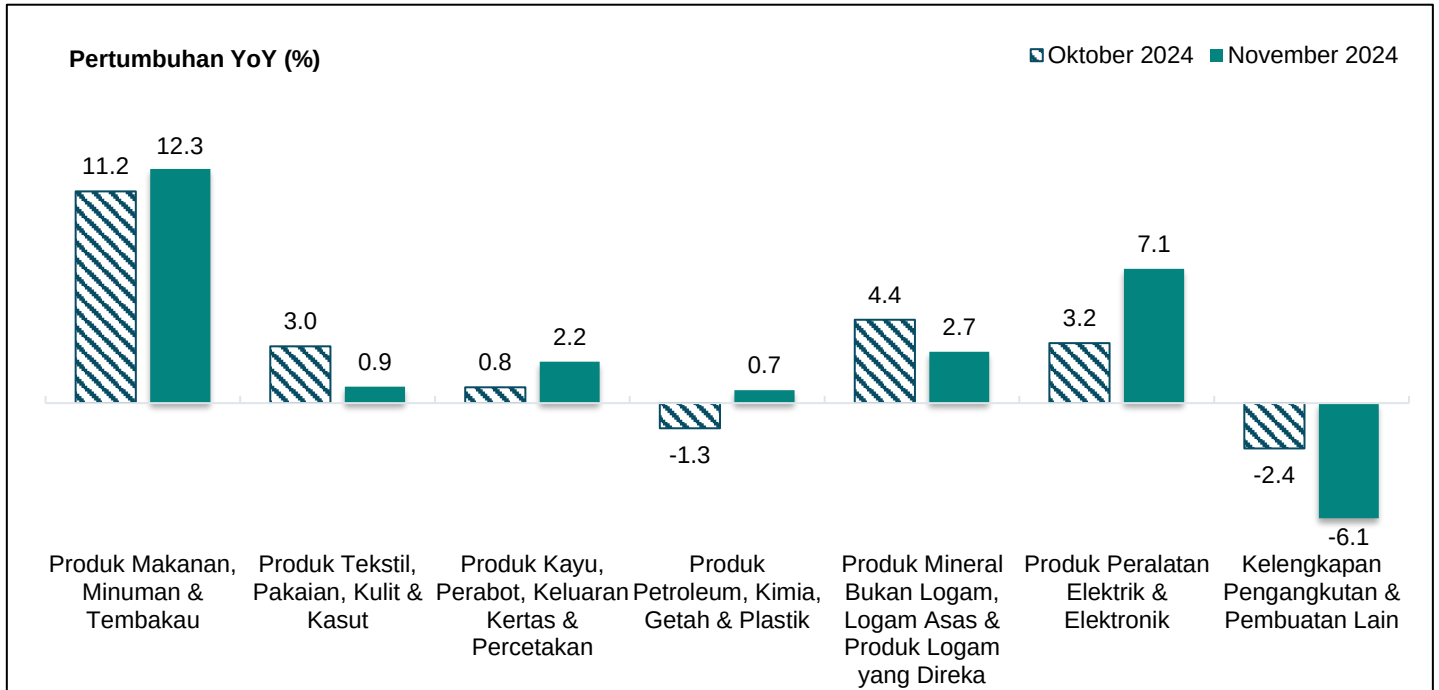

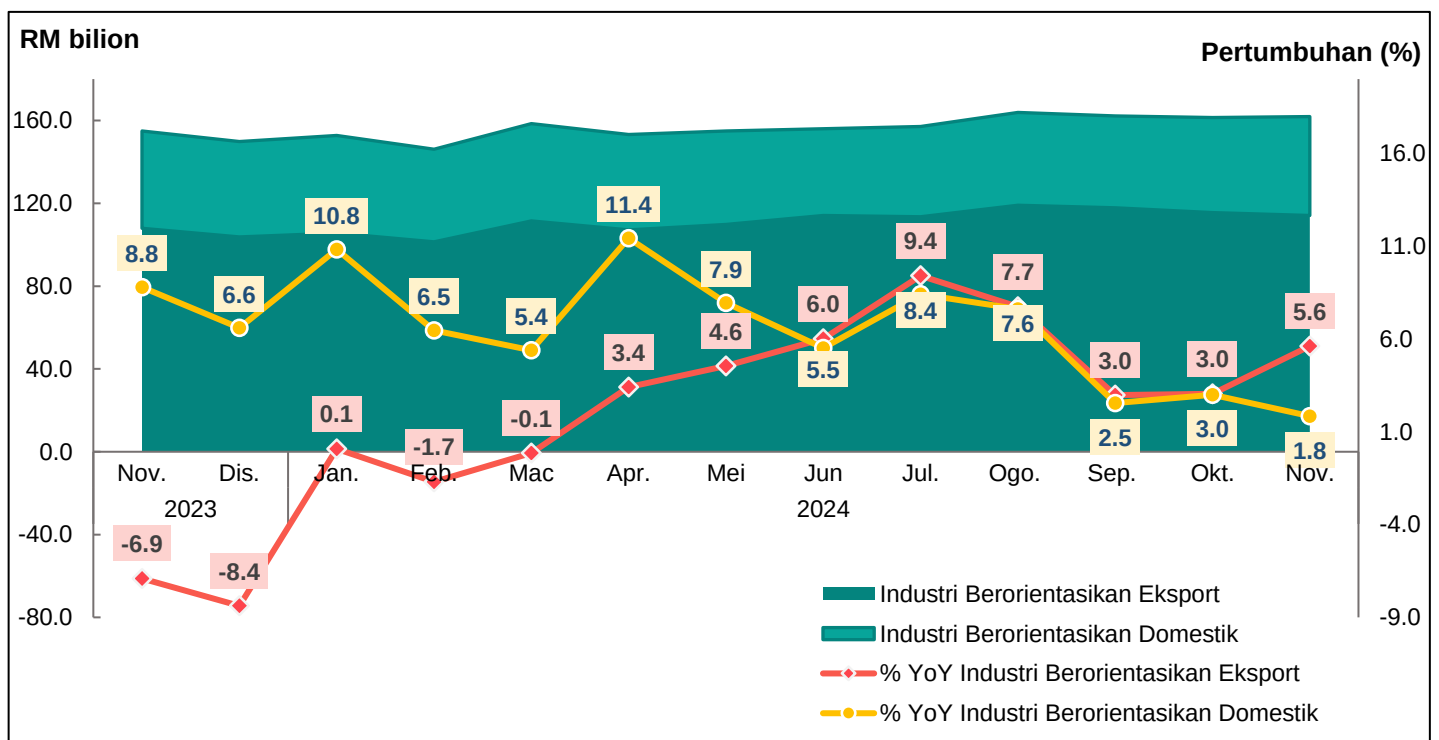
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan,
November 2023 - November 2024**



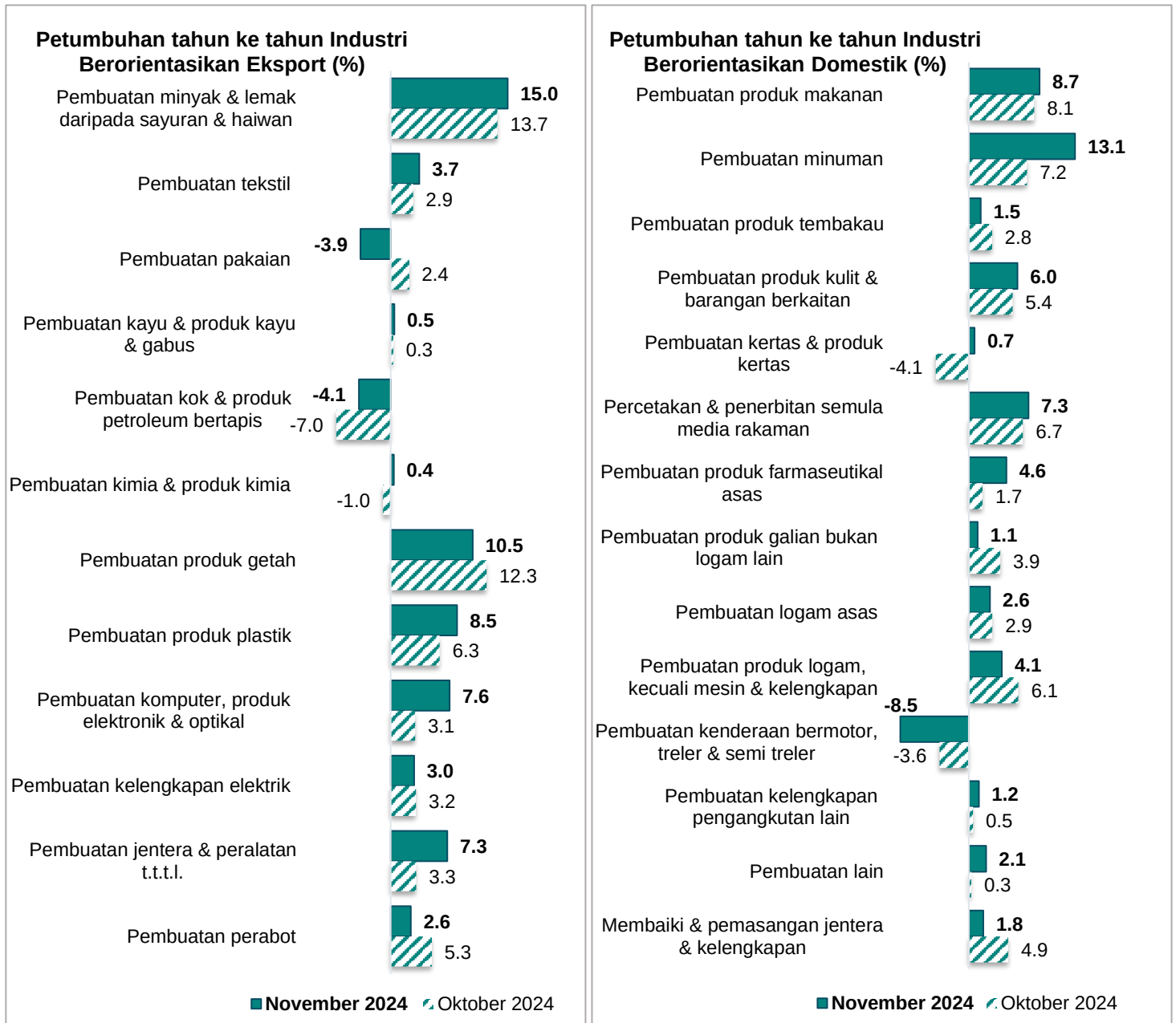
Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan, Oktober 2024 dan November 2024

MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA NOVEMBER 2024

***The Manufacturing sector sales expanded by 4.5 per cent;
amounted to RM161.9 billion in November 2024***

PUTRAJAYA, JANUARY 10, 2025 – The Manufacturing sector sales expanded by 4.5 per cent year-on-year, amounted to RM161.9 billion in November 2024. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, November 2024**.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “The expansion in the manufacturing sector for November 2024 was driven by a double-digit increase of 12.3 per cent in the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector (October 2024: 11.2%); and enhanced by 7.1 per cent rise in the Electrical & electronics products sub-sector (October 2024: 3.2%). Month-on-month basis, the sales value increased by 0.3 per cent from RM161.4 billion registered in October 2024.”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which accounting for 71.5 per cent of total manufacturing sales rose by 5.6 per cent, up from the 3.0 per cent in October 2024. The steady growth was largely attributed to the strong performance in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (15.0%); Manufacture of rubber products (10.5%); as well as Manufacture of computer, electronics and optical products industries (7.6%). In

comparison by month-on-month, export-oriented industries dropped by 1.2 per cent in November 2024.

Meanwhile, domestic-oriented industries increased by 1.8 per cent (October 2024: 3.0%). Manufacture of processed food industry recorded 8.7 per cent increase as compared to 8.1 per cent in the preceding month. However, Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment registered moderate growth of 4.1 per cent as compared to 6.1 per cent in October 2024. In comparison to the previous month, the sales value of domestic-oriented industries sustained to expand, recorded 4.1 per cent in November 2024.

The Chief Statistician added, “There were 2.40 million employees involved in the Manufacturing sector in November 2024, marking a 1.0 per cent increase compared to a 0.9 per cent growth in October 2024. The increase was observed largely in the Food, beverages & tobacco (2.1%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (1.3%); and Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (1.0%) sub-sectors. In comparison to the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector augmented slightly by 0.1 per cent in November 2024 (October 2024: 0.4%).

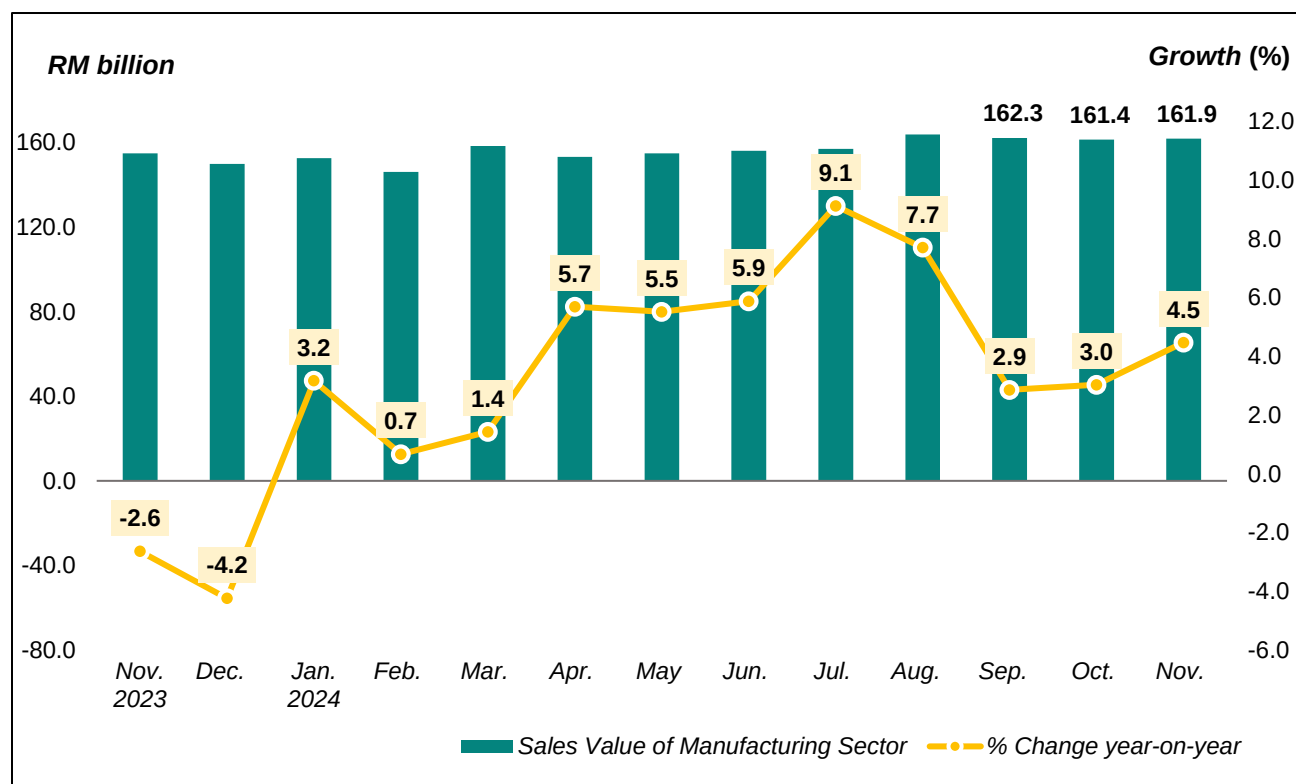
In November 2024, salaries & wages in the Manufacturing sector rose to RM8.30 billion (October 2024: RM8.28 billion). Compared to the previous month, salaries & wages increased by 0.2 per cent. For the same period, the average monthly salaries & wages per employee rose by 0.8 per cent year-on-year to RM3,455. Simultaneously, the sales value per employee rose by 3.4 per cent, registered RM67,414.”

Throughout the first eleven months this year (January – November 2024), the sales value of the Manufacturing sector was amounted to RM1,728.1 billion, increased by 4.5 per cent as compared to the same period of 2023 (January – November 2023: 0.6%). The number of employee uptick by 1.0 per cent to 2.40 million persons, while salaries & wages grew by 1.5 per cent to RM90.4 billion with the sales value per employee stood at RM719,493, posting a growth of 3.4 per cent.

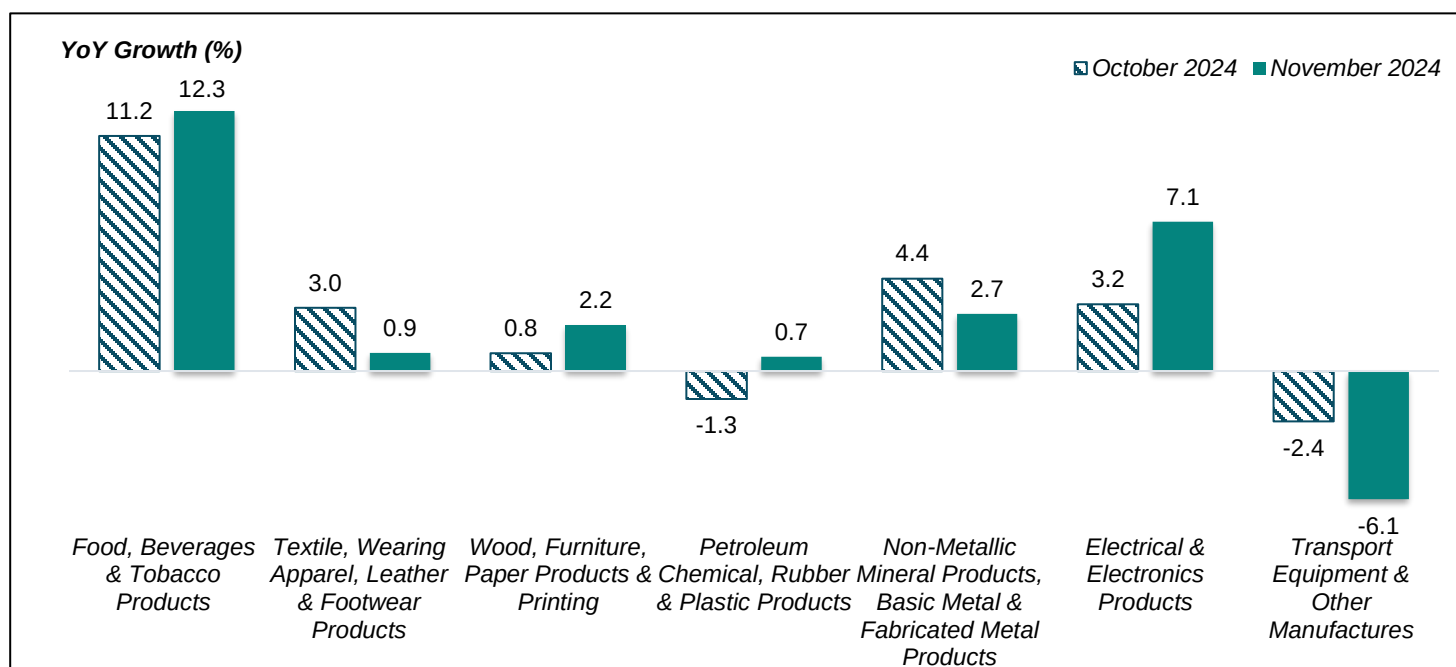

Manufacturing Sector, November 2023 – November 2024**

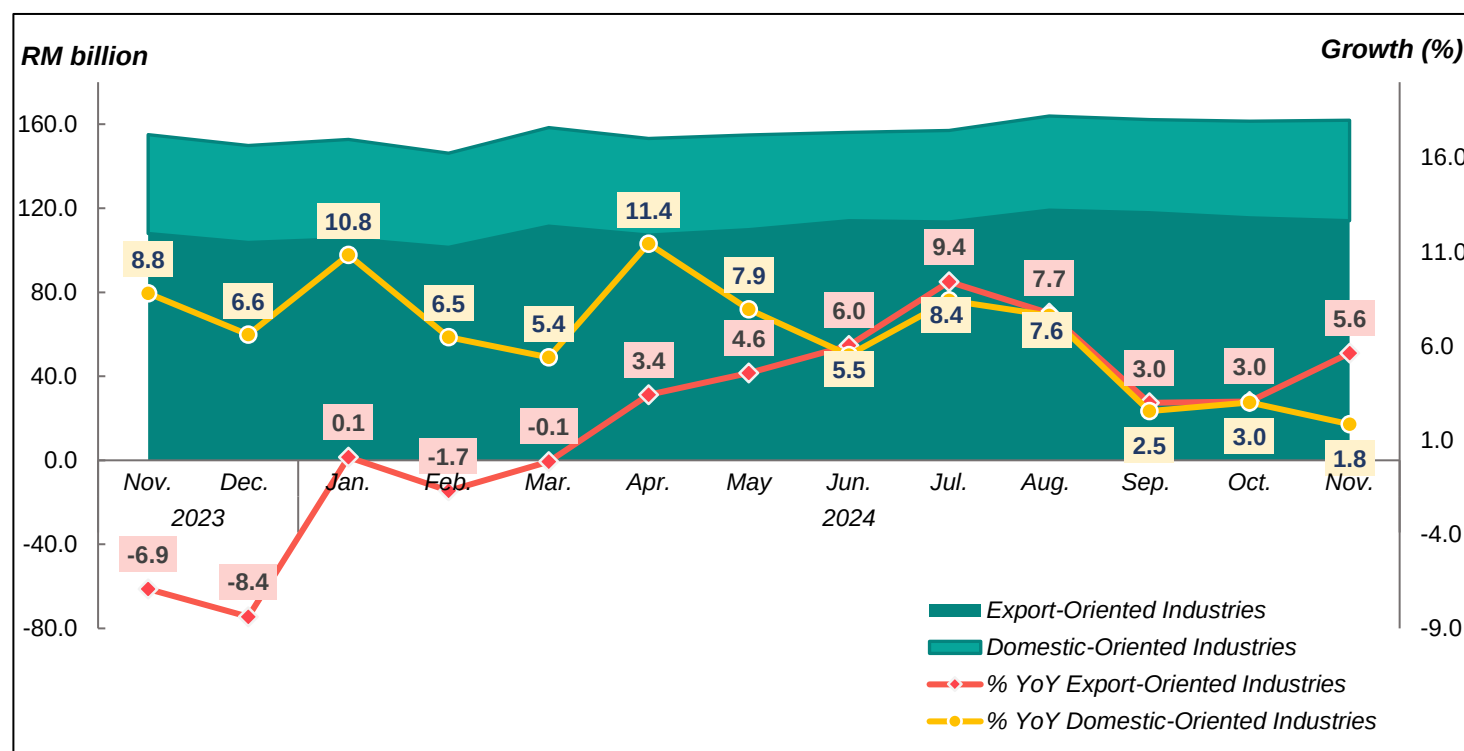
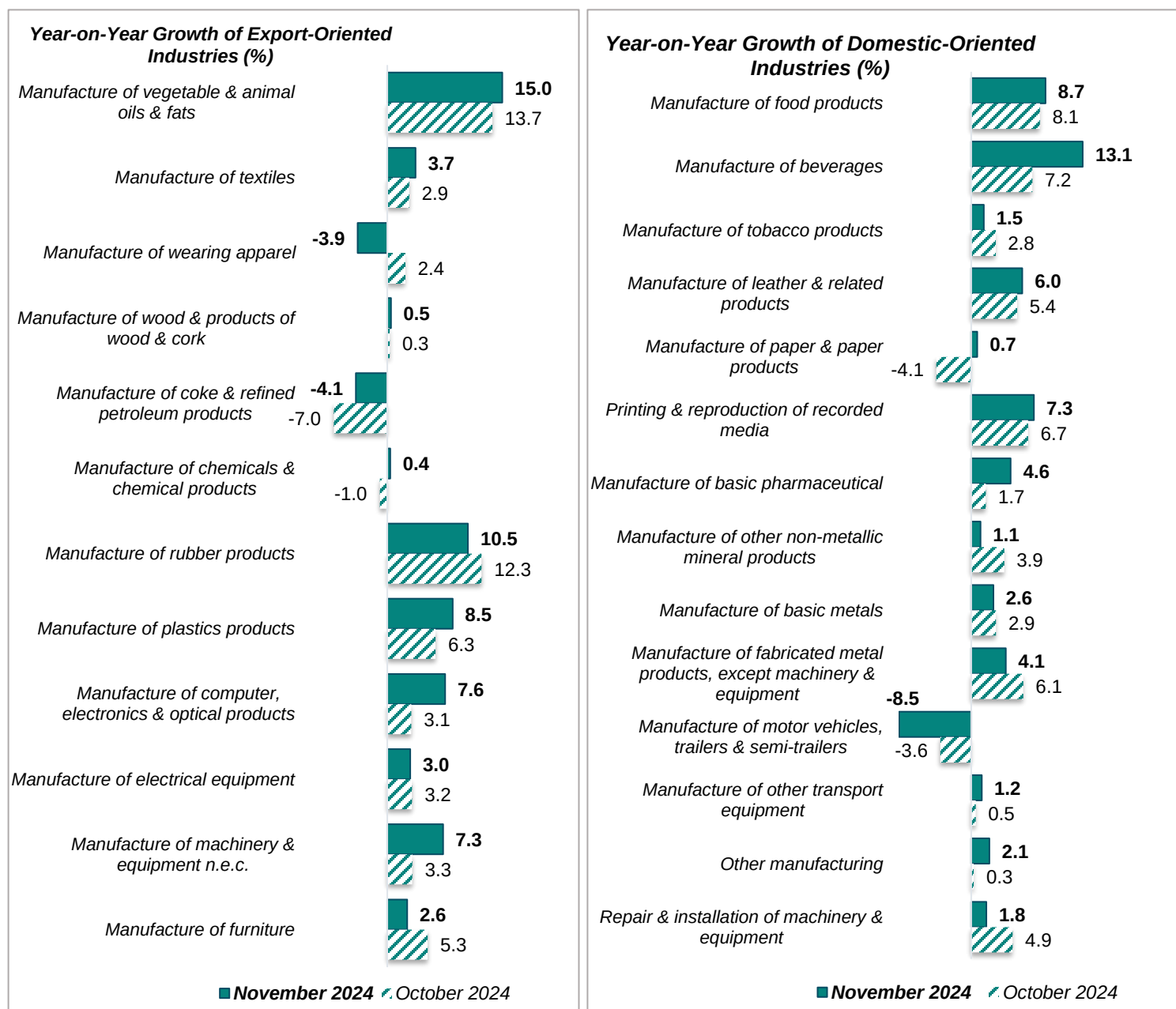


Chart 4: Sales Value of Manufacturing Export and Domestic-Oriented Groups, October 2024 and November 2024
