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KENYATAAN MEDIA BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI DISEMBER 2024

JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN BAGI LAPAN NEGERI MEREKODKAN PERKEMBANGAN POSITIF DENGAN NILAI RM205.6 BILION PADA BULAN DISEMBER 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JANUARI 2025 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM257.9 bilion pada Disember 2024 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM138.5 bilion dan RM119.3 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI DISEMBER 2024**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport bernilai RM138.5 bilion pada Disember 2024, meningkat sebanyak RM20.1 bilion (+16.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (+RM15.4 bilion), Johor (+RM4.7 bilion), Selangor (+RM1.9 bilion), Sabah (+RM1.3 bilion), Perak (+RM1.1 bilion), Melaka (+RM416.7 juta), Kelantan (+RM18.5 juta) dan Perlis (+RM7.1 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di Kedah sebanyak RM1.6 bilion, W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM1.5 bilion), Sarawak (-RM819.5 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM415.5 juta), Pahang (-RM342.1 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM30.0 juta) dan Terengganu (-RM15.1 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 38.0 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (18.1%), Selangor (16.2%), Sarawak (7.4%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.7%).

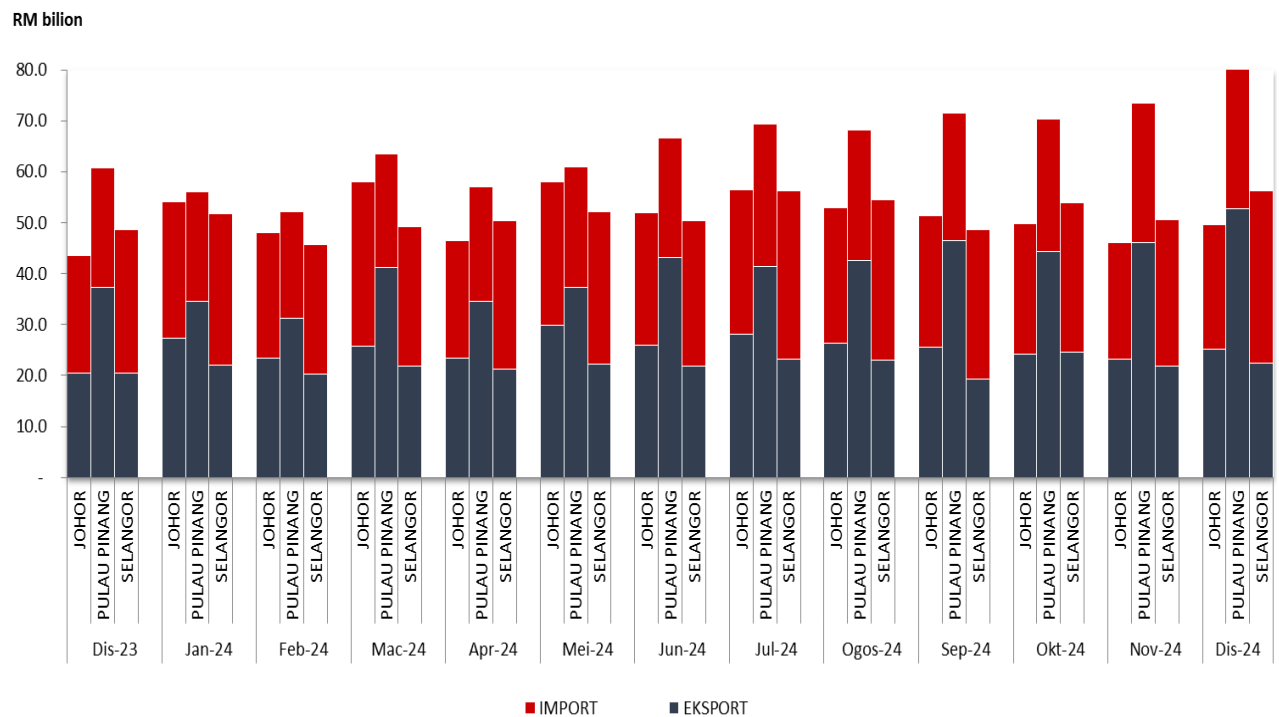
Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Disember 2024 meningkat RM12.7 bilion (+11.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun 2023. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Selangor (+RM5.9 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM3.9 bilion), Johor (+RM1.3 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.1 bilion), Perak (+RM704.5 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM590.1 juta), Sarawak (+RM558.8 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM237.3 juta), Sabah (+RM69.5 juta), Melaka (+RM54.9 juta) dan Perlis (+RM32.3 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Negeri Sembilan sebanyak RM1.3 bilion, Pahang (-RM393.4 juta), Terengganu (-RM139.7 juta) dan Kelantan (-RM115.9 juta).

Selangor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 28.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Pulau Pinang (22.9%), Johor (20.6%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.5%) dan Kedah (5.9%).

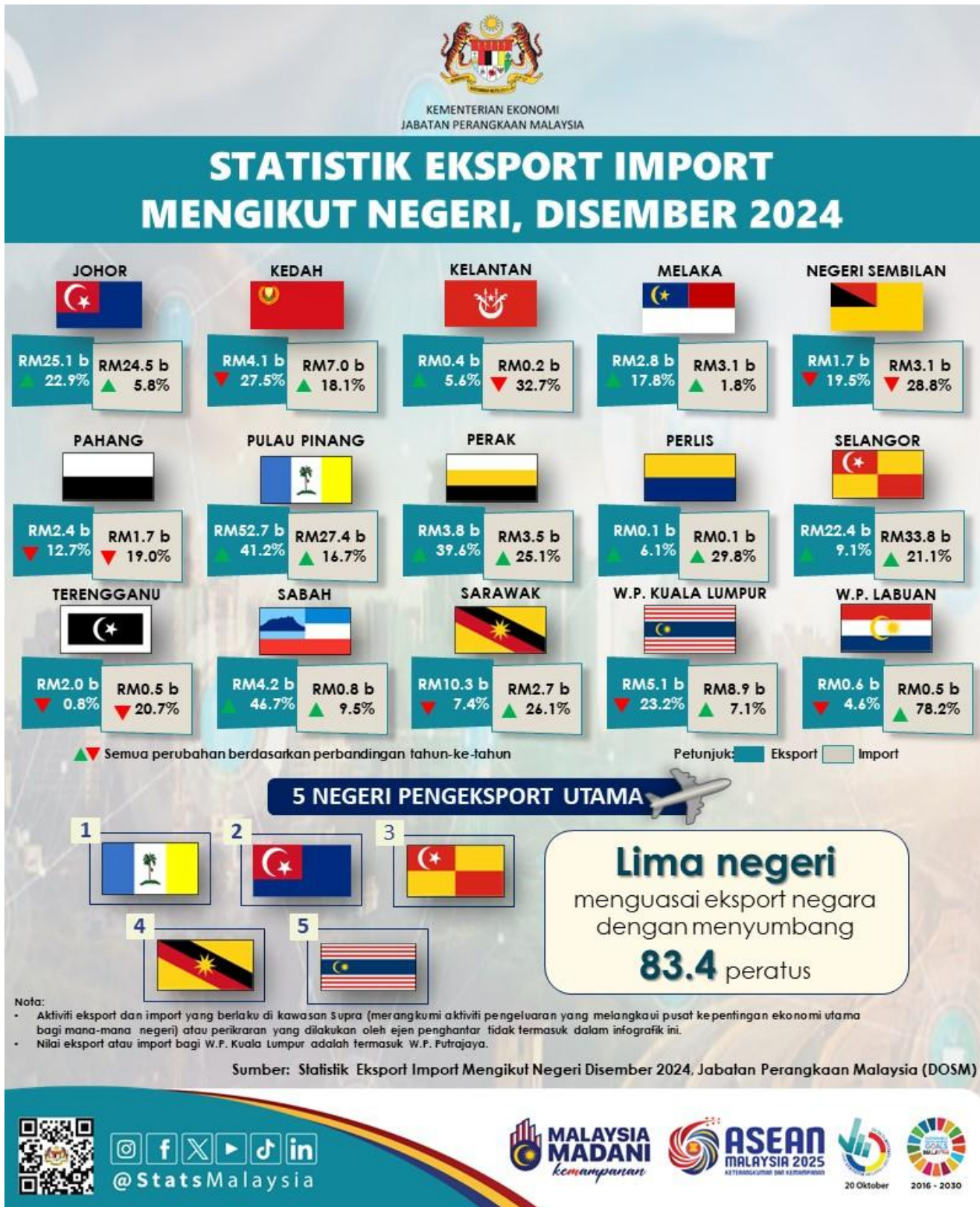

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE DECEMBER 2024

TOTAL TRADE FOR EIGHT STATES RECORDED A POSITIVE GROWTH WITH A VALUE OF RM205.6 BILLION IN DECEMBER 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JANUARY 2025 – Malaysia's total trade for December 2024 amounted to RM257.9 billion with exports and imports recorded RM138.5 billion and RM119.3 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE DECEMBER 2024**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM138.5 billion in December 2024, increased RM20.1 billion (+16.9%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM15.4 billion), Johor (+RM4.7 billion), Selangor (+RM1.9 billion), Sabah (+RM1.3 billion), Perak (+RM1.1 billion), Melaka (+RM416.7 million), Kelantan (+RM18.5 million) and Perlis (+RM7.1 million). However, exports decreased in Kedah by RM1.6 billion, W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM1.5 billion), Sarawak (-RM819.5 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM415.5 million), Pahang (-RM342.1 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM30.0 million) and Terengganu (-RM15.1 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 38.0 per cent share, followed by Johor (18.1%), Selangor (16.2%), Sarawak (7.4%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.7%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in December 2024 increased RM12.7 billion (+11.9%) as compared to the same

month in year 2023. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as Selangor (+RM5.9 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM3.9 billion), Johor (+RM1.3 billion), Kedah (+RM1.1 billion), Perak (+RM704.5 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM590.1 million), Sarawak (+RM558.8 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM237.3 million), Sabah (+RM69.5 million), Melaka (+RM54.9 million) and Perlis (+RM32.3 million). However, imports decreased in Negeri Sembilan by RM1.3 billion, Pahang (-RM393.4 million), Terengganu (-RM139.7 million) and Kelantan (-RM115.9 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 28.4 per cent, followed by Pulau Pinang (22.9%), Johor (20.6%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.5%) and Kedah (5.9%).

December 2023 – December 2024 (RM Billion)**

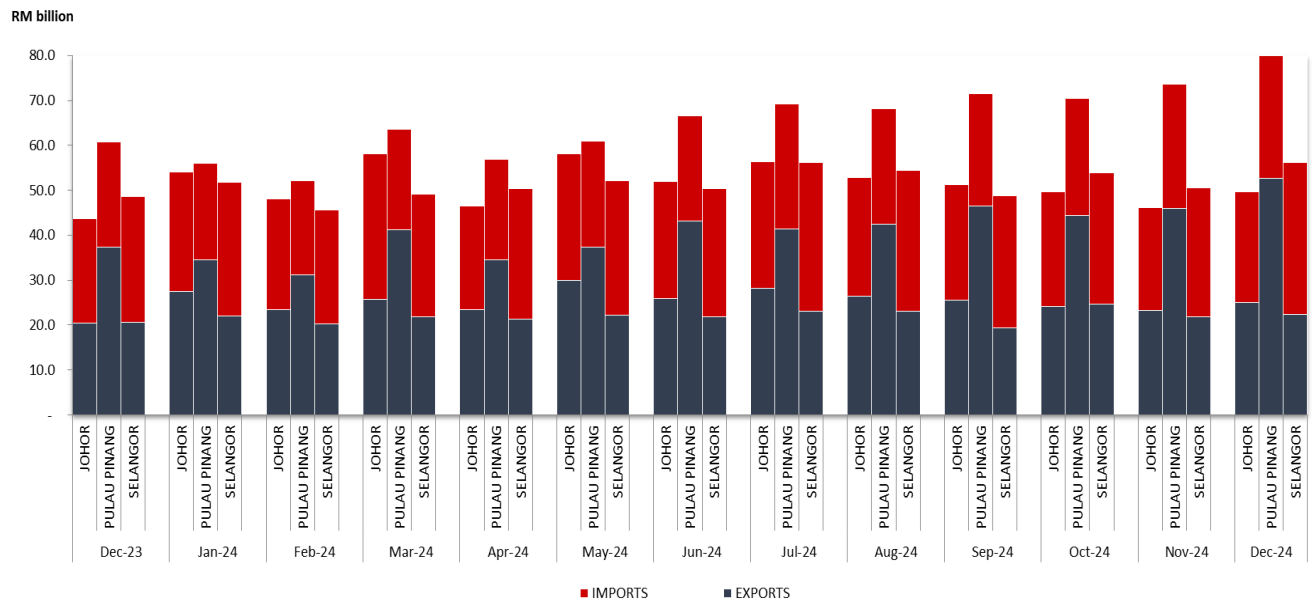
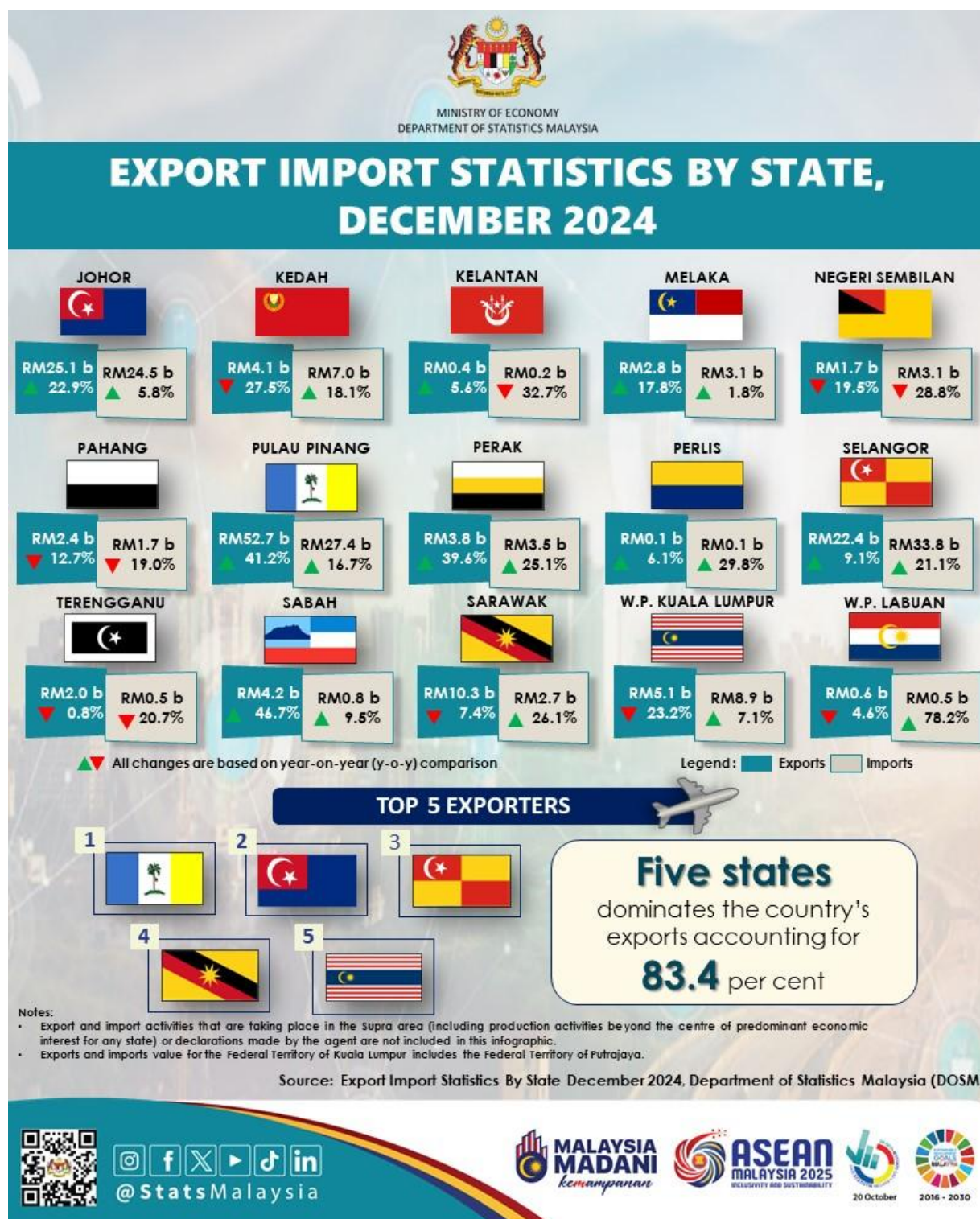


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, December 2024
