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PENUNJUK EKONOMI MALAYSIA INDEKS PELOPOR, SERENTAK & SUSULAN DISEMBER 2024

**Indeks pelopor meningkat 3.1 peratus pada Disember 2024,
memberi isyarat prospek ekonomi yang optimis dalam tempoh terdekat**

PUTRAJAYA, 25 FEBRUARI 2025 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **Penunjuk Ekonomi Malaysia: Indeks Pelopor, Serentak & Susulan bagi Disember 2024**. Indeks Pelopor (IP) memberi petunjuk awal tentang titik perubahan dalam kitaran perniagaan dan arah tuju ekonomi bagi tempoh terdekat.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menyatakan, “Prestasi ekonomi Malaysia terus menunjukkan perkembangan yang memberangsangkan dengan Indeks Pelopor (IP) mencatatkan 3.1 peratus pada Disember 2024, mencapai 113.6 mata berbanding 110.2 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya **(Paparan I)**. Prestasi ini disokong oleh pengukuhan berterusan dalam Indeks Perusahaan Bursa Malaysia yang melonjak 27.1 peratus dan Import Benar Semi Konduktor yang meningkat 21.6 peratus. Selari dengan itu, prestasi bulanan IP meningkat 0.8 peratus dipacu terutamanya oleh Indeks Perusahaan Bursa Malaysia (0.4%) dan Bilangan Unit Kediaman Yang Diluluskan Pembinaan (0.3%)”.

Melihat kepada arah aliran jangka panjang terlicin pada Disember 2024, IP terus berada di bawah 100.0 mata **(Paparan II)**. Namun begitu, ekonomi Malaysia dijangka kekal berdaya tahan, disokong oleh permintaan domestik yang kukuh berikutan

pelaksanaan kenaikan gaji penjawat awam, pelarasan gaji minimum dan pengukuhan pasaran buruh.

Berhubung prestasi ekonomi semasa, Indeks Serentak (IS) turut mencatatkan peningkatan tahunan sebanyak 1.8 peratus, mencecah 126.1 mata berbanding 123.9 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian mempamerkan prestasi kukuh dengan 4.6 peratus, meletakkannya sebagai penyumbang utama kepada peningkatan ini. Walau bagaimanapun, prestasi bulanan IS mencatatkan penurunan marginal 0.3 peratus pada Disember 2024 dipengaruhi oleh penyusutan hampir kesemua komponen IS kecuali Kapasiti Penggunaan dalam Pembuatan (0.03%) dan Indeks Kuantiti Perdagangan Runcit (0.01%).

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah melancarkan OpenDOSM NextGen sebagai medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

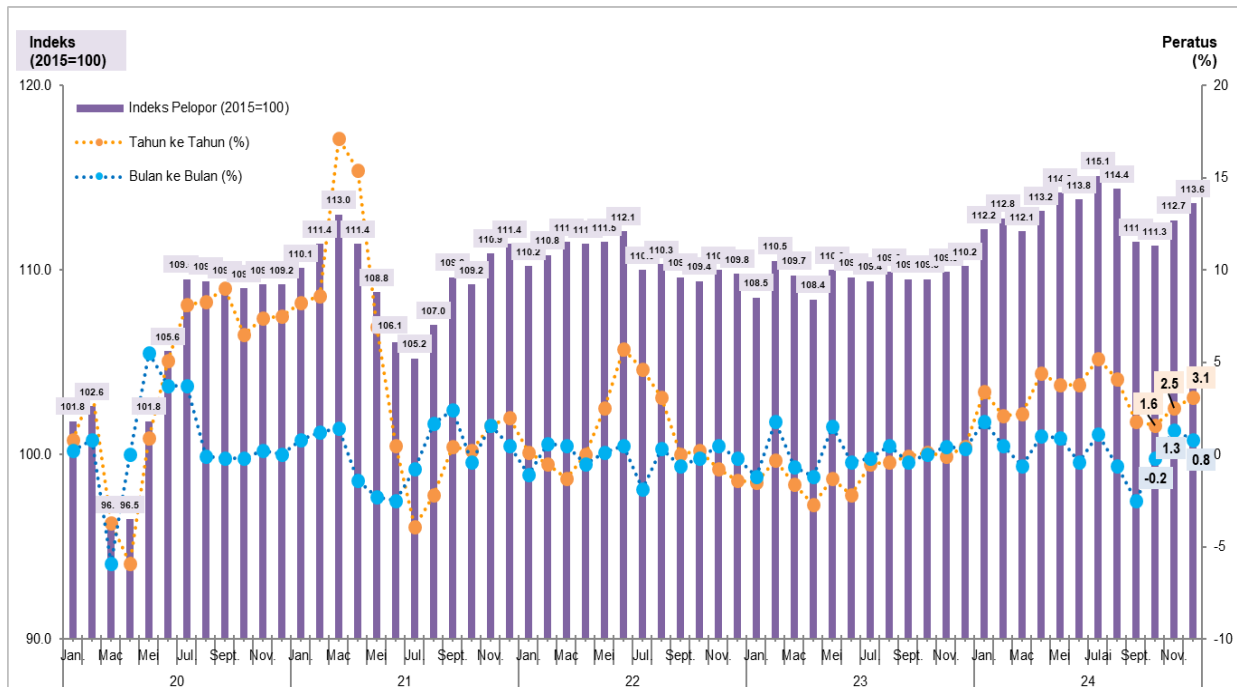

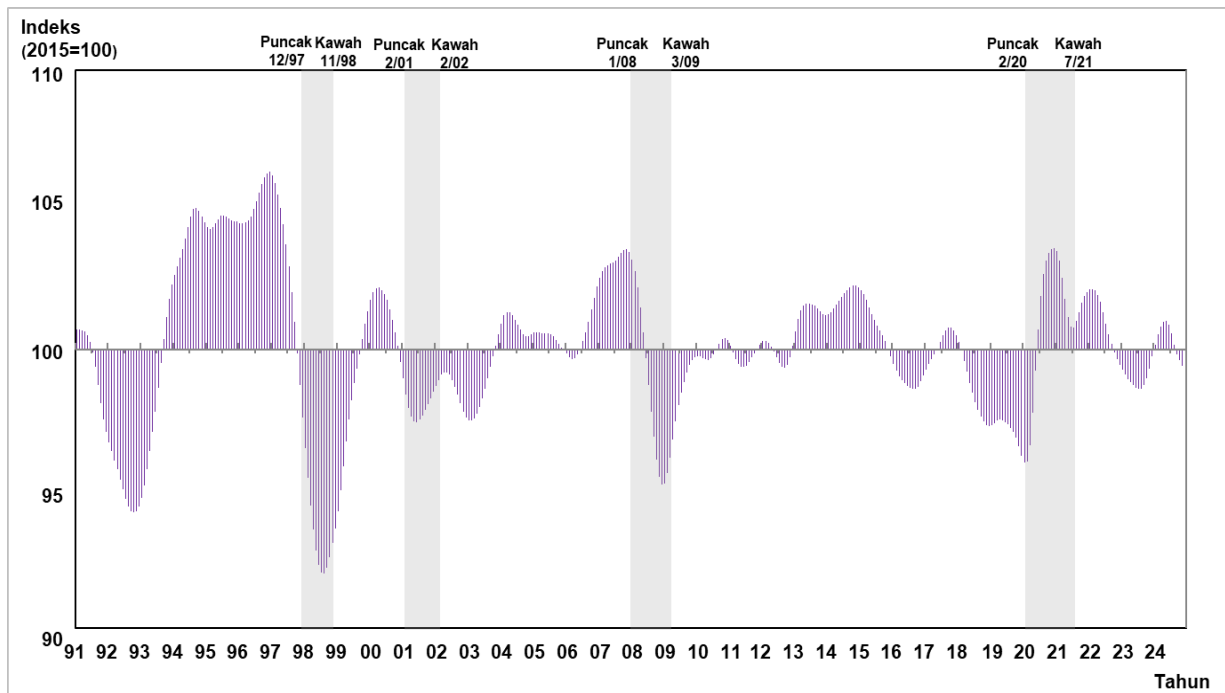

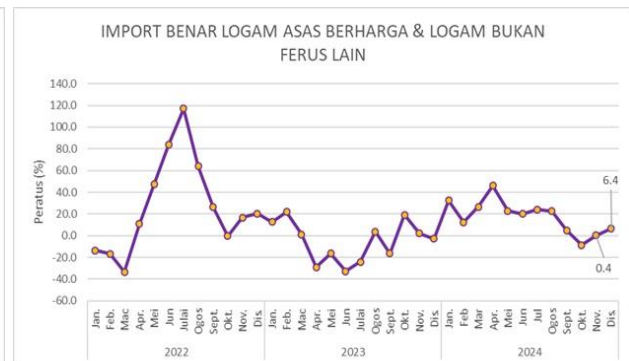
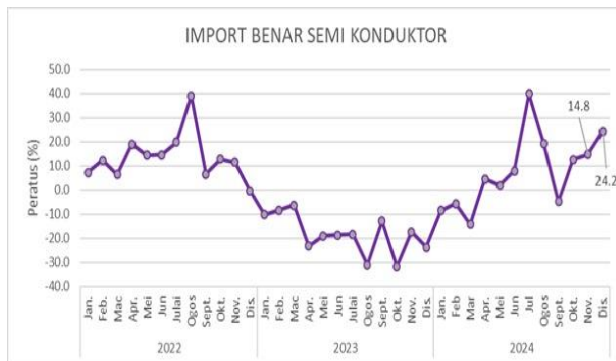
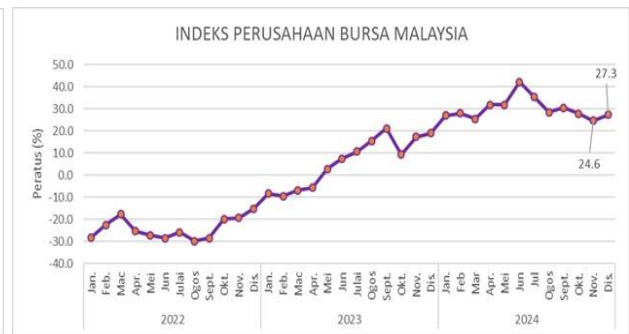
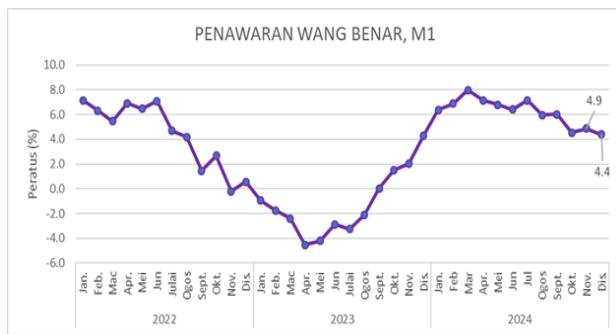
Paparan I: Indeks Komposit Pelopor

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MALAYSIAN ECONOMIC INDICATORS LEADING, COINCIDENT & LAGGING INDEXES DECEMBER 2024

***The Leading Index increased by 3.1 per cent in December 2024,
signalling an optimistic economic prospect in the near term***

PUTRAJAYA, FEBRUARY 25, 2025 – Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia released the **Malaysian Economic Indicators: Leading, Coincident & Lagging Indexes for December 2024**. The Leading Index (LI) provides an early indication of turning points in the business cycle and the direction of the economy in the near term.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin mentioned, "Malaysia's economic performance continues to show encouraging progress with the Leading Index (LI) recording a 3.1 per cent increase in December 2024, reaching 113.6 points versus 110.2 points in the same month of the previous year (**Exhibit I**). This performance was supported by continued strength in the Bursa Malaysia Industrial Index which surged 27.1 per cent and the Real Imports of Semi Conductors, which rose by 21.6 per cent. In line with this, the monthly performance of the LI grew by 0.8 per cent driven mainly by the Bursa Malaysia Industrial Index (0.4%) and the Number of Housing Units Approved (0.3%)".

Looking at the smoothed long-term trend in December 2024, the LI continued below 100.0 points (**Exhibit II**). Nevertheless, Malaysia's economy is expected to remain

resilient, supported by a strong domestic demand following the implementation of salary increases for civil servants, the adjustment of the minimum wage and a strengthening of the labour market.

Regarding the current economic performance, the Coincident Index (CI) also experienced an annual increase of 1.8 per cent, reaching 126.1 points as compared to 123.9 points in the same month of the previous year. The Industrial Production Index demonstrated robust performance with 4.6 per cent, positioning it as the primary contributor to the increase. However, the monthly performance of the LI recorded a marginal decline of 0.3 per cent in December 2024 influenced by decreases in most components of the CI, except for the Capacity Utilisation in Manufacturing (0.03%) and the Volume Index of Retail Trade (0.01%).

The Government of Malaysia has declared National Statistics Day (MyStats Day) on October 20th. MyStats Day theme is "Statistics is the Essence of Life".

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index

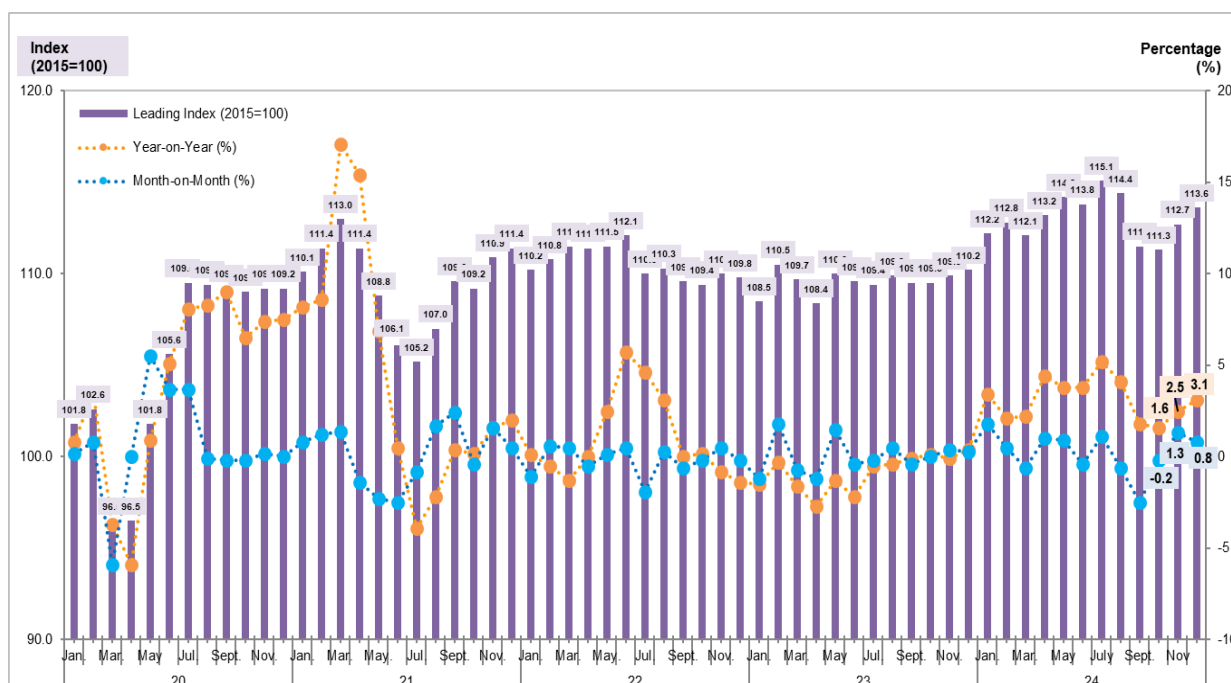


Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle

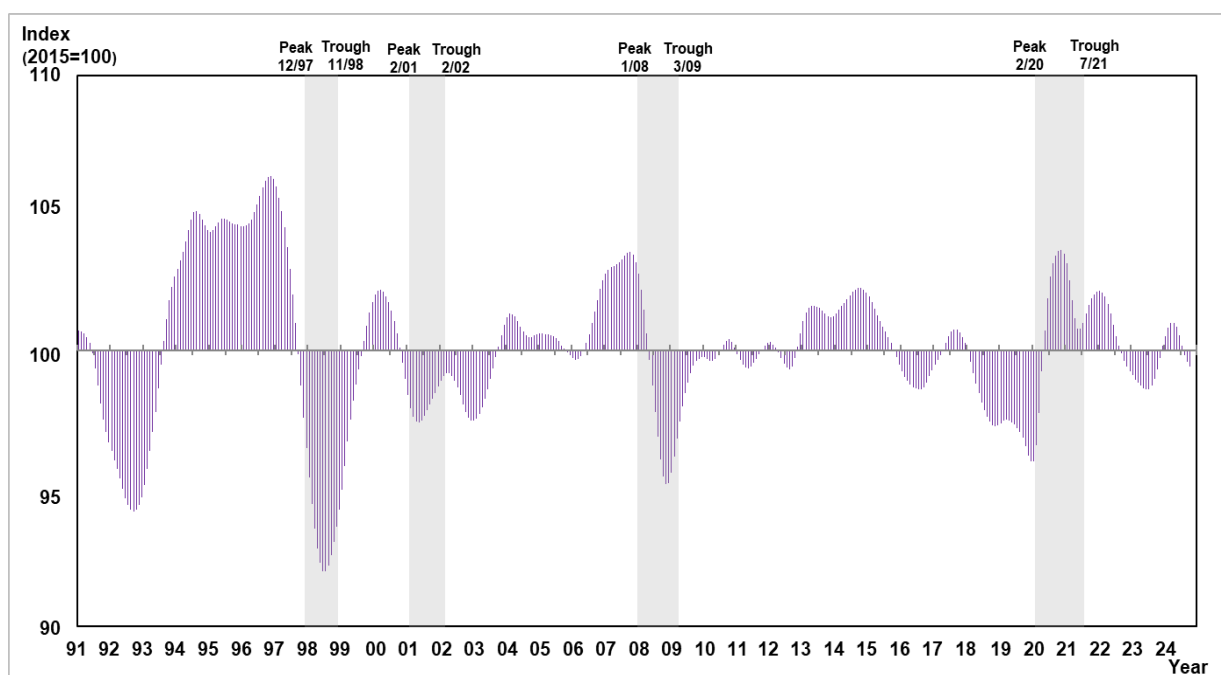


Exhibit III: Annual Changes of Leading Index Components
