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PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA JANUARI 2025

Jualan sektor Pembuatan mencecah RM158.1 bilion pada Januari 2025; tumbuh 3.5 peratus

PUTRAJAYA, 12 Mac 2025 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan pada Januari 2025 meningkat 3.5 peratus (Disember 2024: 5.7%), berjumlah RM158.1 bilion. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Januari 2025** pada hari ini.

Mengulas prestasi jualan Pembuatan terkini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Peningkatan nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan disokong terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau yang merekodkan pertumbuhan kukuh 10.6 peratus pada Januari 2025 (Disember 2024: 14.6%). Ini diikuti dengan subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik dan Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam, masing-masing pada 7.3 peratus (Disember 2024: 8.7%) dan 2.1 peratus (Disember 2024: 3.2%). Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan menguncup sedikit sebanyak 0.2 peratus kepada RM158.1 bilion berbanding RM158.4 bilion yang direkodkan pada Disember 2024."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili 70.2 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, berkembang 5.1 peratus pada Januari 2025 (Disember 2024: 7.1%). Pengembangan tersebut berkait rapat dengan peningkatan dalam Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan sebanyak 11.1 peratus (Disember 2024: 17.0%). Selain itu, Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal turut meningkat sebanyak 7.7 peratus (Disember 2024: 9.4%), sementara Pembuatan produk getah bertumbuh 8.9 peratus (Disember 2024: 10.7%).

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat sedikit sebanyak 0.1 peratus pada Januari 2025 setelah mencatatkan kenaikan 2.5 peratus pada Disember 2024.

Prestasi ini disebabkan oleh penyusutan tahun ke tahun dalam Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler dan semi treler (-17.6%). Walaubagaimana pun, ini diimbangi dengan Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan yang mengekalkan pertumbuhan dua angka pada 10.4 peratus (Disember 2024: 11.2%); Pembuatan produk logam kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (3.1%); dan Pembuatan minuman (9.1%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, kedua-dua industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik jatuh 0.2 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Seramai 2.39 juta orang terlibat dalam sektor ini pada Januari 2025, bertambah 0.9 peratus (Disember 2024: 1.0%). Pertambahan ini didorong terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (2.0%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (1.6%); dan Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (0.6%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini berkurang 0.2 peratus.

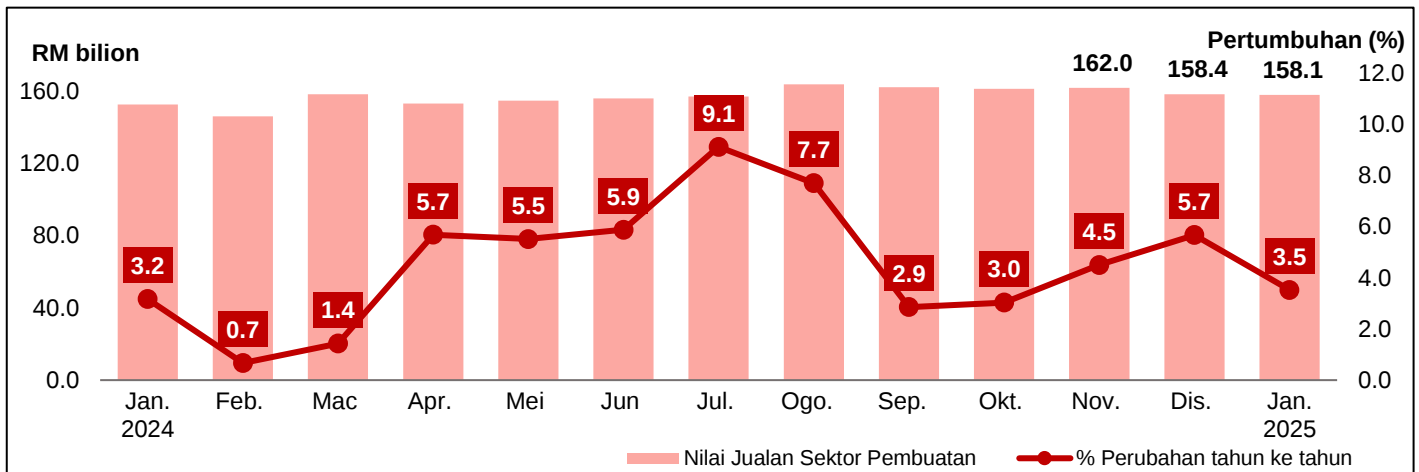
Pada masa yang sama, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga mencatatkan peningkatan 1.5 peratus (Disember 2024: 1.7%), berjumlah RM8.5 bilion pada Januari 2025. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, gaji & upah yang dibayar susut 4.6 peratus. Seterusnya, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja meningkat kepada RM66,011 (2.6%), manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja adalah RM3,540, meningkat 0.6 peratus tahun ke tahun.”

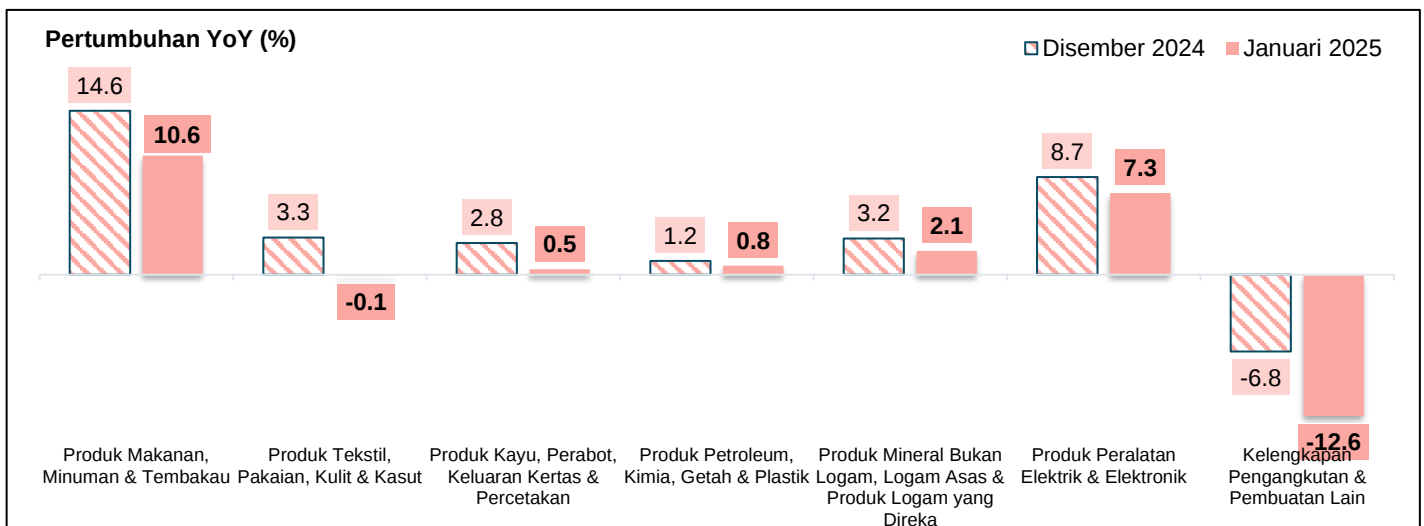

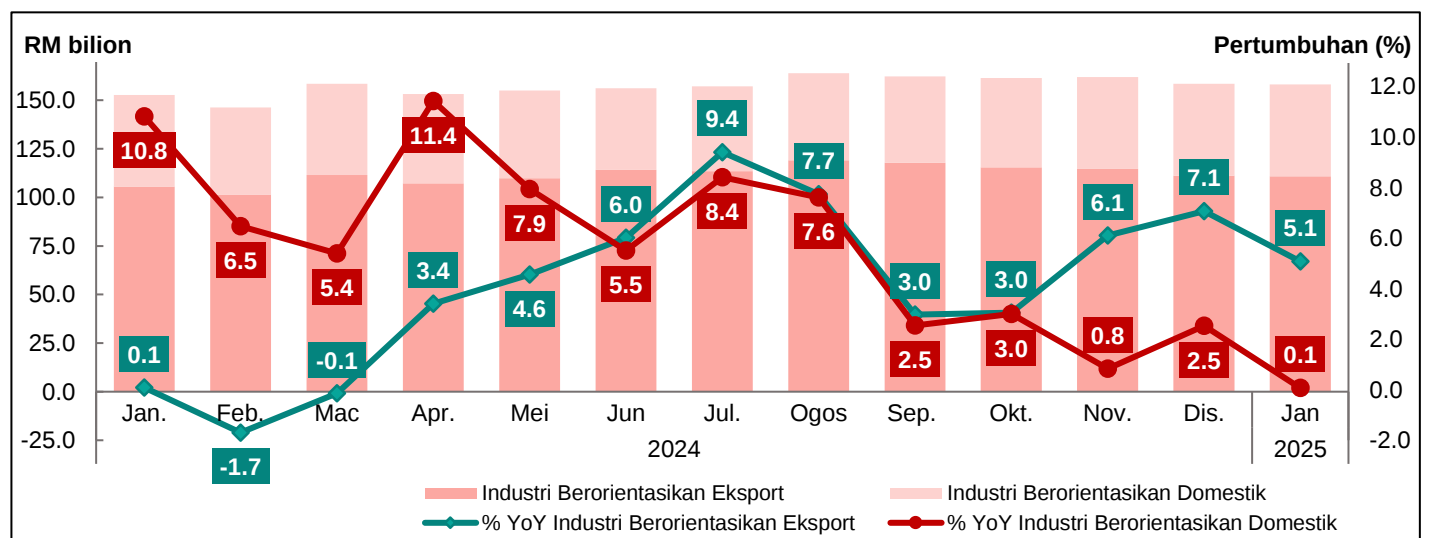
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
Januari 2024 - Januari 2025**



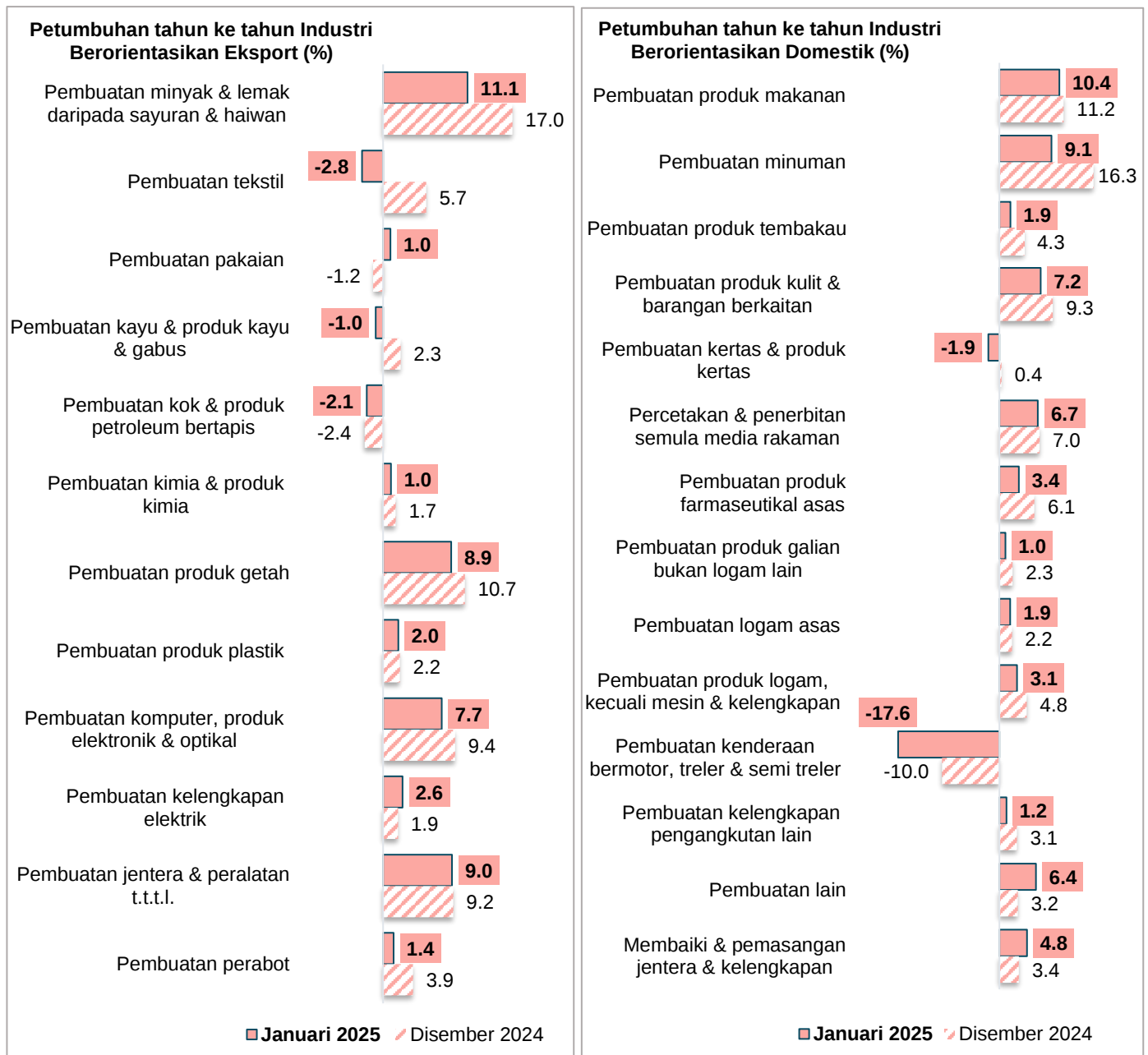
**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia,

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MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA JANUARY 2025

***The Manufacturing sector sales achieved RM158.1 billion in
January 2025; grew 3.5 per cent***

PUTRAJAYA, 12 March 2025 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector in January 2025 increased 3.5 per cent (December 2024: 5.7%), amounted to RM158.1 billion. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, January 2025**.

Commenting on the latest Manufacturing sales performance, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, "The increase of sales value in the Manufacturing sector was primarily supported by the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector which recorded a robust growth of 10.6 per cent in January 2025 (December 2024: 14.6%). This was followed by the Electrical & electronics products and Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products sub-sectors at 7.3 per cent (December 2024: 8.7%) and 2.1 per cent (December 2024: 3.2%), respectively. Comparison with the preceding month, the sales value decreased marginally by 0.2 per cent to RM158.1 billion as against RM158.4 billion recorded in December 2024."

The sales value of export-oriented industries which representing 70.2 per cent of total sales, expanded by 5.1 per cent in January 2025 (December 2024: 7.1%). The expansion was predominantly attributable to the increase in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats by 11.1 per cent (December 2024: 17.0%). Furthermore, Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products also rose by 7.7 per cent (December 2024: 9.4%), while Manufacture of rubber products grew by 8.9 per cent (December 2024: 10.7%).

Similarly, the domestic-oriented industries marginally grew by 0.1 per cent in January 2025 after registered 2.5 per cent increase in December 2024. The performance was due to the year-on-year decline in the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers (-17.6%). However, this was offset with the Manufacture of food processing products which remained the double-digit growth at 10.4 per cent (December 2024: 11.2%); Manufacture of fabricated metal products industry except machinery & equipment (3.1%); and the Manufacture of beverages (9.1%). On a month-on-month basis, both export and domestic-oriented industries dropped by 0.2 per cent.

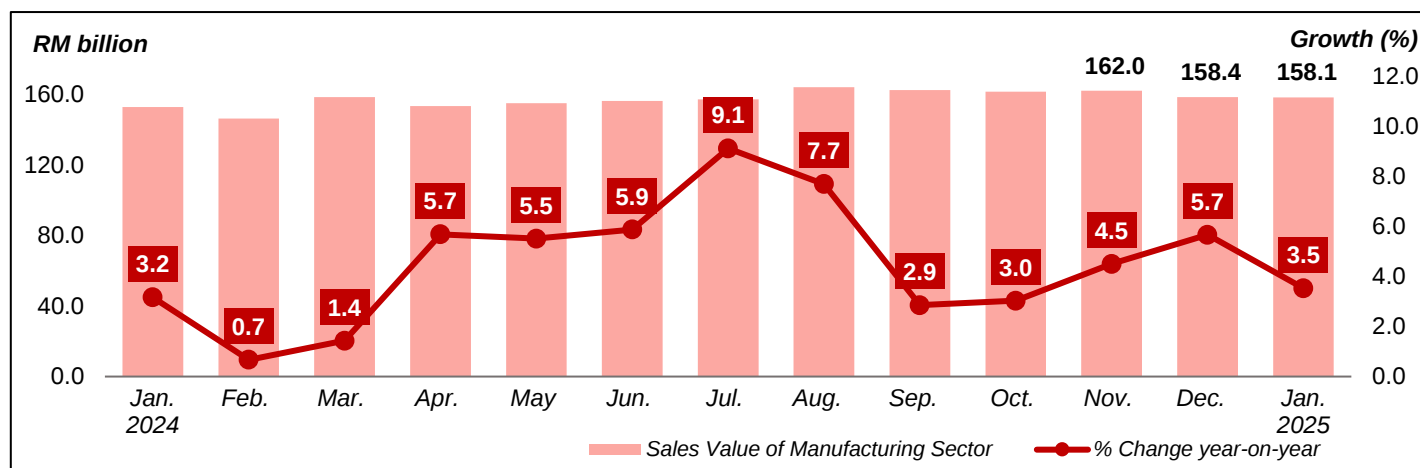
Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia stated, “There are 2.39 million persons engaged in this sector during January 2025, augmented by 0.9 per cent (December 2024: 1.0%). The augmentation was mainly driven by the Food, beverages & tobacco (2.0%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (1.6%); and Electrical & electronics products (0.6%) sub-sectors. On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in this sector decreased 0.2 per cent.

On the same note, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector also posted an increase of 1.5 per cent (December 2024: 1.7%), amounted to RM8.5 billion in January 2025. Comparison by month-on-month, the salaries & wages paid dropped by 4.6 per cent. Subsequently, the sales value per employee went up to RM66,011 (2.6%), while the average salaries & wages per employee was RM3,540, rose by 0.6 per cent year-on-year.”

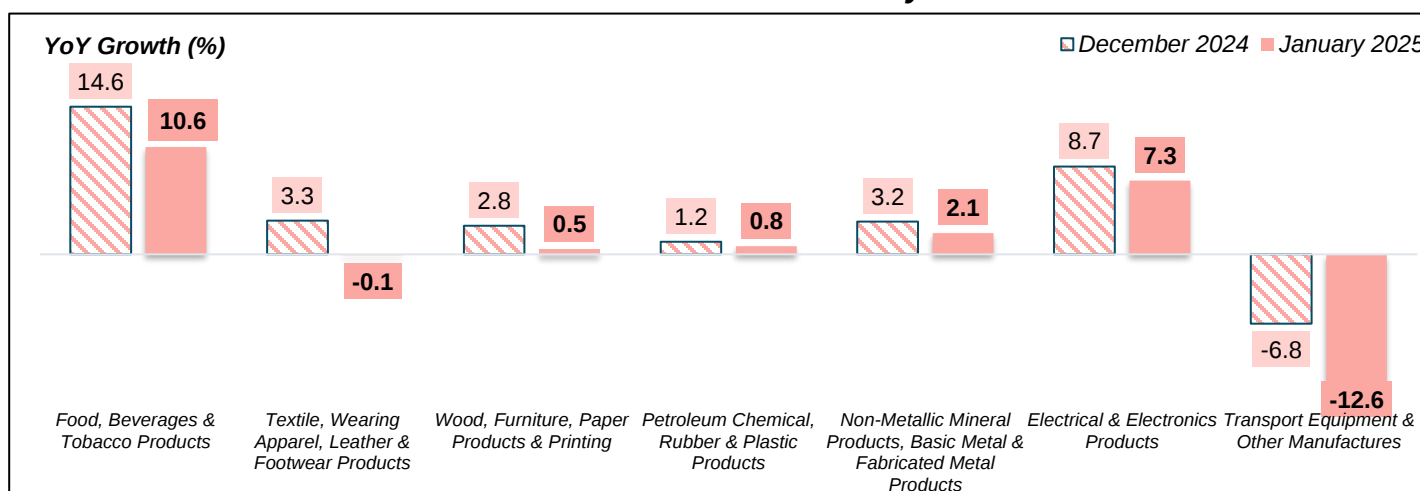

Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, January 2024 – January 2025**

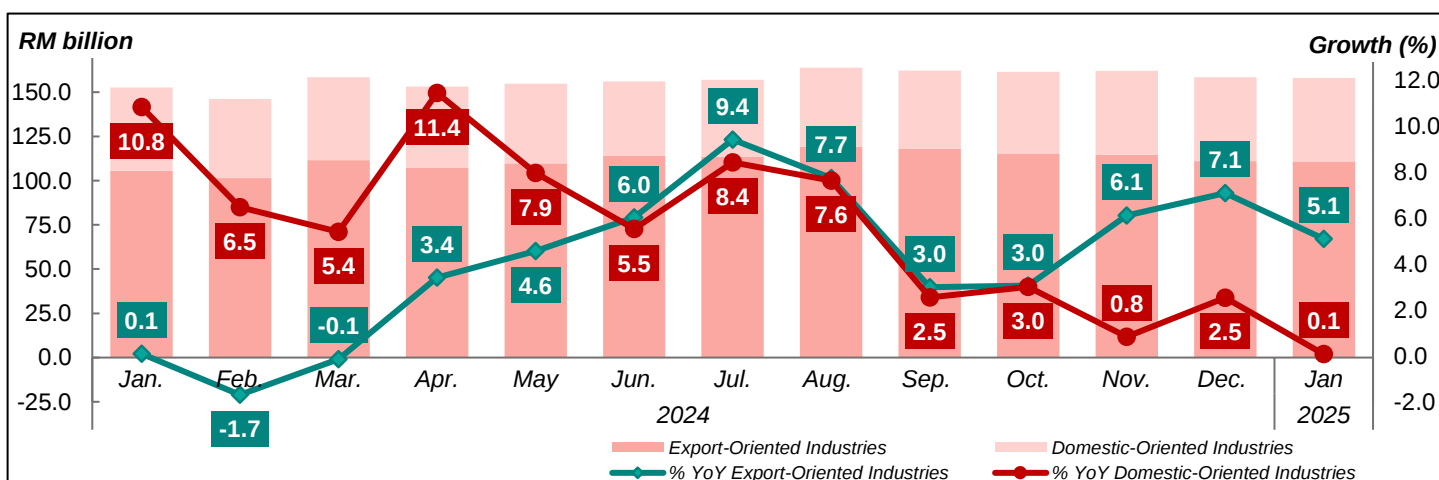
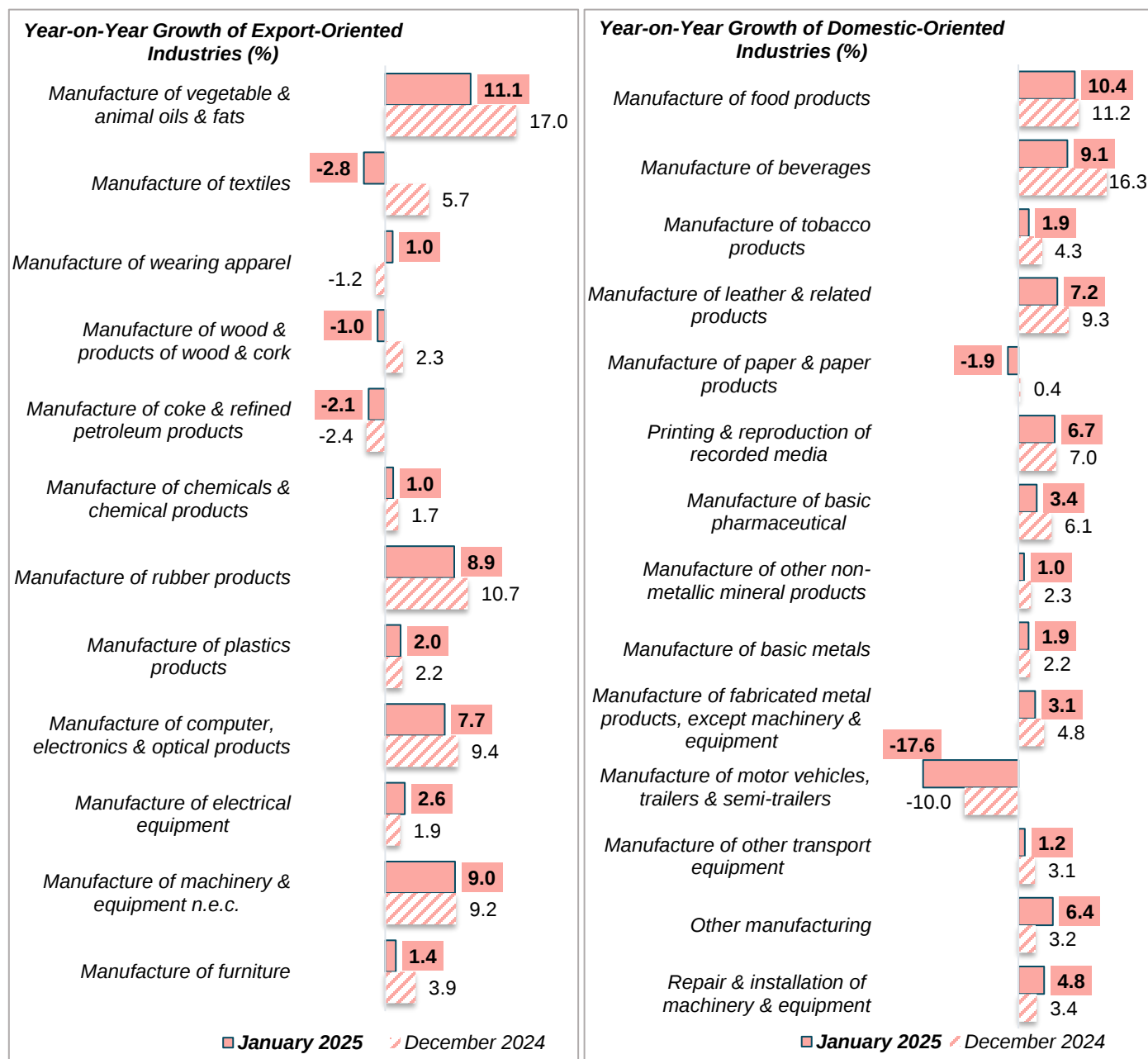


Chart 4: Sales Value of Manufacturing Export and Domestic-Oriented Groups, December 2024 and January 2025
