### **BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI FEBRUARI 2025**

#### **JUMLAH EKSPORT BAGI LAPAN NEGERI MEREKODKAN PENINGKATAN POSITIF BERNILAI RM71.6 BILION PADA BULAN FEBRUARI 2025**

**PUTRAJAYA, 28 MAC 2025** – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernalilai RM223.9 bilion pada Februari 2025 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernalilai RM118.3 bilion dan RM105.6 bilion, seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI FEBRUARI 2025**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport bernalilai RM118.3 bilion pada Februari 2025, meningkat sebanyak RM6.9 bilion (+6.2%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (+RM9.3 bilion), Selangor (+RM1.3 bilion), Melaka (+RM656.2 juta), Sabah (+RM623.1 juta), Perak (+RM411.1 juta), Kelantan (+RM165.5 juta), Perlis (+RM29.3 juta) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM21.5 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di Sarawak sebanyak RM3.0 bilion, Kedah (-RM900.3 juta), Pahang (-RM777.5 juta), Terengganu (-RM491.0 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM323.7 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM152.2 juta) dan Johor (-RM3.9 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 34.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (19.8%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (7.4%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.8%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Februari 2025 meningkat RM5.5 bilion (+5.5%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun 2024. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (+RM3.2 bilion), Selangor (+RM2.1 bilion), Melaka (+RM1.3 billion), Perak (+RM764.1 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM674.8 juta), Johor (+RM324.6 juta) dan Kelantan (+RM81.9 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Negeri Sembilan sebanyak RM1.2 bilion, Kedah (-RM714.4 juta), Sarawak (-RM389.7 juta), Pahang (RM360.1 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM272.7 juta), Sabah (-RM121.6 juta), Terengganu (-RM52.9 juta) dan Perlis (-RM8.7 juta).


Selangor mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 25.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (23.5%), Pulau Pinang (22.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (8.1%) dan Kedah (4.6%).



## PRESS STATEMENT

### **FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE FEBRUARY 2025**

#### **TOTAL EXPORTS FOR EIGHT STATES RECORDED A POSITIVE INCREASE WITH A VALUE OF RM71.6 BILLION IN FEBRUARY 2025**

**PUTRAJAYA, 28 MARCH 2025 –** Malaysia's total trade for February 2025 amounted to RM223.9 billion with exports and imports recorded RM118.3 billion and RM105.6 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE FEBRUARY 2025**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM118.3 billion in February 2025, increased RM6.9 billion (+6.2%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM9.3 billion), Selangor (+RM1.3 billion), Melaka (+RM656.2 million), Sabah (+RM623.1 million), Perak (+RM411.1 million), Kelantan (+RM165.5 million), Perlis (+RM29.3 million) and W.P. Labuan (+RM21.5 million). However, exports decreased in Sarawak by RM3.0 billion, Kedah (-RM900.3 million), Pahang (-RM777.5 million), Terengganu (-RM491.0 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM323.7 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM152.2 million) and Johor (-RM3.9 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 34.2 per cent share, followed by Johor (19.8%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (7.4%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.8%).

*Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in February 2025 increased RM5.5 billion (+5.5%) as compared to the same month in year 2024. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM3.2 billion), Selangor (+RM2.1 billion), Melaka (+RM1.3 billion), Perak (+RM764.1 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM674.8 million), Johor (+RM324.6 million) and Kelantan (+RM81.9 million). However, imports decreased in Negeri Sembilan by RM1.2 billion, Kedah (-RM714.4 million), Sarawak (-RM389.7 million), Pahang (RM360.1 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM272.7 million), Sabah (-RM121.6 million), Terengganu (-RM52.9 million) and Perlis (-RM8.7 million).*




