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### PERANGKAAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA MAC 2025

**Jualan sektor Pembuatan mencecah RM164.3 bilion pada Mac 2025;  
meningkat 3.7 peratus**

**PUTRAJAYA, 8 Mei 2025** - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat 3.7 peratus (Februari 2025: 4.7%), berjumlah RM164.3 bilion pada Mac 2025. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Mac 2025** pada hari ini.

Mengulas prestasi jualan Pembuatan terkini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Peningkatan nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan dipacu terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau yang merekodkan pertumbuhan kukuh 11.8 peratus pada Mac 2025 (Februari 2025: 14.5%). Ini diikuti dengan subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik dan Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam, masing-masing pada 7.4 peratus (Februari 2025: 7.8%) dan 4.0 peratus (Februari 2025: 4.4%). Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan turut meningkat sebanyak 7.3 peratus kepada RM164.3 bilion berbanding RM153.1 bilion yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili 70.9 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, berkembang 4.6 peratus pada Mac 2025 (Februari 2025: 5.8%). Pengembangan disebabkan terutamanya oleh peningkatan dalam Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan sebanyak 14.7 peratus (Februari 2025: 18.1%). Selain itu, Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal terus meningkat sebanyak 8.0 peratus (Februari 2025: 7.8%), sementara Pembuatan produk getah bertumbuh 7.5 peratus (Februari 2025: 8.4%).

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik tumbuh sebanyak 1.8 peratus pada Mac 2025, setelah mencatatkan pertumbuhan 2.3 peratus pada Februari 2025.

Prestasi ini disebabkan oleh peningkatan tahun ke tahun dalam Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan yang kekal menunjukkan peningkatan dengan 9.4 peratus pada Mac 2025 (Februari 2025: 11.3%); diikuti dengan Pembuatan produk logam kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (3.2%); dan Pembuatan logam asas (5.7%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, kedua-dua industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing melonjak semula kepada peningkatan 8.6 peratus dan 4.2 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Seramai 2.39 juta orang terlibat dalam sektor ini pada Mac 2025, bertambah 1.1 peratus (Februari 2025: 1.2%). Pertambahan ini didorong terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (2.1%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (1.6%); dan Peralatan elektrik & elektronik yang kekal tumbuh 1.2 peratus. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini berkurang 0.2 peratus.

Pada masa yang sama, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga mencatatkan peningkatan 1.8 peratus (Februari 2025: 2.0%), berjumlah RM8.4 bilion pada Mac 2025. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, gaji & upah yang dibayar susut 0.4 peratus. Seterusnya, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja meningkat kepada RM68,805 (2.6%), manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja adalah RM3,508, meningkat 0.7 peratus tahun ke tahun.”

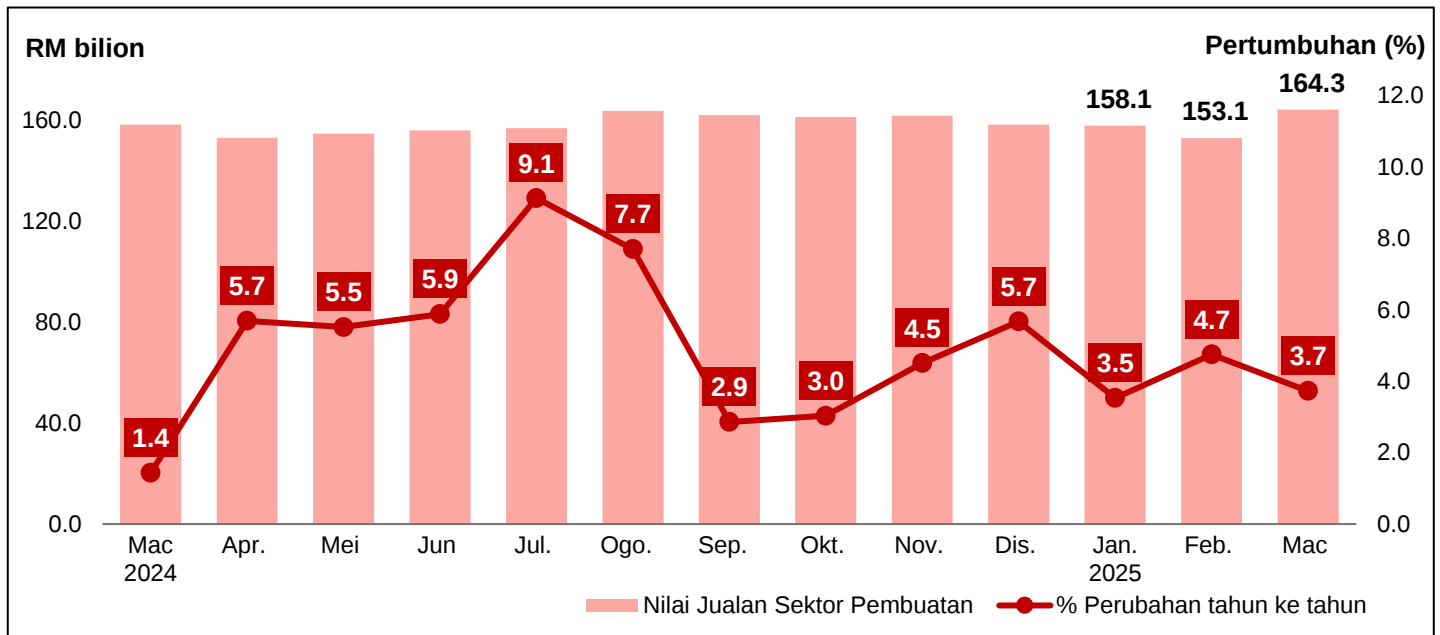
Bagi prestasi sektor Pembuatan pada suku tahun pertama 2025, nilai jualan mencatatkan RM475.6 bilion, meningkat sebanyak 4.0 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun 2024 (ST4 2024: 4.4%). Bilangan pekerja menokok sebanyak 1.1 peratus kepada 2.39 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah meningkat 1.8 peratus kepada RM25.3 bilion dengan nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja berjumlah RM199,108, tumbuh 2.9 peratus.

Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

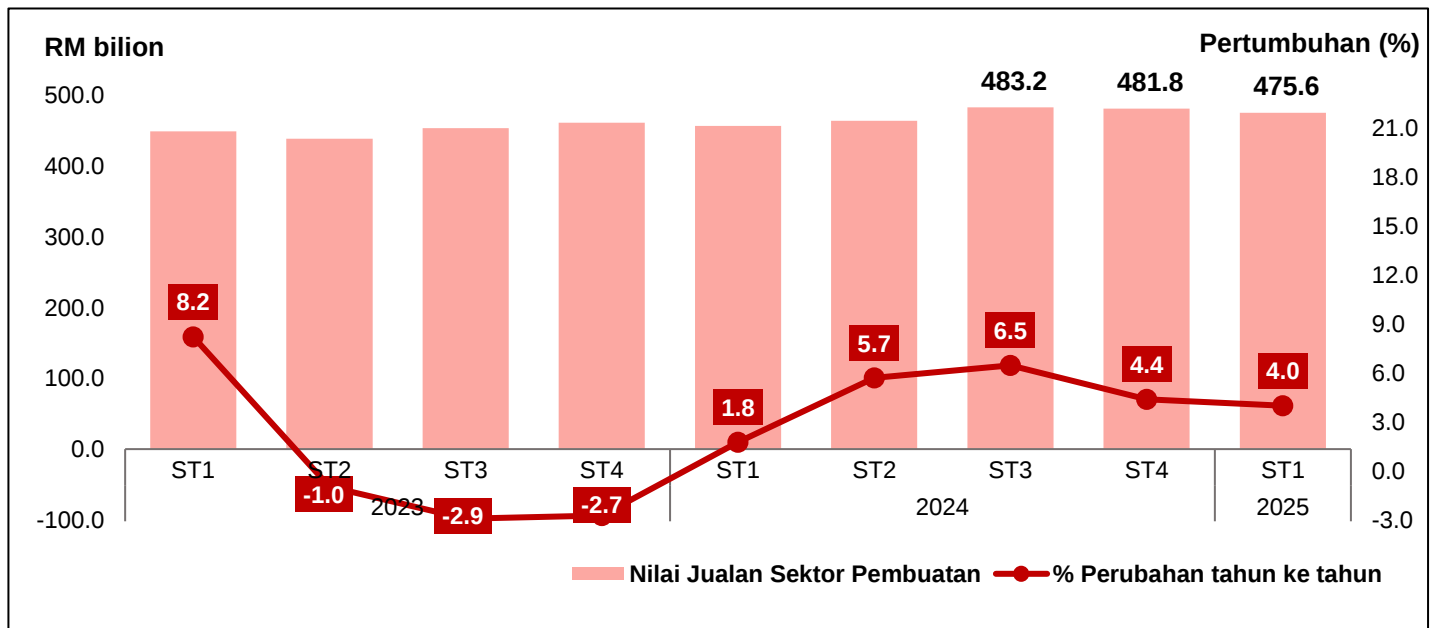

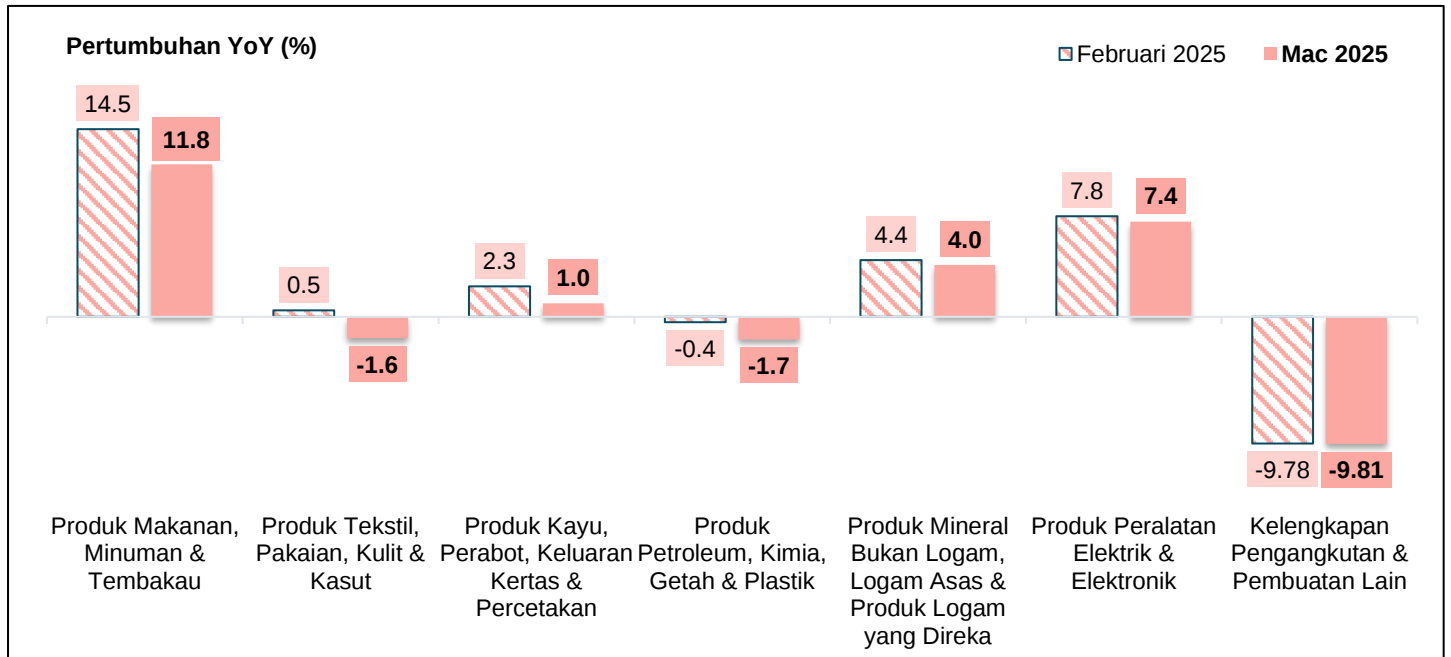
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia  
Mac 2024 - Mac 2025**



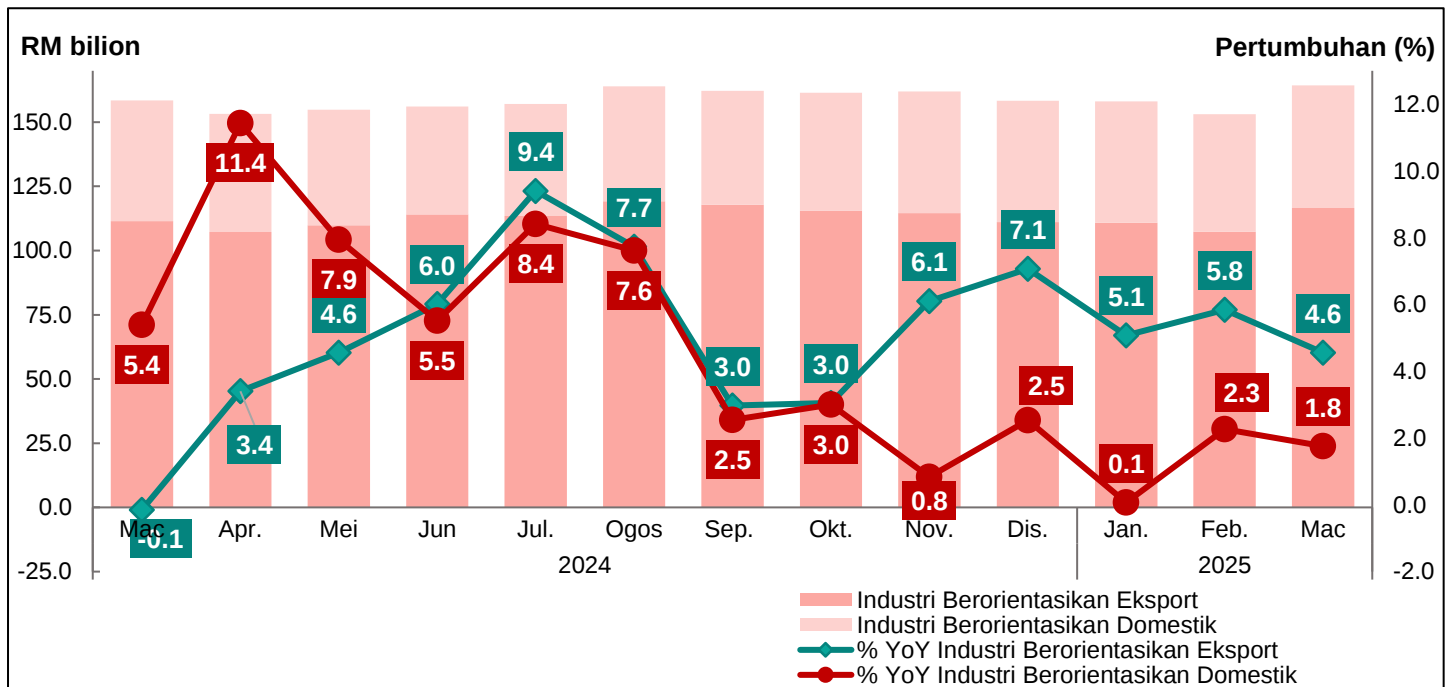
**Carta 2: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia  
ST1 2023 – ST1 2025**



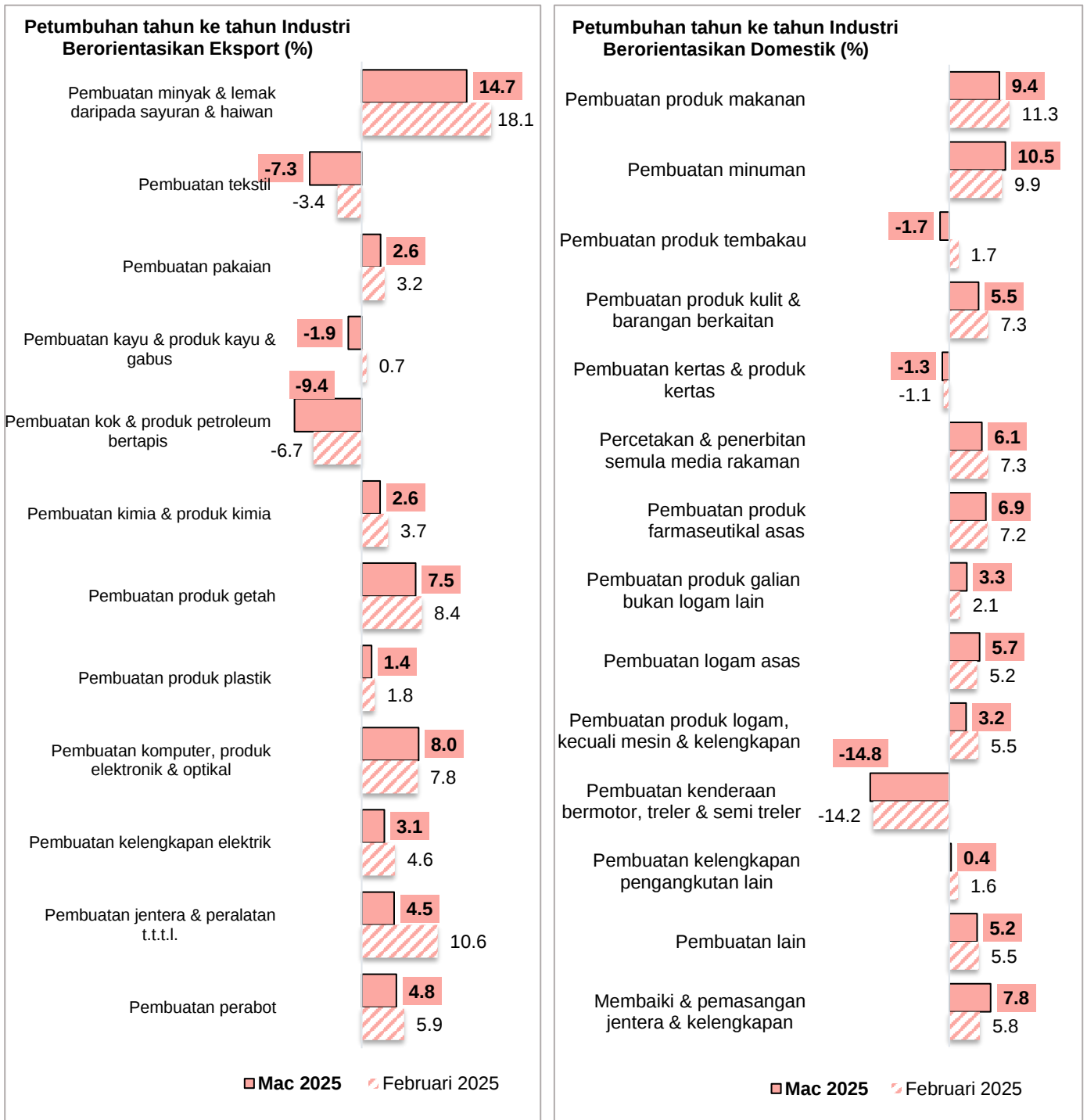
**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia, Februari dan Mac 2025**

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### MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA MARCH 2025

***The Manufacturing sector sales reached RM164.3 billion in March 2025;  
rose 3.7 per cent***

***PUTRAJAYA, 8 May 2025*** – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose 3.7 per cent (February 2025: 4.7%), amounted to RM164.3 billion in March 2025. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, March 2025**.

Commenting on the latest Manufacturing sales performance, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “The growth in sales value within the Manufacturing sector was mainly driven by the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector which recorded a strong growth of 11.8 per cent in March 2025 (February 2025: 14.5%). This was followed by the Electrical & electronics products and Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products sub-sectors at 7.4 per cent (February 2025: 7.8%) and 4.0 per cent (February 2025: 4.4%), respectively. Comparison with the preceding month, the sales value also increased by 7.3 per cent to RM164.3 billion as against RM153.1 billion recorded in the preceding month.”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which representing 70.9 per cent of total sales, expanded by 4.6 per cent in March 2025 (February 2025: 5.8%). The expansion was primarily due to the increase in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats by 14.7 per cent (February 2025: 18.1%). Furthermore, Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products also rose by 8.0 per cent (February 2025: 7.8%), while Manufacture of rubber products grew by 7.5 per cent (February 2025: 8.4%).

Similarly, the domestic-oriented industries grew by 1.8 per cent in March 2025, after registered an increase of 2.3 per cent in February 2025. The performance was due to the

year-on-year increase in the Manufacture of food processing products which continued to show an increase with 9.4 per cent in March 2025 (February 2025: 11.3%); followed by the Manufacture of fabricated metal products industry except machinery & equipment (3.2%); and the Manufacture of basic metals (5.7%). On a month-on-month basis, both export and domestic-oriented industries rebounded to the increase of 8.6 per cent and 4.2 per cent, respectively.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia stated, “There are 2.39 million persons engaged in this sector during March 2025, augmented by 1.1 per cent (February 2025: 1.2%). The augmentation was mainly driven by the Food, beverages & tobacco (2.1%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (1.6%); and Electrical & electronics products which remained to grow at 1.2 per cent. On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in this sector decreased 0.2 per cent.

On the same note, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector also posted an increase of 1.8 per cent (February 2025: 2.0%), amounted to RM8.4 billion in March 2025. Comparison by month-on-month, the salaries & wages paid dropped by 0.4 per cent. Subsequently, the sales value per employee went up to RM68,805 (2.6%), while the average salaries & wages per employee was RM3,508, rose by 0.7 per cent year-on-year.”

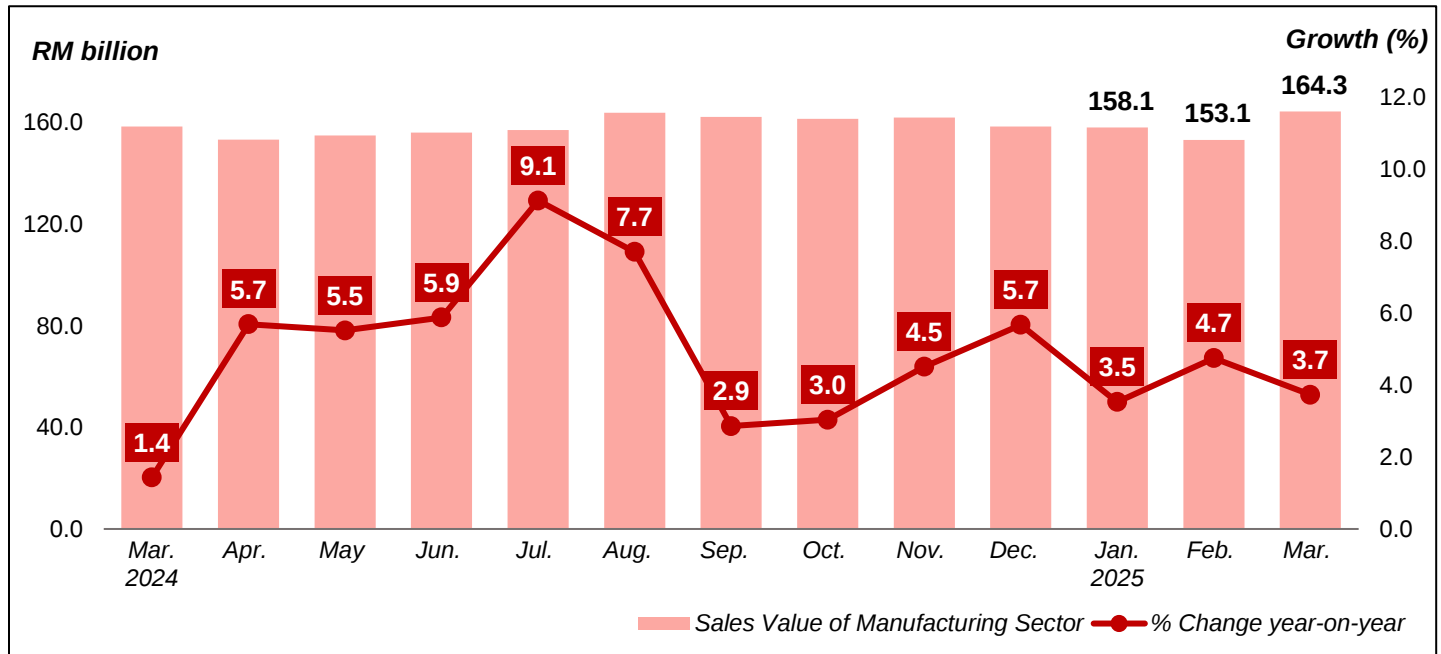
For the performance of the Manufacturing sector in the first quarter of 2025, the sales value was registered at RM475.6 billion, increased by 4.0 per cent as compared to the same period of 2024 (Q4 2024: 4.4%). The number of employee uptick by 1.1 per cent to 2.39 million persons, while salaries & wages increased by 1.8 per cent to RM25.3 billion with the sales value per employee stood at RM199,108, grew 2.9 per cent.

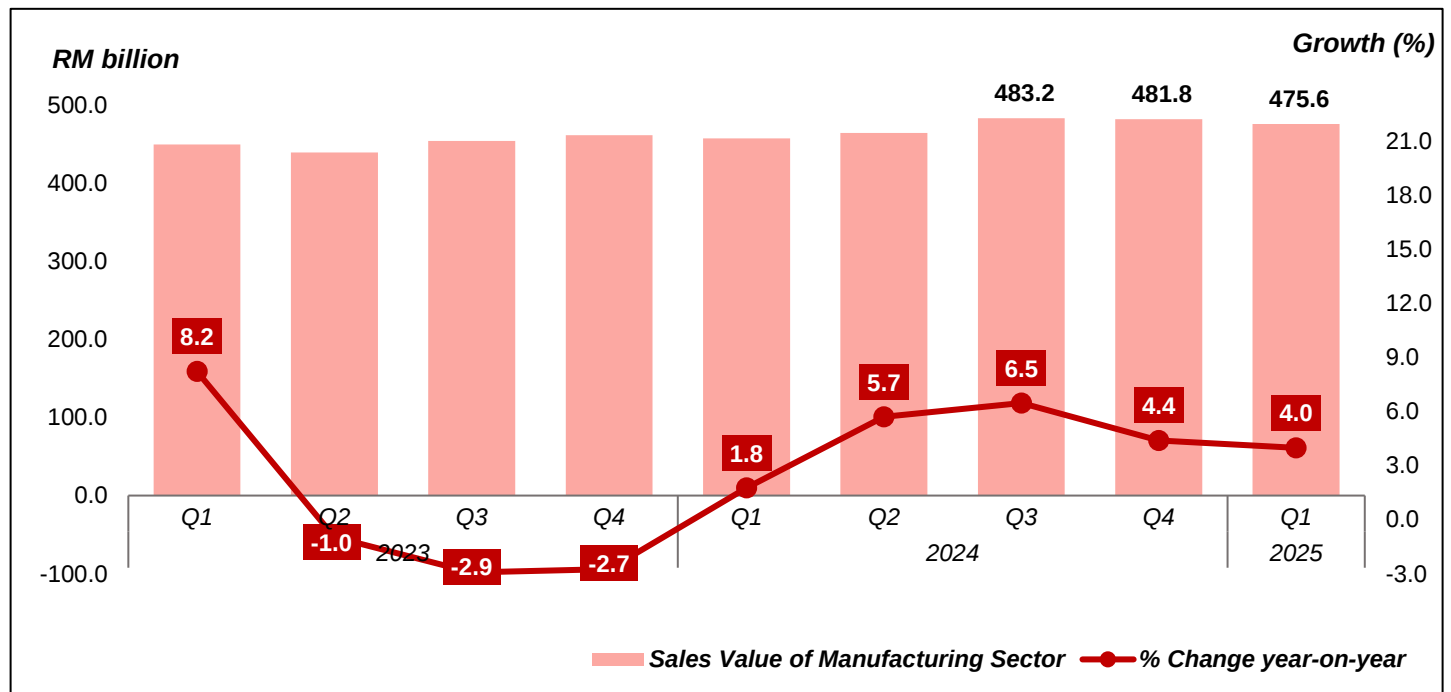

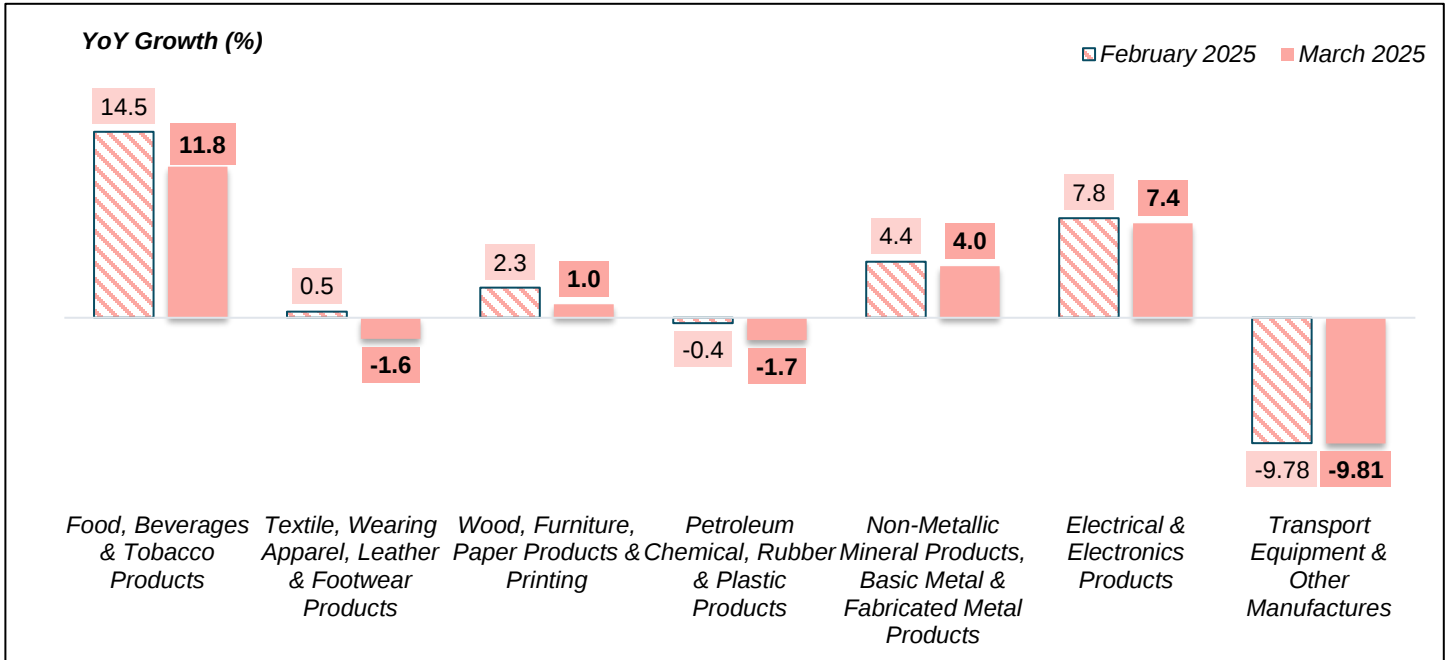
**Chart 1: Sales Value of the Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia  
March 2024 – March 2025**



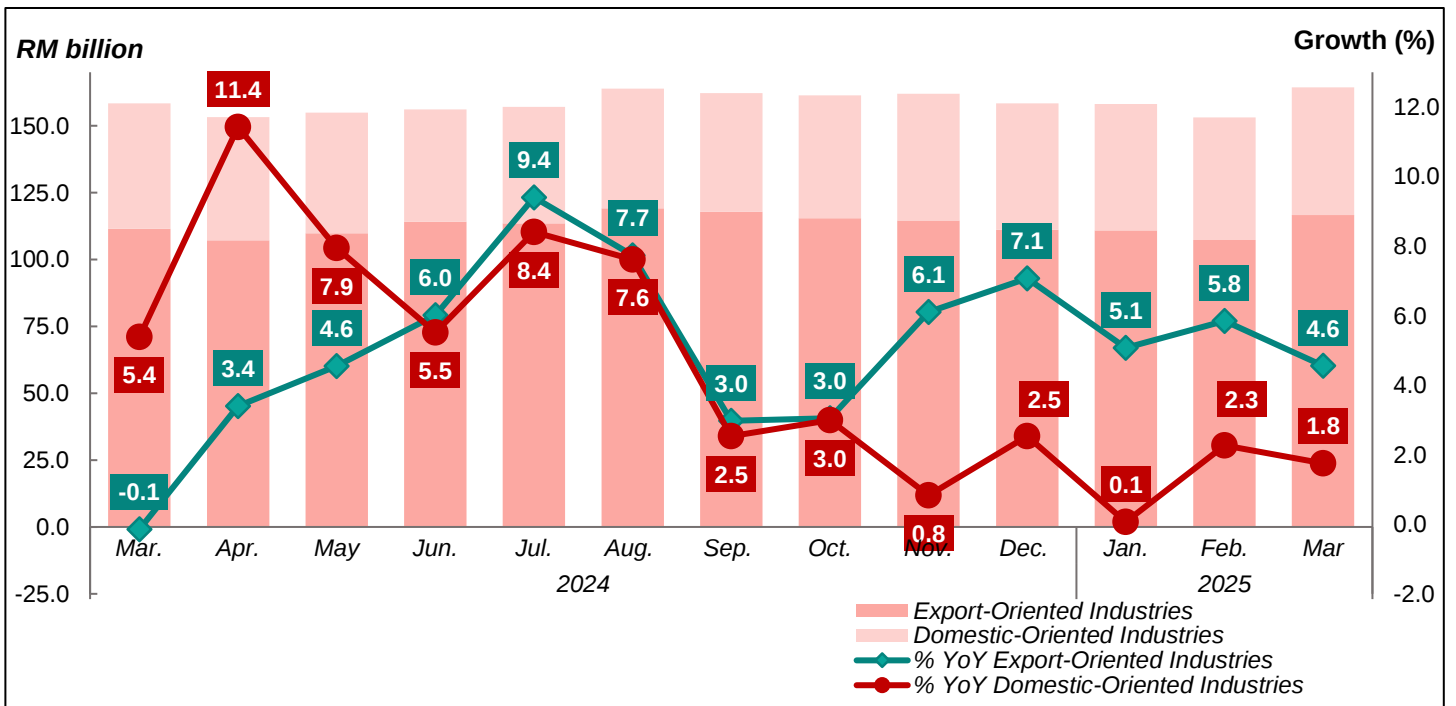
**Chart 2: Sales Value of the Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia
