PERANGKAAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA MEI 2025

Jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat 2.4 peratus, berjumlah RM158.7 bilion pada Mei 2025

PUTRAJAYA, 11 Julai 2025 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat 2.4 peratus (April 2025: 4.7%), berjumlah RM158.7 bilion pada Mei 2025. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Mei 2025** pada hari ini.

Mengulas prestasi jualan Pembuatan terkini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Peningkatan nilai jualan dalam sektor Pembuatan disumbangkan terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau, kekal pengembangan yang kukuh dengan peningkatan 13.0 peratus pada Mei 2025 (April 2025: 10.8%). Pertumbuhan ini juga disokong oleh subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik dan Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam, yang masing-masing meningkat sebanyak 5.0 peratus (April 2025: 9.6%) dan 3.7 peratus (April 2025: 4.6%). Walaubagaimana pun, nilai jualan menurun sebanyak 1.1 peratus kepada RM158.7 bilion berbanding RM160.4 bilion yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya."

Pertumbuhan nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili 71.1 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, tumbuh 2.7 peratus pada Mei 2025 (April 2025: 5.1%). Pengembangan ini disebabkan terutamanya oleh peningkatan dalam Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan sebanyak 15.9 peratus (April 2025: 12.2%). Sementara itu, Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal terus meningkat sebanyak 4.9 peratus (April 2025: 10.2%), dan Pembuatan jentera dan peralatan t.t.t.l. meningkat sebanyak 7.7 peratus (April 2025: 9.5%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport melonjak kepada 0.1 peratus (April 2025: -3.3%).

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik berkembang sebanyak 1.9 peratus pada Mei 2025, selepas peningkatan 3.6 peratus pada April 2025. Prestasi ini disokong oleh pertumbuhan kukuh dalam Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan pada 10.5 peratus pada Mei 2025 (April 2025: 10.0%); serta dalam industri Pembuatan logam asas (4.3%); dan Pembuatan produk logam kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (3.5%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan domestik susut 3.9 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Sejumlah 2.40 juta orang pekerja direkodkan dalam sektor ini pada Mei 2025, bertambah sebanyak 0.9 peratus (April 2025: 1.2%). Pertambahan ini dipacu terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (1.8%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (1.4%); dan Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (1.1%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini menurun sedikit sebanyak 0.1 peratus.

Pada masa yang sama, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga mencatatkan peningkatan 1.6 peratus (April 2025: 2.4%), berjumlah RM8.3 bilion pada Mei 2025. Selain itu, gaji & upah yang dibayar bertambah baik sebanyak 0.2 peratus berbanding RM8.3 bilion yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Selanjutnya, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja mencatatkan RM66,163 (1.6%), manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja adalah RM3,470, meningkat 0.7 peratus tahun ke tahun.”

Dalam tempoh lima bulan pertama tahun ini (Januari – Mei 2025), nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan berjumlah RM794.7 bilion, meningkat 3.8 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama 2024 (Januari – Mei 2024: 3.3%). Bilangan pekerja meningkat sebanyak 0.9 peratus kepada 2.40 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah meningkat 1.9 peratus kepada RM41.9 bilion dengan nilai jualan setiap pekerja berjumlah RM331,327, meningkat 2.9 peratus.

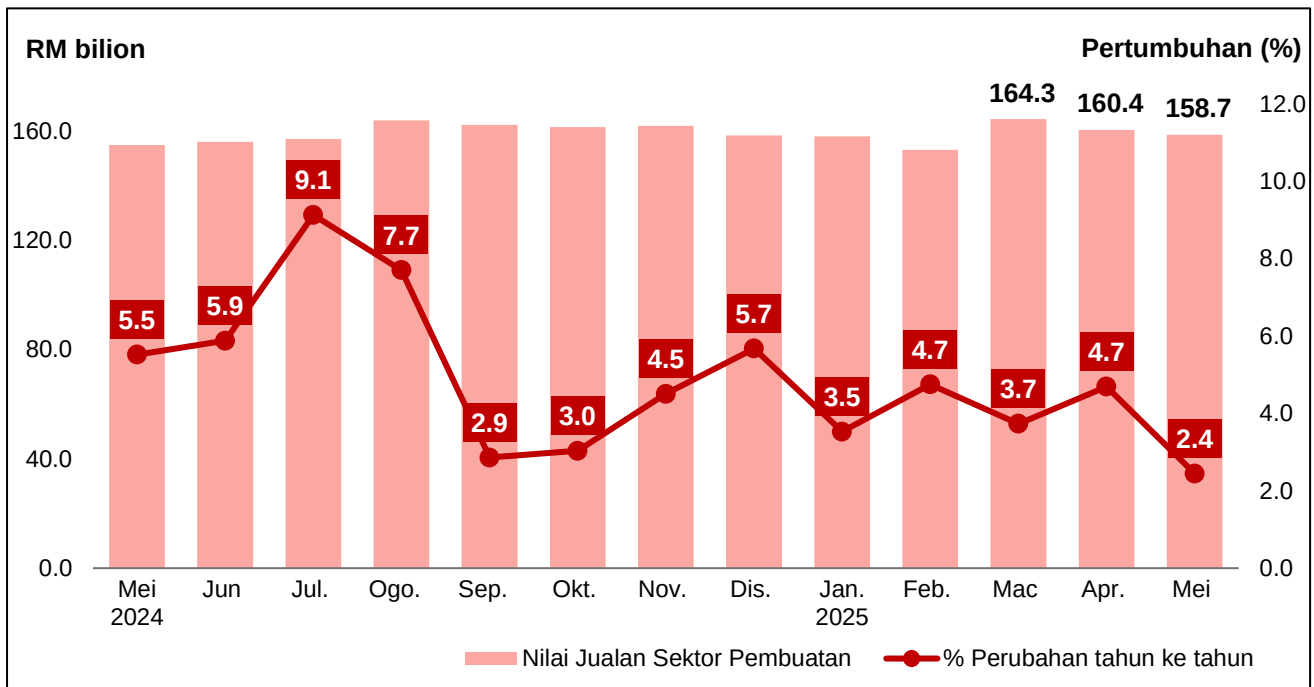
Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah berjaya menduduki kedudukan teratas di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan *Open Data Inventory* (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 198 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

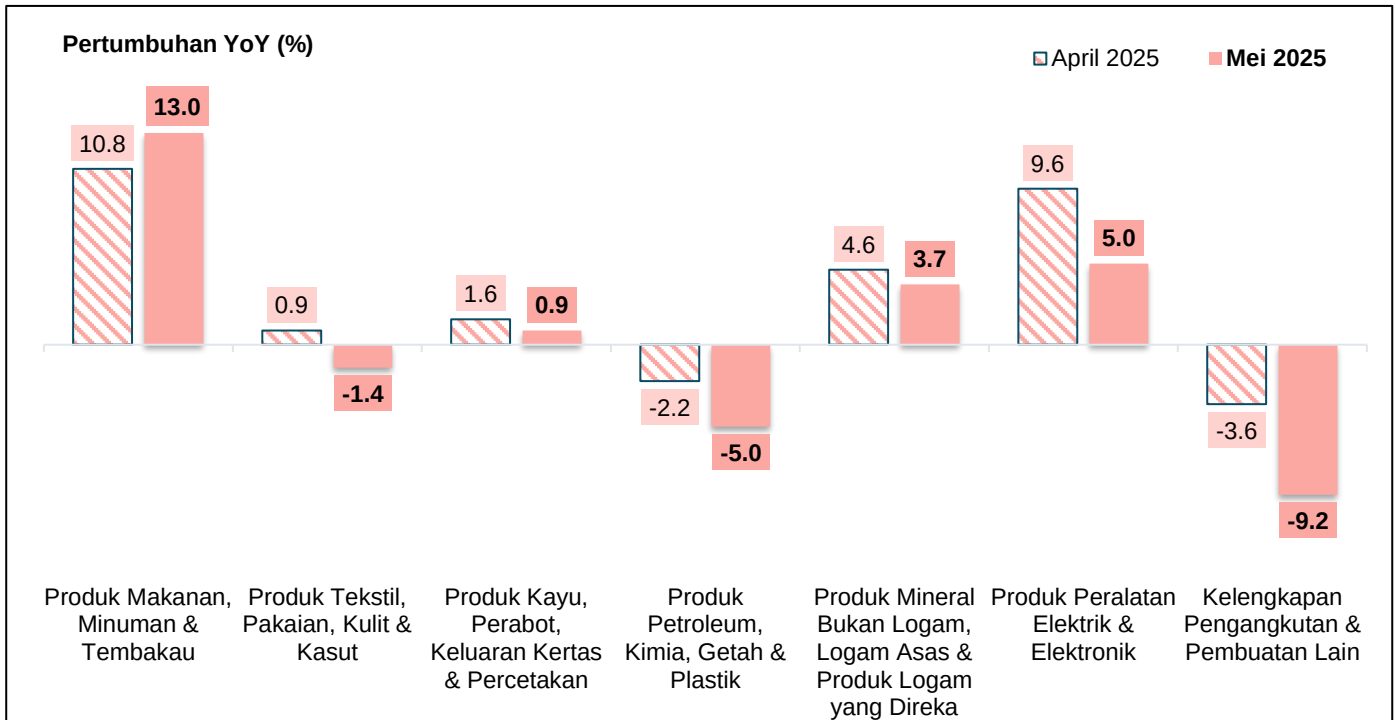

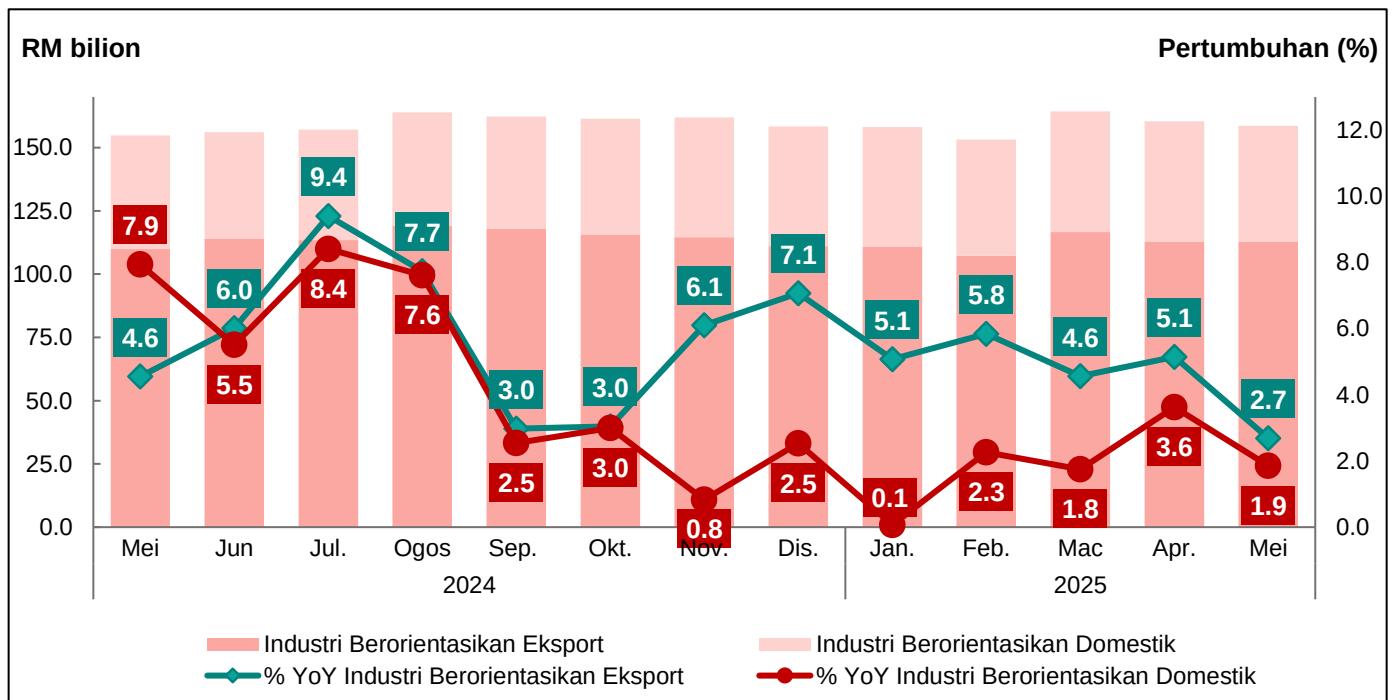
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
Mei 2024 - Mei 2025**



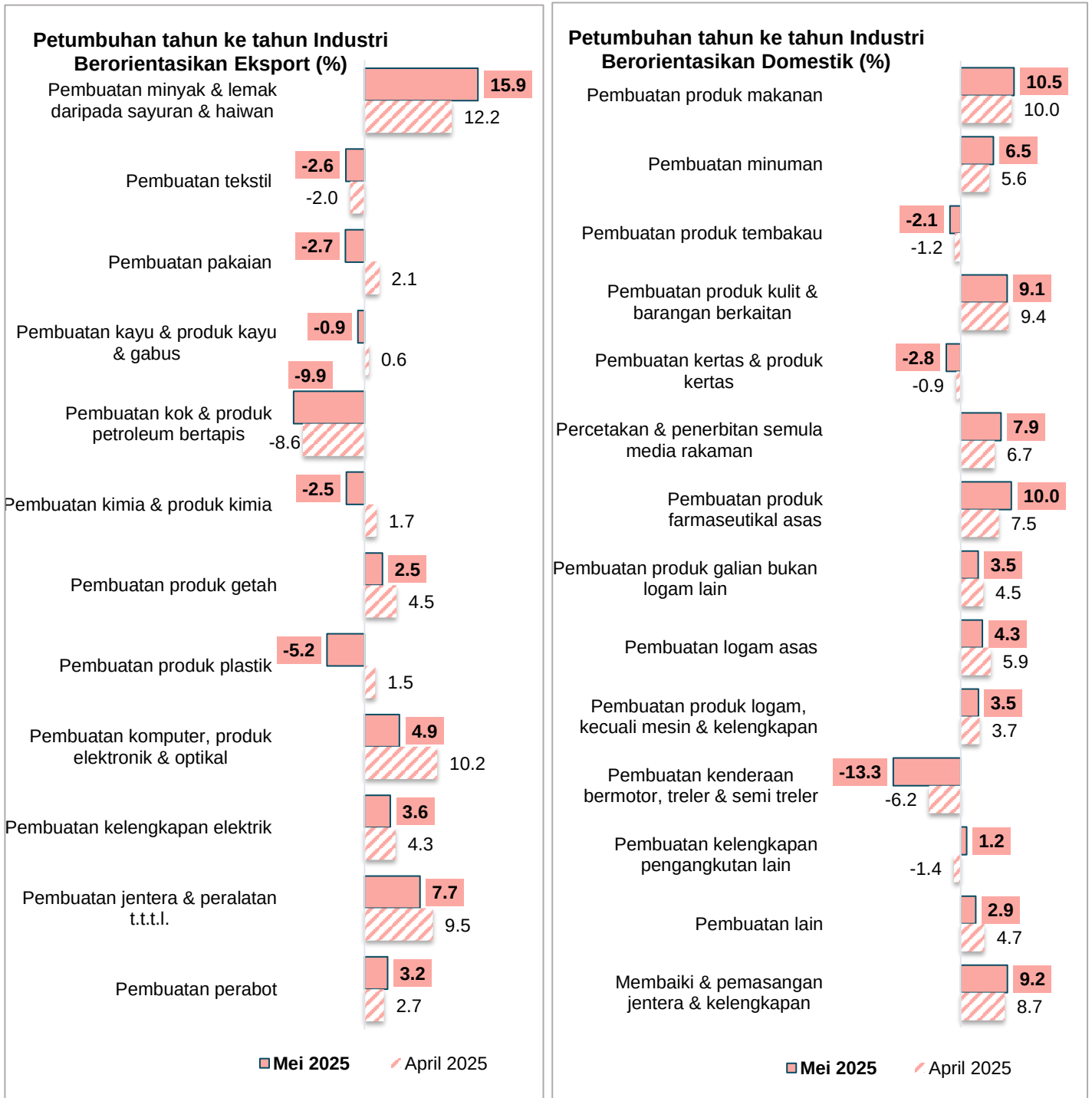
Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia, April dan Mei 2025

MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA MAY 2025

***The Manufacturing sector sales rose 2.4 per cent, amounted to
RM158.7 billion in May 2025***

PUTRAJAYA, 11 July 2025 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose 2.4 per cent (April 2025: 4.7%), totalled at RM158.7 billion in May 2025. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, May 2025**.

Commenting on the latest Manufacturing sales performance, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “The growth in sales value within the Manufacturing sector was mainly contributed by the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector, sustained the strong expansion with a 13.0 per cent increase in May 2025 (April 2025: 10.8%). This growth was also supported by the Electrical & electronics products and the Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products sub-sectors, which rose by 5.0 per cent (April 2025: 9.6%) and 3.7 per cent (April 2025: 4.6%), respectively. However, the sales value dropped by 1.1 per cent to RM158.7 billion as against RM160.4 billion recorded in the prior month.”

Sales value growth in the export-oriented industries which accounting for 71.1 per cent of total sales, grew by 2.7 per cent in May 2025 (April 2025: 5.1%). The performance was primarily due to the increase in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats by 15.9 per cent (April 2025: 12.2%). Meanwhile, the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products expanded by 4.9 per cent (April 2025: 10.2%), and the Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. advanced by 7.7 per cent (April 2025: 9.5%). On a month-on-month comparison, export-oriented industries rebounded to 0.1 per cent (April 2025: -3.3%).

Likewise, the domestic-oriented industries expanded by 1.9 per cent in May 2025, following 3.6 per cent rise in April 2025. The performance was supported by robust growth in the Manufacture of food processing products at 10.5 per cent in May 2025 (April 2025: 10.0%), as well as in the Manufacture of basic metals (4.3%) and Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (3.5%). On a month-on-month comparison, domestic-oriented industries declined 3.9 per cent.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia stated, “A total of 2.40 million employees were recorded in this sector during May 2025, augmented by 0.9 per cent (April 2025: 1.2%). The augmentation was mainly driven by the Food, beverages & tobacco (1.8%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (1.4%); and Electrical & electronics products (1.1%). On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in this sector marginally decreased by 0.1 per cent.

On the same note, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector also posted an increase of 1.6 per cent (April 2025: 2.4%), amounted to RM8.3 billion in May 2025. Furthermore, the salaries & wages paid improved by 0.2 per cent compared to RM8.3 billion recorded in the preceding month. Subsequently, the sales value per employee registered at RM66,163 (1.6%), while the average salaries & wages per employee was RM3,470, rose by 0.7 per cent year-on-year.”

Within the first five months this year (January – May 2025), the sales value of the Manufacturing sector was amounted to RM794.7 billion, increased by 3.8 per cent as compared to the same period of 2024 (January – May 2024: 3.3%). The number of employee upticked by 0.9 per cent to 2.40 million persons, while salaries & wages increased by 1.9 per cent to RM41.9 billion with the sales value per employee stood at RM331,327, grew 2.9 per cent.

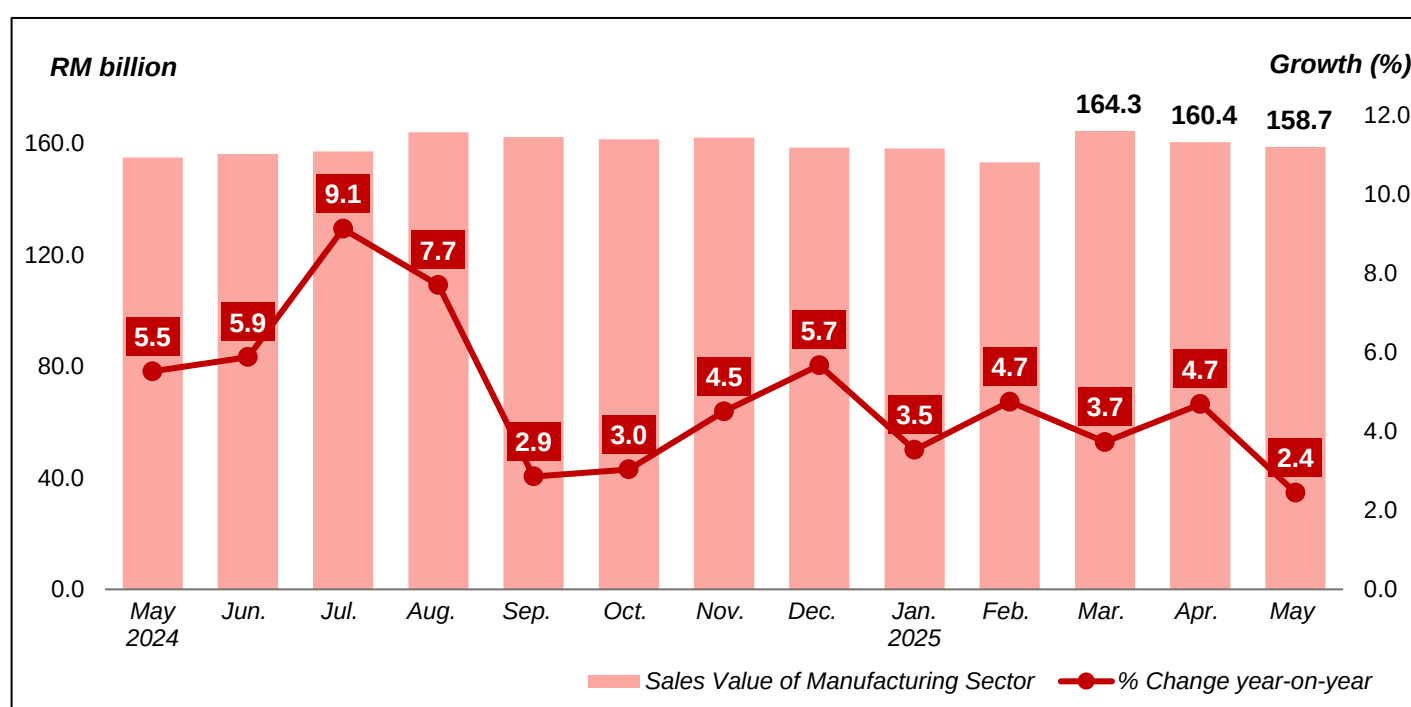

Malaysia has, for the first time, successfully secured the top position globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 198 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life'. Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

Chart 2: Growth of Manufacturing Sales Value by Sub-sector, Malaysia, April and May 2025

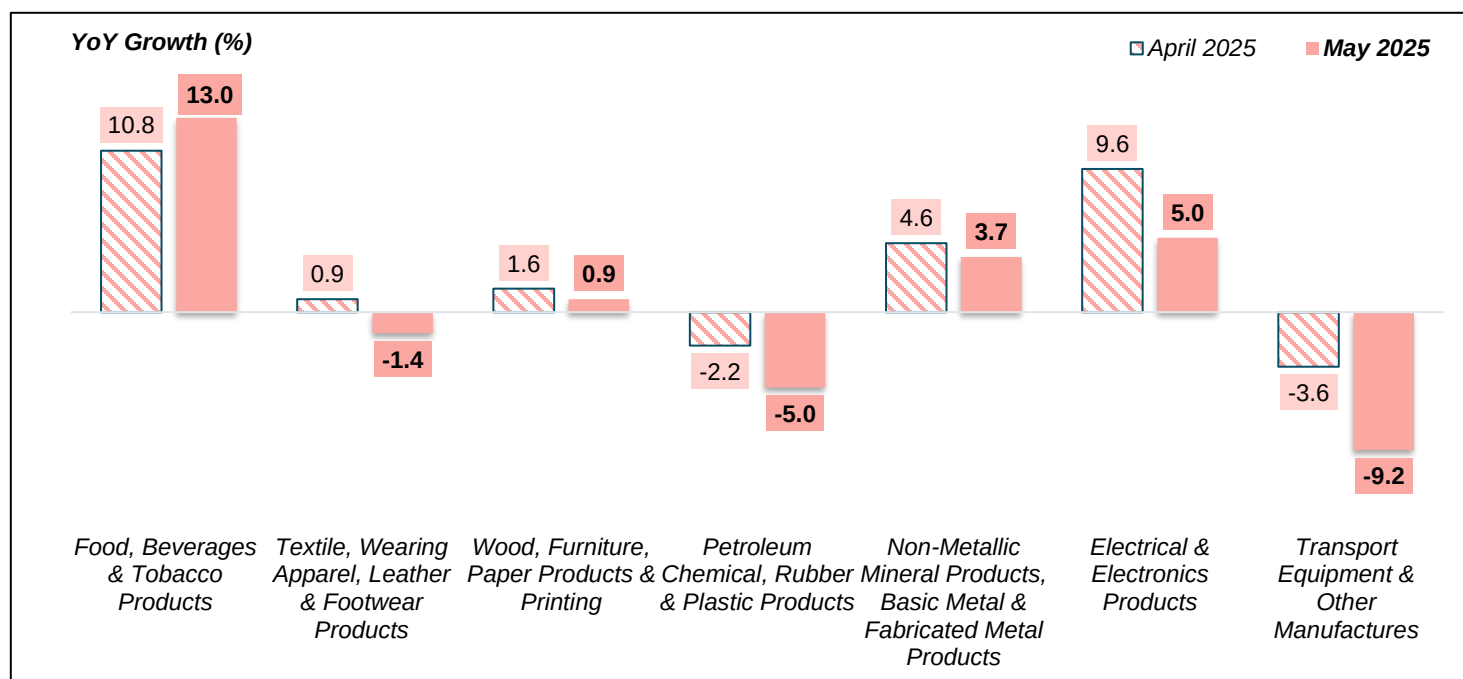


Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, May 2024 – May 2025

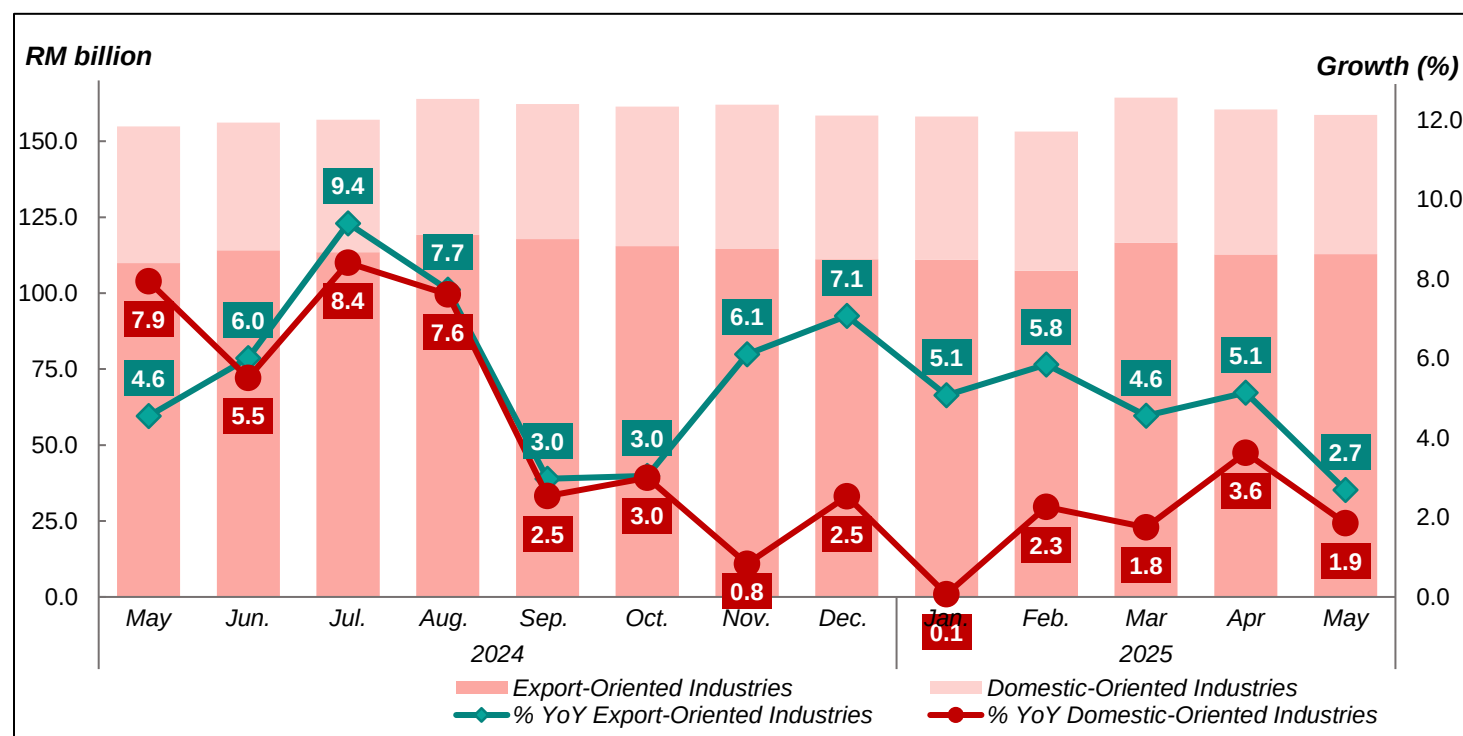
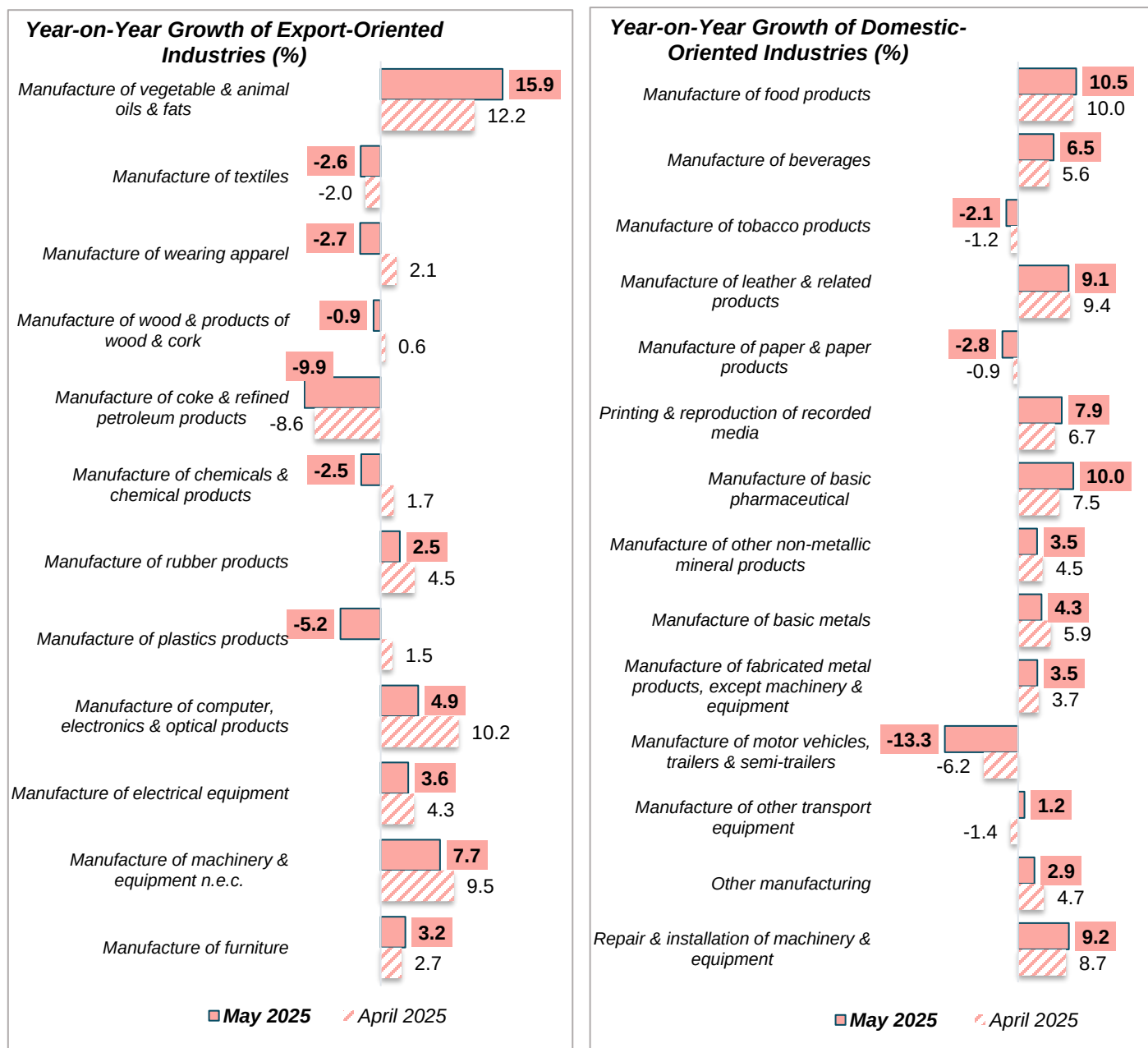


Chart 4: Sales Value of Manufacturing Export and Domestic-Oriented Groups, April and May 2025
