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PENUNJUK EKONOMI MALAYSIA INDEKS PELOPOR, SERENTAK & SUSULAN JUN 2025

Pertumbuhan ekonomi Malaysia menyederhana dengan Indeks Pelopor mencatatkan marginal negatif 0.2 peratus pada Jun 2025

PUTRAJAYA, 25 Ogos 2025 – Kadar pertumbuhan tahunan Indeks Pelopor (IP) mencatatkan penurunan marginal 0.2 peratus pada Jun 2025, mencatatkan 113.4 mata berbanding 113.6 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya (**Paparan I**), seperti yang dilaporkan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM). Prestasi ini diperjelaskan dalam penerbitan **Penunjuk Ekonomi Malaysia: Indeks Pelopor, Serentak & Susulan bagi Jun 2025** yang diterbitkan pada hari ini. IP memberi petunjuk awal tentang titik perubahan dalam kitaran perniagaan dan arah tuju ekonomi bagi tempoh terdekat.

Mengulas lanjut mengenai prestasi IP terkini, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Penurunan ini mencerminkan penyusutan dalam empat daripada tujuh komponen, dengan penurunan paling ketara dilihat dalam Import Benar Logam Asas Berharga & Logam Bukan Ferus Lain (-27.4%). Dari segi perbandingan bulanan, IP turut menyusut 0.5 peratus, dipengaruhi oleh penurunan dalam kedua-dua komponen import iaitu Import Benar Logam Asas Berharga & Logam Bukan Ferus Lain (-1.0%) dan Import Benar Semi Konduktor (-0.5%)".

Meneliti arah aliran jangka panjang terlicin pada Jun 2025, IP kekal berada di bawah 100.0 mata (**Paparan II**), menjangkakan momentum ekonomi yang mereda. Prospek ini disokong oleh asas domestik yang kukuh namun dipengaruhi oleh cabaran luaran.

Sementara itu, Indeks Serentak (IS) yang mencerminkan prestasi ekonomi semasa meningkat 1.7 peratus kepada 128.2 mata pada Jun 2025 berbanding 126.1 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh pengukuhan kesemua komponen, dengan Nilai Caruman Benar KWSP mencatat kenaikan tertinggi sebanyak 6.1 peratus. Secara bulanan, IS bertambah 0.4 peratus, disokong oleh Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian yang meningkat 0.3 peratus.

Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh Open Data Watch (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan.' Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

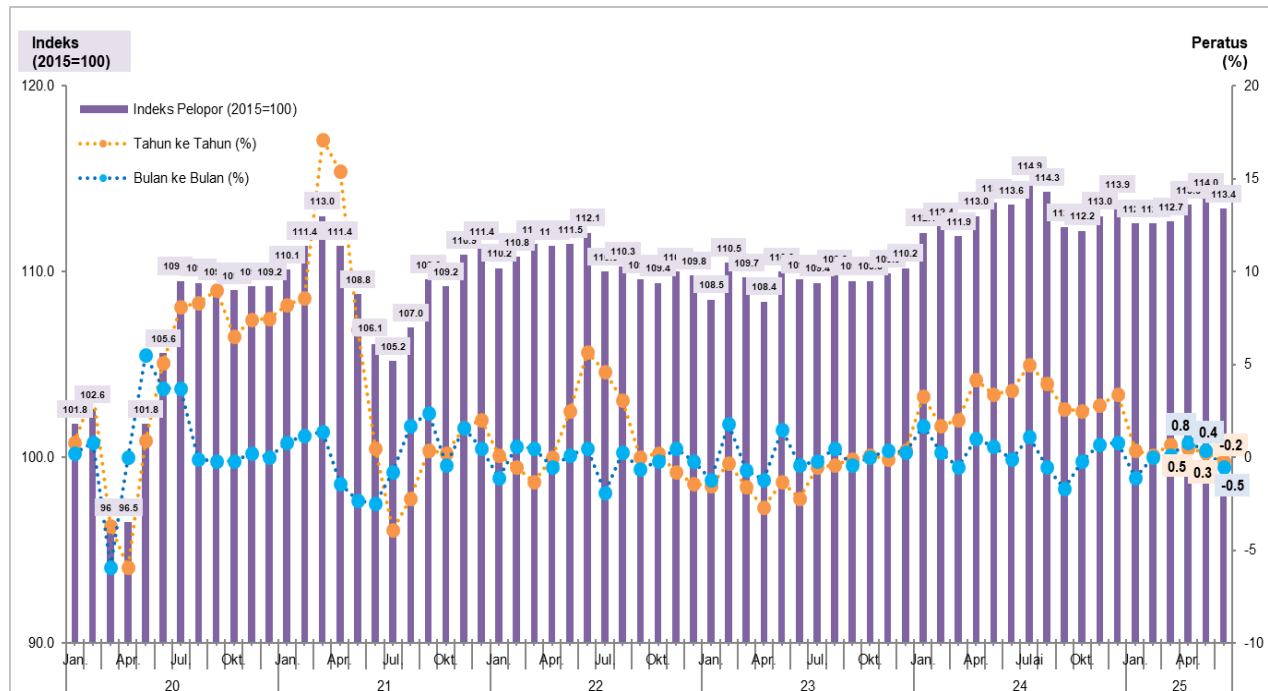

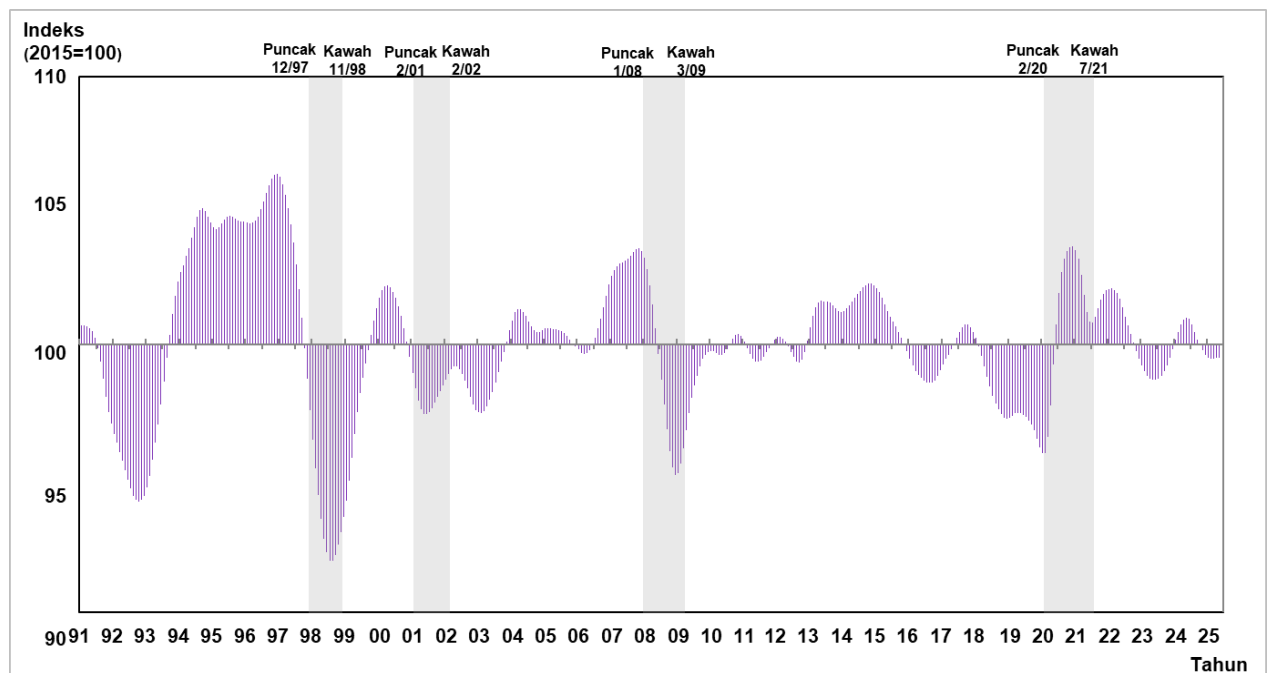

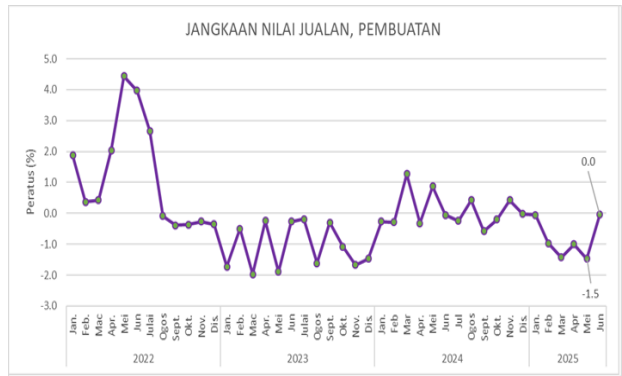
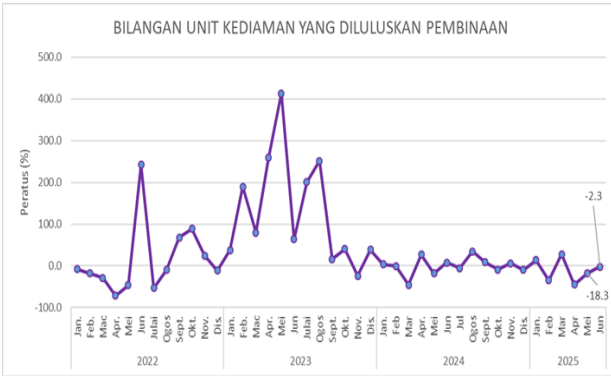
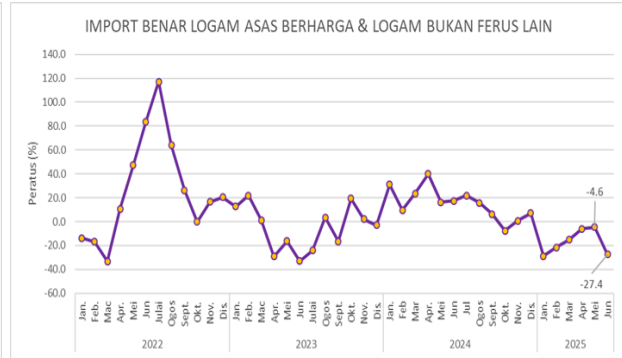
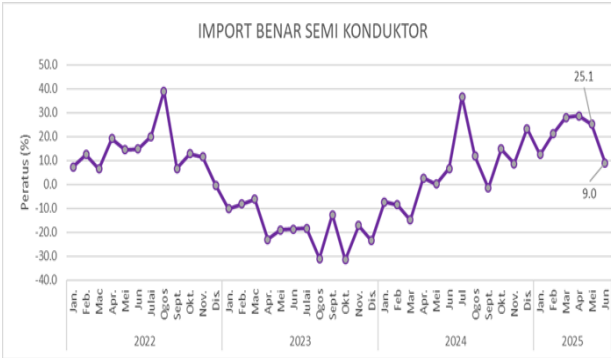
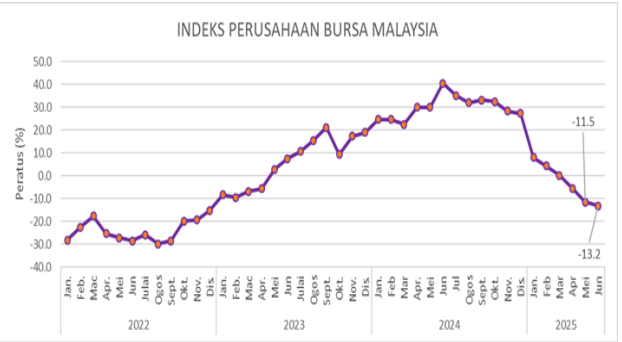
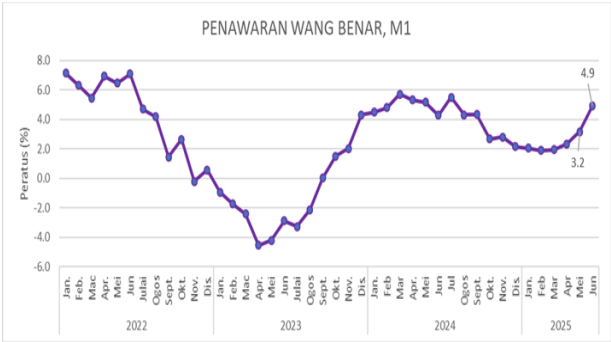
Paparan I: Indeks Komposit Pelopor

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MALAYSIAN ECONOMIC INDICATORS LEADING, COINCIDENT & LAGGING INDEXES JUNE 2025

Malaysia's economic growth moderates with the Leading Index recording a marginal negative of 0.2 per cent in June 2025

PUTRAJAYA, August 25, 2025 – The annual growth rate of the Leading Index (LI) recorded a marginal decline of 0.2 per cent in June 2025, recording 113.4 points as compared to 113.6 points in the same month of the previous year (**Exhibit I**), as reported by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM). This performance is explained in the **Malaysian Economic Indicators: Leading, Coincident & Lagging Indexes for June 2025** publication released today. The LI provides an early indication of turning points in the business cycle and the near-term direction of the economy.

Commenting further on the recent LI performance, the Chief Statistician of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The decline reflected weaknesses in four out of seven components, with the most notable drop seen in the Real Imports of Other Basic Precious & Other Non-Ferrous Metals (-27.4%). On a month-on-month basis, the LI also declined by 0.5 per cent, affected by decreases in both import components, namely the Real Imports of Other Basic Precious & Other Non-Ferrous Metals (-1.0%) and the Real Imports of Semi Conductors (-0.5%)".

*Examining the smoothed long-term trend in June 2025, the LI remained below 100.0 points (**Exhibit II**), anticipating to an easing economic momentum. The outlook is supported by a strong domestic foundation but weighed down by external challenges.*

Meanwhile, the Coincident Index (CI) reflecting current economic performance grew by 1.7 per cent to 128.2 points in June 2025 as compared to 126.1 points in the same month of the previous year. This increase was driven by improvements across all components, with the Real Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) Contribution Value recording the highest rise of 6.1 per cent. On a monthly basis, the CI rose 0.4 per cent, aided by the Industrial Production Index (IPI), which advanced by 0.3 per cent.

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life'. Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index

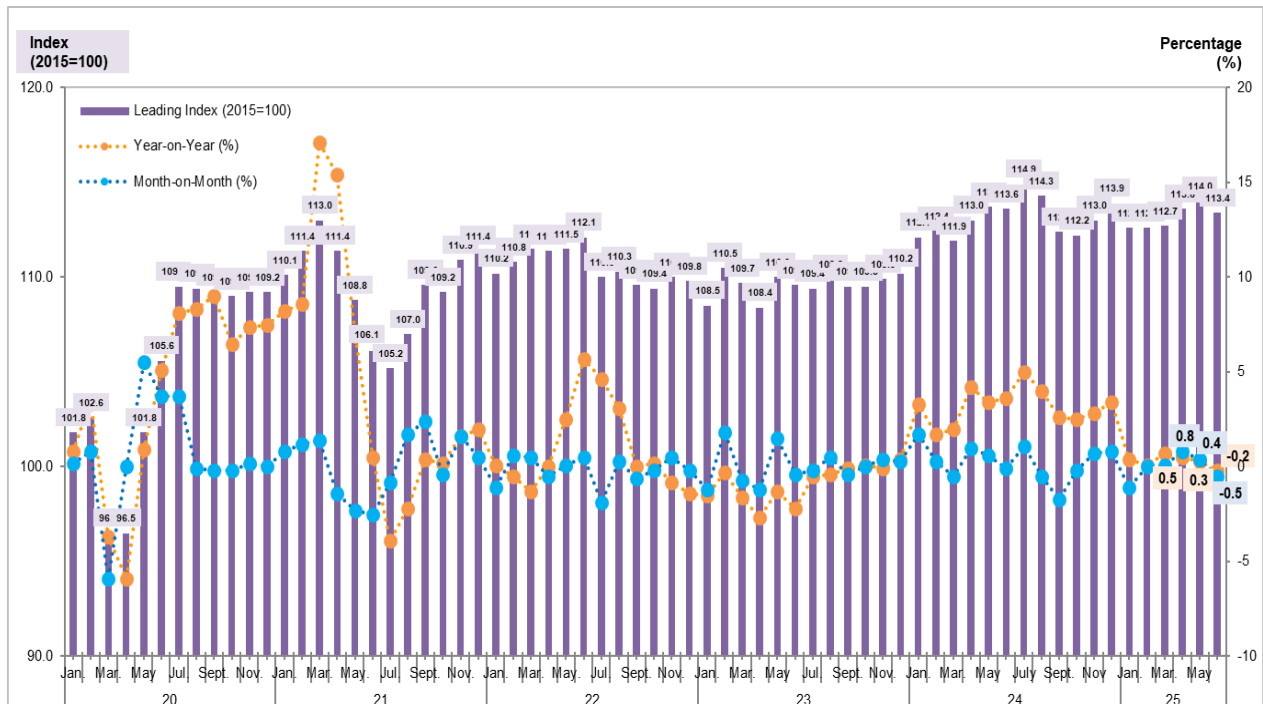


Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle

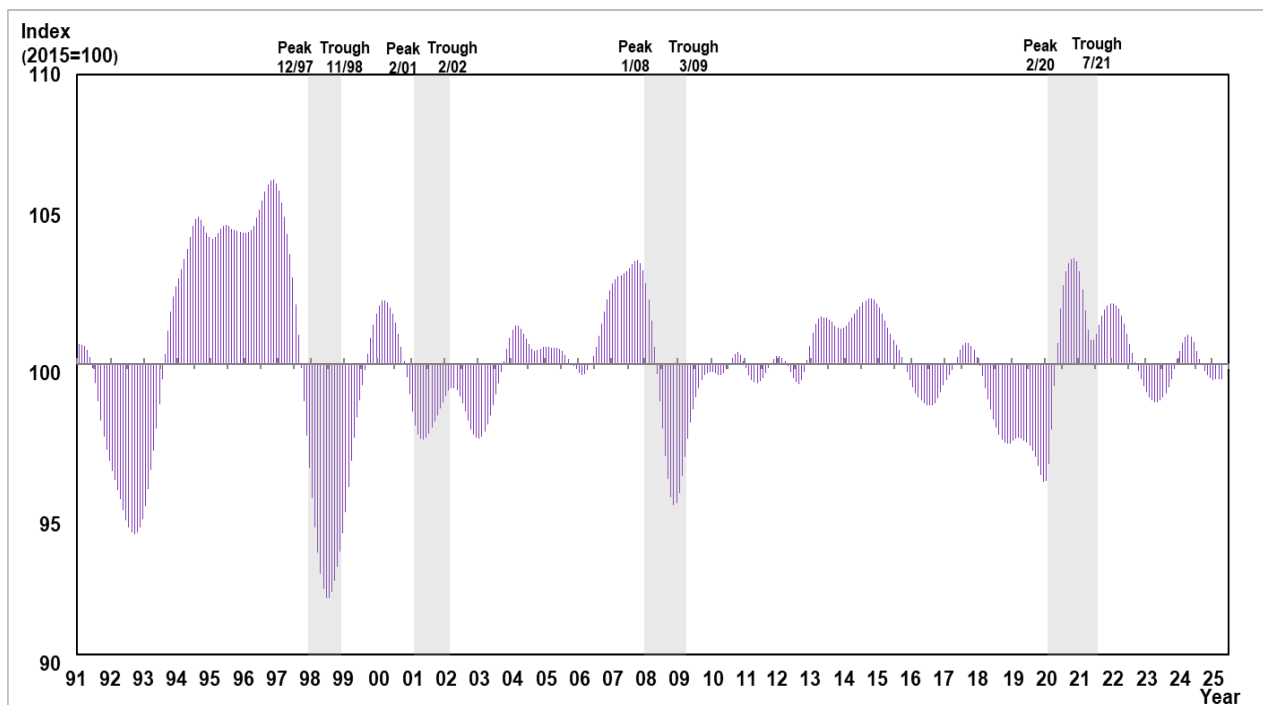


Exhibit III: Annual Changes of Leading Index Components
