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PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA JULAI 2025

Jualan sektor Pembuatan merekodkan RM162.5 bilion, meningkat 3.5 peratus pada Julai 2025

PUTRAJAYA, 11 September 2025 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat 3.5 peratus tahun ke tahun (Jun 2025: 3.3%), berjumlah RM162.5 bilion pada Julai 2025. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Julai 2025** pada hari ini.

Mengulas prestasi jualan Pembuatan terkini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Peningkatan nilai jualan dalam sektor Pembuatan disumbangkan terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau, berkembang 8.9 peratus pada Julai 2025 (Jun 2025: 14.7%). Pertumbuhan ini turut disokong lagi oleh subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik dan Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam, yang masing-masing meningkat sebanyak 6.9 peratus (Jun 2025: 4.5%) dan 3.8 peratus (Jun 2025: 3.0%). Pada masa yang sama, nilai jualan meningkat 0.8 peratus, mencapai RM162.5 bilion berbanding RM161.2 bilion yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya."

Pertumbuhan nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili 71.7 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, tumbuh 2.7 peratus pada Julai 2025 (Jun 2025: 2.4%). Prestasi ini disebabkan terutamanya oleh peningkatan dalam Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan sebanyak 6.3 peratus (Jun 2025: 15.9%). Sementara itu, Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal tumbuh 6.9 peratus (Jun 2025: 3.8%), dan Pembuatan jentera dan peralatan t.t.t.l. meningkat sebanyak 12.4 peratus (Jun 2025: 10.5%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport susut sedikit sebanyak 0.3 peratus (Jun 2025: 4.1%).

Begitu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik kekal pada pertumbuhan stabil 5.6 peratus pada Julai 2025. Prestasi ini disokong oleh pertumbuhan kukuh dalam Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan pada 12.7 peratus pada Julai 2025 (Jun 2025: 14.0%); serta dalam industri Pembuatan logam asas (7.2%); dan Pembuatan produk logam kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (4.0%). Walaubagaimana pun, industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat 3.8 peratus berbanding bulan sebelumnya.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Sejumlah 2.4 juta orang pekerja direkodkan dalam sektor ini pada Julai 2025, bertambah sebanyak 1.1 peratus (Jun 2025: 1.0%). Pertambahan ini dipacu terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (2.0%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (1.4%); dan Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (1.4%). Berasaskan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini meningkat 0.2 peratus.

Seiring dengan itu, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga mencatatkan pengembangan 2.3 peratus (Jun 2025: 1.6%), berjumlah RM8.31 bilion pada Julai 2025. Tambahan pula, gaji & upah yang dibayar susut 0.2 peratus berbanding RM8.33 bilion yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Selanjutnya, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja mencatatkan RM67,833 (2.3%), manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja adalah RM3,469, meningkat 1.2 peratus tahun ke tahun.”

Merumuskan kenyataannya, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Bagi tempoh dari Januari sehingga Julai 2025, sektor Pembuatan merekodkan jualan kumulatif sebanyak RM1.1 trilion, tumbuh 3.7 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun 2024 (Januari – Julai 2024: 4.5%). Bilangan pekerja meningkat sebanyak 1.1 peratus kepada 2.4 juta orang, manakala gaji & upah meningkat 1.9 peratus kepada RM58.5 bilion. Selain itu, nilai jualan setiap pekerja berjumlah RM466,735, tumbuh 2.5 peratus.”

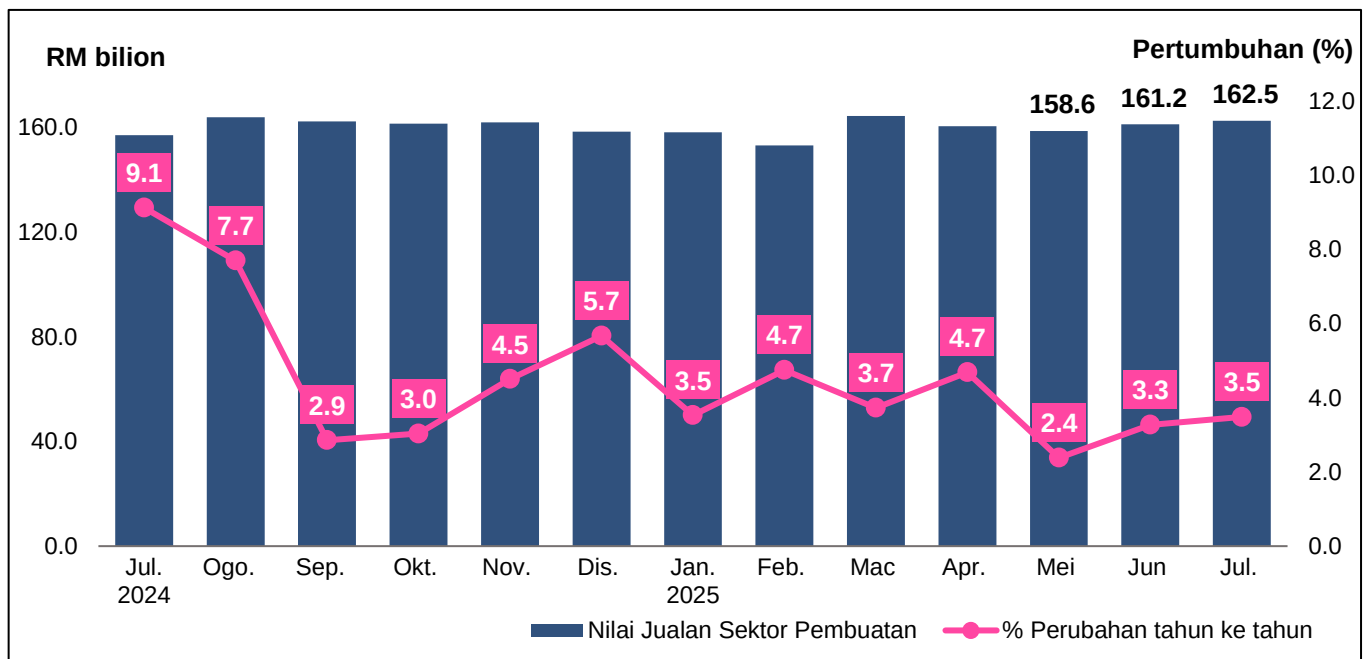
Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh Open Data Watch (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

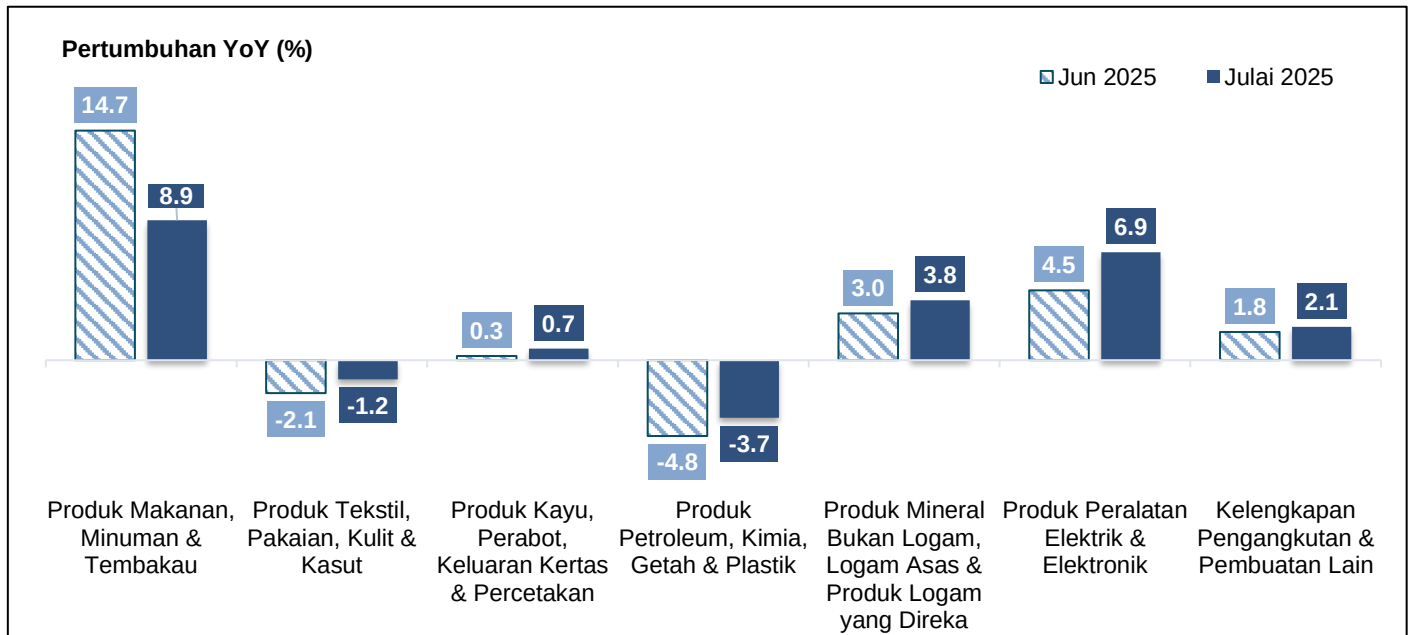

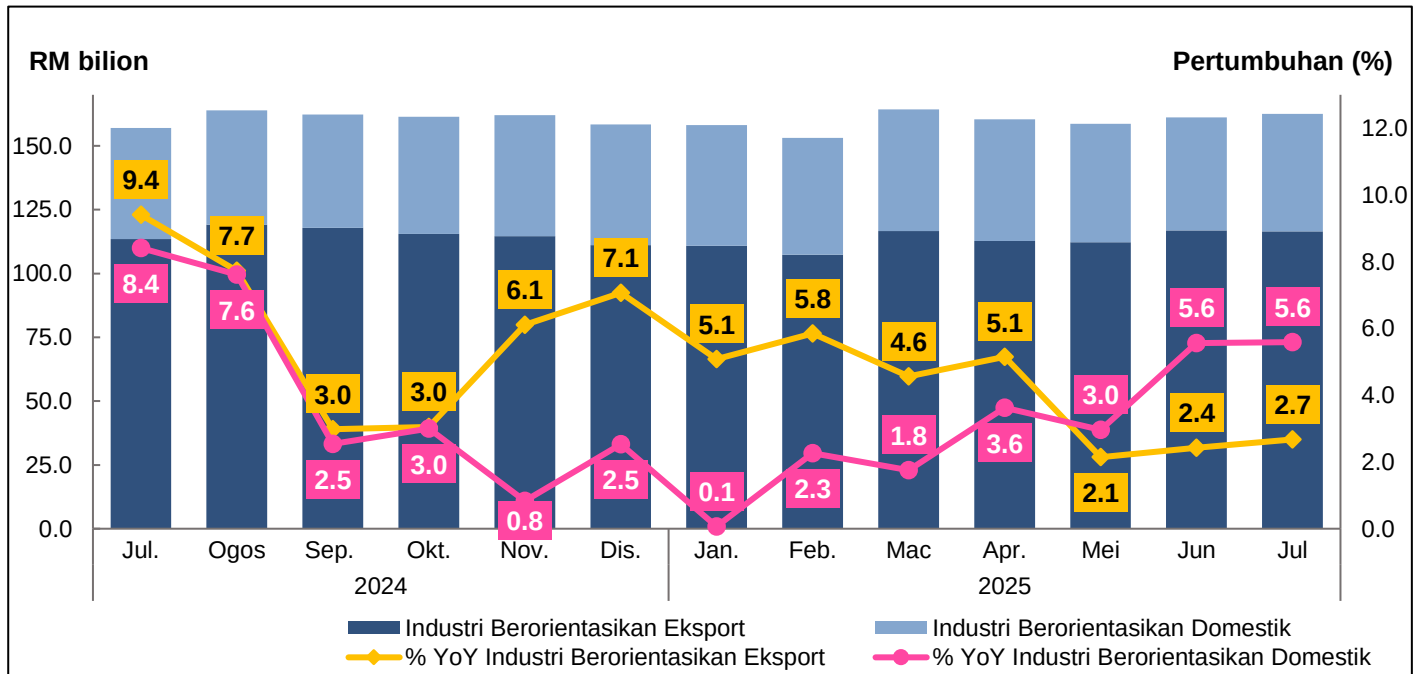
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
Julai 2024 - Julai 2025**



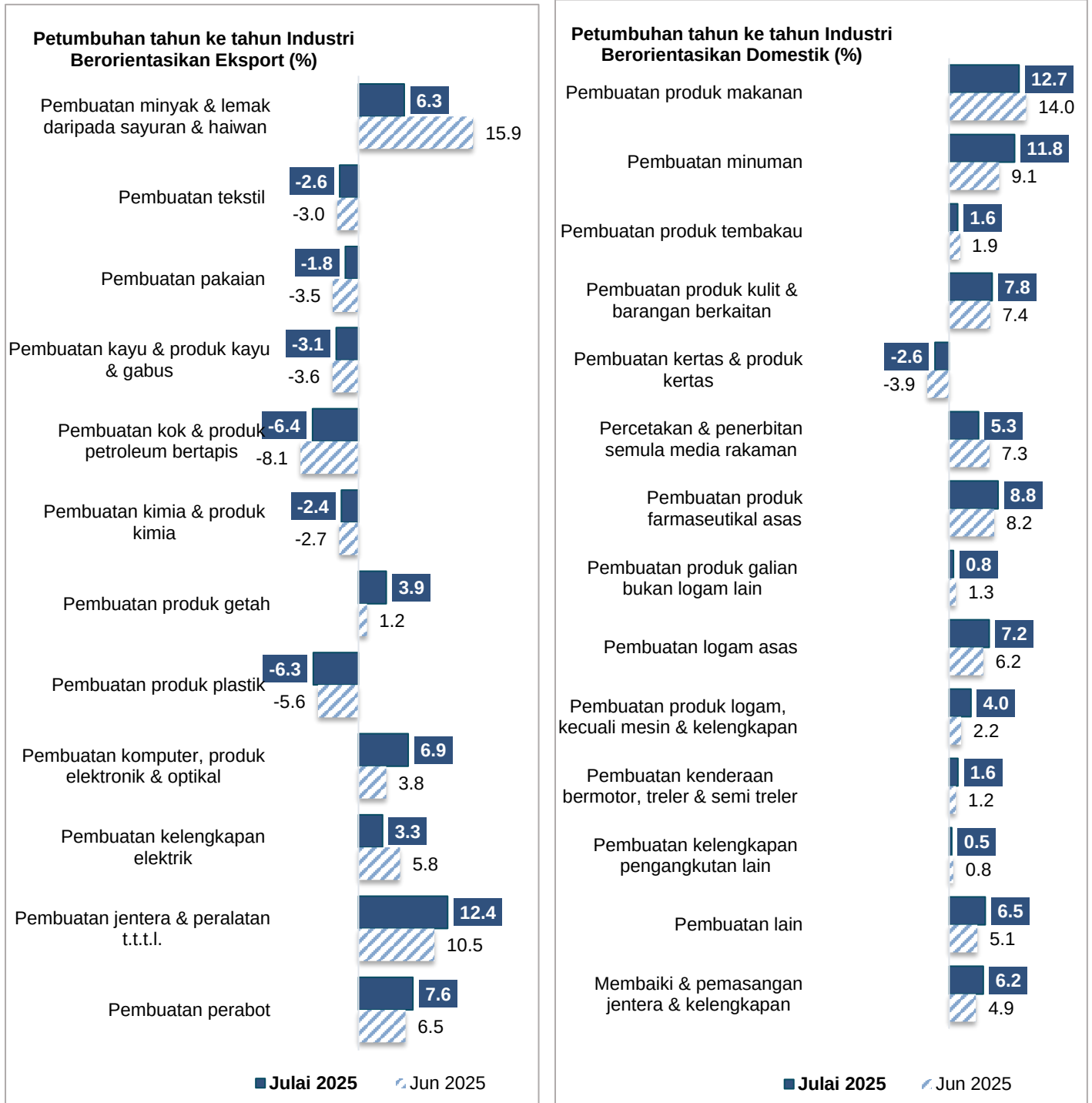
Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia, Jun dan Julai 2025

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MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA JULY 2025

***Sales in the Manufacturing sector recorded RM162.5 billion,
rose 3.5 per cent in July 2025***

PUTRAJAYA, 11 September 2025 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector increased 3.5 per cent year-on-year (June 2025: 3.3%), totalled at RM162.5 billion in July 2025. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of ***Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, July 2025***.

Commenting on the latest Manufacturing sales performance, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “The growth in sales value within the Manufacturing sector was mainly contributed by the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector, expanded by 8.9 per cent in July 2025 (June 2025: 14.7%). The growth was further supported by the Electrical & electronics products and the Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products sub-sectors, which rose by 6.9 per cent (June 2025: 4.5%) and 3.8 per cent (June 2025: 3.0%), respectively. In the same period, sales value increased by 0.8 per cent, reaching RM162.5 billion from RM161.2 billion recorded in the prior month.”

Sales value growth in the export-oriented industries which accounting for 71.7 per cent of total sales, grew by 2.7 per cent in July 2025 (June 2025: 2.4%). The performance was primarily due to the increase in the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats by 6.3 per cent (June 2025: 15.9%). Meanwhile, the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products grew by 6.9 per cent (June 2025: 3.8%), and the Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. advanced by 12.4 per cent (June 2025: 10.5%). On a month-on-month comparison, export-oriented industries slightly declined by 0.3 per cent (June 2025: 4.1%).

Likewise, the domestic-oriented industries remained the steady growth at 5.6 per cent in July 2025. The performance was supported by robust growth in the Manufacture of food processing products at 12.7 per cent in July 2025 (June 2025: 14.0%), as well as in the Manufacture of basic metals (7.2%) and Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (4.0%). Furthermore, the domestic-oriented industries increased 3.8 per cent as compared to the preceding month.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia stated, “A total of 2.4 million employees were recorded in this sector during July 2025, augmented by 1.1 per cent (June 2025: 1.0%). The augmentation was mainly driven by the Food, beverages & tobacco (2.0%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (1.4%); and Electrical & electronics products (1.4%). On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in this sector increased 0.2 per cent.

Correspondingly, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector also posted an expansion of 2.3 per cent (June 2025: 1.6%), amounted to RM8.31 billion in July 2025. In addition, the salaries & wages paid dropped by 0.2 per cent compared to RM8.33 billion recorded in the preceding month. Subsequently, the sales value per employee registered at RM67,833 (2.3%), while the average salaries & wages per employee was RM3,469, increased by 1.2 per cent year-on-year.”

Concluding his statement, the Chief Statistician said, “For the period of January to July 2025, the Manufacturing sector recorded cumulative sales of RM1.1 trillion, grew 3.7 per cent as compared to the same period of 2024 (January – July 2024: 4.5%). The number of employee upticked by 1.1 per cent to 2.4 million persons, while salaries & wages increased by 1.9 per cent to RM58.5 billion. Moreover, the sales value per employee stood at RM466,735, grew 2.5 per cent.”

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life'. Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

July 2024 – July 2025**

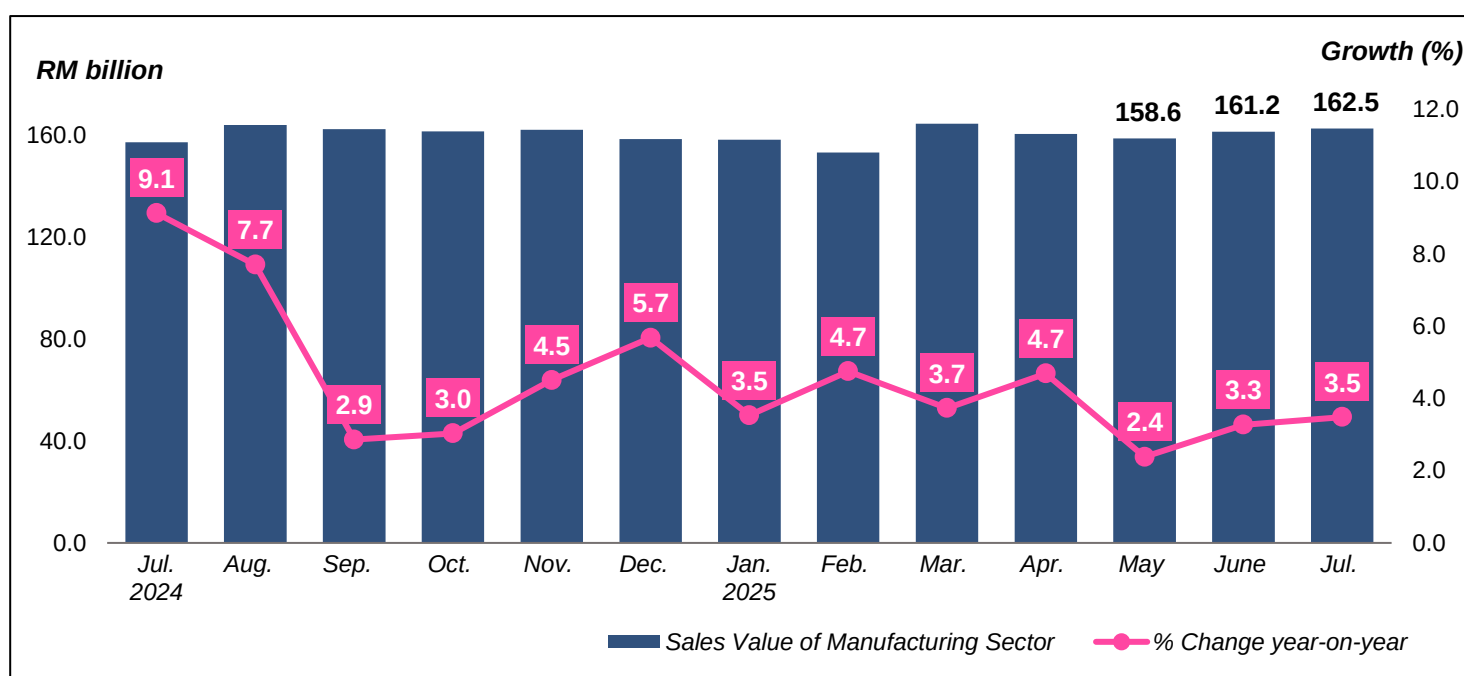


Chart 2: Growth of Manufacturing Sales Value by Sub-sector, Malaysia, June and July 2025

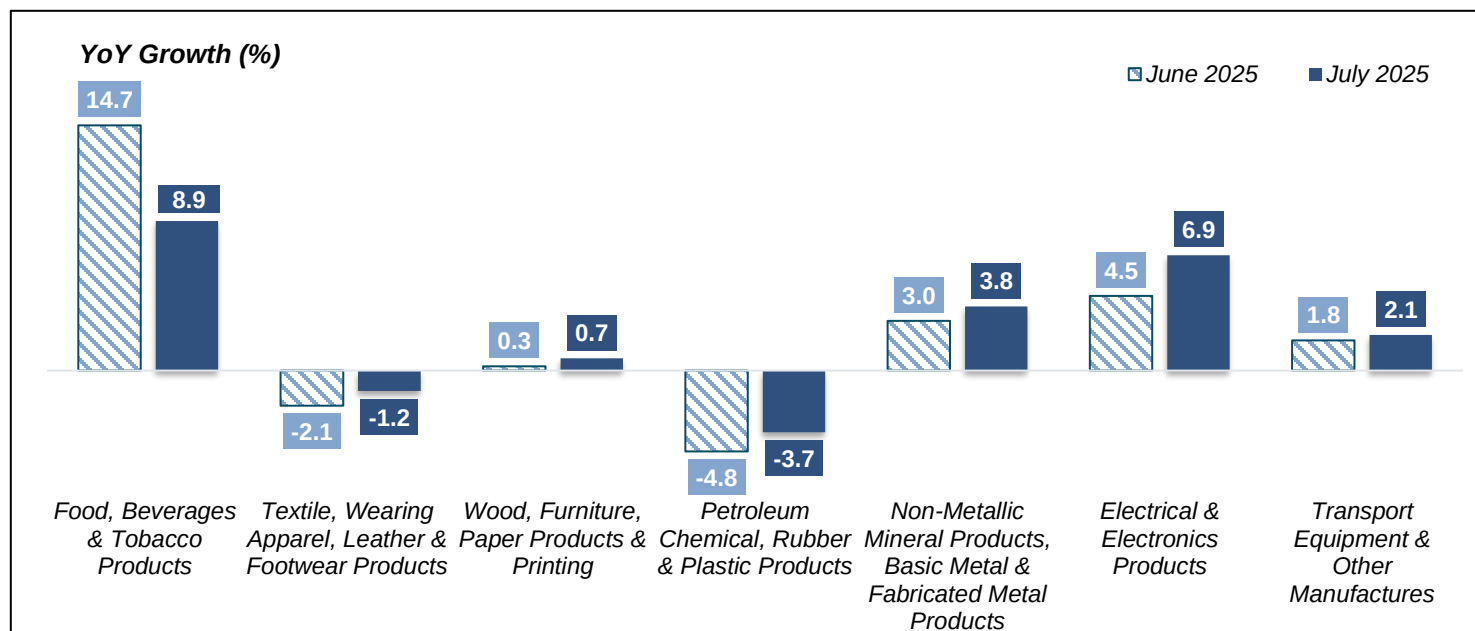


Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, July 2024 – July 2025

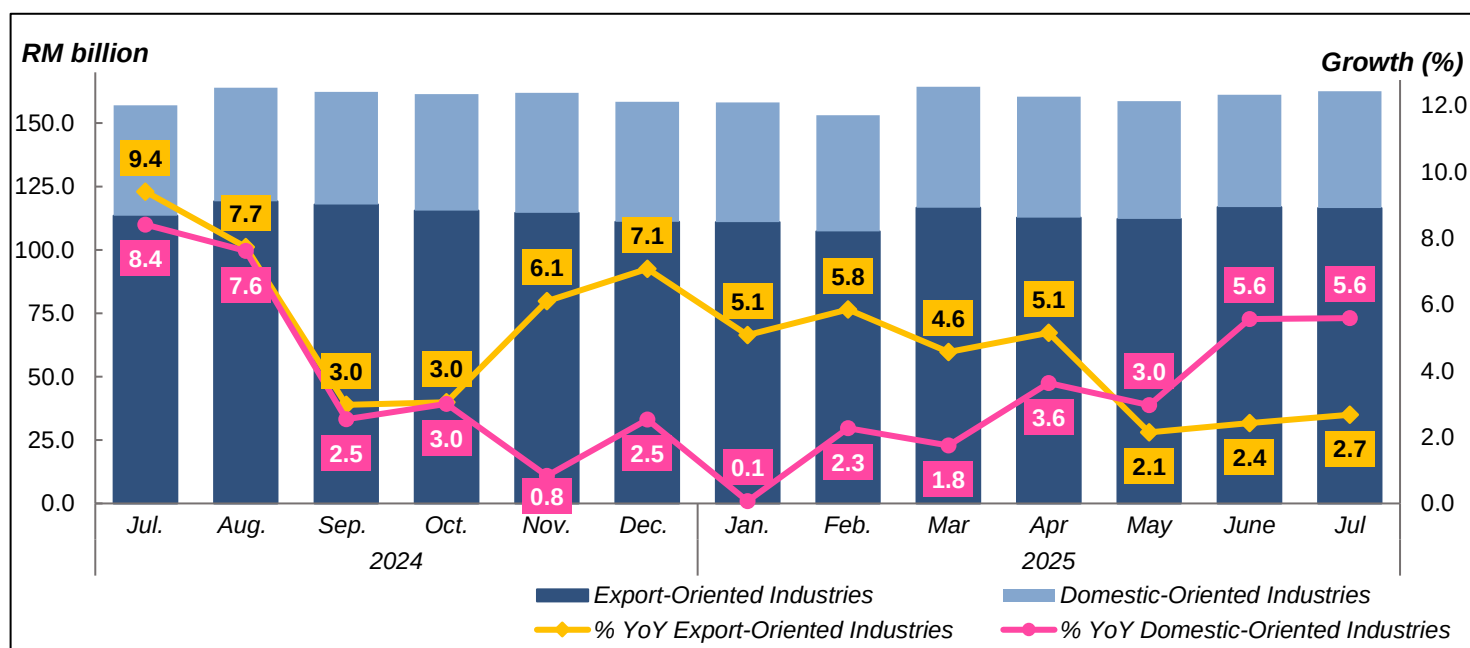
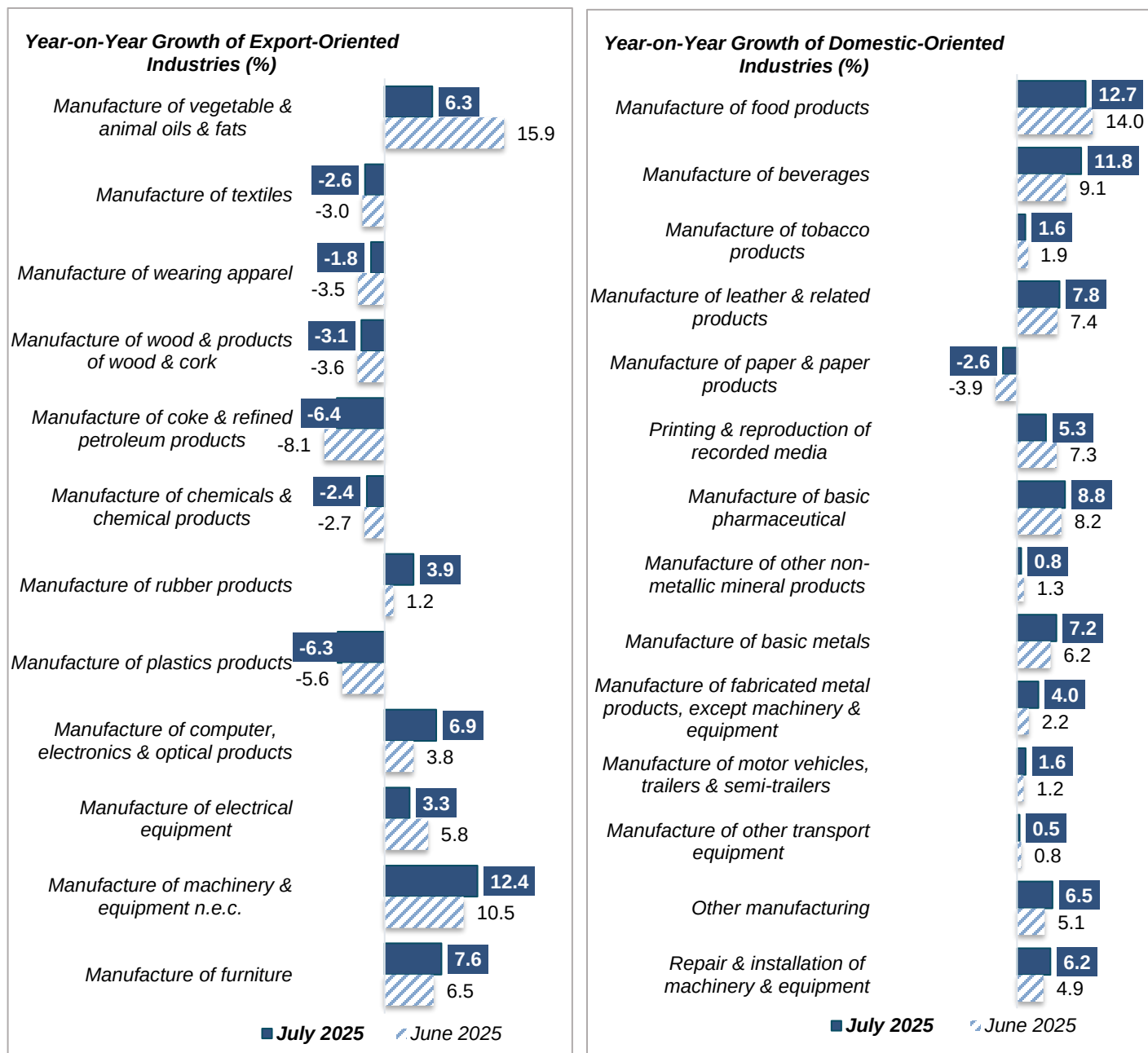


Chart 4: Sales Value of Manufacturing Export and Domestic-Oriented Groups, June and July 2025
