PERANGKAAN GETAH BULANAN, MALAYSIA

JULAI 2025

Pengeluaran getah asli Malaysia meningkat 36.7 peratus pada Julai 2025

PUTRAJAYA, 12 September 2025 – Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah menerbitkan **Perangkaan Getah Bulanan, Malaysia, Julai 2025**. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik pengeluaran, import, eksport, penggunaan domestik, stok, harga, bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah dan produktiviti bagi estet getah.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, pengeluaran getah asli meningkat 36.7 peratus pada Julai 2025 (35,884 tan metrik) berbanding pada Jun 2025 (26,249 tan metrik). Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan pengeluaran getah asli menurun 5.5 peratus (Julai 2024: 37,960 tan metrik). Pengeluaran getah asli Malaysia pada Julai 2025 disumbangkan terutamanya oleh sektor pekebun kecil (86.8%) berbanding sektor estet (13.2%).

Jumlah stok getah asli pada Julai 2025 meningkat 1.6 peratus kepada 171,061 tan metrik berbanding 168,448 tan metrik pada Jun 2025. Kilang pemproses getah menyumbang stok akhir sebanyak 85.1 peratus diikuti kilang pengguna getah (14.8%) dan estet getah (0.1%).

Eksport getah asli Malaysia berjumlah 37,198 tan metrik pada Julai 2025, meningkat 25.2 peratus berbanding Jun 2025 (29,719 tan metrik). China terus kekal sebagai destinasi utama untuk eksport getah asli iaitu menyumbang 47.3 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport pada Julai 2025 diikuti Jerman (15.0%), India (6.7%), Amerika Syarikat (6.1%) dan Mesir (3.0%). Prestasi eksport disumbangkan

oleh produk berasaskan getah asli seperti sarung tangan getah, tayar, tiub dan benang getah. Produk sarung tangan getah merupakan eksport utama dengan nilai sebanyak RM1.3 billion pada Julai 2025, meningkat 49.3 peratus berbanding Jun 2025 (RM0.9 billion).

Analisis perbandingan harga purata bulanan menunjukkan Lateks Pekat merekodkan peningkatan iaitu 2.3 peratus (Julai 2025: 571.30 sen sekilogram; Jun 2025: 558.66 sen sekilogram) manakala Sekerap meningkat sebanyak 4.0 peratus (Julai 2025: 586.68 sen sekilogram; Jun 2025: 564.13 sen sekilogram). Trend harga bagi semua jenis Getah Mutu Malaysia (G.M.M) pula menunjukkan peningkatan antara 2.3 peratus dan 8.8 peratus. *The World Bank Commodity Price Data* melaporkan harga bagi getah jenis TSR 20 (*Technically Specified Rubber*) meningkat 4.4 peratus daripada USD1.61/kg kepada USD1.68/kg dan SGP/MYS (Singapura/Malaysia) meningkat 3.3 peratus daripada USD2.16/kg kepada USD2.23/kg.

Menurut *Malaysia Rubber Board Digest* keluaran Julai 2025, Pasaran Getah Kuala Lumpur dilihat meningkat pada Julai sebelum beransur-ansur menurun menjelang akhir bulan. Peningkatan sepanjang bulan ini didorong oleh faktor-faktor antaranya keseimbangan bekalan getah asli berikutan hujan lebat di wilayah pengeluar utama, peningkatan permintaan, kemajuan positif dalam perjanjian perdagangan Amerika Syarikat dan keyakinan terhadap usaha rangsangan China. Sentimen pasaran juga meningkat oleh permintaan getah sederhana yang dijangkakan oleh Persatuan Negara Pengeluar Getah Asli (ANRPC) dan perkembangan dalam industri automobil global.

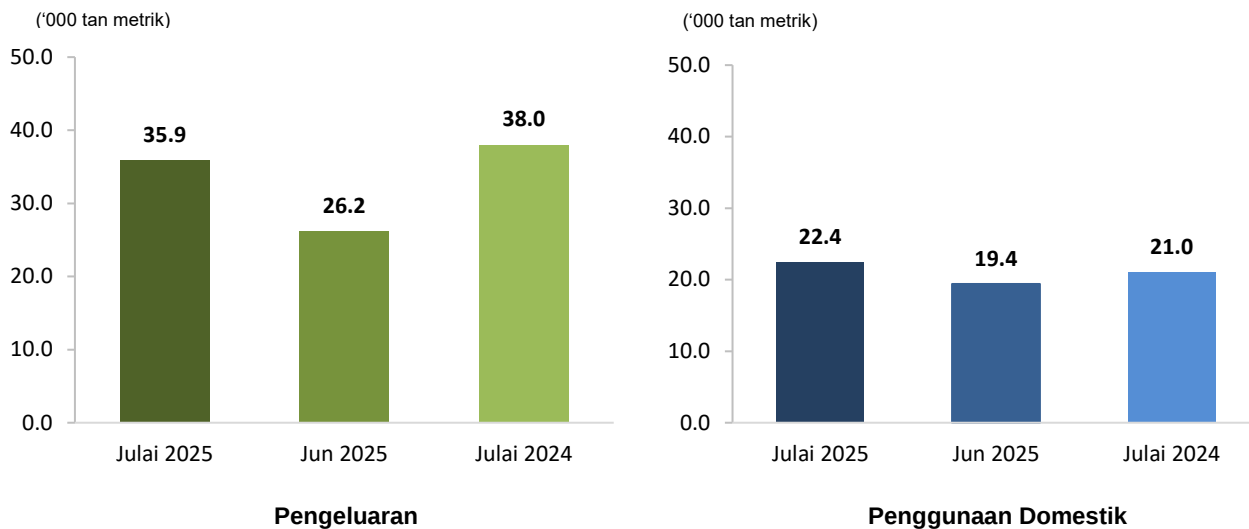
Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan *Open Data Inventory* (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

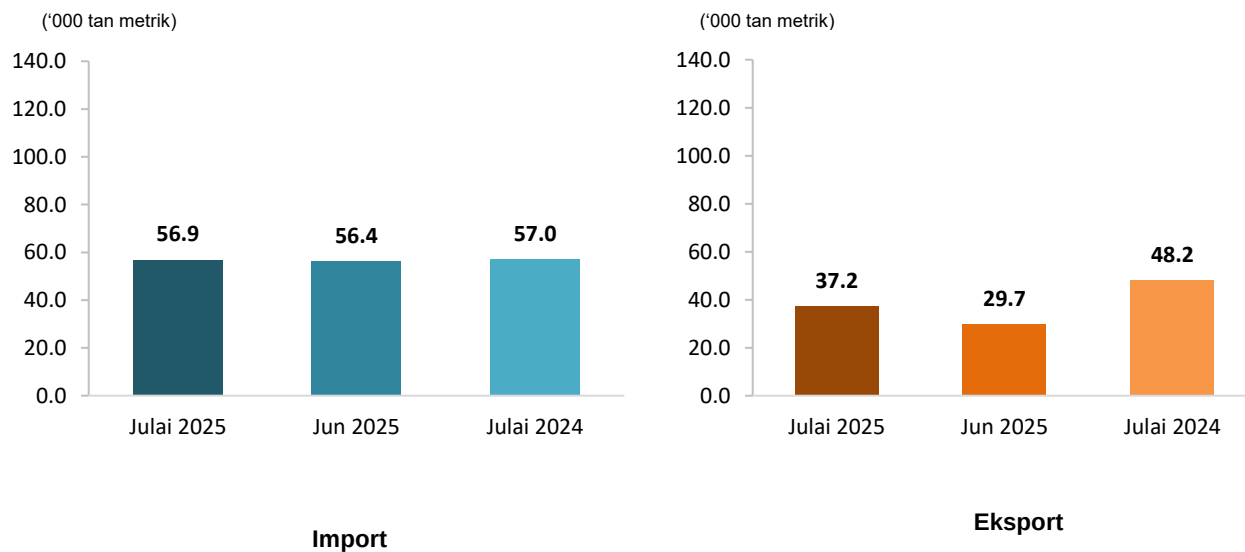

MONTHLY RUBBER STATISTICS, MALAYSIA JULY 2025

Malaysia natural rubber production increased by 36.7 per cent in July 2025

PUTRAJAYA, SEPTEMBER 12, 2025 – The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) released the **Monthly Rubber Statistics, Malaysia, July 2025**. This publication consists of statistics on production, imports, exports, domestic consumption, stocks, prices, number of employees, salaries & wages and productivity of rubber estates.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, Natural Rubber (NR) production increased by 36.7 per cent in July 2025 (35,884 tonnes) as compared to June 2025 (26,249 tonnes). Year-on-year comparison showed that the production of NR decreased by 5.5 per cent (July 2024: 37,960 tonnes). Production of NR in July 2025 for Malaysia was mainly contributed by smallholders sector (86.8%) as compared to estates sector (13.2%).

Total stocks of NR in July 2025 increased by 1.6 per cent to 171,061 tonnes as compared to 168,448 tonnes in June 2025. Rubber processors factory contributed 85.1 per cent of the stocks followed by rubber consumers factory (14.8%) and rubber estates (0.1%).

Exports of Malaysia's NR amounted to 37,198 tonnes in July 2025, increased 25.2 per cent as against June 2025 (29,719 tonnes). P.R. China remained as the main destination for NR exports which accounted 47.3 per cent of total exports in July 2025 followed by Germany (15.0%), India (6.7%), the United States of America (6.1%) and Egypt (3.0%). The exports performance was contributed by NR-based product such as gloves, tyre, tube and rubber thread. Gloves were the main exports of rubber-based

products with a value of RM1.3 billion in July 2025, an increase of 49.3 per cent as compared to June 2025 (RM0.9 billion).

Analysis of the average monthly price showed that Concentrated Latex recorded an increase of 2.3 per cent (July 2025: 571.30 sen per kg; June 2025: 558.66 sen per kg) while Scrap increased by 4.0 per cent (July 2025: 586.68 sen per kg; June 2025: 564.13 sen per kg). Trend of prices for all Standard Malaysian Rubber (S.M.R) showed an increase between 2.3 per cent and 8.8 per cent. The World Bank Commodity Price Data reported the prices for TSR 20 (Technically Specified Rubber) has increased 4.4 per cent (from USD1.61/kg to USD1.68/kg) and SGP/MYS (Singapore/Malaysia) increased 3.3 per cent (from USD2.16/kg to USD2.23/kg).

According to the Malaysia Rubber Board Digest published in July 2025, the Kuala Lumpur Rubber Market was seen to increase in July before gradually declining towards month end. Gains throughout this month were driven by factors including concerns of NR supply due to heavy rainfall in major producing regions, rising demand, positive the United States of America trade deals progress and optimism over China's stimulus efforts. Market sentiment was also lifted by moderate rubber demand anticipated by the Association of Natural Rubber Producing Countries (ANRPC) and developments in the global automobile industry.

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life'. Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

(‘000 tonnes)

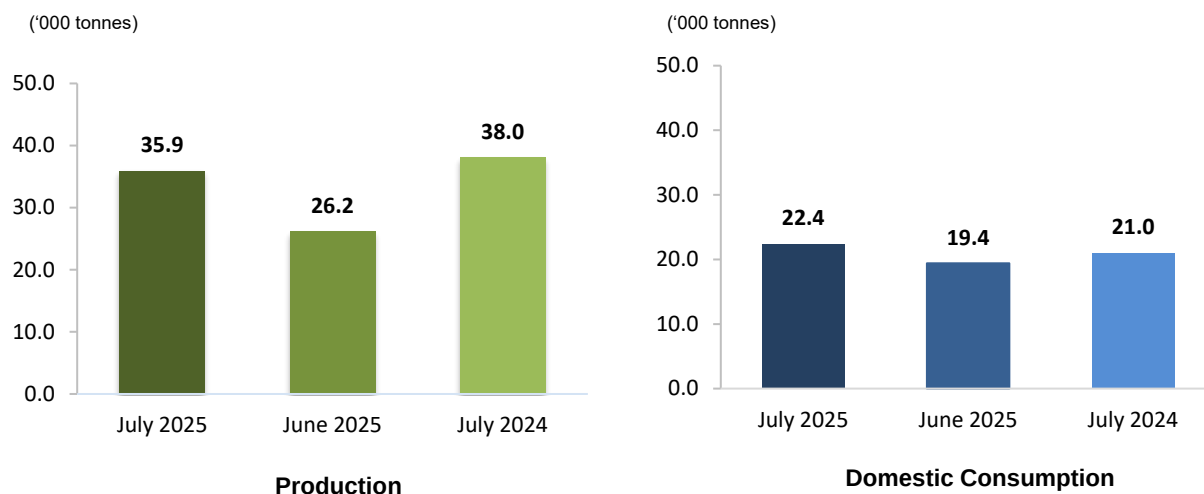
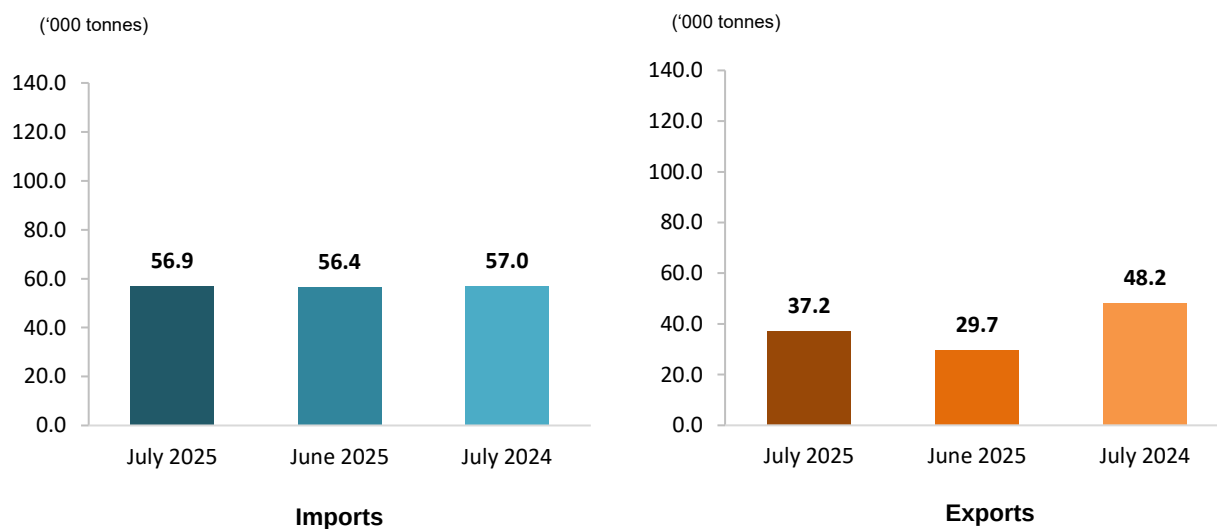


Chart 2: Imports and exports of natural rubber July 2024, June - July 2025
