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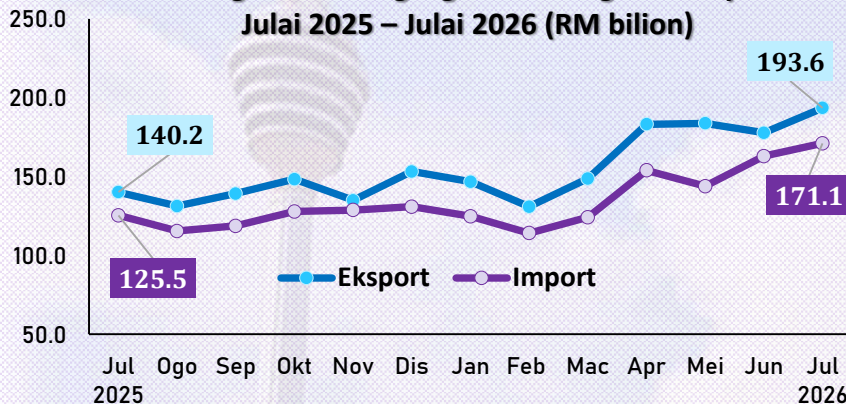

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PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI MALAYSIA, JULAI 2026

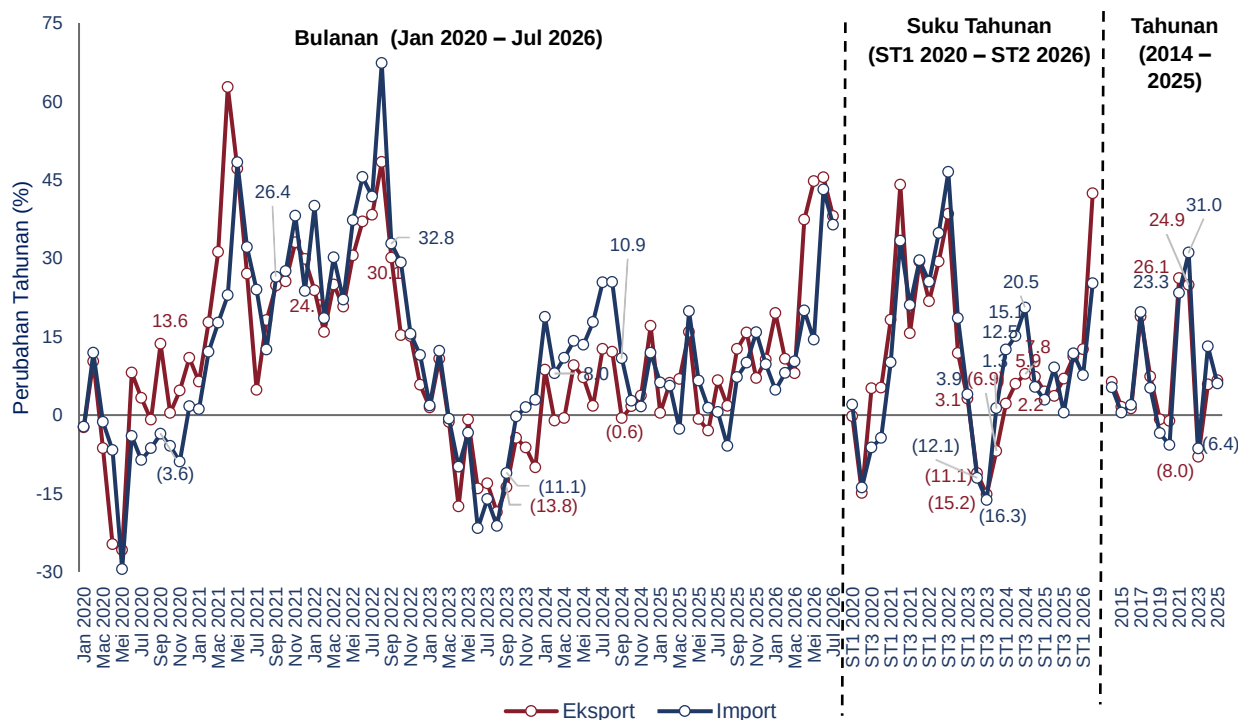
Prestasi perdagangan Malaysia mengekalkan trend positif pada Julai 2026, seiring dengan peningkatan dua digit eksport (+38.0%) dan import (+36.4%) tahun ke tahun. Jumlah dagangan meningkat 37.3 peratus atau RM99.0 bilion kepada RM364.7 bilion.

Selain itu, imbalan dagangan naik 51.9 peratus atau RM7.7 bilion daripada RM14.8 bilion kepada RM22.5 bilion berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

Perbandingan bulanan menunjukkan eksport, import, jumlah dagangan dan lebihan dagangan masing-masing meningkat 8.8 peratus, 5.5 peratus, 7.3 peratus dan 42.4 peratus.

Jumlah dagangan, eksport, import dan lebihan dagangan semuanya mencatatkan trend positif bagi tempoh Januari hingga Julai 2026. Jumlah dagangan meningkat 24.7 peratus kepada RM2.2 trilion, dipacu oleh peningkatan eksport (+29.2%) dan import (+19.8%). Selain itu, lebihan dagangan melonjak 138.7 peratus kepada RM170.5 bilion.

EKSPORT

Eksport pada Julai 2026 meningkat kepada RM193.6 bilion, mencatatkan kenaikan 38.0 peratus

Prestasi Eksport

Eksport Malaysia melonjak 38.0 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM193.6 bilion pada Julai 2026.

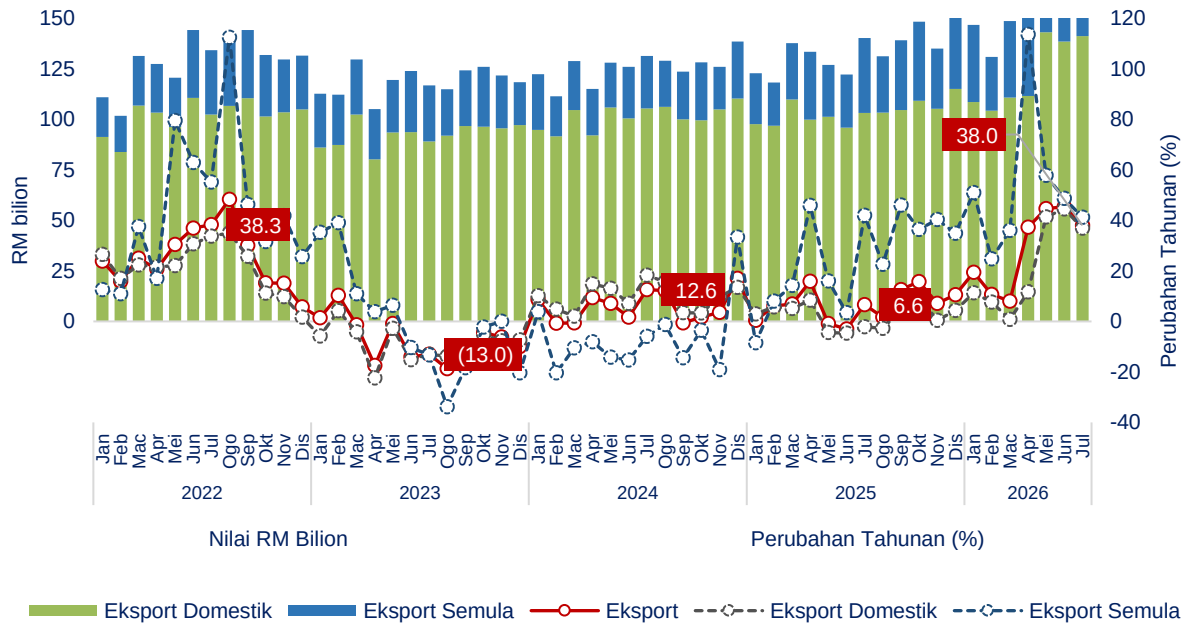
Pertumbuhan eksport yang positif ini didorong terutamanya oleh peningkatan eksport domestik dan eksport semula. Eksport domestik bernilai RM141.3 bilion (73.0%)

daripada jumlah eksport), meningkat 36.9 peratus atau RM38.1 bilion.

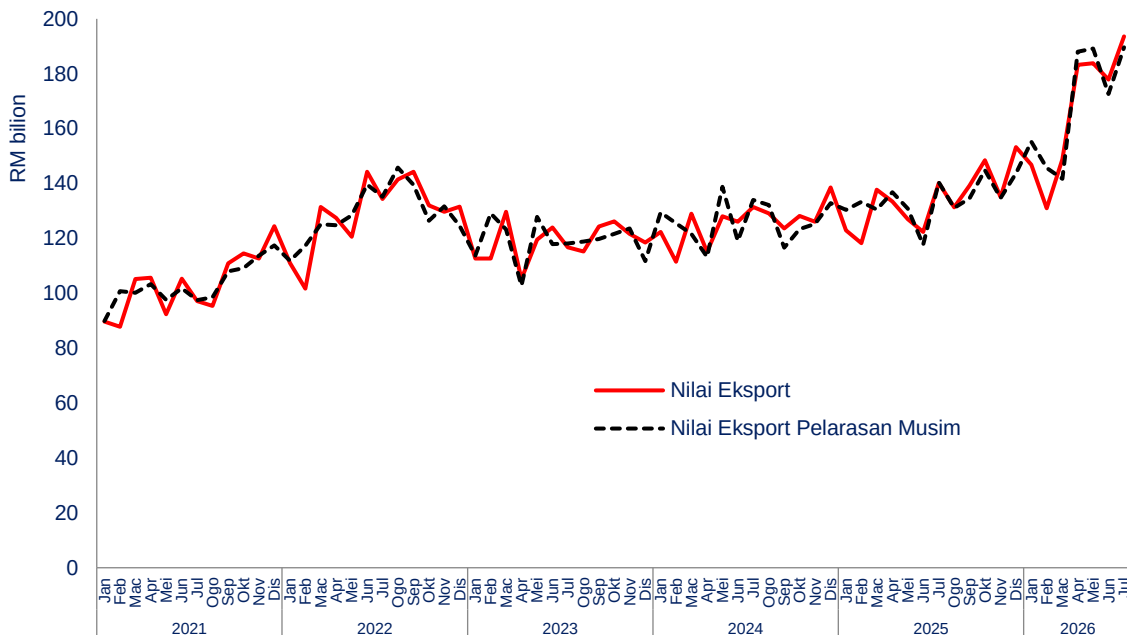
Eksport semula (27.0% daripada jumlah eksport) mencatatkan pertumbuhan 41.2 peratus atau RM15.2 bilion daripada RM37.0 bilion kepada RM52.3 bilion.

Seiring dengan itu, perbandingan bulanan menunjukkan eksport meningkat 8.8 peratus atau RM15.7 bilion daripada RM177.9 bilion kepada RM193.6 bilion. Berdasarkan analisis pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan, eksport meningkat 9.8 peratus kepada RM189.6 bilion.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Negara Destinasi Utama

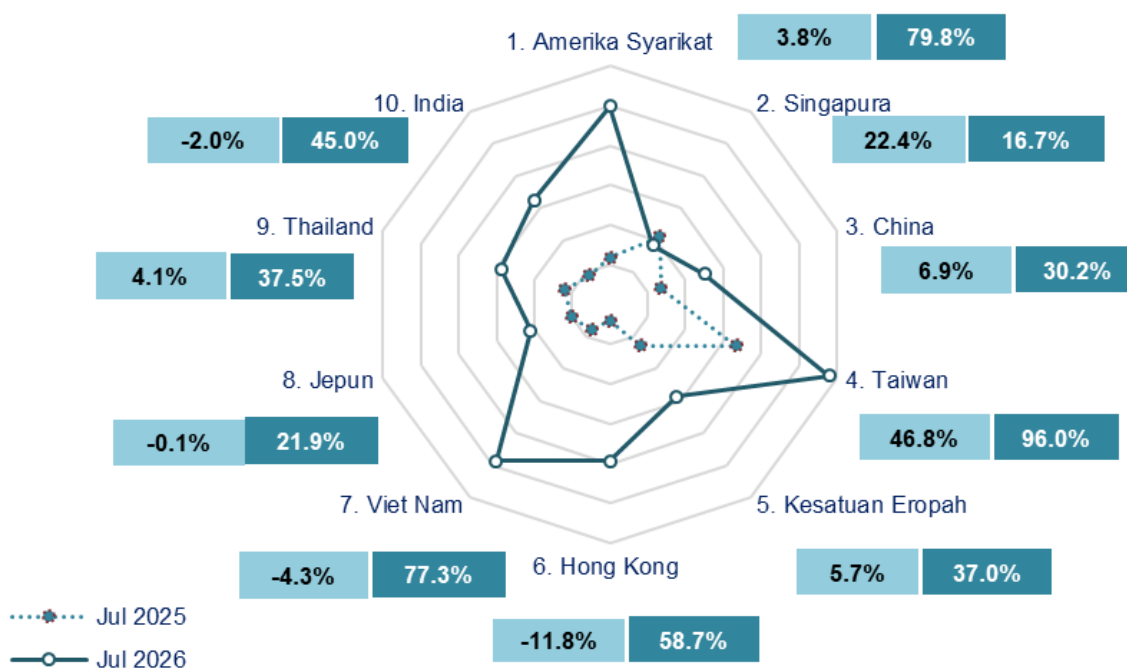
Amerika Syarikat dan Singapura kekal sebagai destinasi utama bagi eksport Malaysia, dengan sumbangan bersama sebanyak 32.7 peratus daripada jumlah eksport pada Julai 2026.

Amerika Syarikat (17.2% daripada jumlah eksport) kekal sebagai destinasi eksport terbesar dengan nilai RM33.2 bilion, melonjak sebanyak 79.8 peratus atau RM14.7 bilion tahun ke tahun. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM8.3 bilion, +77.0%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM5.3 bilion, +403.6%) serta jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM317.3 juta, +35.7%).

Eksport ke Singapura (15.5% daripada jumlah eksport) bernilai RM30.1 bilion, meningkat 16.7 peratus atau RM4.3 bilion. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM2.6 bilion, +16.5%), jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM1.4 bilion, +71.6%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM562.2 juta, +119.5%) serta barangan perkilangan logam (+RM155.7 juta, +30.5%).

Eksport ke semua sepuluh destinasi utama mencatatkan pertumbuhan pada Julai 2026, termasuk Amerika Syarikat, Singapura, China, Taiwan, Kesatuan Eropah, Hong Kong, Viet Nam, Jepun, Thailand dan India.

Eksport ke Negara ASEAN

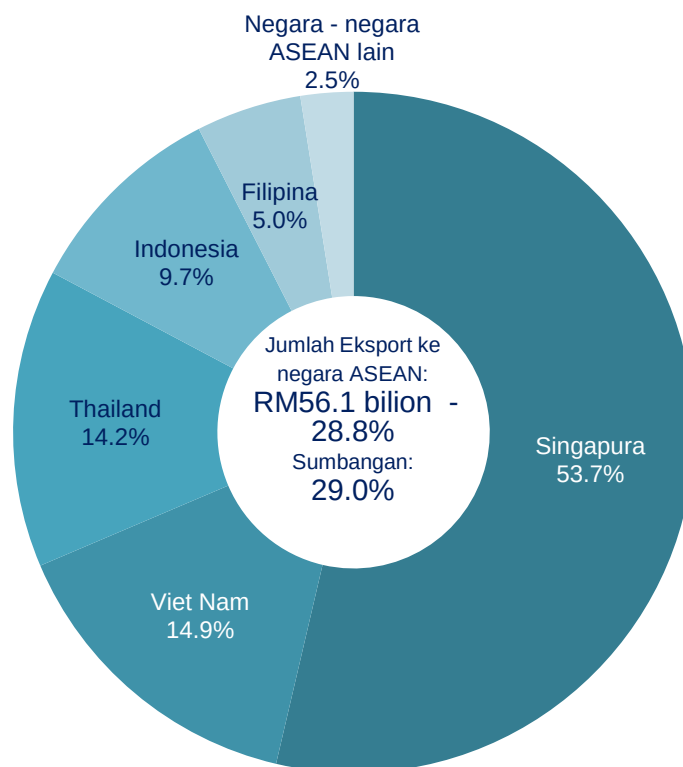
Eksport Malaysia ke negara ASEAN menyumbang 29.0 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, berjumlah RM56.1 bilion, dan meningkat 28.8 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

Peningkatan ini terutamanya disumbangkan oleh eksport barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM7.2 bilion, +35.0%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM2.0 bilion, +199.1%), jentera,

kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM1.6 bilion, +53.9%), keluaran petroleum (+RM1.2 bilion, +25.0%), gas asli cecair (+RM344.7 juta, +88.9%) serta barangan perkilangan logam (+RM329.5 juta, +24.2%).

Eksport Malaysia ke negara ASEAN didominasi oleh Singapura menyumbang 53.7 peratus dengan nilai RM30.1 bilion, meningkat 16.7 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

Eksport barangan perkilangan (89.8% daripada jumlah eksport) mencatatkan peningkatan dua digit 42.6 peratus kepada RM173.9 bilion. Penyumbang utama kepada pertumbuhan positif ini ialah barangan elektrik & elektronik (E&E) (+RM32.3 bilion; +51.0%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM10.5 bilion; +216.0%) serta jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM2.8 bilion; +41.6%).

Eksport hasil perlombongan (4.6% daripada jumlah eksport) meningkat 9.6 peratus kepada RM8.9 bilion, didorong oleh eksport yang lebih

tinggi bagi bijih logam & serpihan logam (+RM1.5 bilion, +115.2%), gas asli cecair (+RM627.2 juta, +14.1%) serta timah (+RM153.4 juta, +76.7%).

Eksport keluaran pertanian (5.0% daripada jumlah eksport) meningkat 5.6 peratus kepada RM9.6 bilion. Peningkatan ini sejajar dengan eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi minyak kelapa sawit & hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (+RM524.6 juta, +7.8%), getah asli (+RM78.5 juta, +26.7%) serta makanan laut, segar, sejuk atau beku (+RM29.0 juta, +14.2%).

Eksport mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

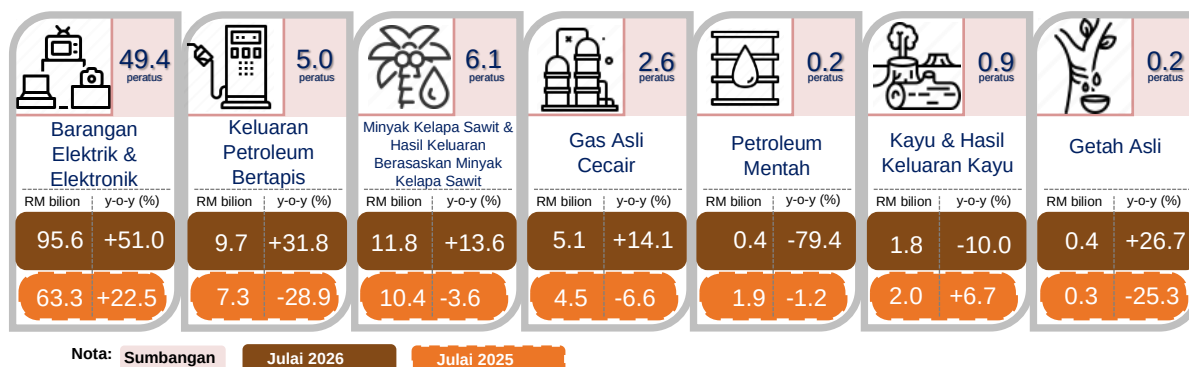
Prestasi eksport menunjukkan pertumbuhan positif pada Julai 2026 bagi produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik (49.4% daripada jumlah eksport) meningkat 51.0 peratus atau RM32.3 bilion kepada RM95.6 bilion;
- Keluaran petroleum bertapis (5.0% daripada jumlah eksport) naik 31.8 peratus atau RM2.3 bilion kepada RM9.7 bilion. Walau bagaimanapun, volum eksport menurun 9.2 peratus manakala purata nilai seunit meningkat 45.2 peratus;
- Getah asli (0.2% daripada jumlah eksport) meningkat 26.7 peratus atau RM78.5 juta kepada RM372.8 juta, selaras dengan kenaikan 14.3 peratus dalam purata nilai seunit dan peningkatan 10.9 peratus dalam volum eksport. Selain itu, harga getah (SMR20) menurun bulan ke bulan dari Jun 2026 daripada RM923.0 kepada RM887.7 (-3.8%);
- Gas asli cecair (2.6% daripada jumlah eksport) meningkat 14.1 peratus atau RM627.2 juta kepada RM5.1 bilion, selaras dengan kenaikan 29.5 peratus dalam purata nilai seunit, meskipun volum eksport menurun 11.9 peratus; dan
- Minyak kelapa sawit & hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (6.1% daripada jumlah eksport) meningkat 13.6 peratus atau RM1.4 bilion kepada RM11.8 bilion. Eksport minyak sawit, komoditi utama dalam kumpulan ini, mencatatkan peningkatan RM412.5 juta (+7.8%). Volum eksport menurun 3.4 peratus, manakala purata nilai seunit meningkat 11.6 peratus. Selain itu, harga domestik minyak sawit mentah meningkat secara marginal bulan ke bulan 0.1 peratus kepada RM4,493.0 per tan metrik.

Walaupun bagaimanapun, pertumbuhan negatif telah direkodkan bagi produk berikut:

- Petroleum mentah (0.2% daripada jumlah eksport) susut 79.4 peratus atau RM1.5 bilion kepada RM393.0 juta. Penurunan ini sejajar dengan pengurangan 83.8 peratus dalam volum eksport, walaupun purata nilai seunit meningkat 27.2 peratus. Selain itu, harga minyak Brent pada Julai 2026 turut menurun bulan ke bulan kepada RM340.5 setong (-2.2%); dan
- Kayu & hasil keluaran kayu (0.9% daripada jumlah eksport) merosot 10.0 peratus atau RM201.0 juta kepada RM1.8 bilion.

Import meningkat dengan ketara 36.4 peratus, naik daripada RM125.5 bilion kepada RM171.1 bilion

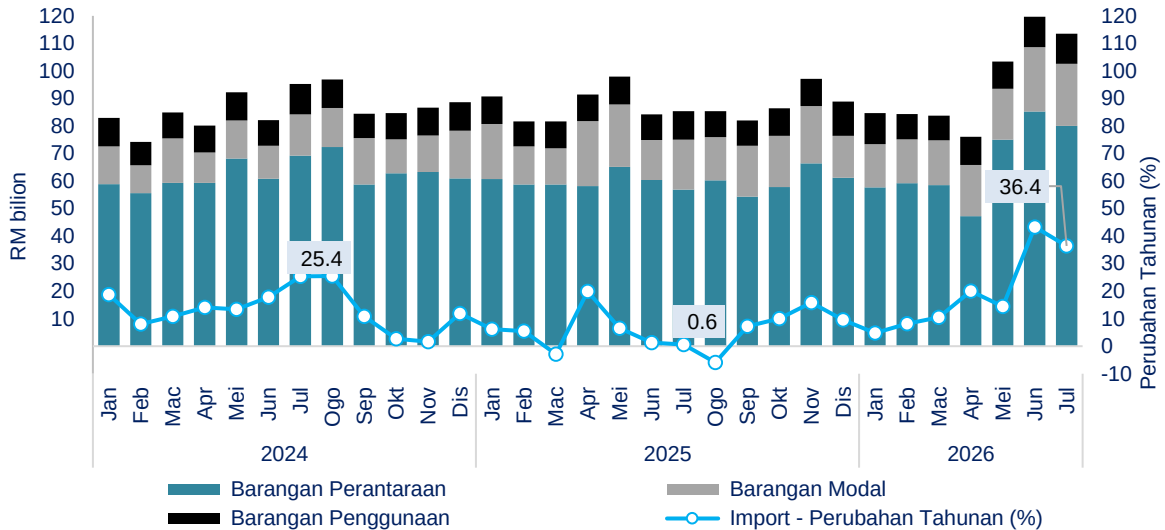
Prestasi Import

Import mencatatkan pertumbuhan dua digit 36.4 peratus atau RM45.7 bilion, meningkat daripada RM125.5 bilion kepada RM171.1 bilion pada Julai 2026. Secara perbandingan bulan ke bulan, import naik 5.5 peratus atau RM9.0 bilion.

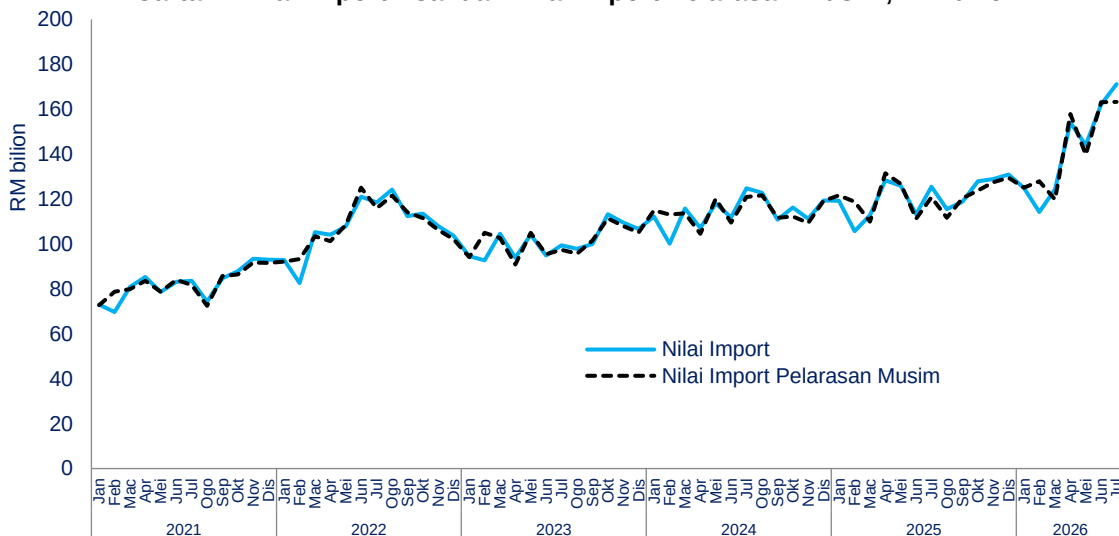
Import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir meningkat tahun ke tahun dengan peningkatan dalam barangan perantaraan (+40.8%), barangan modal (+24.0%) dan barangan penggunaan (+5.2%).

Menurut analisis pelarasan mengikut musim bulan ke bulan, import meningkat secara marginal 0.1 peratus kepada RM163.2 bilion.

Prestasi Import Mengikut Negara Asal Utama

China dan Singapura merupakan dua negara asal utama bagi import Malaysia pada Julai 2026, menyumbang 40.0 peratus daripada jumlah import.

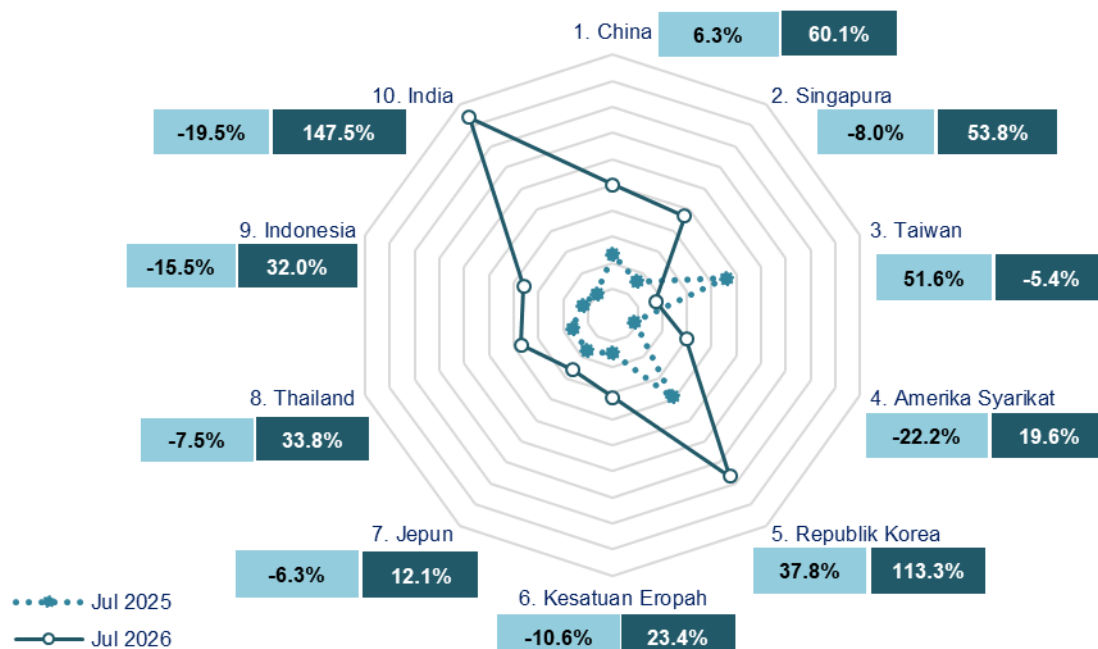
Import dari China (26.8% daripada jumlah import) melonjak 60.1 peratus kepada RM45.8 bilion. Pertumbuhan ini didorong oleh barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM13.3 bilion, +116.4%), diikuti oleh kelengkapan pengangkutan (+RM1.3 bilion, +88.3%) serta barangan perkilangan logam (+RM931.7 juta, +48.8%).

Import dari Singapura (13.3% daripada jumlah import) bernilai RM22.7 bilion, meningkat

53.8 peratus tahun ke tahun. Peningkatan ini terutamanya dipacu oleh import yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM6.1 bilion, +106.7%), jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM512.1 juta, +53.0%) serta keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM339.3 juta, +64.7%).

Import dari sepuluh negara utama mencatatkan pertumbuhan pada Julai 2026, dengan peningkatan ketara dari China, Singapura, Amerika Syarikat, Republik Korea, Kesatuan Eropah, Jepun, Thailand, Indonesia dan India, manakala Taiwan mencatatkan penurunan.

Import dari Negara ASEAN

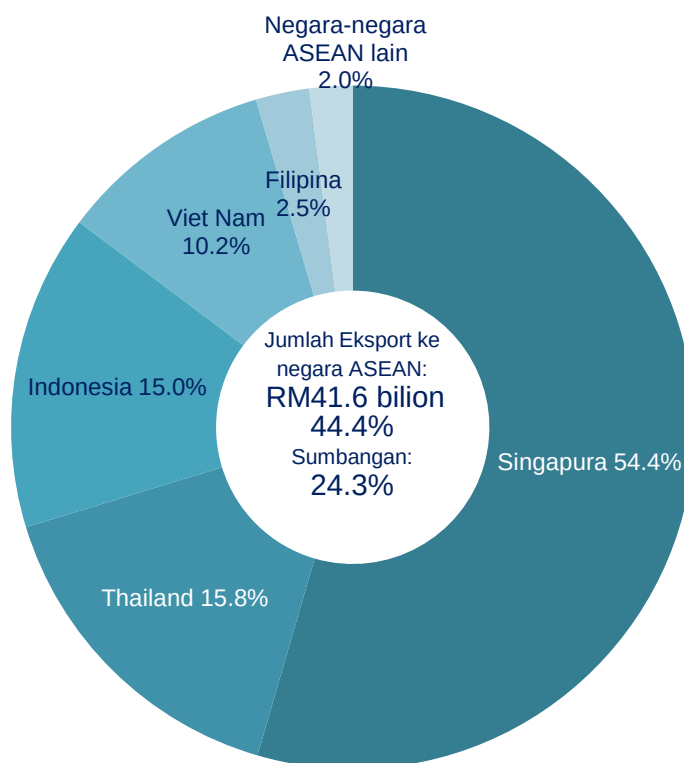
Import dari negara ASEAN menyumbang 24.3 peratus daripada jumlah import, meningkat 44.4 peratus pada Julai 2026 kepada RM41.6 bilion berbanding RM28.8 bilion pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

Peningkatan ini terutamanya didorong oleh import yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik

& elektronik (+RM8.1 bilion, +84.4%), keluaran petroleum (+RM969.0 juta, +21.3%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM746.1 juta, +82.1%) serta hasil galian lain (+RM609.5 juta, +140.6%).

Dalam kalangan negara ASEAN, 54.5 peratus daripada import adalah dari Singapura, melonjak 53.8 peratus kepada RM22.7 bilion.

Carta 9: Peratusan Sumbangan Import dari Negara ASEAN, Julai 2026



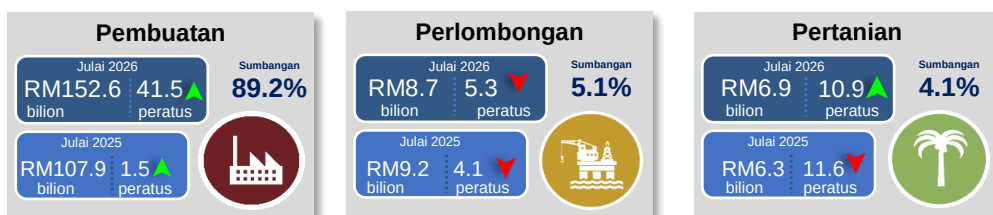
Prestasi Import Mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

Import barangan perkilangan (89.2% daripada jumlah import) meningkat 41.5 peratus daripada RM107.9 bilion kepada RM152.6 bilion. Prestasi ini didorong oleh import yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM28.2 bilion, +58.1%), keluaran petroleum (+RM4.6 bilion, +51.5%), jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM3.5 bilion, +32.5%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM1.7 bilion, +58.2%) serta barangan perkilangan logam (+RM1.6 bilion, +27.7%)

Import hasil perlombongan (5.1% daripada jumlah import) bernilai RM8.7 bilion pada Julai 2026, menurun 5.3 peratus atau RM492.5 juta berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan ini didorong oleh import petroleum mentah yang lebih perlahan (-RM2.5 bilion, -44.4%).

Import keluaran pertanian (4.1% daripada jumlah import) meningkat 10.9 peratus kepada RM6.9 bilion. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh minyak sayuran lain (+RM364.1 juta, +104.5%) serta getah asli (+RM202.3 juta, +48.6%).

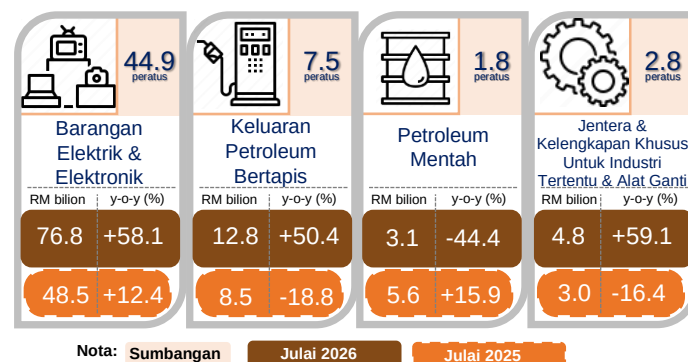
Import mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

Import pada Julai 2026 mencatatkan pertumbuhan berterusan, disokong oleh kemasukan lebih tinggi bagi produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik (44.9% daripada jumlah import), berkembang 58.1 peratus atau RM28.2 bilion kepada RM76.8 bilion;
- Keluaran petroleum bertapis (7.5% daripada jumlah import) meningkat 50.4 peratus atau RM4.3 bilion, seiring dengan kenaikan purata nilai seunit (+45.5%) dan volum import (+3.4%); dan
- Jentera & kelengkapan khusus untuk industri tertentu & alat ganti (2.8% daripada jumlah import), naik 59.1 peratus atau RM1.8 bilion kepada RM4.8 bilion.

Walaupun bagaimanapun, pertumbuhan negatif dicatatkan bagi petroleum mentah (1.8% daripada jumlah import) pada Julai 2026, susut 44.4 peratus atau RM2.5 bilion. Penurunan ini disebabkan oleh pengurangan 52.6 peratus dalam volum import. Namun begitu, purata nilai seunit meningkat 17.4 peratus.

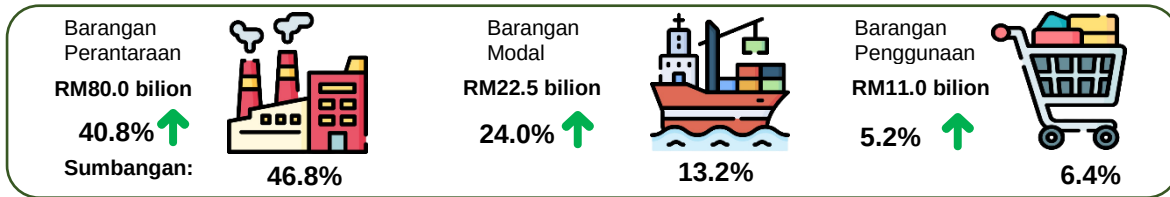

EKSPORT DAN IMPORT MENGIKUT LOKASI

Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM364.7 bilion pada Julai 2026 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM193.6 bilion dan RM171.1 bilion.

Eksport bernilai RM193.6 bilion pada Julai 2026, meningkat RM53.5 bilion (+38.2%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport ini disumbangkan oleh eksport lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM40.4 bilion), Johor (+RM10.1 bilion), Selangor (+RM3.7 bilion), Sarawak (+RM1.6 bilion), Perak (+RM511.9 juta), Kedah (+RM511.0 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM507.0 juta), Kelantan (+RM153.7 juta) dan Negeri Sembilan (+RM35.0 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, eksport menurun di Perlis (-RM31.1 juta), Melaka (-RM156.9 juta), Terengganu (-RM208.8 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM405.1 juta), Pahang (-RM1.0 bilion) dan Sabah (-RM1.9 bilion).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 48.4 peratus, diikuti

oleh Johor (19.1%), Selangor (14.7%), Sarawak (5.2%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (2.9%).

Import pada Julai 2026 meningkat RM45.7 bilion (+36.4%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2025. Peningkatan import ini disumbangkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM21.8 bilion), Selangor (+RM7.8 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM7.3 bilion), Johor (+RM7.3 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.5 bilion), Sarawak (+RM810.2 juta), Pahang (+RM789.5 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM594.3 juta), Sabah (+RM268.5 juta), Perak (+RM180.3 juta) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM145.6 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, import menurun di Terengganu (-RM4.0 juta), Kelantan (-RM24.7 juta), Perlis (-RM43.9 juta) dan Melaka (-RM1.3 bilion).

Pulau Pinang mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 30.0 peratus, diikuti oleh Selangor (23.4%), Johor (22.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (9.6%) dan Kedah (3.9%).

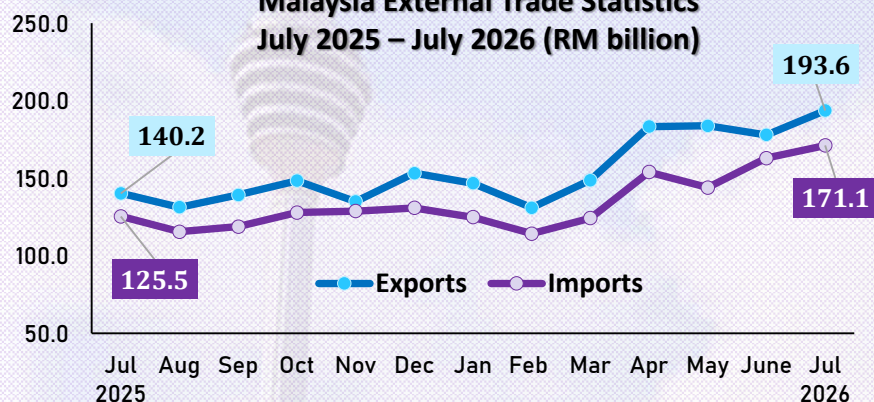

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MALAYSIA'S TRADE PERFORMANCE, JULY 2026

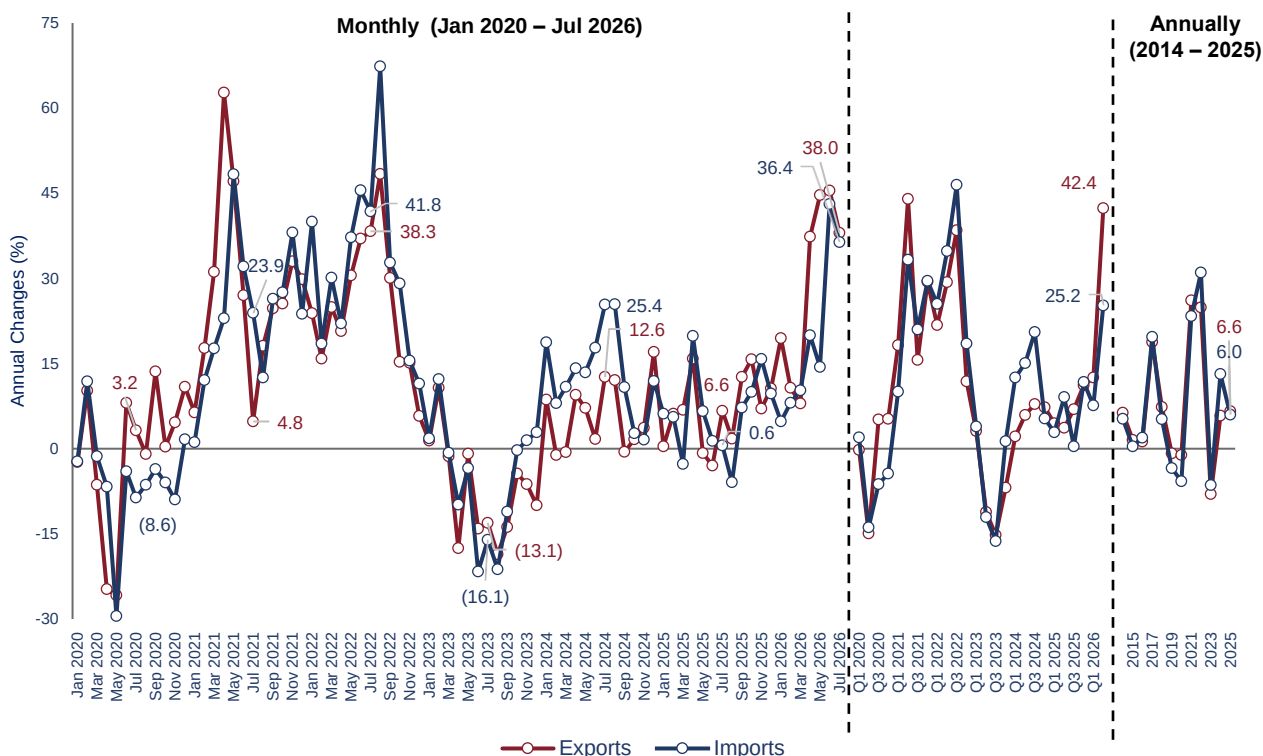
Malaysia's trade performance sustained a positive trend in July 2026, consistent with the double digit rise in export (+38.0%) and imports (+36.4%), year-on-year (y-o-y). Total trade increased by 37.3 per cent or RM99.0 billion, reached RM364.7 billion.

Furthermore, trade balance rose by 51.9 per cent or RM7.7 billion from RM14.8 billion to RM22.5 billion as compared to the same period in the previous year.

The monthly comparison shows that exports, imports, total trade and trade surplus increased by 8.8 per cent, 5.5 per cent, 7.3 per cent and 42.4 per cent respectively.

Total trade, exports, imports and trade surplus all showed positive trends from January to July 2026. Total trade rose by 24.7 per cent to RM2.2 trillion, driven by increases in exports (+29.2%) and imports (+19.8%). In addition, trade surplus escalated by 138.7 per cent to RM170.5 billion.

EXPORTS

Exports in July 2026 rose to RM193.6 billion, reflecting a 38.0 per cent increase

Performance of Exports

Malaysia's exports surged by 38.0 per cent y-o-y to RM193.6 billion in July 2026.

The positive export growth was mainly contributed by increases in domestic exports and re-exports. Domestic exports valued at RM141.3 billion

(73.0% of total exports), increased by 36.9 per cent or RM38.1 billion.

Re-exports (27.0% of total exports) registered a growth of 41.2 per cent or RM15.2 billion from RM37.0 billion to RM52.3 billion.

Concurrently, monthly comparison showed exports up by 8.8 per cent or RM15.7 billion from RM177.9 billion to RM193.6 billion. Based on

month-on-month (m-o-m) seasonally adjusted terms analysis, exports up by 9.8 per cent to RM189.6 billion.

Chart 2: Domestic Exports, Re-Exports (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

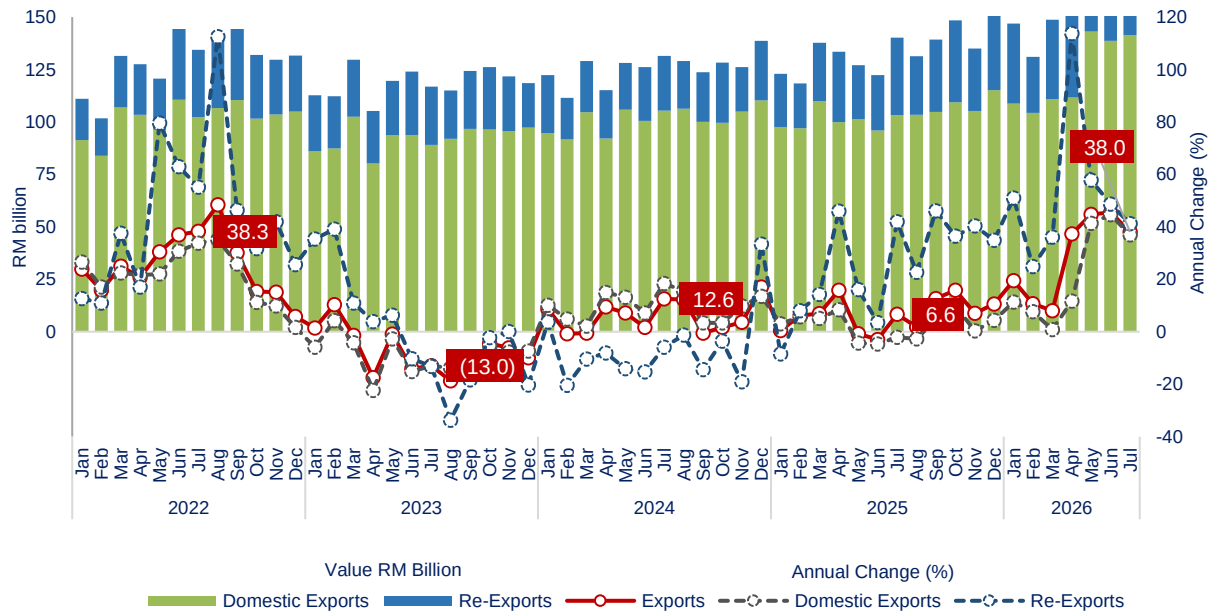
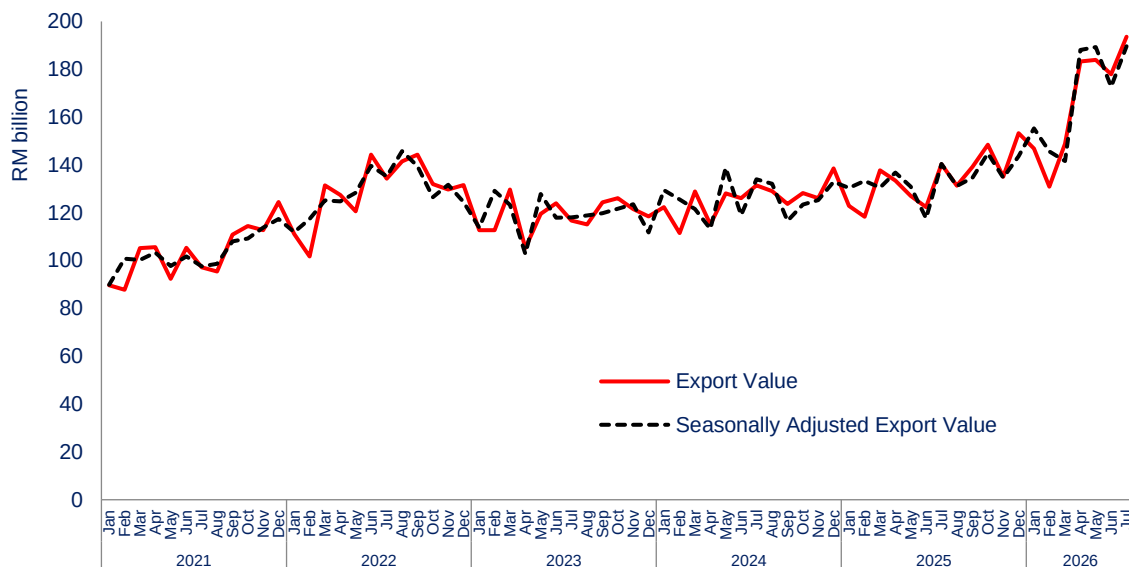


Chart 3: Actual Export Value and Seasonally Adjusted Export Value, RM billion



Export Performance for Major Country of Destination

The United States and Singapore remained the main destinations for Malaysia's export, collectively accounting for 32.7 per cent of total exports in July 2026.

The United States (17.2% of total exports) remained largest export destination with a value of RM33.2 billion, jumped by 79.8 per cent or RM14.7 billion, y-o-y. This increase was due to

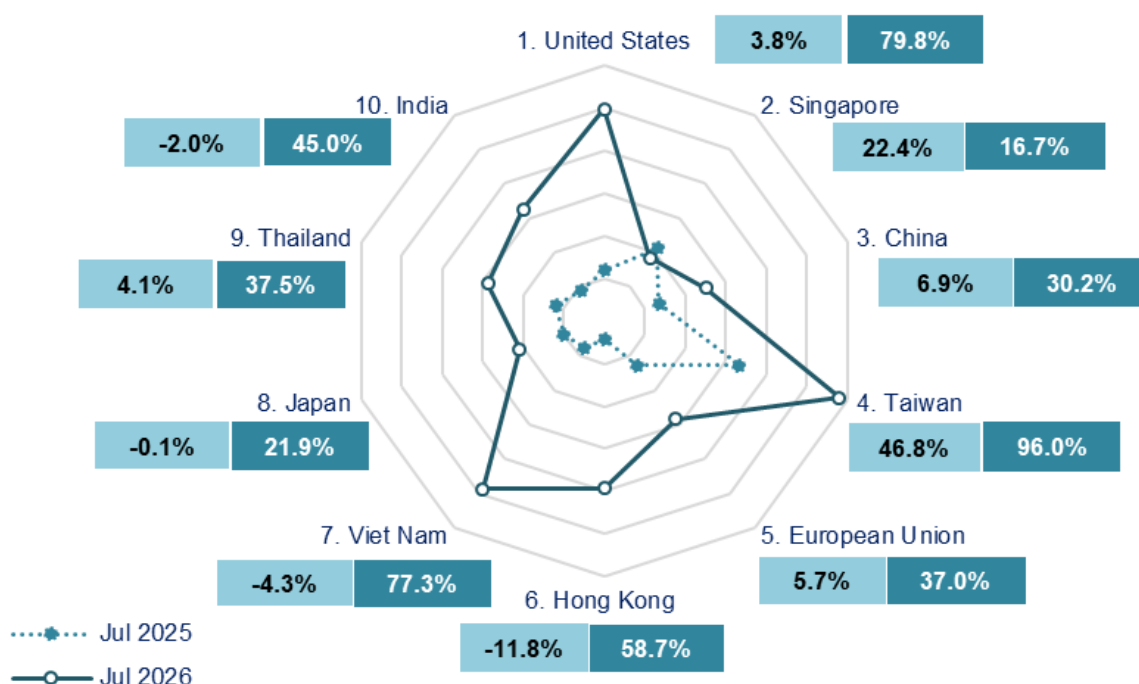
higher exports of electrical & electronic (E&E) products (+RM8.3 billion, +77.0%), other manufactures (+RM5.3 billion, +403.6%) and machinery, equipment & parts (+RM317.3 million, +35.7%).

Exports to Singapore (15.5% of total exports) valued at RM30.1 billion, up by 16.7 per cent or RM4.3 billion. The increase was driven by higher exports of E&E products (+RM2.6 billion,

+16.5%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM1.4 billion, +71.6%), other manufactures (+RM562.2 million, +119.5%) and manufacture of metal (+RM155.7 million, +30.5%).

Exports to all ten major destinations registered growth in July 2026, led by the United States, Singapore, China, Taiwan, the European Union, Hong Kong, Viet Nam, Japan, Thailand and India.

Exports to ASEAN Countries

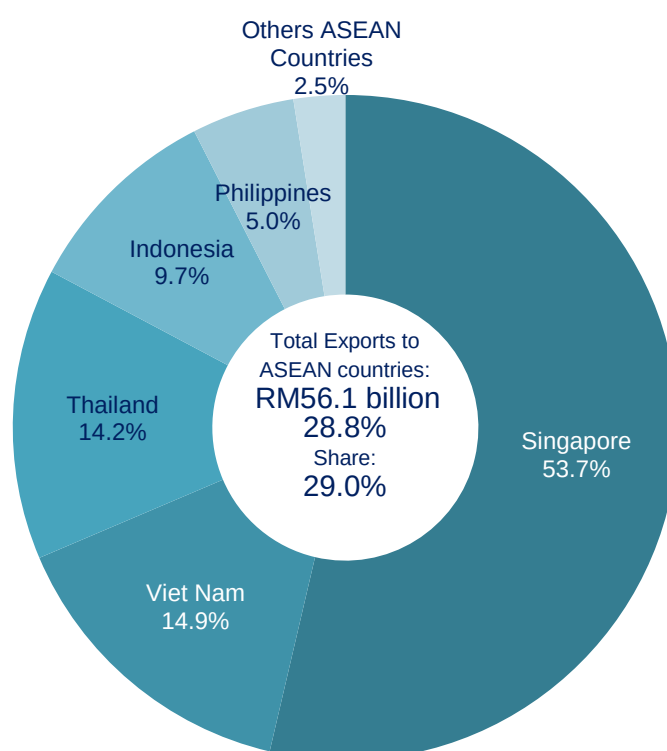
Malaysia's exports to ASEAN countries accounted for 29.0 per cent of total exports, amounting to RM56.1 billion, and increase of 28.8 per cent compared with the same month of the previous year.

This increase was mainly contributed by exports of E&E products (+RM7.2 billion, +35.0%), other manufactures (+RM2.0 billion, +199.1%), machinery, equipment & parts

(+RM1.6 billion, +53.9%), petroleum products (+RM1.2 billion, +25.0%), liquefied natural gas (LNG) (+RM344.7 million, +88.9%) and manufacture of metal (+RM329.5 million, +24.2%).

Malaysia's exports to ASEAN were dominated by Singapore, contributing 53.7 per cent with a value of RM30.1 billion, an increase of 16.7 per cent compared with the previous year.

Export Performance for Economic Sectors

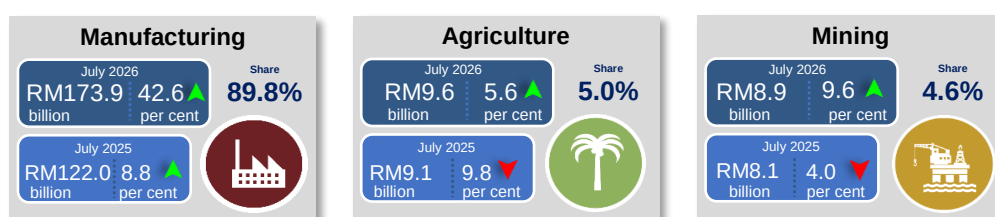
Exports of manufactured goods (89.8% of total exports) registered double digit growth of 42.6 per cent to RM173.9 billion. The main contributors to positive growth were E&E products (+RM32.3 billion; +51.0%), other manufactures (+RM10.5 billion; +216.0%) and machinery, equipment & parts (+RM2.8 billion; +41.6%).

Exports of mining products (4.6% of total exports) rose by 9.6 per cent to RM8.9 billion, caused by higher exports of metalliferous ores & metal scrap (+RM1.5 billion, +115.2%), LNG

(+RM627.2 million, +14.1%) and tin (+RM153.4 million, +76.7%).

Exports of agricultural products (5.0% of total exports) rose by 5.6 per cent to RM9.6 billion. The increase was consistent with the higher exports of palm oil & palm-based agriculture products (+RM524.6 million, +7.8%), natural rubber (+RM78.5 million, +26.7%) and seafood, fresh, chilled or frozen (+RM29.0 million, +14.2%).

Exports of Selected Major Products

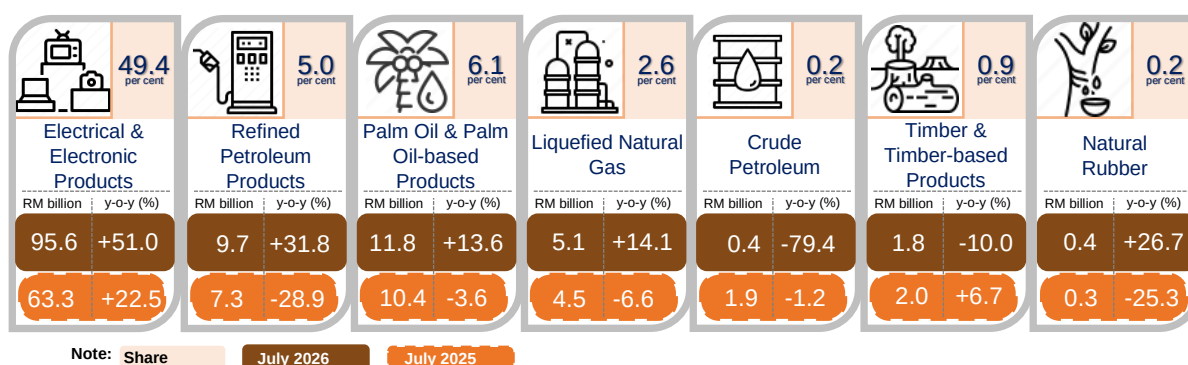
Export performance showed positive growth in July 2026 for the following products:

- E&E products (49.4% of total exports) increased by 51.0 per cent or RM32.3 billion to RM95.6 billion;
- Refined petroleum products (5.0% of total exports) up by 31.8 per cent or RM2.3 billion to RM9.7 billion. However, export volume decreased 9.2 per cent and average unit value increased by 45.2 per cent;
- Natural rubber (0.2% of total exports) rose by 26.7 per cent or RM78.5 million to RM372.8 million, in line with a 14.3 per cent increase in average unit value and a 10.9 per cent rise in export volume. In addition, rubber prices (SMR20) declined m-o-m from June 2026, from RM923.0 to RM887.7 (-3.8%).
- LNG (2.6% of total exports) rose by 14.1 per cent or RM627.2 million to RM5.1 billion, in line with a 29.5 per cent increase in average unit value, despite an 11.9 per cent decline in export volume; and
- Palm oil and palm-based products (6.1% of total exports) rose by 13.6 per cent or RM1.4 billion to RM11.8 billion. Exports of palm oil, the principal commodity within this group, registered an increase of RM412.5 million (+7.8%). Export volume declined by 3.4 per cent, while the average unit value rose by 11.6 per cent. In addition, the domestic price of crude palm oil increased m-o-m marginally by 0.1 per cent to RM4,493.0 per metric tonne.

However, negative growth was recorded for the following products:

- Crude petroleum (0.2% of total exports) fell by 79.4 per cent or RM1.5 billion to RM393.0 million. This was in line with an 83.8 per cent decrease in export volume, despite a 27.2 per cent increase in average unit value. In addition, Brent oil prices in July 2026 also decreased m-o-m to RM340.5 per barrel (-2.2%); and
- Timber & timber-based products (0.9% of total exports) contracted by 10.0 per cent or RM201.0 million to RM1.8 billion.

IMPORTS

Imports rose sharply by 36.4 per cent, climbing from RM125.5 billion to RM171.1 billion

Performance of Imports

Imports recorded double-digit growth of 36.4 per cent or RM45.7 billion, rising from RM125.5 billion to RM171.1 billion in July 2026. On a m-o-m basis, imports up by 5.5 per cent or RM9.0 billion.

analysis, imports increased marginally by 0.1 per cent to RM163.2 billion.

Imports by End Use increased, y-o-y, with an increase in intermediate goods (+40.8%), capital goods (+24.0%) and consumption goods (+5.2%).

According to the m-o-m seasonally adjusted terms

Chart 6: Imports Value (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

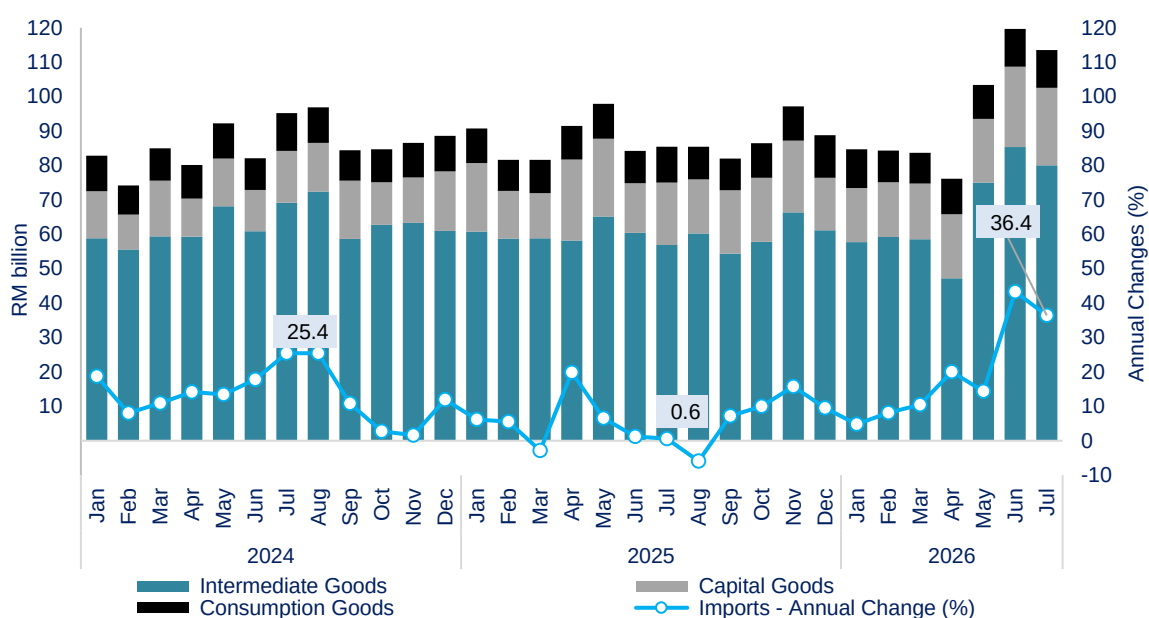
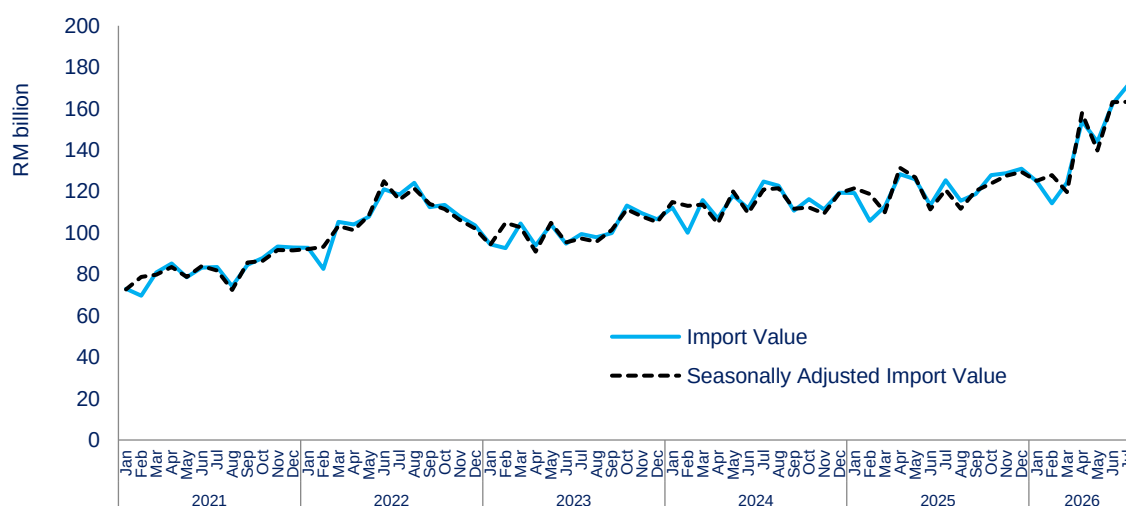


Chart 7: Actual Import Value and Seasonally Adjusted Imports Value, RM billion



Import Performance for Major Country of Origin

China and Singapore were Malaysia's two major countries of origin for imports in July 2026, accounting for 40.0 per cent of total imports.

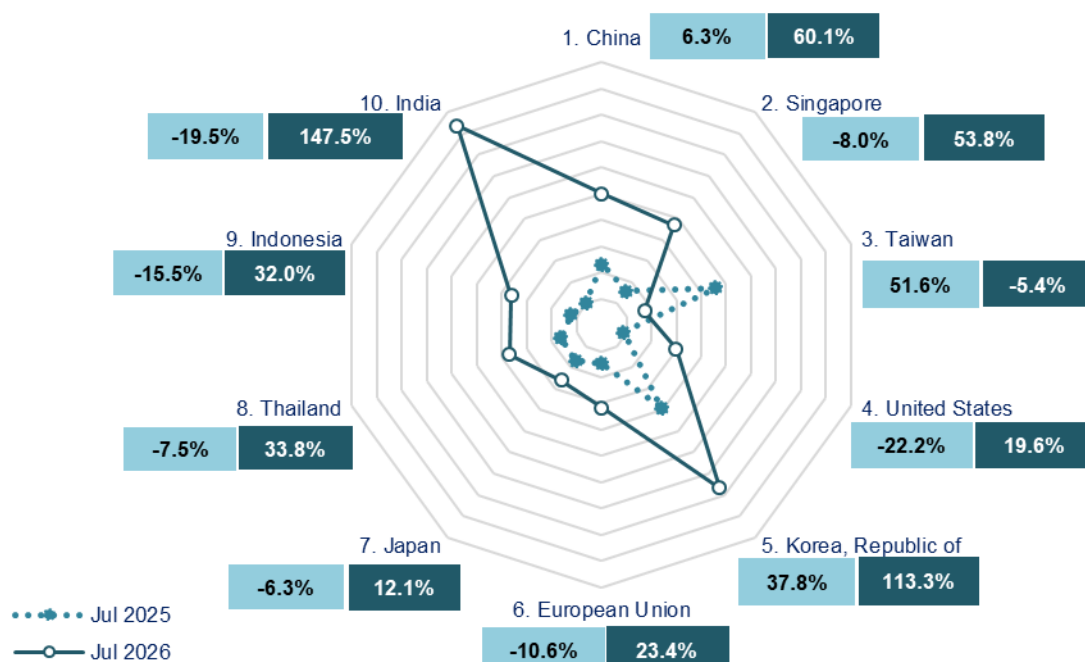
Imports from China (26.8% of total imports) surged by 60.1 per cent to RM45.8 billion. This growth was driven by E&E products (+RM13.3 billion, +116.4%), followed by transport equipment (+RM1.3 billion, +88.3%) and manufacture of metal (+RM931.7 million, +48.8%).

Imports from Singapore (13.3% of total imports) were valued at RM22.7 billion, an increase of

53.8 per cent, y-o-y. This expansion was primarily driven by increased imports of E&E products (+RM6.1 billion, +106.7%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM512.1 million, +53.0%) and other manufactures (+RM339.3 million, +64.7%).

Imports from the top ten major countries recorded growth in July 2026, with notable increases from China, Singapore, the United States, the Republic of Korea, the European Union, Japan, Thailand, Indonesia and India, while Taiwan registered a decline.

Imports from ASEAN Countries

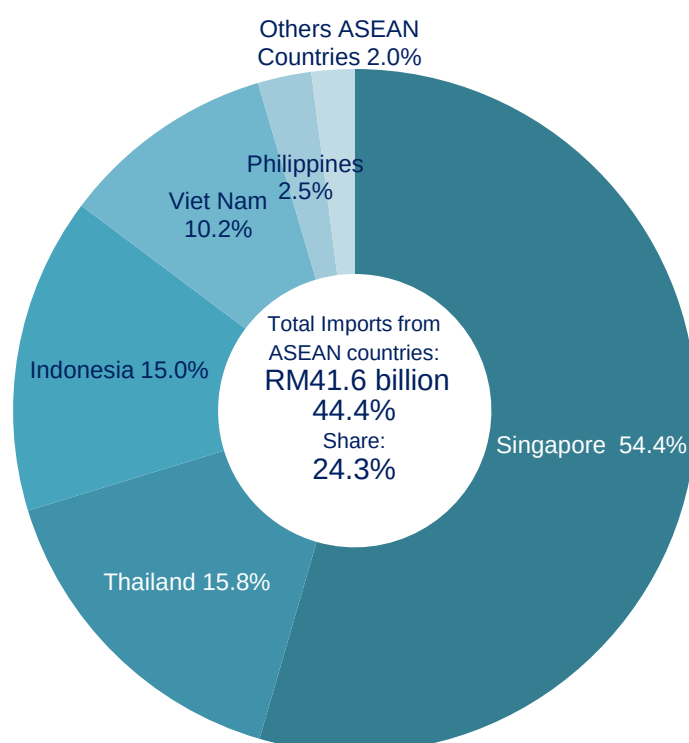
Imports from ASEAN countries accounted for 24.3 per cent of total imports, increased by 44.4 per cent in July 2026 to RM41.6 billion compared to RM28.8 billion in the same month of the previous year.

The increase was mainly driven by higher imports of E&E products (+RM8.1 billion, +84.4%), petroleum products (+RM969.0 million, +21.3%), other manufactures

(+RM746.1 million, +82.1%), and other mining (+RM609.5 million, +140.6%).

Among ASEAN countries, 54.5 per cent of imports were from Singapore, surged by 53.8 per cent to RM22.7 billion.

Chart 9: Percentage Share of Imports from ASEAN Countries, July 2026



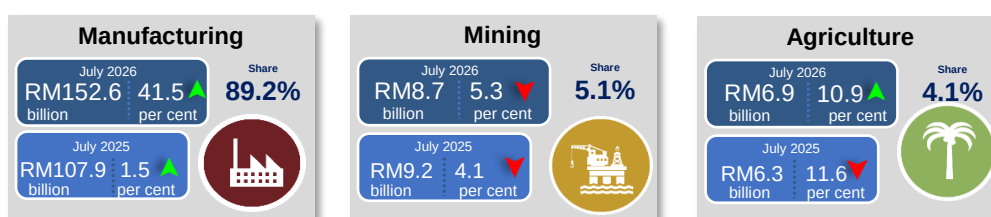
Import Performance for Economic Sectors

Imports of manufactured goods (89.2% of total imports), increased 41.5 per cent from RM107.9 billion to RM152.6 billion. This performance was driven by higher imports of E&E products (+RM28.2 billion, +58.1%), petroleum products (+RM4.6 billion, +51.5%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM3.5 billion, +32.5%), other manufactures (+RM1.7 billion, +58.2%) and manufacture of metal (+RM1.6 billion, +27.7%).

Imports of mining products (5.1% of total imports) valued at RM8.7 billion in July 2026, decreased by 5.3 per cent or RM492.5 million compared to the previous year. The decreased was driven by slower import of crude petroleum (-RM2.5 billion, -44.4%).

Imports of agricultural products (4.1 per cent of total imports) rose 10.9 per cent to RM6.9 billion. This increase was driven by other vegetables oil (+RM364.1 million, +104.5%) and natural rubber (+RM202.3 million, +48.6%).

Exhibit 3: Imports by Sector, July 2025 and July 2026



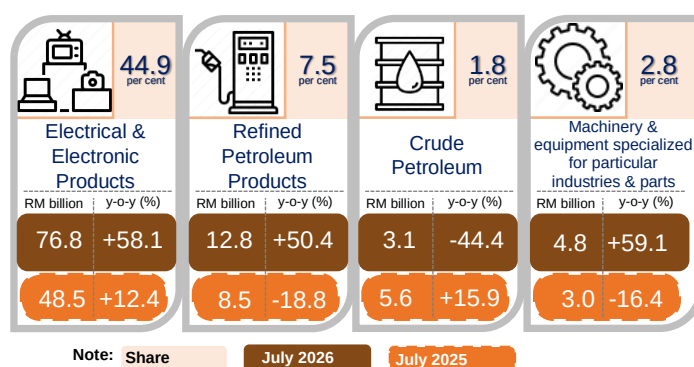
Imports of Selected Major Products

Imports in July 2026 registered sustained growth, supported by stronger inflows of the following products:

- E&E products (44.9% of total imports), expanded 58.1 per cent or RM28.2 billion to RM76.8 billion; value (+45.5%) and import volume (+3.4%); and
- Refined petroleum products (7.5% of total imports) increased by 50.4 per cent or RM4.3 billion, consistent with the rise in average unit
- Machinery & equipment specialised for particular industries & parts (2.8% of total imports), up by 59.1 per cent or RM1.8 billion to RM4.8 billion.

However, negative growth was recorded for crude petroleum (1.8% of total imports) in July 2026, which declined by 44.4 per cent or RM2.5 billion. This decline was attributable to a 52.6 per cent decrease in import volume. However, the average unit value rose by 17.4 per cent.

Exhibit 4: Imports of Selected Major Product, July 2025 and July 2026



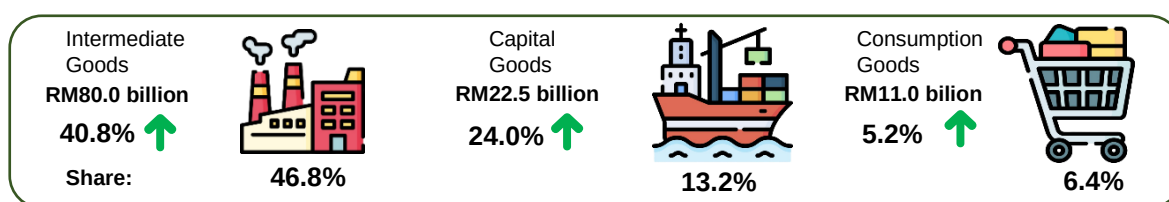
Imports by Broad Economic Categories (BEC) & End Use Classification

Imports increased by 36.4 per cent to RM171.1 billion, with the three main import categories by End Use contributing 66.3 per cent to total imports as follows:

Intermediate goods, valued at RM80.0 billion (46.8% of total imports), expanded by 40.8 per cent, following a sharp rise in imports of parts and accessories of capital goods (except transport equipment) (+RM16.4 billion, +95.8%).

Capital goods, valued at RM22.5 billion (13.2% of total imports), increased by 24.0 per cent, driven by imports of capital goods (except transport equipment) (+RM3.7 billion, +21.8%).

Consumption goods, amounting to RM11.0 billion (6.4% of total imports) grew by 5.2 per cent or RM541.7 million, driven by imports of durables goods (+RM469.4 million, +27.7%) and non-durables goods (+RM367.2 million, +17.0%).

Malaysia's total trade for July 2026 amounted to RM364.7 billion with exports and imports recording RM193.6 billion and RM171.1 billion, respectively.

Exports was valued at RM193.6 billion in July 2026, increased RM53.5 billion (+38.2%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in Pulau Pinang (+RM40.4 billion), Johor (+RM10.1 billion), Selangor (+RM3.7 billion), Sarawak (+RM1.6 billion), Perak (+RM511.9 million), Kedah (+RM511.0 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM507.0 million), Kelantan (+RM153.7 million) and Negeri Sembilan (+RM35.0 million). However, exports decreased in Perlis (-RM31.1 million), Melaka (-RM156.9 million), Terengganu (-RM208.8 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM405.1 million), Pahang (-RM1.0 billion) and Sabah (-RM1.9 billion).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a contribution of 48.4 per cent, followed by

Johor (19.1%), Selangor (14.7%), Sarawak (5.2%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (2.9%).

Imports in July 2026 increased RM45.7 billion (+36.4%) as compared to the same month in year 2025. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in Pulau Pinang (+RM21.8 billion), Selangor (+RM7.8 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM7.3 billion), Johor (+RM7.3 billion), Kedah (+RM1.5 billion), Sarawak (+RM810.2 million), Pahang (+RM789.5 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM594.3 million), Sabah (+RM268.5 million), Perak (+RM180.3 million) and W.P. Labuan (+RM145.6 million). However, imports decreased in Terengganu (-RM4.0 million), Kelantan (-RM24.7 million), Perlis (-RM43.9 million) and Melaka (-RM1.3 billion).

Pulau Pinang dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 30.0 per cent, followed by Selangor (23.4%), Johor (22.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (9.6%) and Kedah (3.9%).

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NOTA TEKNIKAL

1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan ini mengandungi Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan dengan import dan eksport (termasuk eksport semula) mengikut seksyen dan Bahagian barangan, negara asal dan yang dituju, barangan utama / terpilih, Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) dan penggunaan akhir serta data pelarasan musim.

Statistik ini juga meliputi Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan import dan eksport di peringkat negeri (mengikut pintu keluar dan masuk) dengan seluruh dunia.

2. OBJEKTIF

Objektif utama penerbitan ini untuk membekalkan statistik tentang prestasi perdagangan Malaysia dengan negara-negara lain dari segi nilai dan volum barangan. Penerbitan ini menjadi input kepada penggubalan dasar, rujukan penting dalam pelaksanaan keputusan, pemantauan dan penilaian keberkesanan program pembangunan negara serta penyelidikan.

3. BIDANG DAN LIPUTAN

3.1 Malaysia menggunakan 'sistem perdagangan umum' dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri. Di bawah sistem ini, sempadan negara digunakan sebagai sempadan perangkaan. Semua barang yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari negara (selain pengecualian yang disebutkan di para 11 di bawah) direkodkan, sama ada barangan itu tertakluk kepada kelulusan tertentu atau pun tidak. Barangan yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari gudang-gudang simpanan kastam, Zon Bebas direkodkan di dalam perangkaan ini.

3.2 Butir-butir tentang kapal dan kapal terbang dagangan dan persendirian turut **diambil kira** jika ianya diimport atau dieksport sebagai barang yang dibeli, dijual atau disewa (kewangan) tidak kira sama ada ianya tiba atau berlepas dengan kuasanya sendiri.

3.3 Eksport mengikut lokasi adalah berdasarkan negeri asal (iaitu negeri dalam Malaysia di mana peringkat akhir pengeluaran atau pembuatan berlaku). Sebaliknya, import mengikut lokasi berdasarkan negeri destinasi terakhir (iaitu negeri di mana barangan dikeluarkan daripada kawalan Kastam, tetapi tidak semestinya di mana barangan itu akhirnya dijual atau digunakan).

Ketepatan dalam pelaporan negeri asal dan negeri destinasi akhir dalam dokumentasi oleh pihak Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) memberi kesan kepada kualiti statistik perdagangan barangan mengikut lokasi. Dalam hal ini, lokasi pemuatan/pelepasan akan digunakan sebagai proksi bagi negeri asal/destinasi akhir yang sebenar.

3.4 Aktiviti eksport dan import yang berlaku di kawasan Supra (merangkumi aktiviti pengeluaran yang melangkaui pusat kepentingan ekonomi utama bagi mana- mana negeri) atau periklanan yang dilakukan oleh ejen penghantar tidak termasuk dalam penyusunan statistik import dan eksport mengikut lokasi. Nilai import atau eksport bagi W.P. Kuala Lumpur adalah termasuk W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SUMBER DATA

- 4.1 Pengiklanan import dan eksport (*hard/soft copy*) yang diluluskan oleh Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) dan Pihak Berkuasa Zon Bebas.
- 4.2 Keterangan mengenai pengiraman bungkusan pos/courier yang dibekalkan oleh Pos Malaysia Berhad.
- 4.3 Penyata dan pengiklanan eksport mengenai *bunkers* dan *stores* yang dibekalkan kepada kapal terbang yang dikeluarkan/diluluskan oleh syarikat-syarikat petroleum.
- 4.4 Penyata penjualan barangan yang dibekalkan oleh pengusaha-pengusaha kedai bebas cukai.
- 4.5 Penyata jualan dan belian elektrik yang dikeluarkan oleh syarikat pengeluar

5. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

- 5.1 Penyusunan statistik ini selaras dengan garis panduan dalam **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** daripada Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu.

- 5.2 **Import**

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai import apabila ianya dibawa **masuk** ke dalam negara, sama ada terus ataupun disimpan di gudang dalam kawasan yang dikawalselia oleh pihak Kastam tanpa mengira sama ada barangan tersebut adalah untuk kegunaan sendiri, diproses, digunakan dalam pembuatan ataupun untuk dieksport semula ke negara lain.

- 5.3 **Eksport**

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan atau diimport untuk dieksport semula) dianggap sebagai eksport apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

- 5.4 **Eksport Domestik**

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan) dianggap sebagai eksport domestik apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

- 5.5 **Eksport Semula**

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai eksport semula apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara dalam keadaan seperti mana ianya **diimport** tanpa mengalami sebarang **perubahan**. Proses membungkus semula, menyisih atau menggred tidak dikira sebagai satu proses perubahan.

- 5.6 **Imbangan Perdagangan**

Imbangan perdagangan ialah perbezaan antara nilai eksport dan import. Apabila eksport melebihi import **lebih** direkodkan manakala **defisit** pula dicatatkan apabila import melebihi eksport.

6. ASAS PENILAIAN

- 6.1 **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** digunakan sebagai asas penilaian untuk semua transaksi barangan.
- 6.2 **Nilai** ditunjukkan dalam Ringgit Malaysia.
- 6.3 **Import** dinilai mengikut **cif (cost, insurance and freight – kos, insuran dan tambang)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengimport termasuk semua perbelanjaan insuran dan tambang semasa dalam perjalanan **tetapi** kos pemunggahan dari alat pengangkutan tidak diambil kira **kecuali** kos tersebut ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.
- 6.4 **Eksport** dinilai mengikut **fob (free on board)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengeksport termasuk semua perbelanjaan pengangkutan ke sempadan tersebut, duti eksport dan duti lain yang perlu dibayar serta kos untuk memunggah barang ke atas alat pengangkutan **kecuali** kos terakhir itu ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.

7. KLASIFIKASI BARANG DAGANGAN

- 7.1 Penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (barangan) bagi bulan rujukan Januari 2022 hingga Mei 2022 menggunakan Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) 2017 yang juga dikenali sebagai Perintah Duti Kastam (PDK) 2017. Bermula bulan rujukan Jun 2022, HS2022 yang juga dikenali sebagai PDK2022 telah digunakan menggantikan HS2017. Walau bagaimanapun, pengelasan mengikut Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 masih digunakan dengan penyelarasan bersesuaian.
- 7.2 Selepas perbincangan dan perundingan dengan Lembaga Minyak Sawit Malaysia (MPOB), pilihan kod untuk minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit adalah berdasarkan minyak kelapa sawit tulen dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit serta kod-kod yang berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (melebihi 50%).

8. VOLUM

Volum merupakan berat bersih atau ukuran lain bagi barangan itu, tidak termasuk kontena. Jika barangan itu dilaporkan dalam pelbagai unit ukuran, maka unit ukuran tersebut tidak dapat diselaraskan. Oleh itu, hanya nilai barangan sahaja dipaparkan.

9. NEGARA ASAL DAN YANG DITUJU

- 9.1 **Negara asal** merujuk kepada lokasi / negara barangan yang dibawa masuk ke dalam negara. Jika maklumat negara asalnya tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi barangan melalui Singapura, maka import berkenaan dilaporkan dari Singapura.
- 9.2 **Negara yang dituju** merujuk kepada destinasi/negara akhir barangan itu dijangka akan digunakan. Bagi barangan yang dihantar dengan *optional bill of lading*, negara di mana pelabuhan pertama diketahui akan dilaporkan sebagai negara yang dituju. jika maklumat negara yang dituju tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi

barangan yang dieksport melalui Singapura, maka eksport berkenaan dilaporkan ke Singapura.

- 9.3 **Bagi bunkers dan stores yang dibekalkan kepada kapal dan kapal terbang,** negara yang dituju ditentukan mengikut lokasi/negara residen syarikat pengendali kapal atau kapal terbang tersebut.

10. TRANSAKSI BERNILAI RENDAH (TBR)

Mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2023, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM1,000' bagi Semenanjung Malaysia telah diliputi dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri dan transaksi bernilai 'di bawah RM5,000' telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar. Manakala mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2024, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM2,000' untuk Sabah dan Sarawak telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar.

11. PENGECUALIAN

Barang-barang yang tidak termasuk dalam Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri adalah:

- 11.1 barangan transit, iaitu pengangkutan barangan di bawah kawalan kastam dari sebuah stesen kastam ke sebuah stesen kastam yang lain. Misalnya, pergerakan barangan dari Thailand ke Singapura melalui Semenanjung Malaysia dan pergerakan barangan dari sebuah zon bebas ke sebuah zon bebas yang lain di Malaysia. Barang dalam transit yang diliputi *through bills of lading* / *air-way bills* juga termasuk di bawah kategori ini;
- 11.2 barangan pindah kapal, iaitu pemindahan barangan di bawah kawalan pihak yang berkuasa, dari suatu pengangkutan yang digunakan untuk pengimportan kepada suatu pengangkutan lain yang digunakan untuk pengeksportan **dalam** kawasan kawalan pihak berkuasa yang sama. Stesen ini merupakan stesen pengimportan dan juga pengeksportan. Sebagai contoh, barangan dari Myanmar yang dibawa masuk ke kawasan kastam Pulau Pinang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke negara ketiga (misalnya ke Hong Kong). Satu lagi contoh adalah barangan dari India yang dibawa masuk melalui Kawasan Bebas Pelabuhan Klang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke Negara Ketiga (misalnya ke Sepanyol);
- 11.3 emas (kewangan) dan wang kertas serta duit syiling dalam edaran;
- 11.4 barangan yang diimport dan dieksport oleh, atau bagi pihak perkhidmatan diplomatik dan Angkatan Tentera Bukan Malaysia;
- 11.5 filem wayang untuk disewa;
- 11.6 kemasukan barangan untuk sementara waktu dan ianya tertakluk kepada pengeksportan semula dalam keadaan yang sama. Barangan ini diimport untuk tujuan tertentu dan dieksport semula dalam masa yang telah ditentukan tanpa mengalami sebarang perubahan, kecuali susut nilai yang biasa. Contohnya, binatang dan motokar bagi pertunjukan sarkas, perlumbaan, pertandingan dan pameran serta peralatan-peralatan bunyi untuk pertunjukan muzikal;
- 11.7 *barges (lash)* yang digunakan untuk mengangkut kargo dari kapal ke pantai atau sebaliknya;

- 11.8 ikan dan hasil laut lain yang dibawa oleh kapal laut berdaftar di Malaysia dan mendarat terus dari laut.
 - 11.9 bekas untuk menyimpan sesuatu barang/benda, silinder, botol dan seumpamanya yang dinyatakan sebagai 'dikembalikan';
 - 11.10 bekalan dan minyak yang dibekalkan kepada kapal laut dan kapal terbang yang dikendalikan oleh operator yang menetap di Malaysia;
 - 11.11 semua sampel, pemberian dan bahan untuk ujian atau analisa tanpa mengira nilai transaksi yang terlibat;
 - 11.12 tiket loteri & toto;
 - 11.13 pergerakan barangan di antara Negeri di dalam Semenanjung Malaysia tanpa mengira cara pengangkutan serta pergerakan barangan melalui **darat** di antara Sabah dan Sarawak;
 - 11.14 disket atau CD-ROM yang mengandungi perisian komputer dan / atau data, dibuat mengikut pesanan, audio dan videotapes yang mengandungi perakaman asal dan customised blueprints, dll; dan
 - 11.15 barangan untuk **dibaiki**.
12. **KEMASKINI TERHADAP NEGARA-NEGARA KESATUAN EROPAH (EU)**
- 12.1 Mulai 1 Julai 2013, Croatia menganggotai EU. Perkembangan ini telah dirangkumkan di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Julai 2013 dan seterusnya.
 - 12.2 Bermula 1 Februari 2020, United Kingdom secara rasminya keluar daripada EU. Perkembangan ini telah diambil kira di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Februari 2020 dan seterusnya.
13. Bermula rujukan Januari 2022, Statistik Eksport Produk Halal mengikut Pengelasan Barangan disusun daripada hasil gabungan pangkalan data Perdagangan Luar Negeri dengan senarai syarikat berstatus halal yang diperoleh daripada Jabatan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (JAKIM).
14. **PELARASAN MUSIM**
- Data siri masa adalah amat berguna untuk ahli ekonomi, pembuat dasar dan polisi serta penganalisis siri masa untuk mengenal pasti ciri-ciri penting siri ekonomi seperti arah, *turning point* dan konsistensi antara penunjuk ekonomi yang lain. Kadang-kadang ciri ini sukar untuk diperhatikan kerana pergerakan bermusim. Oleh itu, sekiranya kesan bermusim boleh disingkirkan, perilaku data siri ini dapat dilihat dengan lebih baik. Anggaran dan penyingkiran kesan bermusim dipanggil pelarasan bermusim.
- Pelarasan bermusim adalah satu proses untuk mengenal pasti dan menyingkirkan bentuk pola bermusim yang biasa berlaku dalam tempoh satu tahun, yang mungkin juga merangkumi pengaruh dari kesan cuti yang bergerak dan hari bekerja/ berdagang bagi suatu tempoh. Objektif utama proses ini adalah untuk menyerlahkan dasar arah aliran dan pergerakan-pergerakan jangka pendek dalam siri ini.

Di Malaysia, kebanyakan data siri masa terjejas oleh kesan bermusim. Oleh itu, untuk menghapuskan kesan bermusim dan juga melaras musim data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia, pakej pelarasan bermusim standard, X-12 ARIMA telah digunakan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan, Malaysia.

Data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia kerap dipengaruhi oleh perayaan agama utama seperti Aidilfitri bagi umat Islam, Tahun Baru Cina untuk kaum Cina dan Deepavali untuk kaum India. Tarikh perayaan-perayaan ini tetap mengikut tahun lunar tetapi berbeza-beza mengikut kalendar Gregorian. Oleh itu, untuk menganggar dan menyingkirkan kesan cuti yang bergerak dari data siri masa, satu prosedur telah dibangunkan iaitu *Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia* (SEAM).

Kaedah SEAM digunakan untuk membuang kesan bermusim bagi data Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia. Pelarasan musim dibuat ke atas data bulanan bagi jumlah eksport dan import. Data siri pelarasan bermusim untuk tiga tahun sebelumnya akan disemak setiap tahun apabila data untuk 12 bulan lengkap.

15. KLASIFIKASI MENGIKUT KATEGORI EKONOMI UMUM (BEC)

15.1 Klasifikasi mengikut Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) diwujudkan adalah untuk meringkaskan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (PPLN) mengikut kelas komoditi ekonomi yang luas. Di samping itu, ia dibentuk sebagai pengantara untuk menukarkan data PPLN yang disusun berdasarkan HS kepada kategori penggunaan akhir yang lebih bermakna dalam konteks Sistem Akaun Negara (SNA) iaitu barang modal, barang pengantara dan barang penggunaan. Penyusunan ini membolehkan data PPLN dihubungkan dengan perangkaan ekonomi umum seperti perangkaan akaun negara dan perangkaan perindustrian bagi tujuan penganalisan ekonomi di peringkat negara, kawasan dan dunia.

15.2 BEC termasuk sembilan belas kategori asas. Setiap kategori BEC didefinisikan dari segi bahagian, kumpulan, sub-kumpulan dan tajuk HS. Setiap tajuk asas HS ditetapkan secara khusus kepada satu kategori BEC. Penetapan ini dibuat berasaskan penggunaan akhir yang utama bagi sesuatu komoditi dalam setiap tajuk HS, walaupun terdapat banyak komoditi yang didagangkan di peringkat antarabangsa boleh dikelaskan kepada pelbagai kegunaan.

15.3 Statistik dalam Jadual 17: Import Mengikut Penggunaan Akhir dijana berdasarkan import tertangguh iaitu import tolak eksport semula. Angka tersebut boleh menjadi negatif bagi bulan rujukan tertentu jika eksport semula melebihi daripada import.

16. KERAHSIAAN DATA

Data perdagangan telah disusun di bawah peruntukan ***Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)***. Akta ini mensyaratkan bahawa kandungan penyata individu adalah sulit. Selaras dengan peruntukan tersebut, hanya angka agregat diterbitkan.

17. DASAR PINDAAN

Data pada bulan semasa adalah sementara (provisional) dan tertakluk kepada pindaan sehingga ia dimuktamadkan. Pindaan dibuat sekiranya wujud maklumat tambahan. Bermula tahun 2021, data muktamad akan dikeluarkan 7 (tujuh) bulan selepas tahun rujukan.

Perangkaan muktamad perdagangan luar negeri bagi tahun rujukan 2021 telah digunakan mulai bulan rujukan Jun 2022.

18. PEMBUNDARAN

Jumlah-jumlah kecil, apabila dicampurkan, **mungkin** tidak bersamaan dengan jumlah besar disebabkan oleh pembundaran.

TECHNICAL NOTES

1. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics of Malaysia's External trade (merchandise) pertaining to imports and exports (including re-exports) by sections, divisions and groups of commodity, country of origin and destination, selected/major commodities, Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification and end-use as well as seasonally adjusted data.

This publication also contains statistics of Malaysia's External Trade (merchandise) on imports and exports at the state level (based on exit and entry points) with the rest of the world.

2. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of compiling Malaysia's external trade statistics is to provide information on Malaysia's trade performance vis-a-vis the rest of the world in terms of volume and value of merchandise goods. The trade statistics, therefore, serve as a tool in assisting the government in formulating policies and monitoring economic performance as well as for development planning. The data can also be used by the private sector and individuals for specific purposes such as for economic projection and analysis.

3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

3.1 *The 'general trade system' of recording is adopted in compiling Malaysian external trade statistics. Under this system, the national boundary of the country is used as the statistical frontier. All goods entering or leaving the country (except specific exclusions mentioned in paragraph 11 below) are recorded, whether or not such goods are subject to clearance. Accordingly, goods entering or leaving customs bonded warehouses, Free Zones are recorded in the statistics.*

3.2 *Details of commercial and private ships and aircraft are also **included** in these statistics if they were imported or exported as goods purchased, sold or leased (financial) whether or not they arrived or departed under their own power.*

3.3 *Exports by location based on the state of origin (i.e. state of Malaysia where the final stage of production or manufacturing occurs). On the other hand, imports by location based on the state of final destination (i.e. the state of Malaysia in which goods are released from Customs controls, but not necessarily where they are ultimately sold or consumed).*

The accuracy in reporting the actual State of origin and State of final destination on Royal Malaysian Customs Department documentation affects the quality of State merchandise trade statistics. In this case, the location of loading/discharge may be used as a proxy for the actual state of origin/final destination.

3.4 *Export and import activities that are taking place in the Supra area (including production activities beyond the centre of predominant economic interest for any state) or declarations made by the agent are not included in the compilation of imports and*

exports statistics by location. Imports or exports value for the W.P. Kuala Lumpur includes the W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SOURCE OF DATA

- 4.1 Import and export declarations (hard/soft copy) approved by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) and Free Zone Authorities.
- 4.2 Particulars on postal/courier packages are provided by Pos Malaysia Berhad.
- 4.3 Statements and export declarations on bunkers and stores supplied to aircraft issued/approved by the petroleum companies.
- 4.4 Statements on goods sold are supplied by the operators of duty-free shops.
- 4.5 Statements on the sale and purchase of electricity issued by 'power producer company'.

5. CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- 5.1 The compilation of these statistics is in accordance with the guidelines of the **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** from the United Nations.

5.2 Imports

Goods are regarded as imports when they are brought **into** the country either directly or into bonded warehouses, irrespective of whether such goods are for consumption, to be processed, use in manufacturing or subsequent re-exports to other countries.

5.3 Exports

Goods (locally produced or manufactured or imported for subsequent re-exports) are regarded as exports when they are taken **out** of the country.

5.4 Domestic Exports

Goods (locally produced or manufactured) are regarded as domestic exports when they are taken **out** of the country.

5.5 Re-exports

Goods are regarded as re-exports when they are taken **out** of the country in the same form as they were **imported** without any **transformation**. Re-packing, sorting or grading processes are not considered as part of the transformation process.

5.6 Balance of Trade

The balance of trade is the difference between the value of exports and imports. When exports exceed imports it is recorded as a **surplus** while a **deficit** is registered when imports exceed exports.

6. BASIS OF VALUATION

- 6.1 The **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** is used as the basis of valuation for all transactions of goods.
- 6.2 **Values** are shown in Malaysian Ringgit.
- 6.3 **Imports** are valued on a **c.i.f. (cost, insurance and freight)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the importing country, including all charges for transport and insurance whilst in transit **but** excluding the cost of unloading from the carrier **unless** it is borne by the carrier.
- 6.4 **Exports** are valued on a **f.o.b. (free on board)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the exporting country, including all costs of transporting the goods to the statistical / customs frontier, export and other duties payable as well as the cost of loading the goods onto the carrier **unless** the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

7. CLASSIFICATION OF COMMODITIES

- 7.1 The compilation of External Trade Statistics (merchandise) for the reference month of January 2022 to May 2022 used the Harmonised Commodity description and Coding system (HS) 2017, also known as Customs Duties Order (PDK) 2017. Commencing from the reference month of June 2022, HS2022 also known as PDK2022 has been used to replace HS2017. However, Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 is still in use with appropriate updates.
- 7.2 After discussion and consultation with Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB), the selection of codes for palm oil and palm oil-based products is based on pure palm oil and palm oil-based products as well as those codes which are predominantly palm oil and palm oil-based products (more than 50%).

8. VOLUME

Volume, where shown, represent the nett weight or other measurement of the goods exclusive of packing containers. Where a commodity item comprises different kinds of commodities for which a common unit of measurement cannot be used, only values are shown.

9. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND DESTINATION

- 9.1 **Country of origin** refers to the location/country of goods brought into the country. If the country of origin information cannot be determined, for example, for goods via Singapore, then the import is reported from Singapore.
- 9.2 **Country of destination** refers to the final destination/country where the goods are expected to be used. For goods sent with a country where the first port is known will be reported as the country of destination. if the destination country information cannot be determined, for example, for goods exported through Singapore, then the exports is reported to Singapore.
- 9.3 **For bunkers and stores supplied to ships and aircraft**, the country of destination is determined according to the country of residence of the operator of the ship or aircraft.

10. LOW VALUE TRANSACTIONS (LVT)

With effect from reference month of January 2023, single transactions with a value 'below RM1,000' for Peninsular Malaysia have been covered in the compilation of External Trade Statistics and transactions worth 'below RM5,000' have been reported according to the pledged HS code. Meanwhile with effect from reference month of January 2024, single transactions with a value 'below RM2,000' for Sabah and Sarawak have been reported according to the pledged HS code.

11. EXCLUSIONS

Classes of goods excluded from external trade statistics are: -

- 11.1 transit cargo, that is goods transported under customs control from one Customs office to another. Examples are the movement of goods from Thailand bound for Singapore through Peninsular Malaysia and the movement of goods within Malaysia from one free trade zone to another. All goods in transit covered through bills of lading/air-way bills are also included in this category;
- 11.2 transshipment cargo, that is goods transferred under the control of the relevant authorities from the importing means of transport to the exporting means of transport **within** the area of control of the same authorities, which is the office of both importation and exportation. For example, goods from Myanmar brought into the Pulau Pinang Customs area for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Hong Kong). Another example is goods from India brought into the Port Klang Free Zone for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Spain);
- 11.3 gold bullion (monetary) and issued currency notes and coins;
- 11.4 goods imported and exported by, or on behalf of, diplomatic services and non- Malaysian Armed Forces;
- 11.5 exposed cinematographic films on a rental basis;
- 11.6 temporary admission of goods subject to re-exportation in the same state. Such goods must be imported for a specific purpose and must be intended for re- exportation within a specified period without having undergone any change except normal depreciation.

Examples are animals and cars for circuses, races, competitions and exhibitions and instruments/sound equipment for musical performances;

- 11.7 *barges (lash) used for the transportation of cargo from vessel to shore or vice- versa;*
- 11.8 *fish and other marine produce landed by Malaysian registered vessels direct from the sea;*
- 11.9 *containers, cylinders, bottles, crates and the like specified as returnable;*
- 11.10 *stores and fuel supplied to ships and aircraft handled by operators of Malaysian residence;*
- 11.11 *samples, gifts and specimens for test or analysis, irrespective of value;*
- 11.12 *toto & lottery tickets;*
- 11.13 *movement of goods by any mode of transportation between states within Peninsular Malaysia and movement of goods by **land** between Sabah and Sarawak;*
- 11.14 *diskettes or CD-ROMs with stored computer software and/or data, developed to order, audio and videotapes containing original recordings and customised blueprints, etc; and*
- 11.15 *goods for **repair**.*

12. **UPDATE TO EUROPEAN UNION (EU) COUNTRIES**

- 12.1 *From 1st July 2013, Croatia has joined EU. This development has been incorporated in the publication from July 2013 onwards.*
- 12.2 *Starting from 1st February 2020, the United Kingdom officially leaves the EU. This development has been considered in the publication from February 2020 onwards.*

- 13. *Commencing from January 2022, statistics on Exports of Halal Products by Commodity Classification is compiled from an integrated external trade database with list of Halal certified companies which obtained from the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM).*

14. **SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT**

Time-series data are very useful for economists, policy & decision makers and time-series analysts to identify the important features of economic series such as direction, turning point and consistency between other economic indicators. Sometimes this feature is difficult to observe because of seasonal movements. Thus, if the seasonal effect can be removed, the behaviour of the series would be better viewed. The estimation and removal of the seasonal effects is called seasonal adjustment.

Seasonal adjustment is a process to identify and to remove the regular within-a-year seasonal pattern, which may also include the influences of moving holidays and working / trading days effect in each period. The ultimate objective of the process is to highlight the underlying trends and short-term movements in the series.

In Malaysia, most of the time series data are affected by seasonal effects. Hence, to eliminate the seasonal effect as well as to seasonally adjust the Malaysian economic time series data, a standard seasonal adjustment package, X-12 ARIMA was used by Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

Malaysian economic time series data are often affected by major religious festivals such as Eid-ul Fitr of the Muslims, Chinese New Year of the Chinese and Deepavali of the Indians. These festivals' dates are fixed according to the lunar year but vary according to the Gregorian calendar. Therefore, to estimate and remove moving holiday effect from time-series data, a procedure was developed, namely Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia (SEAM).

The SEAM method is used to remove seasonal effect for Malaysia's merchandise external trade data. The seasonal adjustment is carried out on monthly total exports and total imports. The seasonally adjusted series data for the preceding three years are revised each year when the figures for complete 12 months become available.

15. CLASSIFICATION BY BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES (BEC)

- 15.1** *The BEC was originally devised mainly for the summarization of data on international trade by large economic classes of commodities. In addition, it was designed to serve as a means for converting external trade data compiled on the HS into end use categories that are meaningful within the framework of the System of National Accounts (SNA) namely capital goods, intermediate goods, and consumption goods. This aggregation permits external trade statistics to be considered jointly with other sets of general economic statistics such as national accounts and industrial statistics for national, regional or world level economic analysis.*
- 15.2** *The BEC includes nineteen basic categories. Each category of the BEC is defined in terms of divisions, groups, sub-groups and basic headings of HS. Each HS basic heading is allocated entirely to one BEC category. The allocation is done on the basis of the main end use of the commodities in each HS basic heading, although it is recognised that many commodities that are traded internationally may be put to a variety of uses.*
- 15.3** *The statistics in Table 17: Imports by End Use are generated based on retained imports i.e. imports minus re-exports. The figure could be negative for a reference month if re-exports are higher than imports.*

16. CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS

The trade data statistics have been compiled under the provisions of the **Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)**. The Act stipulates that the contents of individual returns are **confidential**. In conformity with the said stipulation, only aggregated figures are published.

17. REVISION POLICY

Data for the current month is provisional and subject to revision until it is finalised. Revisions are made if there are additional information. Starting 2021, final data will be released by 7 (seven) months after reference year. Final external trade statistics for reference year 2021 was used from reference month June 2022.

18. ROUNDING

Sub-totals **may** not add up exactly to totals due to rounding.
