





Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI) recorded a positive growth of 1.4 per cent in June 2021 and surged 22.6 per cent in June 2021

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) rose **1.4 per cent** in June 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year. The growth of IPI in June 2021 was underpinned by the expansion of **10.3 per cent** in Mining index. Meanwhile, the Manufacturing and Electricity indices fell **0.2 per cent** and **4.8 per cent** respectively.

The Manufacturing sector output based on year-on-year comparison decreased by **0.2 per cent** in June 2021 after recording a growth of 29.8 per cent in May 2021. The main subsectors contributed to the Manufacturing sector in June 2021 were Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products (**19.0%**), Electrical & Electronics Products (**8.4%**) and Textiles, Wearing Apparel, Leather Products & Footwear (**-14.5%**). The export-oriented industries driven the growth of the Manufacturing sector by **8.7 per cent** while domestic-oriented industries decreased by **20.8 per cent**.

The Mining sector output grew **10.3 per cent** in June 2021 as compared to the same period of the previous year. The expansion was influenced by the increase in Natural Gas index (**13.4%**) and Crude Oil & Condensate index (**6.3%**). The Electricity sector output contracted **4.8 per cent** in June 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year.

The IPI for the second quarter 2021 soared **22.6 per cent** as compared to the same period of the previous year. The growth was steered by the Manufacturing, Mining and Electricity indices which increased by **26.3 per cent**, **15.1 per cent** and **8.6 per cent** respectively.
