MONTHLY RUBBER STATISTICS MALAYSIA, DECEMBER 2016

Natural Rubber (NR) increased by 5.2 per cent in December 2016

Natural rubber (NR) production increased by **5.2** per cent in December 2016 to **69,727** tonnes as compared to November 2016. The main contributor of NR production is from smallholding sector with **92.9** per cent.

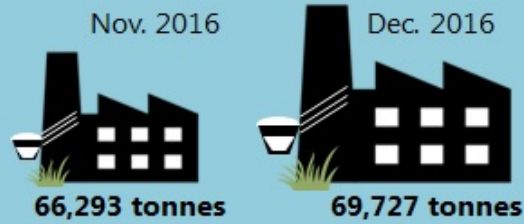
Average monthly price of Latex Concentrate was **615.88** sen per kilogramme, rose by **77.43** sen per kilogramme from the previous month. For Standard Malaysian Rubber 20, the average monthly price also went up by **127.39** sen per kilogramme to **839.55** sen per kilogramme.

Exports of NR in December 2016 recorded at **61,380** tonnes increased by **12.4** per cent as compared to the previous month. Five main destinations of NR exports were China, Germany, Iran, U.S.A and Finland.

Meanwhile, domestic consumption of NR dropped by **0.9** per cent to **40,838** tonnes within the same period. Rubber gloves industry remains as a main domestic consumer of NR at **74.9** per cent.

At the end of December 2016, level of NR stocks increased by **10.4** per cent to **203,451** tonnes.

More than **90%** of NR production was from the smallholding sector.



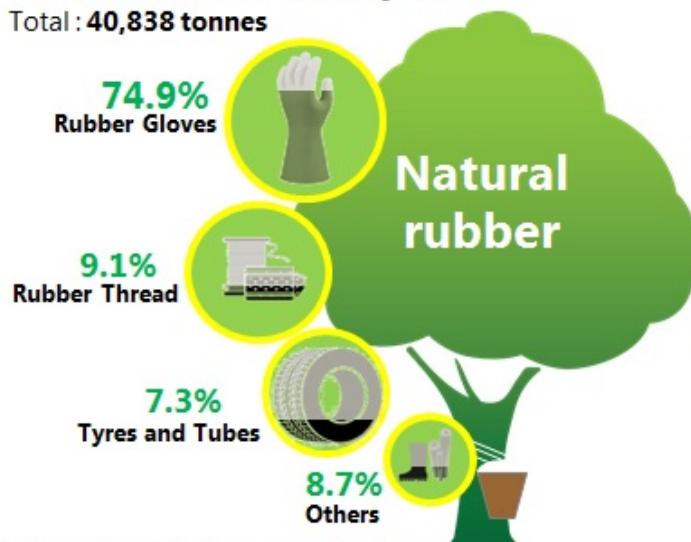

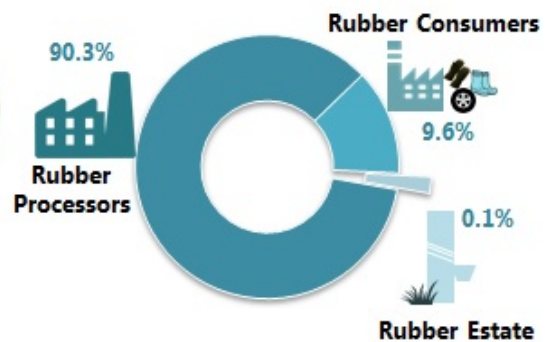

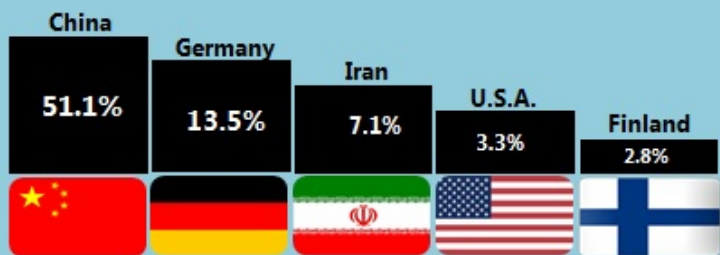

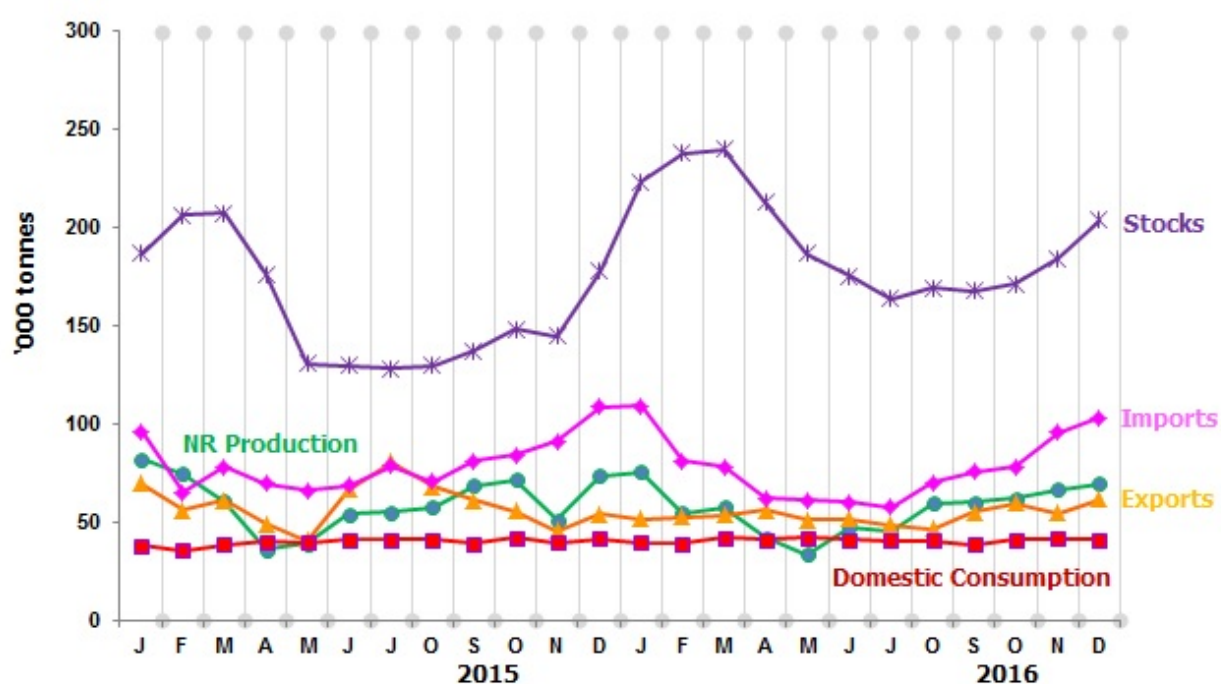
