

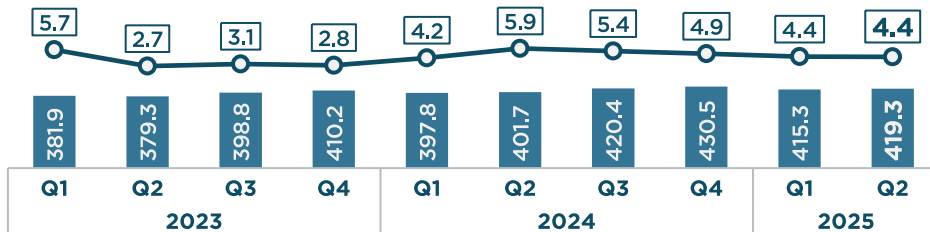

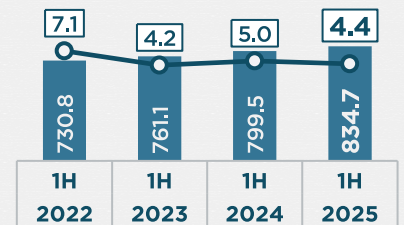
GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP), SECOND QUARTER OF 2025

driven mainly by the Services and Manufacturing sectors.

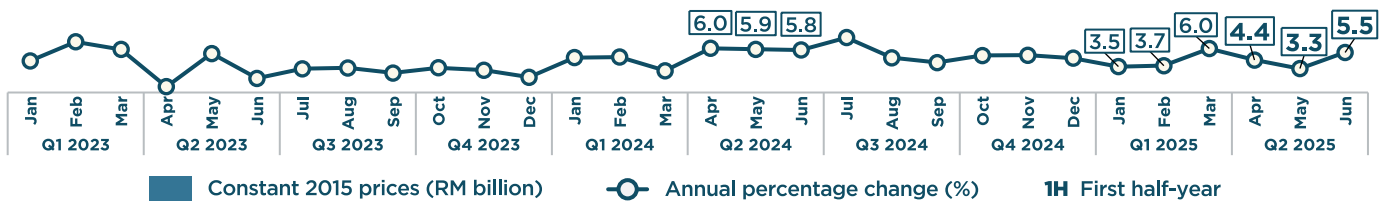

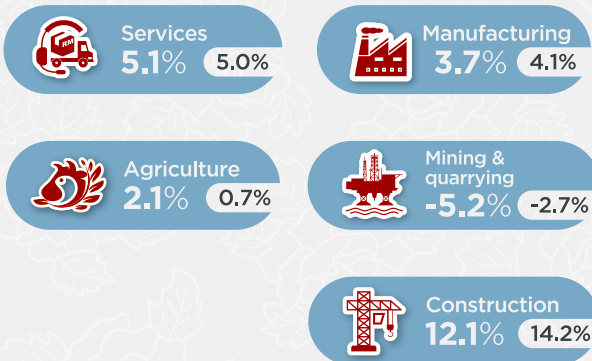

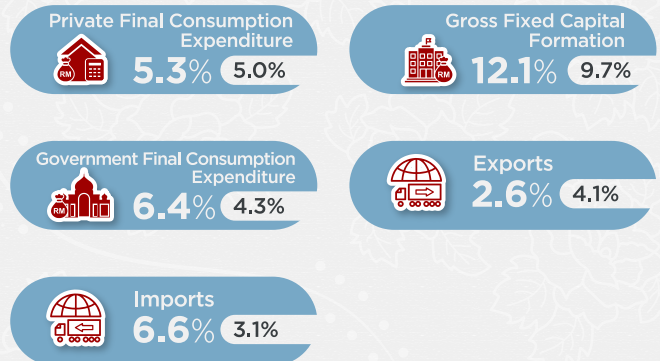
GDP PERFORMANCE BY KIND OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITY AND TYPE OF EXPENDITURE

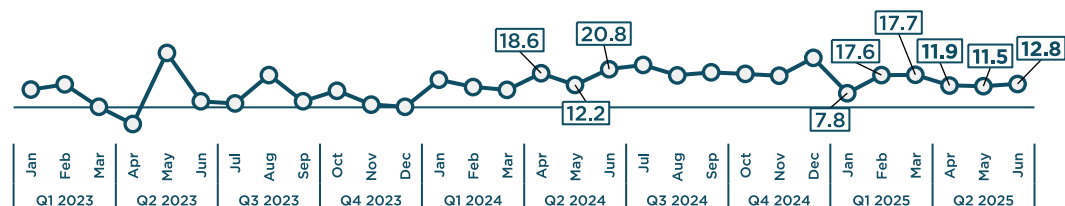

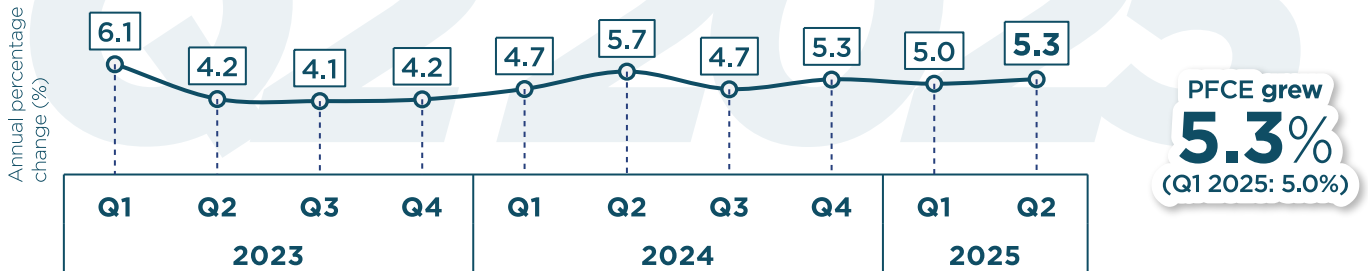

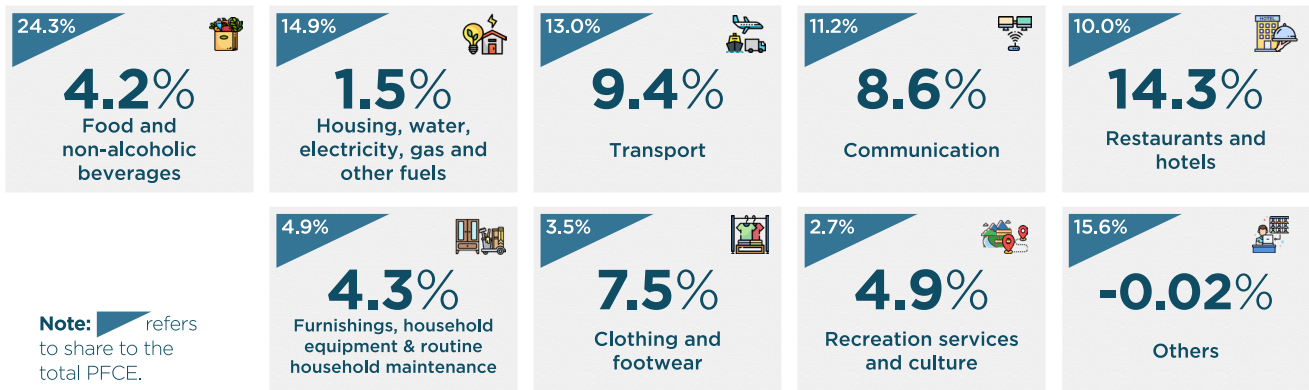

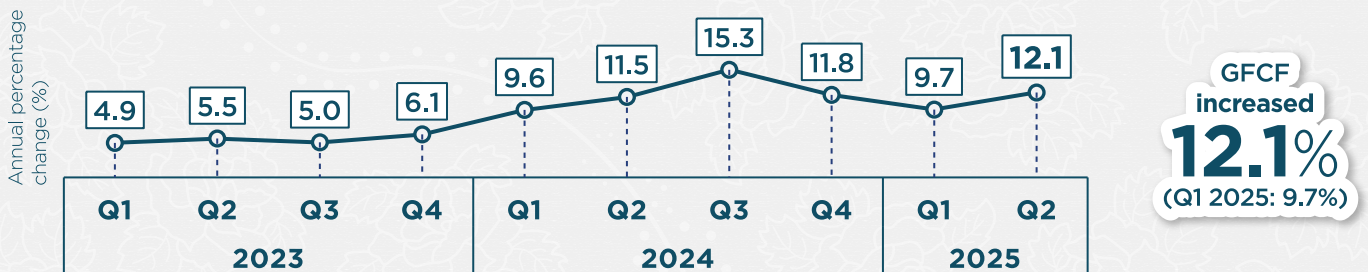
PRIVATE FINAL CONSUMPTION EXPENDITURE (PFCE)
