

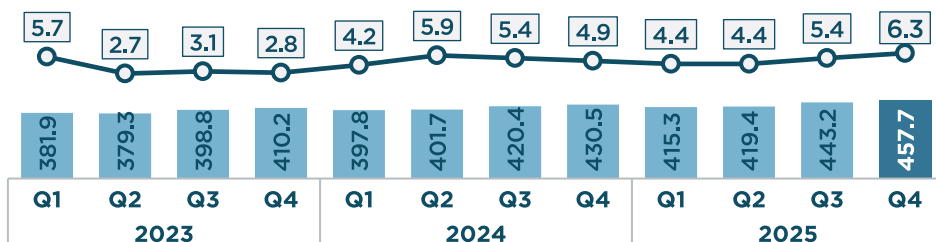

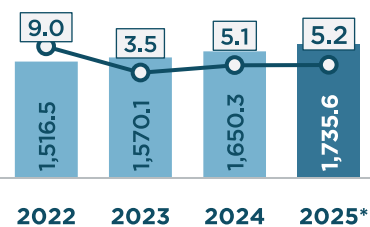
# GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP), FOURTH QUARTER OF 2025

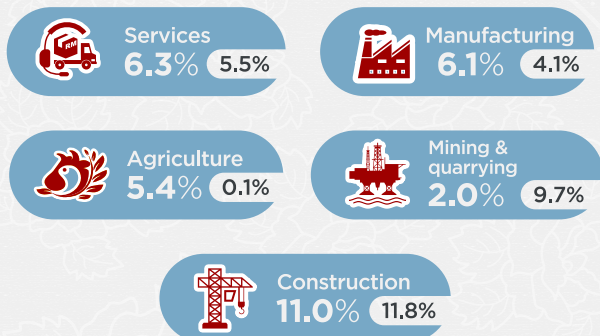

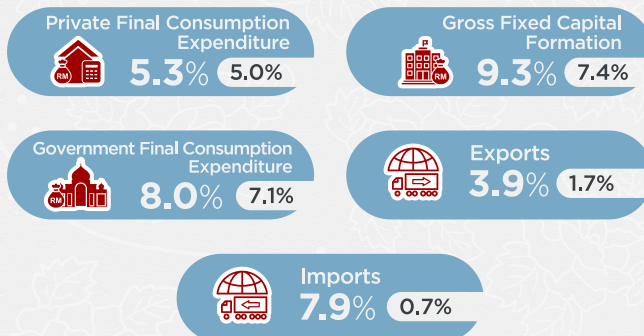

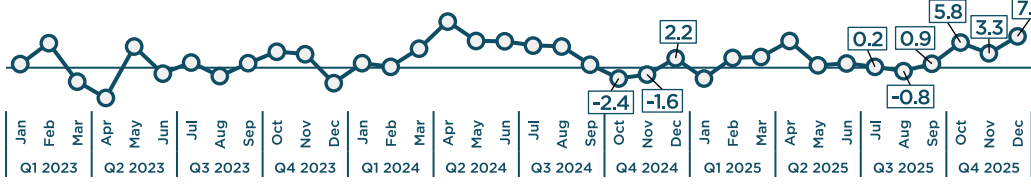

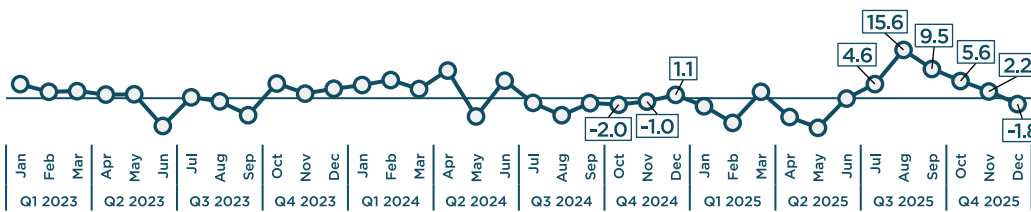

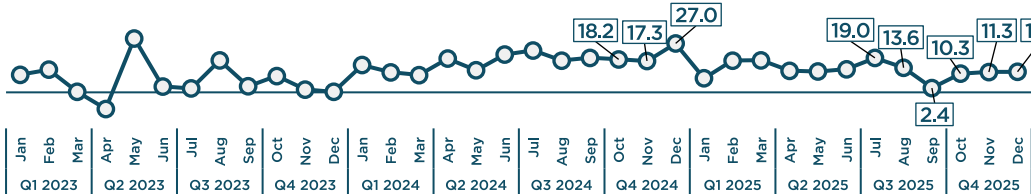

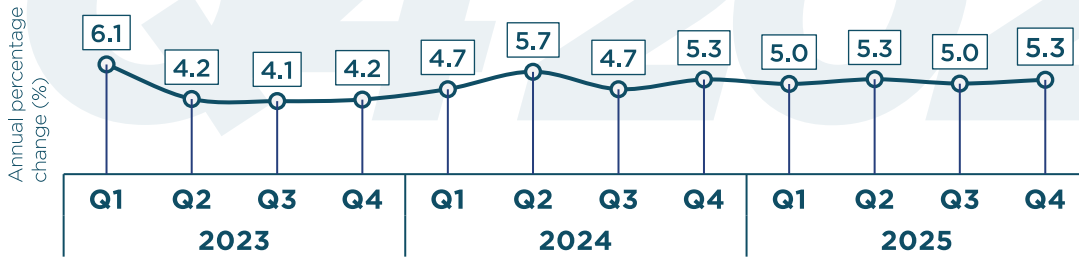

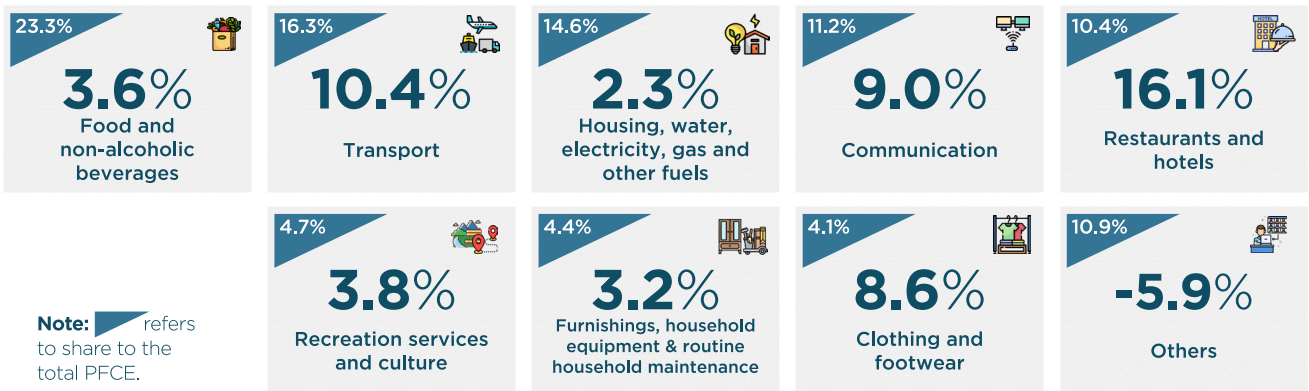


# PRIVATE FINAL CONSUMPTION EXPENDITURE (PFCE)



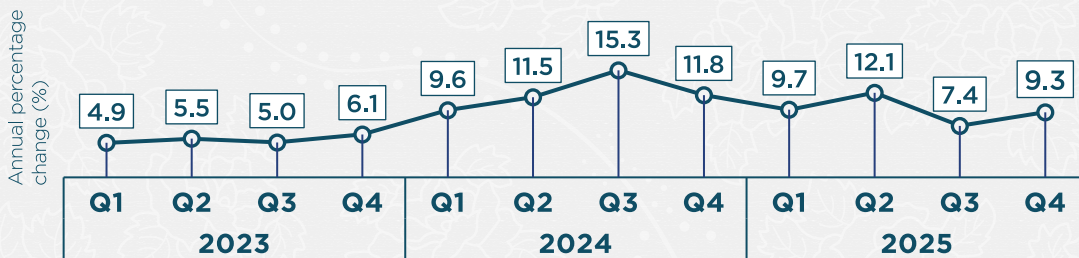
PFCE increased **5.3%**
