He had held the post of Deputy Chief Statistician (Programme Social/Demographic) before being appointed as the Chief Statistician of Malaysia.

He has served in the public service for over 36 years when he joined the Administrative and Diplomatic Service on 13<sup>th</sup> January 1986. YBhg. Datuk Dr. Mohd Gazali Abas is the former Secretary General of the Ministry of Education and Secretary General of the Ministry of Human Resources. In addition, he has also served as Director of the National Institute of Public Administration (INTAN), Deputy Secretary General (Operations) of the Ministry of Human Resources, Director of the Human Capital Development Section of the Economic Planning Unit of Prime Minister's Department and Executive Director of the Network of Asia Pacific Schools and Institutes of Public Administration and Governance (NAPSIPAG).

### Description of the Session
