KENYATAAN MEDIA BAGI PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, OKTOBER 2022

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan Malaysia berjumlah RM158.9 bilion pada Oktober 2022, meningkat 12.9 peratus berbanding setahun yang lalu

PUTRAJAYA, 12 Disember 2022 – Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan Malaysia berjumlah RM158.9 bilion pada Oktober 2022, meningkat 12.9 peratus berbanding setahun lalu. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Oktober 2022** pada hari ini.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Pertumbuhan dua digit yang berterusan bagi nilai jualan pada bulan Oktober 2022 dipacu terutamanya oleh subsektor Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik (23.8%), khususnya dalam industri Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis. Selain itu, pengembangan nilai jualan ini juga didorong oleh subsektor Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik (16.6%) dan Produk Makanan, Minuman dan Tembakau (4.6%) yang masing-masing disokong oleh industri Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal dan industri Pembuatan produk makanan."

Nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang lebih daripada dua pertiga atau 74.4 peratus daripada jumlah nilai jualan, terus mencatatkan pertumbuhan dua digit sebanyak 16.1 peratus pada Oktober 2022 (September 2022: 21.5%). Prestasi yang menggalakkan ini adalah selari dengan pertumbuhan eksport perdagangan luar negeri dan peningkatan harga. Selain itu, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan domestik merekodkan kenaikan 4.7 peratus, namun pada kadar sederhana berbanding pertumbuhan 13.9 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Berbanding dengan September 2022, nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport menyusut 2.9 peratus manakala industri berorientasikan domestik mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 1.6 peratus.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia menambah, "Jumlah pekerja sektor Pembuatan adalah seramai 2,321,179 orang pada bulan Oktober 2022, naik 3.6 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya (Oktober 2021: 2,241,048 orang). Peningkatan ini disumbangkan

oleh subsektor Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik (5.6%), Produk Makanan, Minuman dan Tembakau (4.3%) dan Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah dan Plastik (2.0%).”

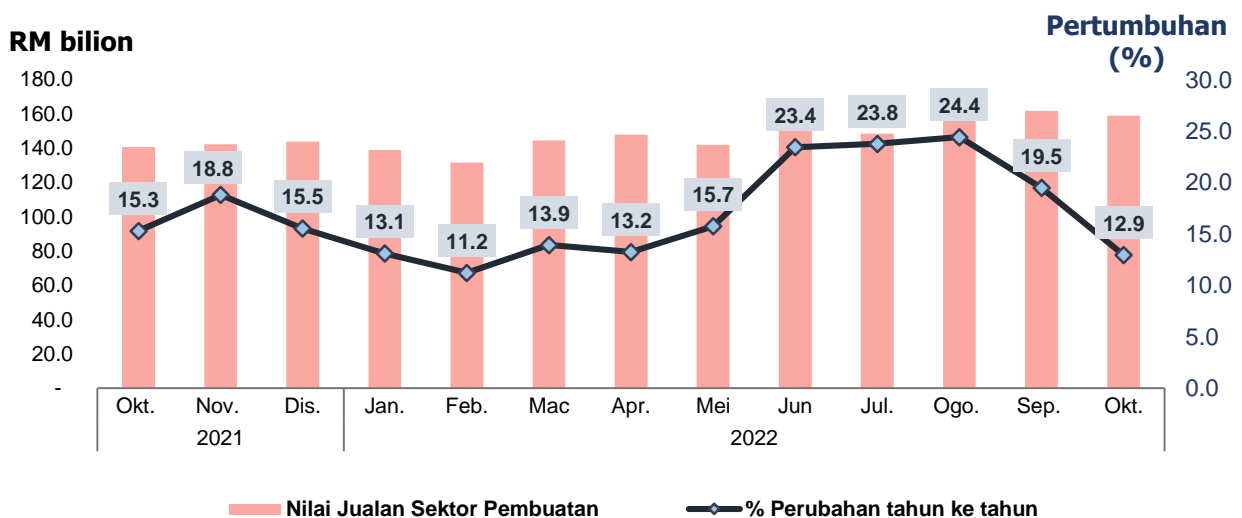
Selari dengan peningkatan pekerja, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat 4.8 peratus, berjumlah RM7,880.9 juta. Di samping itu, nilai jualan per pekerja meningkat 9.0 peratus kepada RM68,441 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2021 manakala purata gaji & upah setiap pekerja adalah sebanyak RM3,395.

Bagi tempoh Januari hingga Oktober 2022, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan melonjak 17.1 peratus kepada RM1,485.2 bilion berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun 2021. Pada masa yang sama, bilangan pekerja meningkat sebanyak 3.6 peratus kepada 2.32 juta orang dengan gaji & upah berkembang 5.3 peratus kepada RM78.1 bilion. Bagi tempoh tersebut, nilai jualan per pekerja merekodkan RM639,852 dengan pertumbuhan 13.0 peratus tahun ke tahun.

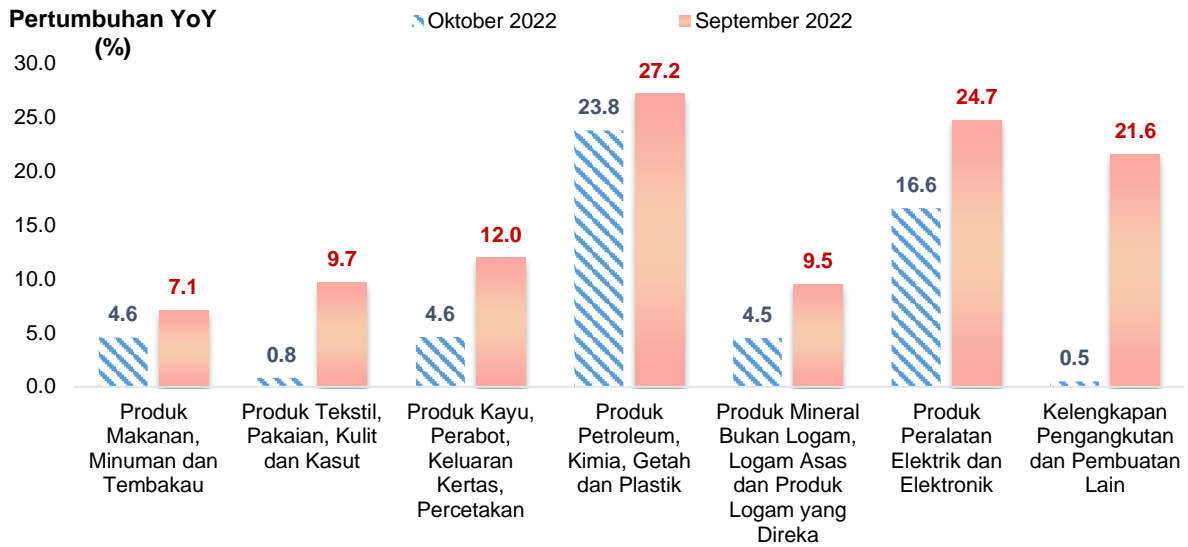

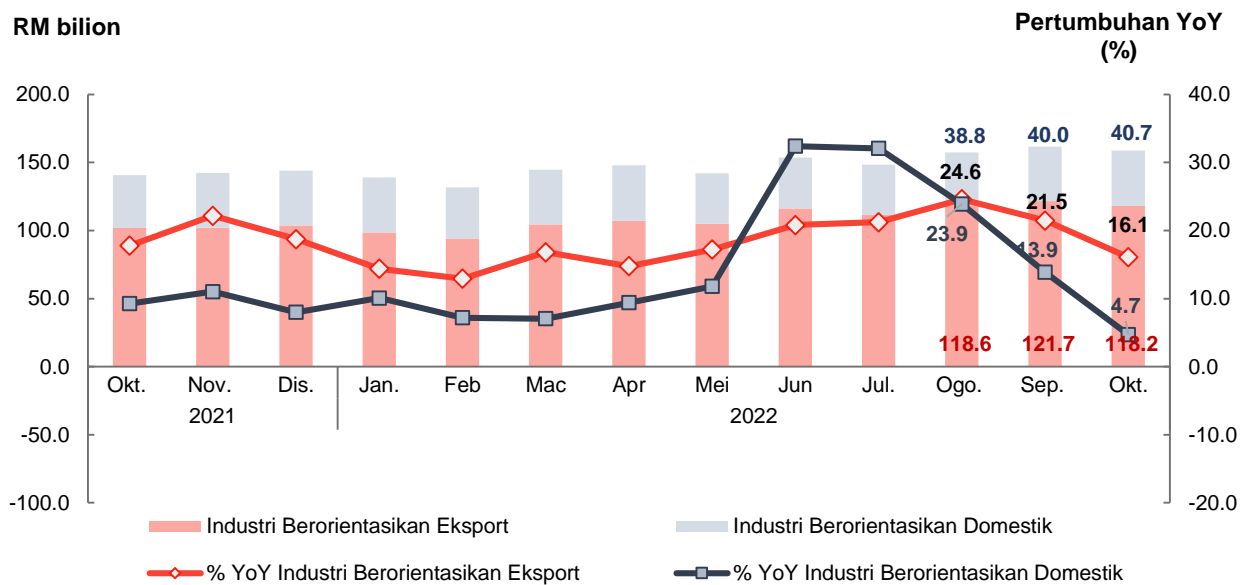
Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Oktober 2021 – Oktober 2022

Malaysia's Manufacturing sales value amounting to RM158.9 billion in October 2022, rose 12.9 per cent as compared to a year ago

PUTRAJAYA, 12 December 2022 - Malaysia's Manufacturing sales amounting to RM158.9 billion in October 2022, rose 12.9 per cent as compared to a year ago. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today on the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, October 2022**.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said, "The continuous double-digit growth in sales value for October 2022 was largely driven by the Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products subsector (23.8%), especially in the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products industries. In addition, the expansion in sales value was also contributed by the Electrical & Electronics Products (16.6%) and Food, Beverages & Tobacco Products (4.6%) subsectors, supported by the Manufacture of computer, electronic & optical products; and Manufacture of food products industries respectively."

The sales value of export-oriented industries which contributed more than two-thirds or 74.4 per cent of total sales, continued to register double-digit growth by 16.1 per cent in October 2022 (September 2022: 21.5%). The favourable performance was in line with the acceleration in external trade exports growth and price increases. On the other hand, sales value in domestic-oriented industries recorded an increase of 4.7 per cent, albeit at a moderate rate as compared to 13.9 per cent growth registered in the previous month. In comparison with September 2022, sales value for export-oriented industries declined by 2.9 per cent while domestic-oriented industries posted an increase of 1.6 per cent.

The Chief Statistician Malaysia added, "The total employees engaged in the Manufacturing sector accounted for 2,321,179 persons in October 2022, increased by 3.6 per cent as compared to year ago (October 2021: 2,241,048 persons). The increment was contributed by the Electrical & Electronic Products (5.6%), Food, Beverages & Tobacco Products (4.3%) and Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber and Plastic Products (2.0%) subsectors."

In line with the increase in number of employees, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector grew by 4.8 per cent, amounting to RM7,880.9 million. Besides that, the sales value per employee rose by 9.0 per cent to record RM68,441 as compared to the same month in 2021, while the average salaries & wages per employee was RM3,395.

For the period of January to October 2022, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector soared 17.1 per cent to RM1,485.2 billion as compared to the same period in 2021. In the meantime, the number of employees went up by 3.6 per cent to record a total of 2.32 million persons with salaries & wages expanded by 5.3 per cent to RM78.1 billion. During the period, sales value per employee amounted to RM639,852 with a growth of 13.0 per cent year-on-year.

Chart 1: Sales Value of the Manufacturing Sector, October 2021 – October 2022

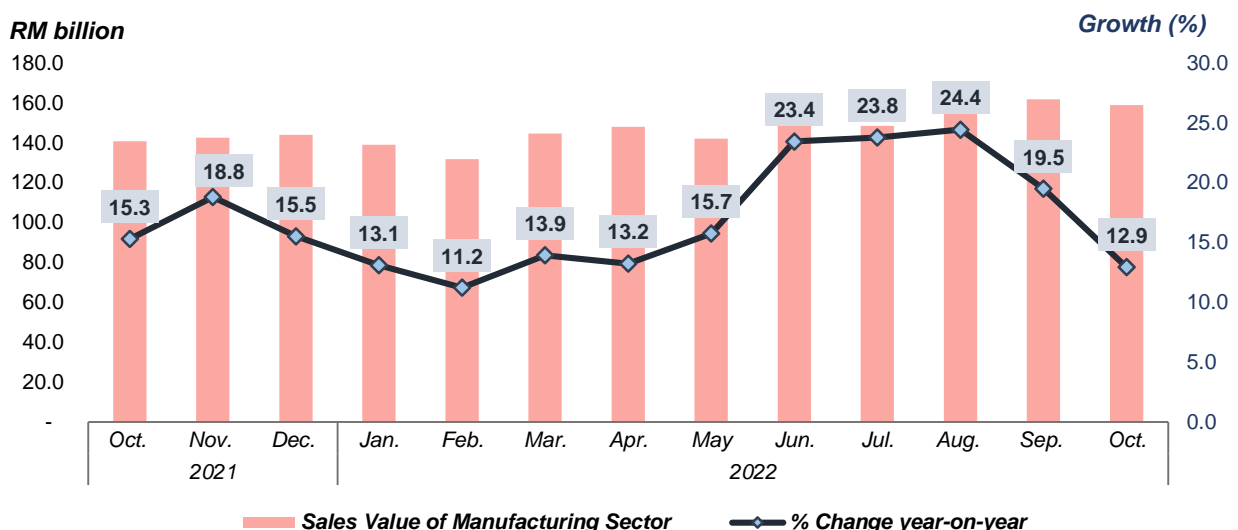


Chart 2: The Growth of Manufacturing Subsector in October 2022 as against September 2022

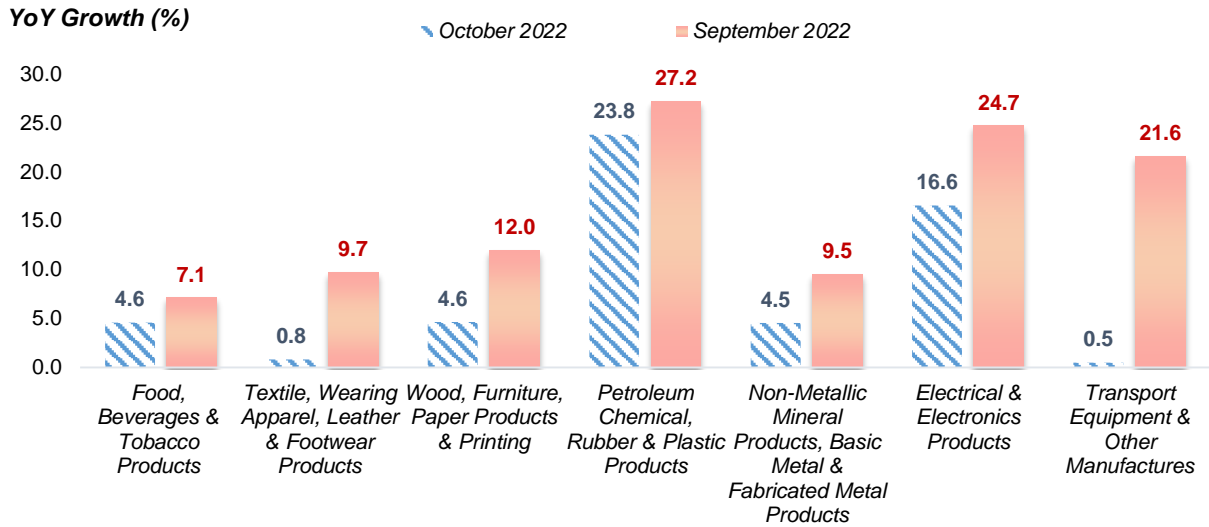
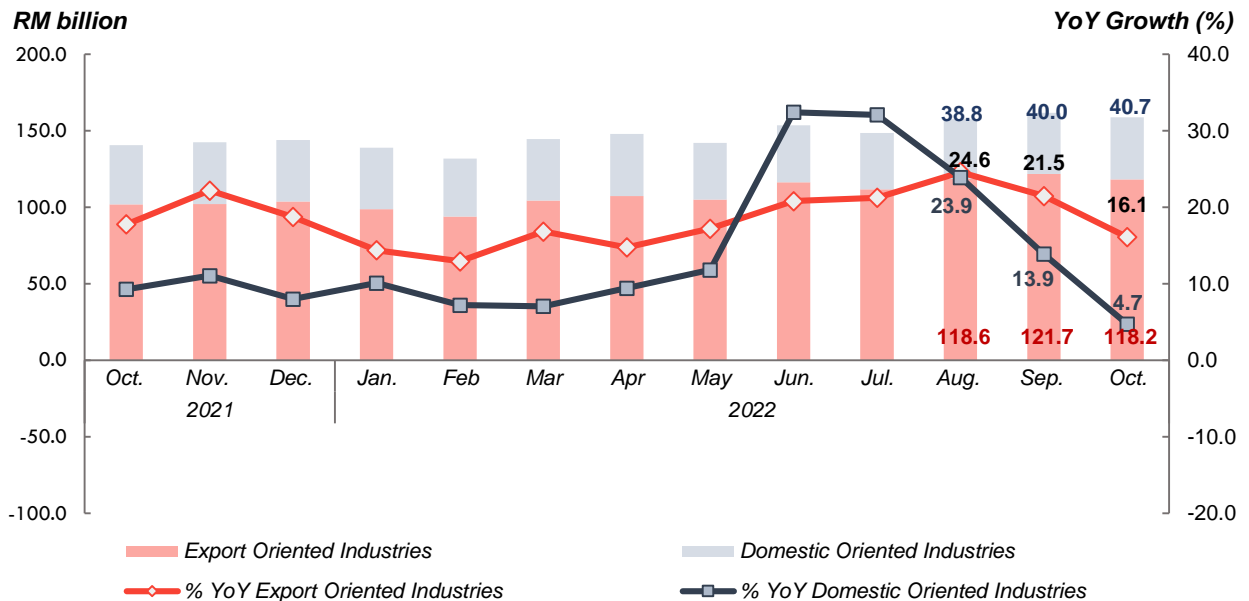


Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, October 2021 – October 2022
