

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTIC OF THE MALAY PENINSULAR

01 The world-position of the southern part of the Malay Peninsula.

02 Stable land area and free from seismic or volcanic disturbance.

03 Large river features.

04 Old limestone played a role in initiating the extremely rugged sculpture in hilly areas.

05 Tropical monsoon climate – north-east “monsoon” and south-west “monsoon”.

06 Covered by equatorial rainforest.



CENSUS OPERATION PHASES

1

The enumeration of dwellings phase

– the objective is to record the dwelling so that no dwelling is left behind during the census in each building that can be used as human residence.



2

The preliminary enumeration phase -

to obtain, in advance and relatively at leisure, a record, in full detail, approximating, as closely as possible, to the exact "snapshot" which will be obtained by the final enumeration.

3

The final or "instantaneous" enumeration phase

at which an endeavour is made to record the actual position at the theoretical instant of census-taking.


