

## Path of Pandemic



### Dec 2019

Cases of pneumonia from an unknown cause appear in Wuhan, China.



### Early 2020

Analysis suggests a novel coronavirus, originating from a seafood market.

### Jan 23, 2020

The outbreak reaches more than 500 cases across China, Japan, Thailand and the US.

On 25<sup>th</sup> January 2020, the first case of COVID-19 was detected in Malaysia and traced back to 3 Chinese nationals who previously had close contact with an infected person in Singapore.

Malaysia was no exception to receive the impact of this pandemic.


### Infection rates and fatalities over time

# Covid 19 Awareness

The occurrence of the COVID-19 pandemic has changed the world's socio-economic landscape as a whole since it was first detected at the end of 2019.

Consequently, Malaysia's Prime Minister has announced Phase 1 of Movement Control Order (MCO) from 18th March to 2nd April 2020.

Due to the increasing number of positive COVID-19 cases, later extended to Conditional MCO (CMCO) and followed by the Recovery MCO (RMCO) which takes more than three months.

To date, the government has reissued the implementation of CMCO in Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur, Wilayah Persekutuan Putrajaya, Selangor and several other areas effective from 14th October until 6th December 2020.


The most at risk are the elderly and those with underlying health conditions. For over 80's there is an almost 15% fatality rate, falling to 8% for those 70 to 79 year olds.



This bar chart shows the number of confirmed cases across Malaysia, 5 most infected states as of December 23rd, 2020.



CodeBlue, the hospital's ICU in Sabah is unable to accommodate so many severely ill Covid-19 patients. The state capital of Sabah has reported 1,582 local Covid-19 cases within the past 14 days as of October 22, including 233 new infections.
