There are two categories of frame at DOSM which are **Household (HH) Frame** for population and social data collection and **Establishment Frame** for economic data collection.

ESTABLISHMENT FRAME

HOUSEHOLD FRAME (HH)

1997 : Sistem Pangkalan Data Rangka Banci (SPDRB) was developed by using Dbase IV platform



2001 : Methodology Division took over management of HH frame



2007 : Platform was changed to Microsoft Access



2008 : The process of developing an online system known as NEWSS (National Enterprise Wide Statistical System)



2010 : NEWSS was used to replace SIDAP and SPDRB



Before 1993 : Controlled through Common Directory system in the Mainframe



1994 : The System was set up in a PC based using Dbase IV platform



1996 : Sistem Daftar Pusat (SIDAP) was developed into a Local Area Network (LAN) environment



2002 : SIDAP was upgraded to Wide Area Network (WAN)



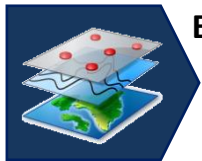


CONCEPTS & DEFINITIONS



HOUSEHOLD FRAME

“A complete list of Enumeration Block (EB) by State, Administrative District, Census District and strata which is each EB contains latest and complete information of Living Quarters (LQ), Institutional Living Quarters (ILQ), Non Living Quarters (NLQ) and Establishment”

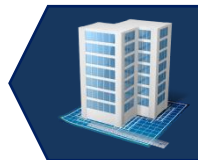


ENUMERATION BLOCK

A land area which is artificially created and consists of specific boundaries.

BUILDING UNIT

A building structure distinctly separated from neighbouring space. One building unit may consist one or more LQ/Establishment inside.



LIVING QUARTERS

A separated structure and independent usually used as a place of abode permanently or temporarily.

INSTITUTIONAL LIVING QUARTERS

LQ occupied by a group of individuals such as hotel, hostel, hospital and others.



NON LIVING QUARTERS

Basically not used as dwellings unit such as mosque, church, school and others.

HOUSEHOLD

A person or group of related or unrelated persons who usually live together and make common provision for food and other living essentials.



HOUSEHOLD'S MEMBER

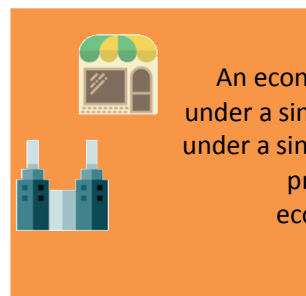
Those who usually lives in one LQ within 3 months and more.

ESTABLISHMENT FRAME

“Ideally, an economic unit which engages, under a single ownership or control, i.e. under a single legal entity, in one, or predominantly one, kind of economic activity at a single location”

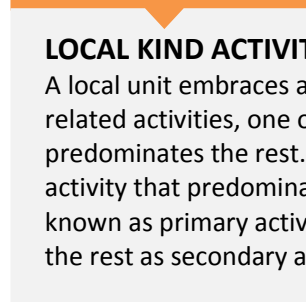

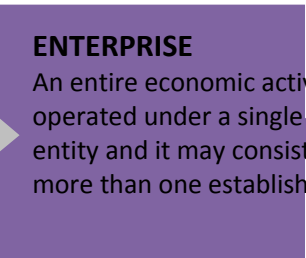
ESTABLISHMENT

An economic unit which engages, under a single ownership or control, under a single legal entity, in one, or predominantly one, kind of economic activity at a single location.



LOCAL KIND ACTIVITY UNIT

A local unit embraces a range of related activities, one of which predominates the rest. The activity that predominates is known as primary activity and the rest as secondary activities.



ENTERPRISE

An entire economic activity operated under a single legal entity and it may consist of more than one establishment.



ENTERPRISE GROUP

The operations of a set of legal entities, which are resident in one country and connected to a parent-subsidiary relationship.
